ACAN SEEKING YOUTH VOLUNTEERS  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE YOUTH VOLUNTEER GROUP OF THE ACTION COMMITTEE AGAINST NARCOTICS (ACAN) IS LAUNCHING AN EXERCISE TO RECRUIT ENTHUSIASTIC AND RESOURCEFUL YOUNG PEOPLE TO HELP FIGHT THE DRUG PROBLEM IN HONG KONG.

DISCLOSING THIS AT THE WEEKEND, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NARCOTICS DIVISION OF THE GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT SAID THE FUNCTION OF THE GROUP IS TO ASSIST IN IMPLEMENTING PREVENTIVE EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY PROJECTS ORGANISED BY ACAN.

+THE GROUP IS ESTABLISHED WITH THE AIM OF TRAINING AND ENCOURAGING YOUNG PEOPLE TO TAKE A MORE ACTIVE AND DIRECT PART IN ANTI-NARCOTICS WORK,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+THROUGH THEIR PARTICIPATION IN ACAN'S COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT ACTIVITIES AND SELF-INITIATED PROJECTS, THEY WILL CONTRIBUTE SIGNIFICANTLY TOWARDS A WORTHY SOCIAL CAUSE IN SPREADING THE ANTI-NARCOTICS MESSAGE.

+ANOTHER FEATURE IS THAT THE VOLUNTEERS ARE OF THE SAME AGE LEVEL AS THE YOUTHS AT RISK. THEY SPEAK THE SAME LANGUAGE AND CAN THUS SPREAD THE ANTI-NARCOTICS MESSAGE MORE EFFECTIVELY.+

SINCE ITS ESTABLISHMENT IN SEPTEMBER 1981, THE VOLUNTEER GROUP HAS PARTICIPATED IN 110 ANTI-NARCOTICS PREVENTIVE EDUCATION AND PUBLICITY ACTIVITIES SUCH AS CONCERTS, SEMINARS, TRAINING CAMPS, RUNNING RACE, WATER CARNIVAL AND OTHER OUTDOOR ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY ACAN. IT IS ALSO CONSIDERED TO BE ONE OF THE BEST KNOWN AND MOST WIDELY RECOGNISED VOLUNTEER GROUPS IN THE TERRITORY.

MEMBERS OF THE GROUP ARE ALL HIGHLY MOTIVATED AND ENTHUSIASTIC YOUNG PEOPLE COMING FROM ALL WALKS OF LIFE. THEY MAKE USE OF THEIR LEISURE TIME IN THE EVENINGS AND DURING HOLIDAYS TO CARRY OUT THE WORK.

TRAINING PROGRAMMES WILL BE ORGANISED FOR NEW MEMBERS TO PROVIDE THEM WITH THE NECESSARY KNOWLEDGE AND TECHNIQUES.

THE RECRUITMENT EXERCISE IS NOW OPEN TO ALL YOUNG PEOPLE AGED BETWEEN 18 AND 28 YEARS, WITH A MINIMUM OF FORM FIVE EDUCATION STANDARD.

THIS YEAR, OVER 10 000 HEALTHY AND ENJOYABLE ACTIVITIES AIMED AT PROVIDING A MEANINGFUL SUMMER FOR 1.5 MILLION YOUNG PEOPLE AGED BETWEEN SIX AND 25 HAVE BEEN ORGANISED BY THE 19 DISTRICT BOARDS, VARIOUS GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES.

EDUCATION TEAMS TO FOSTER GOOD CITIZENSHIP

THIRTEEN CIVIC EDUCATION TEAMS, COMPRISING ABOUT 130 MEMBERS, WERE OFFICIALLY FORMED TODAY (SUNDAY) AT AN INAUGURATION CEREMONY ORGANISED BY THE WONG TAI SIN DISTRICT BOARD'S WORKING GROUP ON THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION.

THE CEREMONY, HELD IN CONJUNCTION WITH A CIVIC EDUCATION SEMINAR, WAS THE FIRST ACTIVITY ORGANISED BY THE WORKING GROUP FOR 1986-87.

