## PROVISIONAL TRADE FIGURES FOR JULY

\* \* \* \* \*

THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT TODAY PUBLISHED THE PROVISIONAL FIGURES FOR HONG KONG'S EXTERNAL MERCHANDISE TRADE DURING LAST MONTH. THE VALUE OF DOMESTIC EXPORTS FOR JULY WAS \$3,396 MILLION, IMPORTS WERE WORTH \$4,239 MILLION AND RE-EXPORTS, \$816 MILLION.

THE FIGURES FOR THE PERIOD MAY TO JULY (LATEST THREE MONTHS) SHOWED INCREASES, BY VALUE, COMPARED WITH THE SAME PERIOD IN 1976 OF 9 PER CENT FOR DOMESTIC EXPORTS, 11.5 PER CENT FOR IMPORTS AND 9.3 PER CENT FOR RE-EXPORTS.

COMPARED WITH THE SAME MONTH IN 1976, INCREASES, BY VALUE, OF \$400 MILLION OR 13.3 PER CENT IN EXPORTS, \$535 MILLION OR 14.5 PER CENT IN IMPORTS AND \$68 MILLION OR 9.1 PER CENT IN RE-EXPORTS WERE RECORDED.

THE SHORT-TERM CHANGES, JULY COMPARED WITH JUNE, SHOWED INCREASES OF \$466 MILLION OR 15.9 PER CENT FOR DOMESTIC EXPORTS, \$248 MILLION OR 6.2 PER CENT FOR IMPORTS AND \$10 MILLION OR 1.2 PER CENT FOR RE-EXPORTS.

+THE CONSIDERABLE INCREASE IN THIS MONTH'S DOMESTIC EXPORTS IS CONSISTENT WITH THE SEASONAL RISE USUALLY BEGINNING AT THIS TIME OF THE YEAR,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT SAID.

THE FIGURES FOR THE 12-MONTH PERIOD FROM AUGUST 1976 TO JULY 1977 COMPARED WITH THOSE OF THE PREVIOUS 12-MONTH PERIOD SHOWED INCREASES, BY VALUE, OF 18.1 PER CENT FOR DOMESTIC EXPORTS, 16.4 PER CENT FOR IMPORTS AND 14.6 PER CENT FOR RE-EXPORTS.

GOVERNOR INAUGURATES OLUHO SUBMARINE CABLE SYSTEM  
\* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNOR, SIR MURRAY MACLEHOSE, SAID THE OLUHO CABLE, WHICH STRADDLES THE WESTERN PACIFIC AND SOUTHEAST ASIA, GREATLY EXPANDS THE COMMUNICATION SYSTEM WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE AREA, AND WOULD HELP ALL TO PROSPER.

SIR MURRAY WAS SPEAKING TO PRESIDENT MARCOS OF THE PHILIPPINES AND PRIME MINISTER FUKUDA OF JAPAN WHEN HE INAUGURATED THE HONG KONG END OF THE CABLE LINK AT THE FURAMA HOTEL TODAY.

SIR MURRAY SAID THAT HONG KONG HAD INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL AND FINANCIAL IMPORTANCE, AND GENERATED A NUMBER OF INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS, OUT OF ALL PROPORTION TO ITS SIZE, AND AS THE SOUTHWEST TERMINAL OF THE CABLE WOULD BE A MAJOR BENEFICIARY OF IT.

+WE, THE PEOPLE OF HONG KONG, ARE PROUD TO BE JOINED WITH SUCH IMPORTANT CENTRES AS THE PHILIPPINES AND JAPAN IN THIS NEW OLUHO CABLE LINK, AND WE WISH THEM ADDED PROSPERITY FROM IT.+

THE FOLLOWING IS THE TEXT OF SIR MURRAY'S SPEECH:

+I THANK YOUR EXCELLENCIES (PRESIDENT MARCOS, PRIME MINISTER FUKUDA) FOR YOUR GREETINGS TO THE ASSEMBLY HERE AND ON BEHALF OF HONG KONG I EXTEND OUR GOOD WISHES TO EVERYONE PARTICIPATING IN THE INAUGURATION OF THE OLUHO SUBMARINE CABLE SYSTEM.

