FOREIGN INVESTORS HAVE FAITH IN HK

* * * * *

MOST OF THE HONG KONG MANUFACTURERS ARE HOLDING IN ABEYANCE PLANS FOR FURTHER INVESTMENT IN CHINA AFTER THE RECENT EVENTS THERE, AND IT WAS FOUND THAT THIS CHANGE OF ECONOMIC CLIMATE HAS MADE HONG KONG EVEN MORE ATTRACTIVE TO OVERSEAS INVESTORS, ACCORDING TO THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR OF INDUSTRY, MR ANDREW K.P. LEUNG, TODAY (SATURDAY).

GIVING A TALK AT A SEMINAR ON "HOW WOULD THE POLITICAL DISTURBANCES IN CHINA AFFECT THE ECONOMY IN HONG KONG" ORGANISED BY THE VICTORIA JAYCEES, MR LEUNG CITED A FEW EXAMPLES TO PROVE HIS SAYING.

"MULTI-NATIONAL COMPANIES SUCH AS MCDONNELL DOUGLAS AND HAYES MICROCOMPUTER PRODUCTS HAVE MOVED THEIR REGIONAL HEADQUARTERS, FROM SHANGHAI AND SINGAPORE RESPECTIVELY, TO HONG KONG TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE GEOGRAPHICAL POSITION HERE.

"AS REGARD INWARD INVESTMENT, MULTI-MILLION-DOLLAR PROJECTS ATTRACTED TO HONG KONG RECENTLY INCLUDE DAIWA STEEL, NEC (NATIONAL ELECTRIC COMPANY) AND DAIDO CONCRETE, WHILE AN AUSTRALIAN-OWNED PRINTING COMPANY, MULTIFORM (HK) LTD, HAS JUST ANNOUNCED ITS MAJOR EXPANSION," HE SAID.

MR LEUNG SAID HE BELIEVED HONG KONG COULD ALWAYS BE A BENEFICIARY SHOULD MANUFACTURERS DECIDE TO DIVERSIFY THEIR INVESTMENTS TO OTHER ASIAN COUNTRIES FOLLOWING THE EVENTS IN CHINA.

NEVERTHELESS, HE ATTACHED IMPORTANCE TO THE ECONOMIC LINKS BETWEEN HONG KONG AND CHINA, WHICH HAD BEEN DEVELOPING RAPIDLY SINCE 1979.

MR LEUNG POINTED OUT THAT THE IMMEDIATE EFFECT OF THE RECENT EVENTS IN CHINA APPEARED TO BE MODERATE AS HONG KONG'S DIRECT INVESTMENT AND OUTWARD PROCESSING ARRANGEMENT WERE MAINLY IN GUANGDONG AREA WHICH SUFFERED ONLY MINOR DISRUPTION TO TRANSPORTATION AND TELECOMMUNICATION LINKS.

HE PREDICTED THAT, IN THE LONG RUN, OUTWARD PROCESSING ACTIVITIES IN CHINA WOULD CONTINUE TO GROW.

"PROVIDED MANUFACTURING OPERATIONS CONTINUE TO FUNCTION AS NORMAL IN THE PEARL RIVER DELTA REGION, HONG KONG MANUFACTURERS WILL NOT GIVE UP THE CONSIDERABLE COST ADVANTAGES OF THE OUTWARD PROCESSING ARRANGEMENTS THERE," HE SAID.

"LOCAL MANUFACTURERS ARE LIKELY TO FIND THAT THE CLOSE RELATIONSHIP IN PRODUCTION AND MARKETING BETWEEN HONG KONG AND GUANGDONG CANNOT BE EASILY TRANSPLANTED ELSEWHERE.

"HONG KONG ITSELF COULD BE A BENEFICIARY OF ANY IMMEDIATE RELOCATION OF MANUFACTURING OPERATIONS FROM CHINA, PARTICULARLY FOR HIGHER VALUE-ADDED GOODS," HE ADDED.