THE CIVIC EDUCATION TEAMS WOULD HELP THE DISTRICT BOARD AND THE GOVERNMENT TO DETERMINE THE SCOPE OF CIVIC EDUCATION THAT WAS NEEDED, THE ACTING DISTRICT OFFICER, MR NG HON-WAH, SAID.

+THE FORMATION OF THE TEAMS WILL PROVIDE A CHANCE FOR THE RESIDENTS TO BECOME MORE INVOLVED IN COMMUNITY AFFAIRS AND MORE WILLING TO PUT THE PUBLIC INTEREST BEFORE THEIR OWN,+ MR NG SAID.

THE CIVIC EDUCATION TEAMS WERE SET UP UNDER THE 13 AREA COMMITTEES IN WONG TAI SIN DISTRICT.

MEMBERS COME FROM A CROSS-SECTION OF THE COMMUNITY, AND INCLUDE FACTORY WORKERS, LAWYERS, TEACHERS, SOCIAL WORKERS, COMMUNITY LEADERS, MERCHANTS AND HOUSEWIVES.

THE DISTRICT BOARD CHAIRMAN, MR MICHAEL CHENG, PRAISED THE TEAM MEMBERS FOR THEIR ENTHUSIASM.

+THEIR PARTICIPATION IN CIVIC EDUCATION SETS AN EXAMPLE IN GOOD CITIZENSHIP,+ HE SAID.

TSUEN WAN DB TO DISCUSS DAYA BAY PLANT

SAFETY ASPECTS OF THE DAYA BAY NUCLEAR POWER PLANT WILL BE RAISED AT THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT BOARD MEETING ON TUESDAY (JULY 1).

MEMBERS WILL INQUIRE HOW HONG KONG WILL BE PROTECTED FROM ANY POSSIBLE HARMFUL EFFECTS ARISING FROM THE PROJECT.

IN OTHER MATTERS, MEMBERS WILL DISCUSS THE REVISED DISTRICT BOARD STANDING ORDERS, ILLEGAL STRUCTURES, AND CRIME AT CARPARKS.

A REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE AND REPORTS BY BOARD COMMITTEES WILL BE TABLED.

THE MEETING WILL BE HELD AT 2.30 PM IN THE MAIN CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE REGIONAL COUNCIL ON THE SECOND FLOOR, TSUEN WAN STATION MULTI-STOREY CARPARK BUILDING, 174-208 CASTLE PEAK ROAD, TSUEN WAN.

PUBLIC URGED TO SUPPORT ANTI-RABIES DRIVE

\* \* \* \* \*

THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT HAS URGED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SUPPORT THE GOVERNMENT'S ANTI-RABIES DRIVE BY HAVING THEIR DOGS INOCULATED AND LICENSED IF THEY HAVE NOT ALREADY DONE SO.

THEY CAN DO THIS BY CALLING AT ANY OF THE FOUR GOVERNMENT KENNELS AND 19 DOG INOCULATION AND LICENSING CENTRES THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY, INCLUDING LANTAO ISLAND AND CHEUNG CHAU.

A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID: +DOG OWNERS SHOULD MAKE GOOD USE OF THESE FREE FACILITIES. EACH VACCINATION IS GOOD FOR THREE YEARS AND AFTER THAT RE-INOCULATION IS NECESSARY TO KEEP UP THE DOG'S IMMUNITY.+

APART FROM THE FREE SERVICES AT THESE KENNELS AND CENTRES, HE SAID, THE DEPARTMENT'S MOBILE INOCULATION TEAMS WILL CONTINUE TO VISIT RURAL VILLAGES TO MAKE THEIR SERVICES AVAILABLE TO DOG OWNERS THERE.

IN JULY, THEY WILL CALL ON VILLAGES IN TUEN MUN, TSUEN WAN AND TAI PO AS WELL AS ON MARICULTURE RAFTS IN THE FISH CULTURE ZONES OF PO TOI O, TIN HA WAN, SHAM WAN AND TAP MUN.

THE TAI PO VILLAGES WHICH THE TEAMS WILL VISIT FROM JULY 1 TO 31 ARE TAI OM SHAN, TAI OM TSUEN, SIU OM TSUEN, CHAI KOK, NG TUNG CHAI, TAI YEUNG TSE, TAI MEI TUK, LUNG MEI, LO TSZ TIN, TUNG TSZ A SHAN, WAI HA, SAN TAU KOK, PO SAM PAI, SAM MUN TSAI, SHUEN WAN SHA LAN, SHUEN WAN JIM UK, SHUEN WAN LEE UK AND SHUEN WAN CHAN UK.

