HK'S EXTERNAL TRADE PERFORMANCE IN DECEMBER AND IN 1990

* * * * *

TOTAL MERCHANDISE TRADE IN DECEMBER 1990, AT \$116,335 MILLION, GREW BY 20 PER CENT IN VALUE TERMS AS COMPARED WITH DECEMBER 1989, ACCORDING TO THE DETAILED FIGURES ON THE VALUE OF TRADE IN DECEMBER AND THE WHOLE YEAR OF 1990 RELEASED TODAY (MONDAY) BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT.

OVER THE SAME PERIOD OF COMPARISON, THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS INCREASED BY 1 PER CENT TO \$20,212 MILLION, WHILE THAT OF RE-EXPORTS ROSE BY 24 PER CENT TO \$36,761 MILLION.

THE VALUE OF TOTAL EXPORTS INCREASED BY 15 PER CENT TO \$56,973 MILLION. THE VALUE OF IMPORTS INCREASED BY 25 PER CENT TO \$59,362 MILLION.

THE VALUE OF TOTAL MERCHANDISE TRADE IN THE YEAR 1990, AT \$1,282,405 MILLION, INCREASED BY 13 PER CENT AS COMPARED WITH THE YEAR 1989.

OVER THE SAME PERIOD OF COMPARISON, THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS INCREASED BY 1 PER CENT TO \$225,875 MILLION, WHILE THAT OF RE-EXPORTS INCREASED BY 20 PER CENT TO \$413,999 MILLION.

THUS, THE VALUE OF TOTAL EXPORTS INCREASED BY 12 PER CENT TO \$639,874 MILLION. THE VALUE OF IMPORTS INCREASED BY 14 PER CENT TO \$642,530 MILLION.

THE CHANGES IN THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS TO 10 MAJOR MARKETS ARE SHOWN IN TABLE 1.

COMPARING DECEMBER 1990 WITH DECEMBER 1989, THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS TO SINGAPORE AND THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY RECORDED SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES OF 44 PER CENT AND 24 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY. DOMESTIC EXPORTS TO CHINA, FRANCE AND THE UNITED KINGDOM ALSO INCREASED, BY 13 PER CENT, 7 PER CENT AND 3 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

HOWEVER, THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS TO JAPAN, THE USA, CANADA, THE NETHERLANDS AND TAIWAN DECREASED BY 12 PER CENT, 11 PER CENT, 8 PER CENT, 3 PER CENT AND 2 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

COMPARING THE YEAR 1990 WITH THE YEAR 1989, SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES WERE RECORDED IN THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS TO SINGAPORE AND TAIWAN, BY 34 PER CENT AND 28 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY. THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, CHINA AND THE NETHERLANDS INCREASED BY 14 PER CENT, 10 PER CENT AND 4 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

HOWEVER, THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS TO CANADA, THE USA, THE UNITED KINGDOM AND JAPAN DECREASED IN VALUE TERMS, BY 15 PER CENT, 8 PER CENT, 8 PER CENT AND 7 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

TABLE 2 SHOWS THE CHANGES IN THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS OF THE MAJOR COMMODITY DIVISIONS.

COMPARING THE YEAR 1990 WITH THE YEAR 1989, INCREASES IN THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS WERE REGISTERED FOR PHOTOGRAPHIC APPARATUS, EQUIPMENT AND SUPPLIES, OPTICAL GOODS, WATCHES AND CLOCKS (BY \$1,895 MILLION OR 10 PER CENT); TOBACCO AND TOBACCO MANUFACTURES (BY \$1,004 MILLION OR 50 PER CENT); ARTIFICIAL RESINS AND PLASTIC MATERIALS, AND CELLULOSE ESTERS AND ETHERS (BY \$981 MILLION OR 27 PER CENT); AND OFFICE MACHINES AND AUTOMATIC DATA PROCESSING EQUIPMENT (BY \$786 MILLION OR 5 PER CENT).

DOMESTIC EXPORTS OF CLOTHING WENT UP BY \$291 MILLION ALTHOUGH IN PERCENTAGE TERMS IT REPRESENTED AN INCREASE OF LESS THAN 0.5 PER CENT. THOSE OF TEXTILES INCREASED BY \$92 MILLION OR 1 PER CENT.

