NEW MEASURES TO REGULATE ORDER OUTSIDE POLLING STATIONS
* * * * *

A NUMBER OF NEW MEASURES WILL BE ADOPTED ON THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ELECTION DAY ON SEPTEMBER 15 TO REGULATE ORDER OUTSIDE POLLING STATIONS.

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY (SATURDAY), A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION SAID THEY INCLUDED THE INTRODUCTION OF A BUFFER ZONE SCHEME OUTSIDE POLLING STATIONS WHERE HIGH VOTER TURNOUT AND INTENSIVE CANVASSING ACTIVITIES WERE EXPECTED.

"THE SCHEME AIMS TO GIVE EACH CANDIDATE A FAIR CHANCE TO PROMOTE HIMSELF WITHOUT AFFECTING THE ORDER OF ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE THE POLLING STATIONS AND WITHOUT OBSTRUCTING THE FREE FLOW OF VOTERS TO AND FROM THE POLLING STATIONS," HE SAID.

THE BUFFER ZONES WILL BE CLEARLY MARKED ON THE GROUND WHILE PLANS SHOWING THE BOUNDARY OF THE ZONES WILL ALSO BE ON DISPLAY AT THE RESPECTIVE POLLING STATIONS.

"A MAXIMUM OF TWO PEOPLE PER CANDIDATE WILL BE ALLOWED TO OPERATE IN THESE ZONES AT ANY ONE TIME AND THEY WILL BE IDENTIFIED BY ARM-BANDS ISSUED BY THE RETURNING OFFICER.

"AT SOME POLLING STATIONS WHERE THE GEOGRAPHY OF THE VICINITY OF THE STATIONS DICTATES, ONLY ONE PERSON PER CANDIDATE WILL BE PERMITTED," THE SPOKESMAN EXPLAINED.

"PERSONS OPERATING IN THE BUFFER ZONES WILL BE ADVISED TO CONDUCT THEIR CANVASSING ACTIVITIES ORDERLY AND RESPONSIBLY.

"THE USE OF AMPLIFYING DEVICES WILL NOT BE ALLOWED AND POLICE OFFICERS WILL BE ON DUTY TO MAINTAIN LAW AND ORDER," HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO POINTED OUT THAT NO DISPLAY OF POSTERS, FLAGS, BANNERS, PLACARDS OR OTHER PUBLICITY MATERIAL WOULD BE ALLOWED IN THE BUFFER ZONES EXCEPT WITH THE PRIOR PERMISSION OF THE RETURNING OFFICER.

ALL AUTHORISED DISPLAYS WILL HAVE TO MEET CERTAIN CONDITIONS AND MUST BE REMOVED IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE CLOSE OF THE POLLS AT 10.30 PM ON SEPTEMBER 15.

CANDIDATES ARE BEING INVITED TO ATTEND MEETINGS CHAIRED BY THE RETURNING OFFICERS WHERE THE SCHEME WILL BE EXPLAINED IN DETAIL.

THEY WILL ALSO BE ASKED TO SIGN AN UNDERTAKING TO DEMONSTRATE THEIR PLEDGE OF SUPPORT FOR THE SCHEME.

ANOTHER NEW MEASURE FOR THE ELECTIONS INVOLVES THE DESIGNATION OF AREAS IN THE IMMEDIATE VICINITY OF SELECTED POLLING STATIONS AS KEY SPOTS FOR THE DISPLAY OF PUBLICITY MATERIAL ON ELECTION DAY AND THE DAY BEFORE.

/THESE DISPLAY

THESE DISPLAY SPOTS ARE ALLOCATED TO CANDIDATES BY BALLOT CONDUCTED BY RETURNING OFFICERS IN THE FIRST OR SECOND WEEK OF SEPTEMBER.

"CANDIDATES HOWEVER ARE REQUIRED TO REMOVE ALL ELECTION PUBLICITY MATERIAL ON DISPLAY AT THESE NEW SPOTS WITHIN 24 HOURS FOLLOWING THE ELECTIONS, INSTEAD OF THE NORMAL PERIOD OF SEVEN DAYS," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN AGAIN EMPHASISED THE IMPORTANCE OF CANDIDATES SEEKING APPROVAL BEFORE PUTTING UP ANY ELECTION MATERIAL, EVEN ON THE DAY OF ELECTIONS.

ANY UNAUTHORISED DISPLAYS MAY BE SUBJECT TO REMOVAL AT VERY SHORT NOTICE ON ELECTION DAY.

"AT PRESENT, THE USUAL PRACTICE OF MOST DISTRICTS IS TO GIVE CANDIDATES 24-HOUR NOTICE BEFORE REMOVAL ACTION IS TAKEN.