+ITS CONSTRUCTION IS A MAJOR ACHIEVEMENT - BY THE THREE COMPANIES CONCERNED, JAPANESE, PHILIPPINE AND BRITISH, AND BY THEIR MANAGERS, ENGINEERS, ECONOMISTS, TECHNICIANS AND SEAMEN. WE ARE HERE TO HONOUR AND APPLAUD AN OUTSTANDING ACHIEVEMENT OF MULTI-NATIONAL CO-OPERATION.

+THE CABLE STRADDLES THE WESTERN PACIFIC AND SOUTHEAST ASIA, AN AREA WITH ONE OF THE FASTEST ECONOMIC GROWTH RATES IN THE WORLD. TO CONTINUE TO GROW IT MUST HAVE A FIRST-CLASS AND WORLD-WIDE COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEM.

+THE OLUHO CABLE GREATLY EXPANDS THE SYSTEM WITHIN AND WITHOUT THE AREA, AND WILL HELP ALL OF US TO PROSPER.

+HONG KONG HAS AN INDUSTRIAL, COMMERCIAL AND FINANCIAL IMPORTANCE, AND GENERATES A NUMBER OF INTERNATIONAL COMMUNICATIONS, OUT OF ALL PROPORTION TO ITS SIZE, AND AS THE SOUTHWEST TERMINAL OF THE CABLE WILL BE A MAJOR BENEFICIARY OF IT. AT THE SAME TIME THE EXCEPTIONALLY HIGH STANDARD OF COMMUNICATIONS EQUIPMENT INSTALLED IN HONG KONG BY THE CABLE AND WIRELESS COMPANY WILL BENEFIT ALL USING THE CABLE.

+WE, THE PEOPLE OF HONG KONG, ARE PROUD TO BE JOINED WITH SUCH IMPORTANT CENTRES AS THE PHILIPPINES AND JAPAN IN THIS NEW OLUHO CABLE LINK, AND WE WISH THEM ADDED PROSPERITY FROM IT.+

EXTENSIVE STREET LIGHTING PROGRAMME FOR VILLAGES  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION IS ABOUT TO LAUNCH AN EXTENSIVE PROGRAMME TO LIGHT UP FOOTPATHS AND ACCESS ROADS IN REMOTE VILLAGES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

THE VILLAGE LIGHTING PROGRAMME WILL MAKE WALKING AT NIGHT SAFER IN THESE VILLAGES. ITS COST WILL FORM PART OF THE N.T.A.'S \$5 MILLION LOCAL PUBLIC WORKS VOTE.

WORK IS TO START NEXT MONTH ON INSTALLING THE FIRST 23 STREET LIGHTS IN TWO VILLAGES ON LANTAU ISLAND -- TAI TEI TONG AND LUK TEI TONG. IT SHOULD BE COMPLETED BEFORE THE END OF DECEMBER.

+SITES FOR STREET LIGHTS IN THE TWO VILLAGES HAVE ALREADY BEEN CHOSEN, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE VILLAGERS' REPRESENTATIVES,+ A NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY.

HE SAID TENDERS WOULD BE CALLED SHORTLY AND THE SUBSEQUENT WORK WOULD BE SUPERVISED BY AN ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR ATTACHED TO THE N.T.A.

PLANS ARE ALSO IN AN ADVANCED STAGE FOR SIMILAR PROVISIONS IN SOME VILLAGES IN SHA TIN, YUEN LONG AND SAI KUNG, AND WORK WILL START EARLY NEXT YEAR, HE ADDED.

MORE THAN 80 STREET LIGHTS WILL BE INSTALLED COVERING NINE VILLAGES IN THE THREE DISTRICTS, HE SAID.

+LATER ON, THE PROGRAMME WILL BE EXTENDED TO OTHER VILLAGES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WHERE THERE IS A NEED FOR VILLAGE LIGHTING.+

THE PROGRAMME, HE SAID, HAS BEEN PLANNED FOLLOWING REQUESTS BY REPRESENTATIVES OF VARIOUS VILLAGES.

HE SAID THE PAST MONTHS HAD SEEN MUCH PREPARATORY WORK DONE WITH THE DISTRICT OFFICERS CONCERNED AND VILLAGERS' REPRESENTATIVES GOING OUT ON INSPECTIONS TO LOOK FOR SUITABLE SITES AND TO DECIDE ON THE ROUTINGS.