HOWEVER, DECREASES IN THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS WERE RECORDED IN MISCELLANEOUS MANUFACTURED ARTICLES (BY \$1,853 MILLION OR 7 PER CENT), AND MANUFACTURES OF METAL (BY \$794 MILLION OR 15 PER CENT).

THE CHANGES IN THE VALUE OF IMPORTS FROM 10 MAJOR SUPPLIERS ARE SUMMARISED IN TABLE 3.

COMPARING DECEMBER 1990 WITH DECEMBER 1989, THE VALUE OF IMPORTS FROM ALL THE MAJOR SUPPLIERS INCREASED.

SIGNIFICANT INCREASES WERE RECORDED IN THE VALUE OF IMPORTS FROM SINGAPORE, THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA, THE UNITED KINGDOM AND JAPAN, BY 49 PER CENT, 37 PER CENT, 34 PER CENT AND 33 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

THOSE FROM ITALY, TAIWAN, CHINA, THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, THE USA AND SWITZERLAND INCREASED BY 27 PER CENT, 26 PER CENT, 24 PER CENT, 17 PER CENT, 16 PER CENT AND 9 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

COMPARING THE YEAR 1990 WITH THE YEAR 1989, INCREASES WERE RECORDED IN THE VALUE OF IMPORTS FROM ALL MAJOR SUPPLIERS.

THE VALUE OF IMPORTS FROM CHINA, SWITZERLAND, SINGAPORE, TAIWAN, THE USA, JAPAN AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA INCREASED BY 20 PER CENT, 18 PER CENT, 17 PER CENT, 13 PER CENT, 12 PER CENT, 11 PER CENT AND 11 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

THOSE FROM ITALY, THE UNITED KINGDOM AND THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY INCREASED BY 10 PER CENT, 9 PER CENT AND 7 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

TABLE 4 SHOWS THE CHANGES IN THE VALUE OF IMPORTS OF THE MAJOR COMMODITY DIVISIONS.

COMPARING THE YEAR 1990 WITH THE YEAR 1989, CONSIDERABLE INCREASES IN THE VALUE OF IMPORTS WERE RECORDED IN TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND SOUND RECORDING AND REPRODUCING APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT (BY \$9,839 MILLION OR 25 PER CENT); CLOTHING (BY \$9,383 MILLION OR 21 PER CENT); MISCELLANEOUS MANUFACTURED ARTICLES (BY \$9,007 MILLION OR 24 PER CENT); AND TEXTILES (BY \$7,128 MILLION OR 10 PER CENT).

HOWEVER, DECREASES IN THE VALUE OF IMPORTS WERE REGISTERED FOR TEXTILE FIBRES AND THEIR WASTES (BY \$1,788 MILLION OR 25 PER CENT), AND NON-FERROUS METALS (BY \$689 MILLION OR 8 PER CENT).

THE CHANGES IN THE VALUE OF RE-EXPORTS TO HONG KONG'S 10 MAJOR MARKETS ARE SHOWN IN TABLE 5.

COMPARING DECEMBER 1990 WITH DECEMBER 1989, THE VALUE OF RE-EXPORTS TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, FRANCE AND THE UNITED KINGDOM RECORDED SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES OF 113 PER CENT, 41 PER CENT AND 40 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY. THOSE TO JAPAN, TAIWAN, CHINA, THE USA AND CANADA INCREASED BY 22 PER CENT, 18 PER CENT, 18 PER CENT, 16 PER CENT AND 11 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

HOWEVER, THE VALUE OF RE-EXPORTS TO SINGAPORE AND THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA DECREASED BY 10 PER CENT AND 4 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

COMPARING THE YEAR 1990 WITH THE YEAR 1989, THE VALUE OF RE-EXPORTS TO THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY, FRANCE, THE UNITED KINGDOM, TAIWAN, THE USA AND CANADA INCREASED SUBSTANTIALLY, BY 73 PER CENT, 41 PER CENT, 36 PER CENT, 29 PER CENT, 22 PER CENT AND 21 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY.

THOSE TO SINGAPORE, JAPAN AND CHINA INCREASED BY 14 PER CENT, 9 PER CENT AND 7 PER CENT RESPECTIVELY, WHILE THOSE TO THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA DECREASED BY 2 PER CENT.

TABLE 6 SHOWS THE CHANGES IN THE VALUE OF RE-EXPORTS OF THE MAJOR COMMODITY DIVISIONS.