"HOWEVER, ON ELECTION DAY AND THE DAY BEFORE, CANDIDATES WILL BE GIVEN ONLY VERY SHORT NOTICE, SUCH AS AN HOUR OR TWO, AFTER WHICH UNAUTHORISED DISPLAYS WILL BE LIABLE REMOVAL FORTHWITH," HE SAID.

MEANWHILE, THERE WILL BE STAFF ON DUTY IN THE DISTRICT OFFICES FROM 9 AM TO 6 PM ON SATURDAY, SEPTEMBER 14, THE DAY BEFORE THE ELECTIONS, TO RECEIVE ENQUIRIES OR COMPLAINTS FROM CANDIDATES.

HK'S RECREATION AND CULTURE IN GOOD PROGRESS

* * * * *

THROUGH THE JOINT EFFORTS OF THE GOVERNMENT AND VARIOUS ORGANISATIONS, SUBSTANTIAL PROGRESS HAD BEEN MADE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF RECREATION AND CULTURE, THE SECRETARY FOR RECREATION AND CULTURE, MR JAMES SO, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF A CARNIVAL ORGANISED BY THE PENINSULA JAYCEES' AT THE NEW WORLD PLAZA IN TSIM SHA TSUI, MR SO SAID HONG KONG HAD DONE WELL IN MANY INTERNATIONAL SPORTS EVENTS IN RECENT YEARS, SUCH AS BADMINTON, TABLE-TENNIS, BOWLING, FENCING, WIND-SURFING, SQUASH, SWIMMING, JUDO, CYCLING AND MARTIAL ARTS.

HE SAID FOLLOWING THE RECENT ESTABLISHMENT OF THE HONG KONG SPORTS DEVELOPMENT BOARD (SDB) AND THE RE-NAMING OF THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE AS THE HONG KONG SPORTS INSTITUTE, THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE HONG KONG'S SCENE HAS ENTERED A NEW ERA.

"SDB HAS JUST MAPPED OUT ITS FIVE YEAR STRATEGIC PLAN EARLY THIS YEAR AND WILL CO-ORDINATE THE WORK OF THOSE MAJOR SPORTS ORGANISATION. IT WILL BE TASKED TO STRENGTHEN THE COMMUNICATIONS AMONG ALL NATIONAL SPORTS ASSOCIATIONS.

"THE BOARD WILL ALSO ENHANCE HONG KONG'S INTERNATIONAL STATUS BY FOCUSING ON THE TRAINING OF COACHES AND ADMINISTRATIVE PERSONNELS, SPORTS SCIENCE, SPORTS MEDICINE AND RESEARCH WORK," MR SO SAID.

MR SO SAID THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE COUNCIL FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS (CFPA) WAS A SIGNIFICANT INITIATIVE IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF ARTS IN HONG KONG.

"THE COUNCIL WAS GIVEN THE TASK OF ADVISING THE GOVERNMENT ON HOW BEST ARTS DEVELOPMENT COULD BE PROMOTED AND ENSURING OPTIMUM USE OF GOVERNMENT RESOURCES TO MEET THE NEEDS OF PERFORMING ARTS GROUPS IN HONG KONG.

"OVER THE PAST FIVE YEARS OR SO, CFPA'S BUDGET HAS BEEN INCREASED FROM \$16.3 MILLION TO \$ 35.14 MILLION. THE NUMBER OF ARTS GROUPS BENEFITTING FROM THE COUNCIL'S GRANTS BENEFITTED HAS ALSO DOUBLED FROM 30 TO 60," HE SAID.

MR SO SAID THE HONG KONG ACADEMY FOR PERFORMING ARTS HAD RAISED THE STANDARD OF PERFORMING ARTS AND HAD TRAINED UP SOME 500 TALENTS SINCE ITS INCEPTION IN 1984.

"PROFESSIONAL TRAINING IN DANCE, DRAMA, MUSIC AND TECHNICAL ARTS IS BEING PROVIDED BY THE ACADEMY. IN ADDITION TO FULL-TIME THREE-YEAR DIPLOMA COURSES, THE ACADEMY ALSO PROVIDE TWO-YEAR CERTIFICATE AND PART-TIME EVENING COURSES.

"FROM NEXT SEPTEMBER, THE ACADEMY WILL BEGIN TO HAVE DEGREE COURSES IN MUSIC, DANCE AND DRAMA," HE ADDED.

IN THE PAST, THE DEVELOPMENT OF ARTS IN HONG KONG HAS BEEN FUNDED ESSENTIALLY BY THE GOVERNMENT. HOWEVER, THE CFPA LAST YEAR LAUNCHED A MATCHING GRANT SCHEME TO ENCOURAGE BUSINESS SPONSORSHIP TOWARDS ARTS.