FIRST MEETING OF HK EXAMINATIONS AUTHORITY  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, MR. COLVYN HAYE, SAID TODAY THAT A CONSCIOUS EFFORT MUST BE MADE TO CO-ORDINATE EXAMINATIONS WITH THE REST OF THE EDUCATIONAL SYSTEM AND SUBORDINATE THEM TO FUNDAMENTAL AIMS.

HE WAS SPEAKING AT THE FIRST MEETING THIS AFTERNOON OF THE HONG KONG EXAMINATIONS AUTHORITY, SET UP UNDER THE HONG KONG EXAMINATIONS AUTHORITY ORDINANCE WHICH CAME INTO OPERATION ON AUGUST 1.

THE AUTHORITY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ADMINISTRATION OF THE THREE EXISTING MAJOR SCHOOL EXAMINATIONS - THE HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION EXAMINATION, THE MATRICULATION EXAMINATION OF THE CHINESE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG, AND THE 'A' LEVEL EXAMINATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG - TOGETHER WITH ANY OTHER SCHOOL EXMINATIONS THAT MAY BE INTRODUCED SUBSEQUENTLY, AS WELL AS THE EXTERNAL EXAMINATIONS.

MR. HAYE, WHO CHAIRED THE MEETING, EXTENDED A WARM WELCOME TO THE MEMBERS AND SAID HE WAS CONFIDENT THAT THE AUTHORITY WOULD ACHIEVE ITS BASIC OBJECTIVE -- TO PROVIDE THE YOUNG PEOPLE OF HONG KONG AND THEIR SCHOOLS WITH A RATIONAL, COHERENT EXAMINATIONS SERVICE THAT WOULD ASSIST AND REINFORCE THE EFFORTS OF TEACHERS AND PUPILS IN THE CLASSROOM AND LABORATORY, THE WORKSHOP AND LIBRARY, AND WHEREVER ELSE PEOPLE MIGHT STRIVE TO IMPROVE THEMSELVES INDIVIDUALLY AND COLLECTIVELY.

+SO I SEE OUR TASK, IN BRIEF, AS TWO-FOLD: ON THE ONE HAND AT THE OPERATIONAL LEVEL, IT IS TO MAINTAIN AND WHERE POSSIBLE IMPROVE THE EFFICIENCY AND CO-ORDINATION OF THE VARIOUS EXCELLENT 'MACHINES' WE ARE INHERITING - AND THIS ASPECT OF OUR WORK IS BOUND TO DOMINATE OUR THINKING IN THE IMMEDIATE FUTURE= BUT IN THE LONG RUN, OUR MORE IMPORTANT WORK IS TO FORMULATE AND APPLY, SYSTEMATICALLY OVER ALL THE LEVELS AND SUBJECTS WITHIN OUR SCOPE, A CONSISTENT PHILOSOPHY OF EXAMINATIONS,+ THE ACTING DIRECTOR SAID.

HE APPEALED TO PEOPLE WHO COULD CONTRIBUTE TO THE WORK OF THE AUTHORITY, AT WHATEVER LEVEL, TO OFFER THEIR SERVICES AND HE ASKED THAT THEY BE ENCOURAGED AND RELEASED FOR THIS IMPORTANT SERVICE TO THE COMMUNITY.

ITEMS DISCUSSED AT THE MEETING TODAY INCLUDED AN AMENDED CONSTITUTION FOR THE HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION BOARD AND THE SEEKING OF OVERSEAS RECOGNITION FOR THE HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION EXAMINATION AND FOR THE HONG KONG UNIVERSITY 'A' LEVEL EXAMINATION.

PREPARATIONS FOR OPENING OF NEW TEMPORARY MARKET FOR TSUEN WAN  
\* \* \* \* \*

TSUEN WAN'S NEW \$1 MILLION TEMPORARY MARKET WILL BE OPENED FOR BUSINESS BEFORE THE END OF THE YEAR.