MR LEUNG WAS ALSO CONFIDENT THAT HONG KONG WOULD CONTINUE ITS PRESENT ROLE AS A REGIONAL CENTRE FOR PRODUCT DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT AND THE FABRICATION OF COMPLEX COMPONENTS TO COMPLEMENT VOLUME PRODUCTION IN CHINA.

HE CALLED ON HONG KONG PEOPLE NOT TO LOSE SIGHT OF THE TERRITORY'S INNATE STRENGTHS.

"HONG KONG HAS ALWAYS BEEN HIGHLY RESILIENT. WE HAVE EMERGED SUCCESSFULLY, FOR EXAMPLE, THROUGH REPERCUSSIONS OF THE CULTURAL REVOLUTION AND WORLD ECONOMIC RECESSIONS.

"PROVIDED WE CONTINUE TO BUILD UP OUR ECONOMIC STRENGTH AND AVOID SAPPING IT BY OUR EMOTIONS, THERE IS GREAT HOPE THAT OUR RESILIENCE WILL SHINE THROUGH ONCE AGAIN AS IT HAS DONE IN THE PAST," MR LEUNG SAID.

CURTAIN FALLS ON YOUTH MUSIC CAMP

A GRAND FINALE CONCERT WAS HELD AT THE HONG KONG CULTURAL CENTRE THIS (SATURDAY) AFTERNOON, MARKING THE CLOSE OF THE 1989 HONG KONG YOUTH MUSIC CAMP HELD AT THE LEI YUE MUN PARK OVER THE PAST TWO WEEKS.

TAKING PART IN THE CONCERT WERE ABOUT 200 LOCAL AND OVERSEAS MUSICIANS, INCLUDING SOME FROM AUSTRALIA AND KOREA AS WELL AS CHINA.

A MUSIC OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID THE MUSIC CAMP WAS ONE OF THE MOST SIGNIFICANT TRAINING EVENTS IN HONG KONG'S MUSICAL CALENDAR.

HE POINTED OUT THAT THE RESULT OF THE CAMP WERE IMPRESSIVE, AND WOULD HAVE BENEFICIAL EFFECTS ON THE YOUNG MUSICIANS THEMSELVES.

COMMENTING ON THE CONCERT, THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT IT REPRESENTED THE CULMINATION OF TWO WEEKS OF DEDICATED WORK BY INSTRUCTORS AND CAMPERS.

THE CONCERT ALSO PROVIDED THE CAMPERS WITH AN OPPORTUNITY TO PERFORM IN PUBLIC, AND FOR THE AUDIENCE TO SEE HOW THEY HAD BENEFITTED FROM THE INTENSIVE MUSIC TRAINING, ESPECIALLY FROM THE PROFESSIONALISM OF THE INSTRUCTORS FROM OVERSEAS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE TWO-HOUR CONCERT INCLUDED THREE CHINESE PIECES -- "FAREWELL LADY ZHAO JUN", "MOONLIGHT OVER THE SOUTHERN TERRITORY" AND "CRYING IN GU SU", PERFORMED BY THE MUSIC CAMP SENIOR CHINESE ORCHESTRA UNDER THE BATON OF MR WANG HUIRAN, GUEST CONDUCTOR FROM CHINA.

THE PROGRAMME ALSO INCLUDED PERFORMANCES FROM DVORAK'S "SYMPHONY NO. 9 IN E MINOR, OP.95" BY THE MUSIC CAMP SYMPHONY ORCHESTRA, CONDUCTED BY MR JOHN CURRO FROM AUSTRALIA.