COMPARING THE YEAR 1990 WITH THE YEAR 1989, CONSIDERABLE INCREASES IN THE VALUE OF RE-EXPORTS WERE REGISTERED FOR MISCELLANEOUS MANUFACTURED ARTICLES (BY \$13,826 MILLION OR 33 PER CENT); CLOTHING (BY \$10,540 MILLION OR 28 PER CENT); TELECOMMUNICATIONS AND SOUND RECORDING AND REPRODUCING APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT (BY \$8,813 MILLION OR 32 PER CENT); AND FOOTWEAR (BY \$5,969 MILLION OR 76 PER CENT). THOSE OF TEXTILES INCREASED BY \$4,614 MILLION OR 11 PER CENT.

HOWEVER, DECREASES IN THE VALUE OF RE-EXPORTS WERE RECORDED IN TEXTILE FIBRES AND THEIR WASTES (BY \$1,962 MILLION OR 40 PER CENT), AND MACHINERY SPECIALISED FOR PARTICULAR INDUSTRIES (BY \$708 MILLION OR 9 PER CENT).

ALL THE TRADE STATISTICS DESCRIBED HERE ARE MEASURED AT CURRENT PRICES AND NO ACCOUNT HAS BEEN TAKEN OF THE CHANGES IN PRICES BETWEEN THE PERIODS OF COMPARISON.

A SEPARATE ANALYSIS OF THE PRICE AND VOLUME MOVEMENTS OF EXTERNAL TRADE IN DECEMBER 1990 WILL BE RELEASED IN EARLY MARCH 1991.

DETAILED STATISTICS ON TRADE VALUE BY COMMODITY AND BY COUNTRY ARE PUBLISHED IN TRADE STATISTICS REPORTS. THE DECEMBER 1990 ISSUE OF THE "HONG KONG EXTERNAL TRADE" WITH DETAILED ANALYSES ON IMPORTS, EXPORTS AND RE-EXPORTS IN DECEMBER 1990 AS WELL AS THE WHOLE YEAR OF 1990 WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SALE AROUND FEBRUARY 20, AT THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE, GROUND FLOOR, GPO BUILDING, CONNAUGHT PLACE, CENTRAL AT \$27 PER COPY.

GOVERNOR TO UNDERTAKE OPERATION TOMORROW

* * * * *

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN ANNOUNCED TODAY (MONDAY) THAT THE GOVERNOR WILL BE GOING INTO HOSPITAL TOMORROW (TUESDAY) FOR AN OPERATION ON HIS CHEEK BONE, WHICH WAS FRACTURED IN A FALL ON FEBRUARY 3. THE INJURY IS NOT SERIOUS, BUT THE GOVERNOR HAS BEEN TOLD THAT AN OPERATION IS ADVISABLE.

THE GOVERNOR IS EXPECTED TO BE OUT OF HOSPITAL AND BACK AT WORK ON WEDNESDAY. HOWEVER, HE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO UNDERTAKE ANY PUBLIC ENGAGEMENTS FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE WEEK, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

LIST OF UK-CONNECTED UNDERTAKINGS PUBLISHED

THE GOVERNMENT TODAY (MONDAY) PUBLISHED A LIST OF UNDERTAKINGS WHICH WILL BE TREATED AS HAVING CLOSE CONNECTIONS WITH THE UNITED KINGDOM FOR THE PURPOSE OF SCORING POINTS UNDER THE "CONNECTIONS WITH THE UNITED KINGDOM" HEAD OF THE BRITISH NATIONALITY SELECTION SCHEME.

THE LIST HAS BEEN DRAWN UP ON THE BASIS OF ADVICE GIVEN TO THE GOVERNOR BY THE BRITISH TRADE COMMISSION ACTING WITH THE AUTHORITY OF THE UK GOVERNMENT.

"THE LIST IS NOT EXHAUSTIVE, AND OTHER NAMES MAY BE ADDED TO IT WHEN NEW INFORMATION BECOMES AVAILABLE," A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY.

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT THERE MIGHT BE PEOPLE WHO WERE WORKING FOR UNDERTAKINGS INCLUDED IN THE LIST BUT WHO HAD SENT IN THEIR APPLICATIONS WITHOUT CLAIMING ADDITIONAL POINTS UNDER THE "CONNECTIONS WITH THE UNITED KINGDOM" HEAD.

"THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT WILL AWARD ADDITIONAL POINTS TO THESE APPLICANTS, USING THE INFORMATION FURNISHED IN THEIR APPLICATIONS FORMS UNDER "OCCUPATIONAL OR SERVICE HISTORY". THERE IS THUS NO NEED FOR THEM TO ALTER OR RE-SUBMIT THEIR APPLICATIONS," HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT FOR APPLICATIONS NOT YET SUBMITTED, PERSONS WORKING FOR UNDERTAKINGS IN THE LIST SHOULD INCLUDE THIS INFORMATION IN SECTION 17 OF THE APPLICATION FORM FOR SCORING POINTS UNDER CONNECTIONS WITH THE UNITED KINGDOM.

"ANY APPLICANT WHO WISHES TO KNOW WHETHER A PARTICULAR FIRM OR COMPANY HAS BEEN APPROVED BY THE GOVERNOR FOR THIS PURPOSE MAY ENQUIRE THROUGH THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT HOTLINE 802 3300," THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

UNDER THE BRITISH NATIONALITY SELECTION SCHEME, CURRENT SERVICE WITH SUCH UNDERTAKINGS WILL SCORE POINTS AT A RATE OF ONE POINT FOR EVERY SIX MONTHS, UP TO A MAXIMUM OF 35 POINTS.

PAST SERVICE OF THREE YEARS OR MORE WILL BE AWARDED FIVE POINTS.

CIVIL SERVICE STANDING COMMISSION REPORT NO. 27 PUBLISHED

* * * * *

THE STANDING COMMISSION ON CIVIL SERVICE SALARIES AND CONDITIONS OF SERVICE HAS PUBLISHED ITS PROGRESS REPORT FOR 1990 (REPORT NO. 27).

LAST YEAR WAS A VERY BUSY YEAR FOR THE COMMISSION. THE FOCUS OF ITS WORK CONTINUED TO BE THE OVERALL REVIEW OF THE SALARY STRUCTURE OF THE NON-DIRECTORATE GRADES, WHICH BEGAN IN 1989.

IN MARCH 1990, THE COMMISSION COMPLETED THE SECOND PHASE OF THE REVIEW AND SUBMITTED THE SECOND REPORT ON THE REVIEW (REPORT NO. 25) TO THE GOVERNOR.

THE FINAL STAGE OF THE REVIEW WAS COMPLETED IN DECEMBER WITH THE SUBMISSION OF THE THIRD AND FINAL REPORT (REPORT NO. 26) TO THE GOVERNOR ON DECEMBER 14.

THE WHOLE REVIEW EXERCISE, COVERING A TOTAL OF 342 GRADES WITHIN THE COMMISSION'S PURVIEW, HAS TAKEN A TOTAL OF 20 MONTHS, SOME FOUR MONTHS AHEAD OF THE ORIGINAL SCHEDULE.

THE 1990 CIVIL SERVICE PAY ADJUSTMENT IN APRIL ATTRACTED MUCH PUBLIC CONCERN, IN PARTICULAR THE PROBLEM OF TIME-LAG WITH THE SURVEY DATA.

THE COMMISSION, TAKING ACCOUNT OF THE VIEWS OF THE PAY TREND SURVEY COMMITTEE, REVIEWED THE PAY TREND SURVEY METHODOLOGY. IN NOVEMBER AND SUBSEQUENTLY MADE A NUMBER OF RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE GOVERNOR INCLUDING A CHANGE OF THE SURVEY PERIOD TO ADDRESS THE TIME-LAG PROBLEM.

THE REPORT ALSO RECORDS THE COMMISSION'S ADVICE ON CIVIL SERVICE HOUSING BENEFITS AND A SPECIAL ALLOWANCE FOR THE GENERAL DUTIES TEAM STAFF IN THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND REGIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

THE PAY SURVEY AND RESEARCH UNIT, WHICH IS UNDER THE ADMINISTRATIVE CONTROL OF THE COMMISSION, CONDUCTED A SERIES OF PAY COMPARISON SURVEYS FOR THE 1989 SALARY STRUCTURE REVIEW.

IN ADDITION, THE UNIT CARRIED OUT THE 1989/90 PAY TREND SURVEY BETWEEN JANUARY AND FEBRUARY 1990. AN ACCOUNT OF THE WORK OF THE UNIT IS GIVEN IN THE PROGRESS REPORT.