CONTRACTORS ARE NEARING COMPLETION OF THE PROJECT AT THE JUNCTION OF YAN CHAI AND TAK WAH STREETS. IT WILL REPLACE THE EXISTING MARKET IN THE NEARBY HOI PA STREET AREA.

GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS ARE ALSO FINALISING PLANS FOR THE TRANSFER OF THE TRADERS FROM THE OLD MARKET AREA TO THE NEW MODERN PREMISES.

OFFICIALS FROM THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT TODAY MET LOCAL LEADERS AT THE TSUEN WAN TOWN MANAGEMENT OFFICE TO DISCUSS THE TRANSFER PLAN.

THIS WAS A FOLLOW-UP TO A SIMILAR MEETING HELD BETWEEN GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS AND THE LOCAL LEADERS LAST MARCH WHEN PLANS FOR THE SURVEY AND RESITING OF THE TRADERS WERE FIRST DISCUSSED.

ATTENDING TODAY'S MEETING WERE REPRESENTATIVES OF THE TSUEN WAN RURAL COMMITTEE, THE LOCAL CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AND THE TSUEN WAN HAWKERS' ASSOCIATION.

A NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION SPOKESMAN SAID LATER: +THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT WILL BE SENDING A LETTER TO TRADERS IN THE EXISTING MARKET WITHIN A FEW DAYS OUTLINING DETAILS OF THE RESITING PROPOSALS.

+THE DEPARTMENT HAS EXTENSIVELY SURVEYED THE OLD MARKET AND WE ARE HOPEFUL THAT ALL THOSE FOUND ELIGIBLE FOR RESITES IN THE TEMPORARY MARKET WILL BE ACCOMMODATED.

+WE ARE ALSO SETTING ASIDE A SPECIAL AREA ADJACENT TO THE NEW MARKET FOR FARMER-HAWKERS, SO THAT THOSE PEOPLE WHO HAVE ENGAGED IN THIS TRADE AT THE OLD MARKET FOR SOME YEARS CAN CONTINUE TO DO SO WITHOUT LOSING THEIR FARMER-HAWKER STATUS OR COMMITTING THEMSELVES TO A LEASE OF A MARKET STALL.

+THE NEW TEMPORARY MARKET WILL OPEN UP A MORE SPACIOUS, BETTER-EQUIPPED AND MORE HYGIENIC AREA WHICH WILL GREATLY BENEFIT BOTH TRADERS AND SHOPPERS.+

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT ONCE THE OLD MARKET AREA SITE IS CLEARED, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT CONTRACTORS WOULD MOVE IN IMMEDIATELY TO START WORK ON A STREAMLINED PERMANENT MARKET.

IT WAS PLANNED FOR THIS MARKET TO BE OPENED BY THE END OF 1979, HE ADDED.

AMENDMENTS TO DRAFT KWAI CHUNG, TSUEN WAN OUTLINE  
ZONING PLANS  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE TOWN PLANNING BOARD HAS APPROVED THE DRAFT AMENDMENTS TO KWAI CHUNG AND TSUEN WAN OUTLINE ZONING PLANS.

BOTH THESE AMENDMENTS ARE PUBLISHED TODAY.

THE KWAI CHUNG PLAN INVOLVES ADJUSTMENTS TO BOUNDARIES AND ZONING IN THE KAU WAH KENG AREA.

THE MAJOR CHANGE IS THE RE-ZONING TO +VILLAGE+ OF A PORTION OF DISTRICT OPEN SPACE TO THE SOUTHEAST OF THE AREA TO PERMIT THE RE-SITING OF THE KAU WAH KENG VILLAGE.

FOLLOWING AN ENGINEERING INVESTIGATION, THE EXTENT OF THE RESIDENTIAL (A) ZONE TO THE NORTH OF LAI KING ROAD HAS NOW BEEN CLEARLY DEFINED.

THE AREA WILL BE SERVED BY LOCAL ROADS FROM THE LAI KING ROAD BUT THE THROUGH LINK TO CASTLE PEAK ROAD SHOWN ON THE PREVIOUS OUTLINE ZONING PLAN HAS BEEN DELETED.

THE INVESTIGATION HAS ALSO PERMITTED THE OPEN SPACE (PARK STRIP) ZONING LIMITS TO BE CLEARLY DEFINED.
