WAY BEING SOUGHT TO CONTROL VILLAGE VEHICLES

* * * *

THE GOVERNMENT HOPES SOON TO COME UP WITH A WAY OF CONTROLLING THE VILLAGE VEHICLES THAT HAVE RECENTLY ATTRACTED SO MUCH ATTENTION ON CHEUNG CHAU AND ELSEWHERE.

THE OBJECTIVE IS TO REGULATE THOSE ASPECTS WHICH ARE OF SERIOUS CONCERN, SUCH AS SAFETY AND NOISE, BUT WITHOUT IMPOSING RESTRICTIONS WHICH WOULD UNREASONABLY HAMPER THE USEFUL OPERATION OF THESE VEHICLES IN RURAL AREAS WHERE THEY ARE THE ONLY MEANS OF MOVING HEAVY GOODS.

A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY THAT THE INTENTION WAS TO DIFFERENTIATE BETWEEN VILLAGE VEHICLES WHICH ARE PEDESTRIAN CONTROLLED AND THOSE WITH A SEATED DRIVER. THE FORMER WOULD BE ISSUED WITH A PERMIT AND REQUIRED TO CONFORM TO SIMPLE STANDARDS, SUCH AS DIMENSIONS AND THE FITTING OF BRAKES AND AN ENGINE SILENCER.

MOTOR DRIVEN VILLAGE CARS WOULD BE REQUIRED TO COMPLY WITH THE BASIC PROVISIONS OF THE ROAD TRAFFIC (CONSTRUCTION AND USE) REGULATIONS SO FAR AS THEY APPLIED TO SAFETY AND ROAD WORTHINESS.

LEGAL ADVICE IS BEING SOUGHT ON HOW THESE TWO PROPOSED NEW CATEGORIES OF VEHICLE CAN BE DEALT WITH UNDER THE ROAD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE.

AS THE PROPOSALS WOULD FIRST BE SUBJECT TO THE ADVICE OF THE TRANSPORT ADVISORY COMMITTEE AND THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, AND AS AMENDMENTS TO THE LEGISLATION WOULD BE REQUIRED, THE CHANGES WOULD TAKE SOME TIME TO INTRODUCE.

THE INTERVAL WOULD SERVE AS A SUITABLE PERIOD OF GRACE FOR OWNERS TO ENSURE THEIR VEHICLES MET THE STANDARDS SET.

SIR PHILIP TO VISIT FIRE SERVICES

THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE, WILL VISIT THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT TOMORROW (THURSDAY) TO SEE THE VARIOUS FUNCTIONS OF THE DEPARTMENT AND SOME OF ITS RESCUE AND FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT AND FACILITIES.

SIR PHILIP WILL START HIS HALF-DAY TOUR FROM HMS TAMAR AT 2.15 PM, WHERE HE WILL BOARD A HELICOPTER WITH THE DIRECTOR OF FIRE SERVICES, MR F.M. WATSON, FOR THE FLIGHT TO FIRE SERVICES TRAINING SCHOOL AT PAT HEUNG, NEW TERRITORIES.

AFTER SEEING HOW THE RECRUITS ARE TRAINED AT THE SCHOOL, SIR PHILIP WILL FLY TO THE SHA TIN, NEW TERRITORIES FIRE COMMAND HEADQUARTERS AND TOUR THE COMPLEX.

HE WILL THEN LEAVE BY HELICOPTER FOR HONG KONG ISLAND, TO VISIT OFFICERS AND MEN OF THE SPECIAL MASS TRANSIT RAILWAY STRIKE FORCES DIVISION AT HARBOUR ROAD FIRE STATION.

ADVICE ON USE OF NEW MACHINERY
* * *

FACTORY OPERATORS HAVE BEEN ADVISED TO STUDY CAREFULLY THE DO'S AND DON'TS AND LIMITATIONS LISTED IN THE MANUAL OF INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING A NEW PIECE OF MACHINERY OR EQUIPMENT.

