COMPARING THE ORDER BOOK POSITION IN MAY 1981 WITH THAT IN APRIL, THERE WAS A SLIGHT DECLINE IN THE VOLUME OF ORDERS HELD BY MANUFACTURERS SURVEYED. THE DECREASE OCCURRED MAINLY IN THE WEARING APPAREL, PLASTICS, AND FABRICATED METAL PRODUCTS INDUSTRIES.

THE ABOVE STATISTICS ARE BASED ON AN UPDATED AND ENLARGED PANEL OF THE 200 LARGEST MANUFACTURING COMPANIES SELECTED BY REFERENCE TO THEIR EMPLOYMENT SIZE IN SEPTEMBER 1979. AS THE PANEL IS NOT A SCIENTIFICALLY DESIGNED SAMPLE, RESULTS OBTAINED WILL BE REPRESENTATIVE ONLY OF THE COMPANIES INCLUDED IN THE PANEL, BUT IT IS HOPED THAT THEY WILL GENERALLY INDICATE THE DIRECTION OF CHANGE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF THE MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY AS A WHOLE.

THE SURVEY, WHICH IS CONDUCTED MONTHLY, ALSO ASKS QUESTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT AND PAYROLL AND COVERS THE CONSTRUCTION AND SELECTED SERVICES SECTORS BESIDES MANUFACTURING INDUSTRY.

CHILDREN NEED LOVE, SAYS CHILD EXPERT  
\* \* \* \* \*

A GOVERNMENT CHILD CARE EXPERT TODAY URGED PARENTS AND TEACHERS TO PAY ATTENTION TO THE EMOTIONAL NEEDS OF THE CHILDREN RATHER THAN JUST THEIR PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT.

DR LILLIAN KO, CONSULTANT PAEDIATRICIAN OF THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT POINTED OUT THAT THE PHYSICAL WELL-BEING OF CHILDREN IN HONG KONG IS COMPARABLE TO ANY ADVANCED COUNTRY, AS EVIDENCED BY THE SHARP DECLINE IN THE INFANT MORTALITY RATE AND THE CONTROL OF ACUTE DISEASES.

HOWEVER, THE REVOLUTION BROUGHT ABOUT IN CHILDREN'S PHYSICAL HEALTH IN THE PAST 40 YEARS HAS NOT BEEN MATCHED BY A SIMILAR CHANGE IN THEIR PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL-BEING, SHE SAID.

+THE COMMUNITY IS ALARMED TO FIND AN ASTONISHING RISE IN YOUTH CRIME AND SUICIDES, CHILD ABUSE AND PSYCHOSOMATIC DISORDERS,+ SHE SAID.

DR KO WAS SPEAKING AT THE GRADUATION CEREMONY OF THE LING LEUNG TONG CHURCH KINDERGARTEN THIS AFTERNOON.

SHE SAID THAT FOR MANY PARENTS IN OUR SOCIETY, CHILD REARING IS A PROCESS OF BASICALLY CARING FOR THE PHYSICAL WELL-BEING OF THEIR CHILDREN, AND ENSURING ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT IN SCHOOL AND ULTIMATELY SOCIAL STATUS IN SOCIETY.

THERE ARE PARENTS AND TEACHERS WHO SIMPLY IGNORE OR ARE UNABLE TO ACCEPT THE FACT THAT SMALL CHILDREN ARE ALSO CAPABLE OF FEELINGS AND EMOTIONAL DISTURBANCES SIMILAR TO ADULTS, SAID DR KO.

+IN THE MIDST OF SCHOOL BOOKS AND VITAMIN PILLS, THE EMOTIONAL NEEDS OF CHILDREN ARE OFTEN OVERLOOKED AND LEFT UNFULFILLED,+ SHE SAID.

DR KO TOLD PARENTS AND TEACHERS THAT THERE ARE FOUR BASIC EMOTIONAL NEEDS WHICH HAVE TO BE MET FROM THE VERY BEGINNING OF LIFE TO ENABLE A CHILD TO GO FROM HELPLESS INFANCY TO MATURE ADULTHOOD.

THESE ARE: THE NEED FOR LOVE AND SECURITY- FOR NEW EXPERIENCES- FOR PRAISE AND RECOGNITION, AND FOR RESPONSIBILITY.

