REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE IN 1980

* * * * *

THE HONG KONG REVIEW OF OVERSEAS TRADE IN 1980+ IS NOW ON SALE AT THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE IN THE GPO BUILDING AT CONNAUGHT PLACE.

AT \$26 A COPY, IT CONTAINS A BRIEF TEXT, 18 GRAPHS AND 34 STATISTICAL APPENDICES WITH COMPARATIVE FIGURES FOR THE PREVIOUS YEARS.

INTRODUCING THE REVIEW, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT POINTED OUT THAT IT GIVES A BRIEF ACCOUNT OF THE SIGNIFICANT CHANGES IN THE DIRECTION AND COMPOSITION OF HONG KONG'S OVERSEAS TRADE IN 1980, INCLUDING A COMPREHENSIVE ANALYSIS OF TRADE BY MAJOR TRADING PARTNER AND BY COMMODITY CATEGORY.

TO FACILITATE INTERNATIONAL COMPARISON, A NEW TABLE IS INCLUDED, SHOWING TRADE STATISTICS OF SELECTED COUNTRIES BY CUSTOMS CO-OPERATION COUNCIL NOMENCLATURE (CCCN) COMMODITY CLASSIFICATION.

+ALSO INCLUDED IS AN ANALYSIS OF HONG KONG'S EXPORT PERFORMANCE IN PRINCIPAL OVERSEAS MARKETS, COMPARED WITH THOSE OF MAJOR COMPETITORS,+ HE ADDED.

ACCORDING TO THE REVIEW, SUBSTANTIAL INCREASES WERE NOTED IN IMPORTS FROM CHINA (BY \$6 818 MILLION OR 45 PER CENT) AND FROM JAPAN (BY \$6 324 MILLION OR 33 PER CENT). AMONG THE OVERSEAS MARKETS WITH THE HIGHEST GROWTH IN DOMESTIC EXPORTS WERE THE U.S. (BY \$3 794 MILLION OR 20 PER CENT), THE FEDERAL REPUBLIC OF GERMANY (BY \$1 040 MILLION OR 16 PER CENT), AND CHINA (BY \$1 002 MILLION OR 166 PER CENT).

BY COMMODITY, SUBSTANTIAL GROWTH WAS REGISTERED IN IMPORTS OF TEXTILES (BY \$3 032 MILLION OR 26 PER CENT) AND PETROLEUM (BY \$2 882 MILLION OR 61 PER CENT)- WHEREAS THE COMMODITIES WITH THE HIGHEST GROWTH IN DOMESTIC EXPORTS WERE CLOTHING (BY \$3 127 MILLION OR 16 PER CENT) AND PHOTOGRAPHIC APPARATUS, OPTICAL GOODS AND WATCHES AND CLOCKS (BY \$1 993 MILLION OR 39 PER CENT).

RE-EXPORT TRADE EXPERIENCED STRONG GROWTH IN 1980. THE VALUE OF COMMODITIES OF CHINA ORIGIN RE-EXPORTED THROUGH HONG KONG INCREASED BY \$2 731 MILLION OR 48 PER CENT, WITH THE LARGEST INCREASE REGISTERED IN CLOTHING (BY \$570 MILLION OR 79 PER CENT). RE-EXPORTS OF JAPAN ORIGIN ALSO GREW SUBSTANTIALLY (BY \$2 451 MILLION OR 72 PER CENT), ESPECIALLY FOR ROAD VEHICLES (BY \$673 MILLION OR 184 PER CENT). ON THE OTHER HAND, RE-EXPORTS TO CHINA ALSO INCREASED BY \$3 327 MILLION OR 253 PER CENT, AND RE-EXPORTS TO JAPAN BY \$1 090 MILLION OR 55 PER CENT.

/THE VALUE

THE VALUE OF AIRBORNE TRADE IN 1980, REPRESENTING 22 PER CENT OF TOTAL MERCHANDISE TRADE, INCREASED BY \$9 486 MILLION OR 26 PER CENT OVER 1979. AIRBORNE IMPORTS FROM THE U.S. ROSE BY \$1 336 MILLION OR 39 PER CENT, AND AIRBORNE EXPORTS TO THE U.S. BY \$1 072 MILLION OR 16 PER CENT. ANALYSED BY COMMODITY, WATCHES AND CLOCKS SHIPPED BY AIR EXPERIENCED THE HIGHEST GROWTH IN IMPORTS (BY \$1 456 MILLION OR 36 PER CENT), AS WELL AS IN EXPORTS (BY \$1 769 MILLION OR 46 PER CENT).

THE REVIEW ALSO PUBLISHES UNIT VALUE AND QUANTUM INDEXES WHICH ARE OFTEN USED TO ASSESS THE MOVEMENTS IN COMMODITY PRICES AND THE REAL CHANGES IN TRADE VOLUME. DURING 1980, WHILST THE TRADE VOLUME OF MOST COMMODITIES INCREASED OVER 1979, THE IMPORT VOLUME OF PLASTIC MOULDING MATERIALS DECREASED BY THREE PER CENT, DYEING, TANNING AND COLOURING MATERIALS BY 10 PER CENT, AND ALCOHOLIC DRINKS BY 13 PER CENT.

HONG KONG WAS THE LARGEST EXPORTER OF TOYS AND DOLLS, ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS AND TORCHES IN THE WORLD. HONG KONG WAS ALSO THE SECOND LARGEST EXPORTER OF CLOTHING AFTER ITALY, AND OF RADIO-BROADCAST RECEIVERS AFTER JAPAN.

