PROJECTING THE IMAGE OF YOUNG PEOPLE

A GROUP OF MORE THAN 130 WORKING YOUTHS, STUDENTS, VOLUNTEERS AND MEMBERS OF COMMUNITY CENTRES WILL BE STAGING A MUSICAL PLAY AT THE CITY HALL CONCERT HALL ON THURSDAY EVENING (AUGUST 29).

THE PLAY, ENTITLED +POPCORN+ PROJECTS THE IMAGE OF YOUNG PEOPLE TO SHOW THAT WITH GUIDANCE AND CARE THEY CAN BECOME USEFUL MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY WHEN PROVIDED WITH OUTLETS FOR THEIR VITALITY AND ENERGY.

A THEME SONG HAS ALSO BEEN SPECIALLY COMPOSED FOR THE PLAY WHICH WILL RUN CONTINUOUSLY FOR 80 MINUTES. MUSIC WILL BE PROVIDED BY TWO POP GROUPS, +THE FOUR CHRISTIANS+, +THE RUSTIC THEME+ AND THREE SOLOISTS.

THIS PLAY WILL FORM THE MAIN EVENT IN THE CLOSING CEREMONY TO MARK THE END OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S 1974 SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMMES.

THE GROUP WHO WILL BE STAGING THE MUSICAL ARE YOUNG PEOPLE WHO HAVE EITHER PARTICIPATED IN THE PROGRAMMES OR ARE MEMBERS OF THE DEPARTMENT'S GROUP AND COMMUNITY WORK DIVISION'S COMMUNITY CENTRES AND YOUTH CLUBS.

FUN FAIR FOR TSZ WAN SHAN CHILDREN

A GROUP OF YOUNG PEOPLE IN KOULOON'S TSZ WAN SHAN HOUSING ESTATE ARE ORGANISING A FUN FAIR FOR CHILDREN IN THE ESTATE BETWEEN SIX AND FOURTEEN YEARS OF AGE.

WITH ENCOURAGEMENT FROM THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S COMMUNITY WORK OFFICE THERE, THE GROUP - ABOUT 30 IN ALL - ARE PLANNING AND PREPARING FOR THE FAIR THEMSELVES DURING THEIR SPARE TIME.

THE FAIR IS TO BE HELD AT THE HALL OF THE ESTATE WELFARE BUILDING ON WEDNESDAY (AUGUST 28) FROM 1 P.M. TO 6 P.M. AND WILL BE IN FIVE SESSIONS ENTERTAINING A TOTAL OF ABOUT 1,000 CHILDREN TO AN AFTERNOON OF FUN AND GAMES.

PRIZES FOR THE OCCASION HAVE BEEN DONATED BY A NUMBER OF INDUSTRIAL ORGANIZATIONS.

MRS. SIU LAW GOOK-FONG, OFFICER-IN-CHARGE OF THE COMMUNITY WORK OFFICE, SAID IT WAS HOPED THAT THE YOUTHS, IN ORGANIZING THIS RECREATIONAL ACTIVITY FOR CHILDREN, WILL REALISE SOME OF THE PROBLEMS EXISTING IN THEIR SURROUNDINGS AND SEE HOW THEY CAN HELP TO IMPROVE THE WELFARE OF THEIR COMMUNITY.

NEW PARKING METERS IN WAN CHAI

MOTORISTS USING PARKING METERS IN THE WAN CHAI AREA ON HONG KONG ISLAND ARE ADVISED TO MAKE SURE THAT THE CORRECT COINS ARE INSERTED.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SAID THAT THE CHANGE-OVER OF OLD RATE METERS IN THE AREA TO THOSE WITH THE NEW RATES HAD BEEN COMPLETED.

+UNLIKE THE OLD RATE ONES THE METERS DO NOT TAKE 10-CENT COINS. THEY ACCEPT ONLY 50-CENT OR \$1 COINS DEPENDING ON THE TYPE OF THE METER,+ HE SAID.

HE EXPLAINED THAT UNDER THE NEW RATE SYSTEM THERE ARE TWO TYPES OF TWO-HOUR METERS — ONE WHICH ACCEPTS 50-CENT COINS FOR 30 MINUTES, AND THE OTHER WHICH TAKES 50-CENT COINS FOR ONE HOUR. AT THE NEW RATE HALF-HOUR METERS, THE CHARGE IS A FLAT \$1.

+IT WILL BE IN THE INTEREST OF THE MOTORISTS TO READ CAREFULLY THE REGULATIONS PRINTED ON THE METAL PLATE ATTACHED TO THE PARKING METER TO ENSURE THAT THEY INSERT THE CORRECT COINS,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE CONVERSION WORK, INVOLVING ABOUT 1,400 METERS IN THE AREA, WAS COMPLETED ON WEDNESDAY (AUGUST 21).