REVIEW REPORT ON SERVICES FOR ELDERLY COMPLETED

* * * * *

THE REPORT BY THE CENTRAL COMMITTEE ON SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY, WHICH WAS SET UP IN 1987 TO REVIEW SERVICES FOR SENIOR CITIZENS, HAS BEEN SUBMITTED TO THE SOCIAL WELFARE ADVISORY COMMITTEE FOR DISCUSSION, THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR ALFRED CHUI, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE FONG SHU CHUEN SOCIAL CENTRE FOR THE ELDERLY OF THE HONG KONG SOCIETY FOR THE AGED AT CHAI WAN, MR CHUI SAID THE COMMITTEE HAD MADE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPROVING AND BETTER CO-ORDINATING THE VARIOUS SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY.

AS THE PRESENT POLICY FOR THE ELDERLY AIMED TO ENABLE THE SENIOR CITIZENS TO LIVE WITH THEIR FAMILIES IN THE COMMUNITY, VARIOUS COMMUNITY SUPPORTIVE SERVICES HAD BEEN DEVELOPED TO HELP RESIDENTS TAKE CARE OF THEIR ELDERLY FAMILY MEMBERS, HE SAID.

"ONE OF THESE SERVICES IS SOCIAL CENTRES FOR THE ELDERLY, WHICH PROVIDE RECREATIONAL, GROUP AND EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR THE ELDERLY," HE SAID.

"THERE ARE NOW 103 SOCIAL CENTRES FOR THE ELDERLY IN HONG KONG AND BY THE MID-1990'S THE GOVERNMENT'S PLAN OF PROVIDING ONE SUCH CENTRE FOR EVERY 30,000 POPULATION WILL BE REACHED."

THE FONG SHU CHUEN SOCIAL CENTRE FOR THE ELDERLY, SET UP WITH A \$200,000 DONATION FROM THE FONG SHU FOOK TONG FOUNDATION, HAS ATTRACTED AROUND 270 MEMBERS SINCE IT BEGAN OPERATION TWO MONTHS AGO.

MR CHUI COMMENDED THE FOUNDATION FOR ITS CONTRIBUTIONS TO WELFARE SERVICES.

ABOUT 1,200 COLOURFUL HANDICRAFT ITEMS MADE BY GIRLS AT THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S MA TAU WEI GIRLS' HOME WERE PUT ON SALE AT A CHARITY BAZAAR HELD AT THE HOME TODAY (SATURDAY).

THE BAZAAR WAS ORGANISED IN CONNECTION WITH THE 10TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE INTERNATIONAL YEAR OF THE CHILD, AND PROCEEDS WILL BE USED FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE PROGRAMMES UNDERTAKEN BY GIRLS AT THE HOME.

SOME 250 GUESTS, INCLUDING MEMBERS OF THE GIRLS' FAMILIES, MAGISTRATES AND JUDGES, WORKERS FROM OTHER WELFARE ORGANISATIONS AND STAFF OF THE DEPARTMENT, ATTENDED THE BAZAAR.

BOTH OFFICIATING GUESTS, THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MRS ELIZABETH WONG, AND ENTREPRENEUR MRS THERESA LAU, URGED THE GIRLS TO CONTINUE TO SHARE THEIR LOVE WITH THE UNDERPRIVILEGED MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY AND TO HELP BUILD HONG KONG INTO A MORE STABLE AND PROSPEROUS SOCIETY.

THE SUPERINTENDENT OF THE HOME, MRS MIRANDA CHUNG, SAID: "THE BAZAAR, LIKE MANY OF THE HOME'S SOCIAL SERVICE PROGRAMMES ORGANISED FOR THE GIRLS, AIMS TO CULTIVATE IN THEM A SENSE OF ACHIEVEMENT, TO PROVIDE THEM WITH OPPORTUNITIES TO EXPERIENCE THE JOY OF GIVING LOVE AND TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE CARE OF THE COMMUNITY, AND EVENTUALLY TO REBUILD THEIR SELF-CONFIDENCE AND HOPES IN LIFE."