DR KO SAID THE NEED FOR LOVE AND SECURITY IS PROBABLY THE MOST IMPORTANT BECAUSE IT PROVIDES THE BASIS FOR ALL LATER RELATIONSHIPS.

+ON IT DEPEND THE HEALTHY DEVELOPMENT OF PERSONALITY, THE ABILITY TO CARE AND RESPONSE TO AFFECTION, AND IN TIME TO BECOMING A LOVING, CARING PARENT.

+IF ONE OF THE BASIC NEED REMAINED UNMET OR INADEQUATELY MET, THEN DEVELOPMENT MAY BECOME STUNNED OR DISTORTED,+ SHE SAID.

THE CONSEQUENCES, SHE SAID, ARE DISASTROUS AND COSTLY LATER ON, BOTH FOR THE INDIVIDUAL AND FOR THE SOCIETY.

+CHILDREN WHO WERE ABUSED BY THEIR PARENTS OFTEN GROW UP TO BE ABUSING PARENTS THEMSELVES. THEREFORE, PARENTS AND TEACHERS, ESPECIALLY THOSE INVOLVED WITH PRE-SCHOOL CHILDREN, HAVE A GREAT RESPONSIBILITY,+ SHE SAID.

+BY STRENGTHENING THEIR EMOTIONAL RESILIENCE AND INCREASING THEIR CAPACITY FOR LEARNING, OUR CHILDREN WILL BE MUCH MORE PREPARED TO ADAPT TO A RAPIDLY CHANGING WORLD, AND STAND UP TO THE DIFFICULTIES AND CHALLENGES IN THE FUTURE,+ SHE SAID.

MORE REGISTRATION FACILITIES FOR KOWLOON CITY

THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT'S KOWLOON CITY OFFICE WILL EXPAND ITS SERVICES TO INCLUDE REGISTRATION OF PERSONS FACILITIES FROM MONDAY (JULY 20).

IN ADDITION TO NORMAL IMMIGRATION WORK, THE OFFICE WILL ALSO ACCEPT REGISTRATIONS FOR JUVENILE OR ADULT IDENTITY CARDS MADE BY BONA-FIDE RESIDENTS OF HONG KONG, APPLICATIONS FOR REPLACEMENT OF DEFACED OR DAMAGED IDENTITY CARDS AND AMENDMENT OF NATIONALITY ON IDENTITY CARDS FROM CHINESE TO BRITISH.

HOWEVER, ENTRANTS FROM CHINA WILL STILL HAVE TO GO TO VICTORIA BARRACKS FOR THESE FACILITIES, A SPOKESMAN SAID.

LABOUR RESEARCH TRAINING COURSE CLOSES

A TWO-WEEK REGIONAL TRAINING COURSE IN LABOUR RESEARCH AND STATISTICS FOR SENIOR RESEARCH OFFICERS FROM 11 COUNTRIES IN ASIA AND THE PACIFIC REGION CAME TO A SUCCESSFUL CONCLUSION TODAY (SATURDAY).

OFFICIATING AT THE CLOSING CEREMONY HELD AT THE Y.C. LIANG HALL OF THE CHINESE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG, THE ACTING COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, MR J.C.A. HAMMOND, PRESENTED CERTIFICATES TO PARTICIPANTS, INCLUDING A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT OF HONG KONG.

THE TRAINING COURSE - ORGANISED BY THE INTERNATIONAL LABOUR ORGANISATION'S ASIAN REGIONAL PROJECT FOR STRENGTHENING LABOUR /MANPOWER ADMINISTRATION (ARPLA) IN COLLABORATION WITH THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT - WAS A BLEND OF LECTURES AND PRACTICAL EXERCISES.

SPEAKERS AT THE SESSIONS CAME FROM ARPLA, THE TWO LOCAL UNIVERSITIES, THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT AND THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT.

THE 11 COUNTRIES REPRESENTED WERE BANGLADESH, FIJI, INDIA, INDONESIA, NEPAL, PAKISTAN, PAPUA NEW GUINEA, THE PHILIPPINES, SINGAPORE, SRI LANKA AND THAILAND.

BESIDES ATTENDING THE TRAINING COURSE, THEY ALSO VISITED THE WO CHE ESTATE AT SHATIN TO TAKE A LOOK AT THE DEVELOPMENT OF PUBLIC HOUSING IN HONG KONG.

