GOVERNOR TO RETURN ON TUESDAY

THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE, WILL RETURN TO HONG KONG FROM PEKING ON TUESDAY (SEPTEMBER 2).

HE WILL BE ARRIVING ON FLIGHT CX331, ETA 9.45 PM.

SAFE USE OF BOILERS STRESSED

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT REMINDED FACTORY OWNERS OF THE LAW GOVERNING THE SAFE OPERATION OF BOILERS AND OTHER TYPES OF PRESSURE EQUIPMENT.

THE PRINCIPAL SURVEYOR OF THE DEPARTMENT'S PRESSURE EQUIPMENT DIVISION, MR M.R. MIRZA, SAID THAT DURING THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF THIS YEAR, 1 616 INSPECTIONS OF BOILERS AND STEAM RECEIVERS IN FACTORIES WAS CARRIED OUT COMPARED WITH 788 IN THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR.

THE INSPECTIONS LED TO 151 PROSECUTIONS AGAINST OWNERS FOR BREACHING THE VARIOUS REGULATIONS OF THE BOILERS AND PRESSURE RECEIVERS ORDINANCE AND RESULTED IN FINES AMOUNTING TO MORE THAN \$191 000.

+MOST OF THE OFFENCES RELATED TO THE OPERATION OF BOILERS WITHOUT THE DIRECT SUPERVISION OF A COMPETENT PERSON WHO IS IN POSSESSION OF A CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY ISSUED BY THE DIVISION,+ MR MIRZA SAID.

+AS BOILERS AND PRESSURE EQUIPMENT ARE USUALLY INSTALLED IN PREMISES WHERE THERE IS A LARGE GATHERING OF PEOPLE AT MOST TIME OF THE DAY, ANY INCORRECT OPERATION OR POOR UPKEEP OF THESE BOILERS COULD CAUSE SERIOUS ACCIDENT AND RESULT IN HEAVY LOSS OF LIFE AND PROPERTY.+

HE NOTED THAT THE MAXIMUM PENALTY FOR BREACH OF THIS STATUTORY REQUIREMENT, ON CONVICTION, IS \$30 000.

AT THE END OF JUNE THIS YEAR, A TOTAL OF 18 240 BOILERS AND 42 487 PRESSURE RECEIVERS WAS REGISTERED WITH THE DIVISION.

OWNERS ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO HAVE THEIR EQUIPMENT CHECKED PERIODICALLY BY APPOINTED EXAMINERS WHO ARE QUALIFIED ENGINEERS IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR AUTHORISED TO UNDERTAKE INSPECTIONS OF BOILERS OR PRESSURE EQUIPMENT FOR THE ISSUE OF CERTIFICATE OF FITNESS.

BETWEEN JULY LAST YEAR AND APRIL THIS YEAR, THREE ACCIDENTS INVOLVING FIRE TUBE BOILERS OCCURRED, ALL RESULTING IN FURNACE COLLAPSE.

+THESE ACCIDENTS WERE GENERALLY CAUSED BY THE FAILURE OF COMPETENT PERSONS TO TEND THE BOILERS WHEN THEY WERE IN OPERATION,+ MR MIRZA SAID, ADDING THAT THIS WAS BOTH HAZARDOUS AND UNLAWFUL.

HE REMINDED OWNERS THAT ALL ACCIDENTS MUST BE REPORTED TO THE PRESSURE EQUIPMENT DIVISION WITHIN 24 HOURS AND AN APPOINTED EXAMINER BE CONSULTED ON THE APPOINTMENT OF A COMPETENT BOILER REPAIRER BEFORE INITIATING REPAIRS.

AT PRESENT, THERE ARE 56 APPOINTED EXAMINERS REGISTERED WITH THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT, A LIST OF WHICH IS AVAILABLE FROM THE PRESSURE EQUIPMENT DIVISION, 17TH FLOOR, HARBOUR BUILDING, CENTRAL.

TO HELP OWNERS IN TRAINING THEIR EMPLOYEES FOR ACQUIRING THE REQUIRED CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY, THE DIVISION HAS PUBLISHED TWO GUIDE BOOKS ON THE SAFE OPERATION OF ELECTRICALLY-HEATED BOILERS.

IN ADDITION, A SHORT TRAINING COURSE IS CONDUCTED FROM TIME TO TIME TO PREPARE ELECTRIC BOILER OPERATORS FOR THE CERTIFICATE OF COMPETENCY EXAMINATION.

COMPREHENSIVE TRAINING COURSES FOR ELECTRICALLY-HEATED BOILER ATTENDANTS ARE ORGANISED IN COLLABORATION WITH HAKING WONG TECHNICAL INSTITUTE.

SOUVENIRS OF THE ROYAL VISIT BY THE QUEEN AND THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH IN OCTOBER WILL BE ABLE TO CARRY ROYAL EMBLEMS AND ROYAL PHOTOGRAPHS AND PORTRAITS.

THE LORD CHAMBERLAIN'S OFFICE IN LONDON HAS ANNOUNCED THAT THE RULES GOVERNING THE USE OF SUCH EMBLEMS WILL BE TEMPORARILY RELAXED TO ALLOW THEM TO BE REPRODUCED ON SOUVENIRS AND DISPLAYS COMMEMORATING THE VISIT. NORMALLY SUCH EMBLEMS AND ROYAL PICTURES ARE ALLOWED TO BE REPRODUCED ONLY IN THE MOST EXCEPTIONAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

DESPITE THE RELAXATION, MANUFACTURERS OF SOUVENIRS WILL BE EXPECTED TO OBSERVE CERTAIN LIMITATIONS.