THE HOME IS ONE OF SEVEN RESIDENTIAL INSTITUTIONS RUN BY THE DEPARTMENT, PROVIDING FOR THE DAILY CARE AND CHARACTER TRAINING OF JUVENILE AND TEENAGE GIRLS ON PROBATION OR UNDER CARE AND PROTECTION ORDERS.

THE GIRLS, WHO ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO STAY IN THE HOME FOR ONE YEAR OR MORE, RECEIVE TRAINING IN SOCIAL SKILLS AS WELL AS PREVOCATIONAL TRAINING TO BETTER EQUIP THEM FOR HOUSEHOLD WORK OR EMPLOYMENT.

AN ADDITIONAL 8,500 COPIES OF AN INFORMATION KIT HAVE BEEN PUBLISHED BY THE EASTERN DISTRICT BOARD FOR DISTRIBUTION TO NEW RESIDENTS IN THE DISTRICT.

THE KIT, ENTITLED "MY HOME IN EASTERN DISTRICT", WAS FIRST PUBLISHED IN MARCH THIS YEAR TO HELP NEW ARRIVALS TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THEIR DISTRICT AND THE WORK OF THE DISTRICT BOARD.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE BOARD SAID TODAY (SATURDAY) THAT IN VIEW OF LARGE NUMBER OF TENANTS MOVING INTO NEWLY COMPLETED PUBLIC AND PRIVATE HOUSING ESTATES IN THE DISTRICT, IT WAS NECESSARY TO PRINT ADDITIONAL COPIES TO MEET DEMAND.

"THE KIT WILL ENABLE THEM TO GAIN A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE DISTRICT BY PROVIDING A QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE TO ITS GENERAL CHARACTERISTICS AND BASIC COMMUNITY FACILITIES." HE SAID.

THE KIT, RESEMBLING THE SHAPE OF A HOUSE BUILT OF BRICKS AND BEARING THE LOGO OF THE EASTERN DISTRICT BOARD, HAS BEEN UPDATED TO INCORPORATE LATEST CHANGES IN THE DISTRICT.

IT CONTAINS SIX LEAFLETS OUTLINING DEVELOPMENTS, THE ROLES OF THE DISTRICT BOARD, PUBLIC TRANSPORT SERVICES, ADDRESSES AND TELEPHONE NUMBERS OF GOVERNMENT OFFICES AND LOCAL ORGANISATIONS, AS WELL AS THE CONTACT TELEPHONE NUMBERS OF DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS.

ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE TO DISTRIBUTE THE KITS TO RESIDENTS THROUGH THE MANAGEMENT OFFICES OF NEW HOUSING ESTATES, WHILE COPIES WILL BE DISTRIBUTED AT THE EASTERN DISTRICT OFFICE ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVED BASIS.

STAGE II OF YUEN LONG SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS
* * * * *

THE CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES DEPARTMENT WILL EXTEND THE EXISTING YUEN LONG SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS STAGE I TO IMPROVE SEWAGE TREATMENT FACILITIES IN THE AREA.

THE EXISTING SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS IS DESIGNED TO PROVIDE SECONDARY TREATMENT FOR BOTH DOMESTIC WASTEWATER FROM YUEN LONG AND INDUSTRIAL WASTEWATER FROM THE YUEN LONG INDUSTRIAL ESTATE.

THE DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF YUEN LONG SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS STAGE II. WORK IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN IN NOVEMBER AND TAKE ABOUT 27 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

THE STAGE II WORKS. WHEN COMPLETED. WILL INCREASE THE CAPACITY OF THE STAGE I WORKS FROM 53,000 CUBIC METRES PER DAY TO 70,000 CUBIC METRES PER DAY.

THE WORKS INCLUDE PRIMARY SEDIMENTATION TANKS. AERATION TANKS. FINAL SETTLING TANKS. CONSOLIDATION TANKS. PRIMARY SLUDGE DIGESTION TANK. SECONDARY SLUDGE DIGESTION TANK. ASSOCIATED PIPEWORKS AND ROADWORKS.