"IN JUNE 1990, A GROUP OF ENTHUSIASTIC BUSINESSMEN ESTABLISHED A FOUNDATION OF BUSINESS IN SUPPORT OF THE ARTS (FBSA). ITS MAIN OBJECTIVE ARE TO PROMOTE DEVELOPMENT OF ARTS IN HONG KONG, TO ASSIST THE ARTS IN OBTAINING SPONSORS AND TO HELP FUND CULTURAL EVENTS FEATURING HONG KONG ARTISTS," MR SO SAID.

HE SAID THERE WERE ALTOGETHER EIGHT MUSIC CENTRES UNDER THE MUSIC OFFICE OF THE RECREATION AND CULTURE BRANCH PROVIDING AN INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC TRAINING FOR YOUNG PEOPLE.

"AT PRESENT, THE MUSIC OFFICE RUNS MORE THAN 700 TRAINING CLASSES IN BOTH CHINESE AND WESTERN INSTRUMENTS FOR OVER 3,500 STUDENTS; AS WELL AS ORCHESTRAL TRAINING FOR OVER 4,800 YOUNGSTERS.

"THE MUSIC OFFICE ORGANISES MORE THAN 300 CONCERTS ANNUALLY FOR SOME 170,000 AUDIENCES," MR SO SAID.

MORE GOVT SPENDING ON SERVICES FOR ELDERLY

* * * * *

GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE ON SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY HAS INCREASED FROM \$500 MILLION IN 1982 TO \$2,260 MILLION THIS YEAR, THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MRS ROSE GOODSTADT, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE SIK SIK YUEN HO SHING HOME FOR THE ELDERLY AT KWONG YUEN ESTATE, SHA TIN, MRS GOODSTADT NOTED THAT THERE WAS A SIGNIFICANT IMPROVEMENT TO SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY IN THE PAST 10 YEARS.

"TO ENABLE THE ELDERLY TO REMAIN PART OF THE COMMUNITY, A RANGE OF COMMUNITY SUPPORTIVE SERVICES AND RESIDENTIAL FACILITIES HAS BEEN PROVIDED ON A DISTRICT BASIS," SHE SAID.

"IT IS ESTIMATED THAT TODAY WE NEED 256 SOCIAL CENTRES FOR THE ELDERLY, 30 MULTI-SERVICES CENTRES AND 30 DAY CARE CENTRES, IN ADDITION TO 7,693 PLACES IN HOMES FOR THE AGED AND 8,462 CARE-AND-ATTENTION PLACES TO COPE WITH THE NEEDS OF OUR SENIOR CITIZENS," SHE ADDED.

MRS GOODSTADT SAID NEW SERVICES, SUCH AS RESPITE SERVICE AND OUT-REACHING SERVICE, WERE BEING EXPERIMENTED AND DEVELOPED TO PROVIDE BETTER SUPPORT FOR THE CARE OF THE ELDERLY.

SHE ALSO COMMENDED SIK SIK YUEN FOR THEIR CLOSE CO-OPERATION WITH GOVERNMENT AND ENTHUSIASM IN EXPANDING SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY.

NATURE EDUCATION CENTRE DRAWS CROWDS

* * * * *

MORE THAN 36,000 VISITORS HAVE TOURED THE LIONS NATURE EDUCATION CENTRE IN TSIU HANG, SAI KUNG, SINCE IT WAS OPENED THREE MONTHS AGO.

THE SENIOR COUNTRY PARKS OFFICER OF THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT (AFD), MR C.C. LAY, WHO IS IN CHARGE OF THE CENTRE, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY) THAT SO FAR ABOUT 2,800 PEOPLE HAD MADE USE OF THE CENTRE'S GROUP BOOKING AND GUIDED TOUR FACILITY.

"OTHER VISITORS CAME IN SELF-ORGANISED GROUPS BUT THE MAJORITY ARE FAMILIES SPENDING A DAY OUT AT THE CENTRE ON WEEKENDS," HE SAID.

A SMALL-SCALE OPINION SURVEY CONDUCTED BY THE CENTRE LAST MONTH SHOWED THAT THE THREE EXHIBITION HALLS ON HONG KONG'S AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES AND COUNTRYSIDE RESOURCES, THE SPECIMEN ORCHARD, AND THE CHINESE HERBAL GARDEN WERE MOST FAVOURED BY VISITORS.

"WE ARE GLAD TO LEARN THAT MOST VISITORS POLLED FELT THAT THEIR TRIP HAD BEEN MEANINGFUL AND EDUCATIONAL, PARTICULARLY FOR THE YOUNG.

"THE RESPONDENTS HAD ALSO MADE SOME POSITIVE SUGGESTIONS ON IMPROVING FACILITIES AND ADDING NEW ITEMS OF INTEREST, WHICH WE WILL TRY TO ADOPT AS FAR AS RESOURCES PERMIT," MR LAY SAID.