IN HIS SPEECH, MR HAMMOND SAID THE TRAINING COURSE REPRESENTED ONE OF MANY ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY ARPLA TO IMPLEMENT ITS PROGRAMME OF ASSISTING LABOUR MINISTRIES AND DEPARTMENTS IN THE REGION TO IMPROVE THEIR LABOUR RESEARCH AND STATISTICS FUNCTIONS.

THE IDEA OF HOLDING THE TRAINING COURSE IN HONG KONG TOOK SHAPE AS FAR BACK AS 1979 DURING A VISIT HERE BY THE FORMER CHIEF TECHNICAL ADVISER OF ARPLA, MR NIKOM CHANDRAVITHUN. AT THE END OF LAST YEAR, THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT WAS FORMALLY INVITED BY ARPLA TO ORGANISE THE COURSE.

MR HAMMOND NOTED THAT THE LAST TWO WEEKS HAD BEEN A UNIQUE AND REWARDING EXPERIENCE FOR THE PARTICIPANTS.

TSUEN WAN FACTORY CANTEENS APPROVED

\* \* \*

TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE HAS GIVEN APPROVAL TO 25 OWNERS OF FACTORY PREMISES IN KWAI CHUNG TO OPERATE CANTEENS INSIDE THEIR BUILDINGS.

SINCE THE BEGINNING OF THIS YEAR, THE OFFICE HAS BEEN ACCEPTING APPLICATIONS FROM OWNERS TO MODIFY THEIR LEASES TO ENABLE THEM TO CONTINUE OPERATING CANTEENS FOR THEIR WORKERS.

TO DATE, 42 APPLICATIONS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED. OF THESE, TWO HAVE BEEN FOUND UNSUITABLE FOR MODIFICATION, TWO WERE WITHDRAWN BY THE APPLICANTS AND 13 ARE BEING PROCESSED.

ASSISTANT DISTRICT OFFICER, KWAI CHUNG, MR KEITH LAU, SAID THERE ARE ABOUT 100 FACTORY CANTEENS IN THE DISTRICT WHOSE LEASE CONDITIONS DID NOT CONTAIN PROVISIONS FOR OPERATING CANTEENS.

HE SAID BOTH THE DISTRICT OFFICE AND THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT WERE ADVISING FACTORY OWNERS WHO RUN SUCH CANTEENS TO APPLY FOR LEASE MODIFICATION.

IF THEY COMPLY WITH REQUIREMENTS THEY WILL BE ISSUED WITH A +NO OBJECTION+ LETTER, HE SAID.

+I WOULD SAY MORE THAN 50 PER CENT OF EXISTING CANTEENS IN KWAI CHUNG HAVE ALREADY COME TO LIGHT,+ HE SAID.

HE WARNED THAT FACTORY CANTEENS FAILING TO MEET THE CRITERIA FOR LEASE MODIFICATION AND WHICH DID NOT APPLY AS ADVISED WOULD BE SUBJECT TO LEASE ENFORCEMENT ACTION BY THE DISTRICT OFFICE AND PROSECUTION BY THE NTSD.

+ACTION ALONG THESE LINES WILL CONTINUE TO BRING ALL FACTORY CANTEENS IN THE DISTRICT UNDER CONTROL,+ HE SAID.

THE REQUIREMENTS FOR FACTORY CANTEENS ARE THAT THEY SHOULD NOT HAVE INDEPENDENT OR DIRECT ACCESS TO THE STREET EXCEPT FOR EMERGENCY USE- THE FLOOR AREA OF THE CANTEEN SHOULD NOT EXCEED 10 PER CENT OF THE TOTAL GROSS FLOOR AREA OF THE BUILDING- AND THE LOCATION OF THE CANTEEN SHOULD NOT AFFECT PARKING, LOADING AND UNLOADING OR ANY COMMON PARTS OF THE BUILDING SUCH AS ACCESS, CORRIDORS AND LIFT LOBBIES.

SOCCER PITCH FOR REMOTE NT VILLAGE

A REMOTE VILLAGE ON LANTAU WILL SOON HAVE ITS FIRST SOCCER PITCH.

THE VILLAGE IS TUNG CHUNG, WHICH HAS A POPULATION OF ABOUT 4 000.

ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE HAS STARTED CONVERTING A PIECE OF VACANT LAND ON THE EDGE OF THE VILLAGE INTO A CONCRETE SURFACED MINI-SOCCER PITCH. THE PROJECT IS SCHEDULED TO BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF NEXT MONTH.