VISITS WILL BE MADE TO TUEN MUN VILLAGES FROM JULY 1 TO 10. THESE INCLUDE SO KWUN WAT, SO KWUN WAT SAN TSUEN, SIU SAU TSUEN, SIU SAU SHEUNG TSUEN, KA WO LANE, SIU LAM, SIU LAM SAN TSUEN, KIU ON TSUEN, TAI LAM CHUNG, WONG UK AND WU UK.

THE INOCULATION TEAMS WILL VISIT TSUEN WAN VILLAGES FROM JULY 11 TO 31. THESE INCLUDE TSING LUNG TAU, YUEN TUN, TSING FAI TONG, SHAM TSENG, HON MAN TSUEN, PAI MIN KOK, YAU KOM TAU, TING KAU, CHAI WAN KOK AND FU YUNG SHAN.

THE DOGS AND CATS ORDINANCE REQUIRES OWNERS TO HAVE DOGS OVER FIVE MONTHS' OLD INOCULATED AND LICENSED. VIOLATIONS MAY LEAD TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$5 000 AND SIX MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

ATLA HEARING BEGINS TOMORROW  
\* \* \* \*

THE AIR TRANSPORT LICENSING AUTHORITY WILL HOLD A PUBLIC INQUIRY FROM TOMORROW (MONDAY) TO CONSIDER APPLICATIONS BY THE HONG KONG DRAGON AIRLINES LIMITED AND CATHAY PACIFIC AIRWAYS LIMITED FOR LICENCES TO OPERATE SCHEDULED SERVICES FROM HONG KONG TO, INTER ALIA, AMSTERDAM, LONDON AND MANCHESTER, AND VICE VERSA.

THE HEARING, SCHEDULED FOR FIVE DAYS UNTIL FRIDAY (JULY 4), WILL TAKE PLACE AT COURT NO. 7 ON THE FIFTH FLOOR OF THE SUPREME COURT, QUEENSWAY. IF NECESSARY, IT MAY CONTINUE BEYOND JULY 4.

THE DAILY HOURS OF SITTING ARE FROM 9.30 AM TO 11 AM, 11.30 AM TO 1 PM AND 2.15 PM TO 4.30 PM.

THERE WILL BE A FIVE-MINUTE PHOTOCALL SESSION FOR MEDIA REPRESENTATIVES FROM 9.30 AM TOMORROW (MONDAY) IMMEDIATELY PRIOR TO THE OPENING OF THE HEARING.

EMPLOYERS URGED TO MAKE TYPHOON ARRANGEMENTS  
\* \* \* \*

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT HAS URGED EMPLOYERS TO REACH PRIOR AGREEMENT WITH THEIR EMPLOYEES ON WORKING ARRANGEMENTS CONCERNING TYPHOONS IN ORDER TO AVOID CONFUSION OR DISPUTES.

SUCH AN AGREEMENT SHOULD INCLUDE RULES FOR REPORTING TO WORK, FOR RELEASING EMPLOYEES FROM WORK, AND THE METHOD OF CALCULATING WAGES TO BE PAID UNDER VARIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THAT ALTHOUGH THE LAW DID NOT LAY DOWN ANY PARTICULAR PROVISIONS, IT WOULD BE TO THE BENEFIT OF EMPLOYERS IF THEY AND THEIR EMPLOYEES COULD COME TO SUCH AN AGREEMENT. THE AGREEMENT SHOULD TAKE INTO ACCOUNT THE NATURE OF EMPLOYMENT, INDIVIDUAL EMPLOYEE'S PLACE OF RESIDENCE, AVAILABILITY OF TRANSPORT AND OTHER RELEVANT FACTORS.

DURING A TYPHOON, EMPLOYERS SHOULD GIVE PRIOR CONSIDERATION TO THEIR EMPLOYEES' SAFETY, BOTH AT THE PLACE OF WORK AND IN GETTING TO, OR LEAVING, THEIR HOMES.