THE ADVICE WAS GIVEN BY MR T.K. CHAN, A SUPERINTENDENT OF FACTORY INSPECTORS OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT, IN A TALK ON PREVENTION OF INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS TO THE LIONESSE CLUB OF MT. PHOENIX, HONG KONG.

HE STRESSED THAT INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS, WHICH HAD COST INDUSTRY NEARLY \$334 MILLION IN COMPENSATION PAYOUT AND COURT FINES IN THE PAST THREE YEARS +HAVE TO BE TACKLED FROM ALL FRONTS IF WE WANT TO ACHIEVE THE BEST RESULT+.

TRAINING AND EDUCATION ON SAFETY, LEGISLATIVE CONTROL AND FAMILY INFLUENCE WERE HARDLY ENOUGH TO KEEP ACCIDENTS AT BAY, HE SAID.

DUE ATTENTION HAD TO BE GIVEN TO THOSE HIDDEN DANGERS ASSOCIATED WITH USING A WRONG PIECE OF EQUIPMENT FOR A JOB OR IGNORING A MAKER'S WARNING AGAINST CERTAIN PROHIBITED USE.

MR CHAN POINTED OUT THAT NOT ALL IMPORTED PLANT AND MACHINERY WERE MADE TO CATER FOR LOCAL CONDITIONS AND NEEDS.

MANY OF THEM HAD APPARENTLY NEVER BEEN DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTED WITH DUE REGARD TO SUCH ALIEN FACTORS AS CLIMATIC CONDITIONS, GENERAL WORKING HABITS AND SPACE PROBLEMS AT THE USERS' END.

+THE DIFFERENT VOLTAGE REQUIREMENTS, THE DIFFERENT COLOURING CODE IN ELECTRICAL WIRINGS, AND THE ABSENCE OF SUITABLE INSTRUCTION MANUALS OR DATA SHEETS IN CHINESE, JUST TO NAME A FEW, ARE EVIDENCE OF SUCH LACK OF CONSIDERATION IN THIS RESPECT,+ HE SAID.

AS A RESULT +WRONG+ TYPES OF EQUIPMENT WERE FREQUENTLY BROUGHT IN, WITH THE USERS NOT BEING FULLY AWARE OF THEIR OPTIMUM OPERATING CONDITIONS.

AND, WORST OF ALL, THEY WERE UNAWARE OF THE EQUIPMENT, LIMITATIONS IN APPLICATION, AND USED THEM IN A +MAKE-DO SITUATION,+ MR CHAN ADDED.

MR CHAN POINTED OUT THAT PEOPLE INTERVIEWED IN A PUBLIC OPINION SURVEY ON THE BEST WAYS AND MEANS OF REDUCING ACCIDENTS AT WORK PLACED FAMILY ENCOURAGEMENT AFTER TRAINING - EDUCATION AND LAW ENFORCEMENT.

+THEREFORE WE SHOULD ALSO MOTIVATE INDIVIDUAL FAMILIES TO REMIND AND ENCOURAGE THEIR WORKING MEMBERS TO ADOPT THE SAFE METHOD AT WORK.

+INDEED, A FEW TENDER WORDS WHISPERED INTO ONE'S EAR BEFORE LEAVING HOME FOR WORK, LIKE 'COME HOME SAFELY, LOVE' OR 'DADDY, DON'T GET HURT, PLEASE+', MIGHT WORK MAGIC AND WOULD SAVE A THOUSAND WARNINGS IN FACTORY OR IN A TRAINING SESSION,+ HE SAID.

THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY, SIR JOHN BREMRIDGE TODAY CONTINUED HIS REGULAR VISITS TO LOCAL FACTORIES.

ACCOMPANIED BY THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF INDUSTRY, MR PETER KIANG, SIR JOHN ARRIVED AT FANG BROTHERS TEXTILES LTD. AT KWAI WING ROAD, KWAI CHUNG, WHERE HE WAS WELCOMED BY THE FACTORY'S DIRECTORS, MR JEFFREY FANG AND MR LAWRENCE FANG.