THE 61 METRES BY 37 METRES PITCH WILL BE USED FOR SEVEN-A-SIDE SOCCER MATCHES, OR BY SCHOOLS AND LOCAL ORGANISATIONS FOR ACTIVITIES SUCH AS GAMES DAYS AND FUN FAIRS.

TUNG CHUNG ALREADY HAS A COMMUNITY CENTRE MANAGED BY THE RURAL COMMITTEE. THE PITCH WOULD PROVIDE A NEW RECREATIONAL OUTLET FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS, ESPECIALLY YOUNGSTERS, AN ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE PROJECT COST \$175 100 OF WHICH THE ROYAL HONG KONG JOCKEY CLUB IS DONATING \$125 400. THE BALANCE WILL BE PAID FROM THE ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE LOCAL PUBLIC WORKS VOTE.

SCIENCE TEACHERS LEARN TO USE LIBRARY RESOURCES

TWO WORKSHOPS ON LIBRARY-ASSISTED TEACHING AND LEARNING OF INTEGRATED SCIENCE WILL BE HELD NEXT WEEK FOR 110 INTEGRATED SCIENCE TEACHERS FROM SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

+THE AIM OF THE WORKSHOPS IS TO INTRODUCE TO PARTICIPANTS SOME METHODS OF MAKING THE BEST POSSIBLE USE OF SCHOOL LIBRARY RESOURCES TO SUPPORT AND ENRICH THE INTEGRATED SCIENCE CURRICULUM, + AN EDUCATION DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

THERE WILL BE INTRODUCTORY TALKS GIVEN BY MEMBERS OF THE LIBRARY SECTION AND THE SCIENCE SUBJECTS SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT'S ADVISORY INSPECTORATE, THE ORGANISERS OF THE WORKSHOPS.

THESE WILL BE FOLLOWED BY WORKSHOP SESSIONS WHERE PARTICIPANTS WILL PREPARE LEARNING PROGRAMMES BASED ON LIBRARY RESOURCES RELATING TO THE INTEGRATED SCIENCE CURRICULUM.

THE FIRST TWO-DAY WORKSHOP WILL BE HELD ON JULY 20 AND 23- WHILE THE SECOND WILL BE HELD ON JULY 21 AND 24.

THE ACTING ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER OF PRISONS (PERSONNEL), MR T.A. HANDLEY THIS (SATURDAY) MORNING PRESENTED LETTERS OF APPOINTMENT TO 17 OFFICER CADETS WHO HAVE BEEN PROMOTED TO OFFICERS EFFECTIVE TODAY.

ADDRESSING THE NEWLY PROMOTED OFFICERS IN A CEREMONY HELD AT THE CONFERENCE ROOM AT PRISONS DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS, MR HANDLEY TOLD THE OFFICERS THAT THEY ARE NOW WELL-EQUIPPED FOR WORK IN ANY PENAL INSTITUTION.

+YOU ARE IN A BETTER POSITION THAN A DIRECT INTAKE OFFICER BECAUSE YOU HAVE GAINED VERY USEFUL EXPERIENCE AND, VERY IMPORTANT, CONFIDENCE IN YOUR YEARS AS AN ASSISTANT OFFICER.+

HE ALSO REMINDED THEM THAT THEY MUST ALWAYS SET A GOOD EXAMPLE AND BE ON GUARD AGAINST TEMPTATIONS OF ALL SORTS THAT WILL COME THEIR WAY THROUGH THE NATURE OF THEIR WORK.

THE RECIPIENTS COMPRISED 15 MALE AND TWO FEMALE ASSISTANT OFFICERS.

AMONG THOSE PROMOTED, MR PANNU HARJIT SINGH, WHO JOINED THE PRISONS DEPARTMENT IN DECEMBER 1975, RECEIVED THE COMMISSIONER'S COMMENDATION FOR ALERTNESS AND DILIGENCE IN THE PERFORMANCE OF HIS DUTY IN FEBRUARY 1980.

THE EASTBOUND SLIP ROAD OF KWAI CHUNG ROAD, NEAR MEI FOO SUN CHUEN, WILL BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED TO TRAFFIC FOR ABOUT THREE WEEKS FROM 1.30 AM ON WEDNESDAY (JULY 22) TO FACILITATE REALIGNMENT WORK.