NOTING THAT MANY VISITORS HAD POINTED OUT THE NEED TO SET UP A CAFETERIA AT THE CENTRE, MR LAY SAID PLANS FOR THIS FACILITY WERE NOW IN HAND AND IT WAS HOPED THAT WORK ON THE CAFETERIA COULD START IN NOVEMBER THIS YEAR.

"WE ARE ALSO ACTIVELY WORKING ON NEW ATTRACTIONS AT THE CENTRE, WHICH INCLUDE A TURF CORNER DISPLAYING DIFFERENT GRASS SPECIES, A BAMBOO COLLECTION, AND THE SKELETON AND WET MOUNT OF A PYGMY SPERM WHALE.

"MOREOVER, WE HAVE A PLANTATION PROGRAMME TO STAGGER THE GROWTH OF SEASONAL VEGETABLES AND BEAN AND FRUIT CROPS TO ENSURE THAT THERE IS ALWAYS SOMETHING ON DISPLAY IN THE ECONOMIC CROPS SECTION," MR LAY SAID.

MR LAY ADMITTED THAT THERE HAD BEEN CASES OF VANDALISM BY VISITORS EVEN THOUGH THE SITUATION WAS NOT SERIOUS ON THE WHOLE.

"IN ORDER THAT MORE PEOPLE CAN BENEFIT FROM THE CENTRE, I APPEAL TO THE PUBLIC TO EXERCISE SELF-DISCIPLINE AND NOT TO DAMAGE THE ITEMS ON DISPLAY, WHETHER THEY ARE INDOORS OR OUTDOORS," HE SAID.

HE ADDED THAT VANDALISING FACILITIES AT THE CENTRE IS AN OFFENCE UNDER THE COUNTRY PARKS ORDINANCE WHICH CARRIES A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$2,000 AND THREE MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT.

THE LIONS NATURE EDUCATION CENTRE, THE FIRST OF ITS KIND TO DISPLAY THE RICHNESS OF HONG KONG'S RURAL HERITAGE, FEATURES THREE EXHIBITION HALLS, AN ARBORETUM, ORCHARDS, FIELD CROPS, A CHINESE HERBAL GARDEN, A ROCK AND MINERAL CORNER AND A POULTRY CORNER.

IT IS EASILY ACCESSIBLE BY KMB ROUTE 92 AND GREEN MINIBUS ROUTE 1, BOTH OF WHICH RUN FROM CHOI HUNG TO SAI KUNG.

THE CENTRE IS OPEN DAILY FROM 9.30 AM TO 5 PM EXCEPT ON TUESDAY. ADMISSION IS FREE. FOR GROUP BOOKINGS, PLEASE CALL 733 2121.

HONG KONG AWARDED IN MAP DESIGN COMPETITION

A MAP PRODUCED BY THE SURVEY AND MAPPING OFFICE OF THE BUILDINGS AND LANDS DEPARTMENT HAS WON TOP HONOUR IN AN INTERNATIONAL MAP DESIGN COMPETITION.

THE SMALL SCALE MAP ON ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION IN HONG KONG HAS WON THIS YEAR'S JOHN BARTHOLOMEW AWARD IN THE THEMATIC MAP CATEGORY COMPETITION ORGANISED BY THE BRITISH CARTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY.

THE MAP WITH ILLUSTRATIONS AND DATA GIVES INFORMATIVE REFERENCE MATERIAL ON VARIOUS ASPECTS OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION WORK IN THE TERRITORY.

THIS MAP HAS SINCE BEEN REPRODUCED AND USED AS THE END PAPER MAP ON THE BACK COVER OF THE HONG KONG ANNUAL REPORT 1991 PUBLISHED BY THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SERVICES.

MEANWHILE, ANOTHER MAP SUBMITTED BY THE SURVEY AND MAPPING OFFICE HAS ALSO BEEN HIGHLY COMMENDED IN THE SAME MAP CATEGORY OF THE COMPETITION.

THE SECOND MAP IS THE NORTH-WEST NEW TERRITORIES MAP FROM THE COUNTRYSIDE SERIES.

1,211 TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS REPORTED IN AUGUST

* * * * *

A TOTAL OF 1,656 CASUALTIES WERE REPORTED IN 1,211 TRAFFIC ACCIDENTS WHICH OCCURRED THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY IN AUGUST THIS YEAR.

A POLICE SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SATURDAY) THAT 319 OF THESE ACCIDENTS OCCURRED ON HONG KONG ISLAND, 229 IN KOWLOON EAST, 373 IN KOWLOON WEST AND 290 IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

THE PROVISIONAL FIGURES FOR AUGUST SHOWED THAT 17 PEOPLE WERE KILLED, 338 PEOPLE WERE SERIOUSLY INJURED AND 1,301 SLIGHTLY INJURED IN THESE ACCIDENTS.