ESTABLISHED IN 1966, FANG BROTHERS TEXTILES LTD. IS A LOCALLY OWNED LIMITED FACTORY POSSESSING A SELF-OWNED, MULTI-STOREY INDUSTRIAL BUILDING. ITS PRODUCTS, MAINLY COTTON FABRICS AND KNITWEAR MADE OF COTTON, MAN-MADE FIBRES AND SILK, ARE MAINLY EXPORTED TO THE UNITED STATES AND THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY.

SIR JOHN ALSO VISITED POLYWAY LTD. AT CHEUNG SHUN STREET, CHEUNG SHA WAN AND WAS GREETED BY THE MANAGING DIRECTOR, MR TONY LEUNG AND THE GENERAL MANAGER, MR ANDREW LEUNG. HE WAS THEN SHOWN AROUND THE FACTORY AND SAW THE OPERATION OF THE FACTORY'S BRAND NEW COMPUTER NUMERICAL CONTROLLED MILLING MACHINES.

POLYWAY LTD., ALSO A LOCALLY OWNED LIMITED COMPANY AND SET UP IN 1978, PRODUCES STEEL MOULDS FOR PLASTIC MOULDING AND STEEL DIES FOR METAL STAMPING. APART FROM BEING SOLD LOCALLY, THE PRODUCTS OF THE COMPANY ARE ALSO EXPORTED TO SINGAPORE, THE UNITED STATES AND THE EEC.

USE OF RURAL LAND AS PROPOSED IN THE NORTH EASTERN NEW TERRITORIES STUDY WILL BE TABLED FOR DISCUSSION AT THE NORTH DISTRICT BOARD MEETING TOMORROW (THURSDAY).

ON RURAL LAND USE, THE STUDY TAKES INTO ACCOUNT THOSE AREAS WHERE AGRICULTURE, FISHERIES AND MARICULTURE ARE PRACTISED, AND THOSE AREAS WHICH SHOULD BE DEVELOPED FOR RECREATIONAL USES.

REPRESENTATIVES OF THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES AND THE RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENTS WILL ATTEND THE MEETING TO BRIEF THE BOARD MEMBERS.

AT THE MEETING, MEMBERS WILL ALSO BE INFORMED OF THE PROGRESS ON CLEARANCE OPERATIONS IN IMPROVING THE ENVIRONMENT OF THE DISTRICT, PARTICULARLY IN LUEN WO HUI AND SHEK WU HUI.

OTHER ITEMS ON THE AGENDA INCLUDE PROGRESS REPORTS OF THE DISTRICT BOARD'S COMMITTEES AND A BRIEFING ON THE REPORT +A PERSPECTIVE ON EDUCATION IN HONG KONG+.

A SEMINAR TO DISCUSS THE PROVISION OF GOVERNMENT AND PRIVATE INSTITUTIONS AND COMMUNITY FACILITIES IN KWUN TONG, AS PROPOSED IN THE DISTRICT'S 10-YEAR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME, WILL BE HELD ON FRIDAY (AUGUST 26) EVENING.

THE PROGRAMME, WHICH HAS A DIRECT BEARING ON THE LONG-TERM DEVELOPMENT OF KWUN TONG, INCLUDES PLANS ON CIVIL ENGINEERING WORKS, HIGHWAYS, WATERWORKS, PUBLIC HOUSING AND COMMUNITY FACILITIES IN THE DISTRICT.

ABOUT 150 MEMBERS FROM THE DISTRICT'S 13 AREA COMMITTEES HAVE BEEN INVITED TO THE SEMINAR TO BE HELD AT 8.30 PM IN THE TELFORD GARDENS COMMUNITY HALL.

THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND THE URBAN COUNCIL ARE JOINTLY ORGANISING A SCHOOL CHILDREN POT FLOWER GROWING COMPETITION, IN CONNECTION WITH THE ANNUAL URBAN COUNCIL FLOWER SHOW TO BE HELD IN MARCH NEXT YEAR AT THE CITY HALL.