+NORMALLY, EMPLOYERS SHOULD NOT REQUIRE EMPLOYEES TO REPORT FOR DUTY OR TO CONTINUE WITH THEIR WORK WHEN TYPHOON SIGNAL NO. 8 OR A HIGHER SIGNAL IS HOISTED, OR WHEN PUBLIC TRANSPORT IS ABOUT TO STOP,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

/+THIS, HOWEVER, .....

+THIS, HOWEVER, DOES NOT APPLY TO THOSE WHO ARE REQUIRED TO PERFORM ESSENTIAL OR EMERGENCY DUTIES DURING A TYPHOON.+

EMPLOYERS WHO HAVE DIFFICULTY IN DRAFTING OR PREPARING AGREEMENTS CONCERNING TYPHOON ARRANGEMENTS MAY APPROACH THE LABOUR RELATIONS SERVICE OF THE DEPARTMENT FOR ADVICE.

LANDLORDS WARNED AGAINST HARASSMENT  
\* \* \* \*

A RATING AND VALUATION DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN HAS REMINDED LANDLORDS AND PRINCIPAL TENANTS THAT THEY SHOULD STRICTLY OBSERVE THE PROVISIONS AGAINST HARASSMENT IN THE LANDLORD AND TENANT (CONSOLIDATION) ORDINANCE OR ELSE THEY WOULD BE LIABLE TO FACE PROSECUTION.

HE CITED A RECENT CASE IN WHICH THE WIFE OF A PRINCIPAL TENANT WAS SENTENCED TO A FINE OF \$5 000, OR THREE MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT IN DEFAULT OF PAYMENT, IN KOWLOON DISTRICT COURT. THE WOMAN WAS ACCUSED OF PERSISTENTLY WITHHOLDING ELECTRICITY SUPPLY REASONABLY REQUIRED FOR THE OCCUPATION OF A CUBICLE AS A DWELLING WITH INTENT TO EVICT THE SUB-TENANT, CONTRARY TO THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE.

THE COURT WAS TOLD THE WOMAN HIRED AN ELECTRICAL TECHNICIAN TO DISCONNECT THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY TO THE CUBICLE, WHICH WAS IN A POST-WAR BUILDING IN SHAM SHUI PO.

DESPITE REPEATED REQUESTS BY THE SUB-TENANT AND CONCILIATION AND ADVISORY SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT'S RENT OFFICERS, THE ELECTRICITY SUPPLY WAS NOT RECONNECTED.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT IT WAS A SERIOUS OFFENCE TO HARASS TENANTS.

+ANY PERSON WHO UNLAWFULLY DEPRIVES TENANTS OF THEIR OCCUPATION OF PREMISES OR WITHDRAWS OR WITHHOLDS SERVICES REASONABLY REQUIRED FOR OCCUPATION OF THE PREMISES AS A DWELLING IS LIABLE ON CONVICTION TO A FINE OF \$500 000 AND, IN ADDITION, ON A SECOND OR SUBSEQUENT CONVICTION, TO IMPRISONMENT FOR 12 MONTHS,+ HE SAID.

+ANY ILLEGAL GAIN AS A RESULT OF EVICTING THE TENANT WILL BE FORFEITED AND THE COURT MAY ORDER THE CONVICTED PERSON TO COMPENSATE THE TENANT'S LOSSES,+ HE ADDED.

\$18 MILLION CONTRACT TO IMPROVE ROAD  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT HAS AWARDED AN \$18 MILLION CONTRACT FOR STAGE ONE OF IMPROVEMENTS TO THE SECTION OF MAN KAM TO ROAD, FROM JOCKEY CLUB ROAD TO LIN MA HANG ROAD.

STAGE ONE INCLUDES WIDENING THE THREE-KILOMETRE CARRIAGEWAY FROM SIX TO 10.3 METRES TO ALLOW FOR THREE TRAFFIC LANES.

IT ALSO INCLUDES THE CONSTRUCTION OF A 1.6-METRE-WIDE FOOTPATH ALONG THE CARRIAGEWAY, THE PROVISION OF RETAINING WALLS AND ASSOCIATED DRAINAGE WORKS.