AEROGRAMMES BEARING A \$1 STAMP MOTIF WILL BE PLACED ON SALE FOR THE FIRST TIME AT ALL POST OFFICES ON MONDAY (SEPTEMBER 21), THE POSTMASTER GENERAL ANNOUNCED TODAY.

THE SHAPE AND FORMAT OF THE NEW AEROGRAMME FORM ARE THE SAME AS THE OLD ONE, EXCEPT THAT IT WILL NOW BEAR THE CURRENT POSTAGE FOR AEROGRAMMES AND THE WORDS 'BY AIR MAIL' HAVE BEEN REMOVED FROM THE TOP LEFT CORNER, LEAVING JUST 'AEROGRAMME' ON A DARK BLUE BACKGROUND.

PHILATELISTS ARE ADVISED THAT NO HANDBACK SERVICE WILL BE PROVIDED ON THE FIRST DAY OF ISSUE. HOWEVER, SPECIAL POSTING BOXES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, KOWLOON CENTRAL AND TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICES FOR THOSE WHO WISH TO HAVE THOSE AEROGRAMMES POSTED ON SEPTEMBER 21 HAND-CANCELLED.

10 000 VOTERS IN TSUEN WAN RETURN REGISTRATION FORMS

* * * *

TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE HAS RECEIVED MORE THAN 10 000 REGISTRATION FORMS OF VOTERS FOR THE DISTRICT BOARD ELECTION DURING THE FIRST TWO WEEKS OF REGISTRATION, ACTING TOWN MANAGER, MR LUI HAU-TUEN, SAID TODAY (TUESDAY).

HE SAID THE RESPONSE SO FAR WAS ENCOURAGING, BUT HE URGED THOSE RESIDENTS WHO HAD NOT YET REGISTERED TO DO SO AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

THE SIX-WEEK REGISTRATION OF VOTERS WILL END ON OCTOBER 12.

+THE SUCCESS OF OUR FUTURE DISTRICT BOARD DEPENDS A LOT ON THE CALIBRE OF OUR UNOFFICIALS, INCLUDING THE ELECTED MEMBERS,+ HE SAID.

+MORE ELIGIBLE PERSONS REGISTERING AS VOTERS WILL ENSURE THAT PERSONS WITH THE RIGHT CALIBRE ARE TO BE ELECTED TO THE BOARD,+ HE ADDED.

MR LUI SAID SINCE EARLY THIS MONTH STAFF OF THE DISTRICT OFFICE HAD BEEN VISITING MUTUAL AID COMMITTEES AND LOCAL ORGANISATIONS TO ENCOURAGE ELIGIBLE VOTERS TO REGISTER.

PWD OFFERS TECHNICAL CAREER FOR YOUTHS

YOUNG PEOPLE SEEKING A CAREER IN ELECTRICAL, MECHANICAL, AND ELECTRONIC CRAFTSMANSHIP CAN NOW JOIN THE CRAFT APPRENTICE TRAINING SCHEME.

THE ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS INVITING APPLICATIONS FROM THOSE WHO HAVE COMPLETED MINIMUM FORM TWO AND WHOSE AGE IS BETWEEN 15 AND 17.

+CANDIDATES SELECTED FOR THE SCHEME WILL RECEIVE FOUR YEARS OF TRAINING AS CRAFTSMEN IN ELECTRICAL, MECHANICAL OR AIR-CONDITIONING FIELDS AND BE ENTITLED TO A MONTHLY SALARY BETWEEN \$765 AND \$1 150 WITH ANNUAL PAID LEAVE AND FREE MEDICAL CARE,+ SAID MR WONG SHIU-KWONG, SUPERINTENDENT OF APPRENTICES OF THE ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL OFFICE TODAY.

+ON COMPLETION OF THE COURSE, APPRENTICES WILL BE CONSIDERED FOR APPOINTMENT AS ARTISANS WITH THE GOVERNMENT. THEY WILL ALSO BE FREE TO JOIN THE PRIVATE SECTOR IN WHICH WELL-TRAINED CRAFTSMEN ARE IN GREAT DEMAND,+ HE ADDED.

MR WONG POINTED OUT THAT PROMOTION PROSPECTS FOR ARTISANS ARE GOOD AND THEY WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR PROMOTION TO WORKS SUPERVISOR OR EVEN MORE SENIOR POSTS DEPENDING ON THEIR INDIVIDUAL PERFORMANCE.

THEY MAY BE EMPLOYED IN THE ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL OFFICE, WATER SUPPLIES OFFICE, AND GEOTECHNICAL OFFICE OF THE PWD OR KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY WORKSHOPS ALTHOUGH THERE IS NO GUARANTEE THAT THEY WILL ALL BE TAKEN UP BY THE GOVERNMENT,+ HE ADDED.

HOWEVER, ARTISAN I AND II POSTS ARE NORMALLY FILLED BY CRAFT APPRENTICES WHO HAVE SATISFACTORILY COMPLETED THEIR TRAINING.

MR WONG ADDED THAT SINCE THE FIRST GROUP OF CRAFT APPRENTICES GRADUATED IN 1974 UNDER THE PRESENT RESTRUCTURED TRAINING SCHEME, OVER 40 GRADUATED APPRENTICES HAD BEEN PROMOTED TO WORKS SUPERVISORS AND ONE WAS ALREADY AN ASSISTANT INSPECTOR.

MR WONG WAS HIMSELF AN EX-GOVERNMENT APPRENTICE.

ABOUT 200 APPRENTICES WILL BE RECRUITED FOR THESE POSTS THIS YEAR.

THE FOUR-YEAR APPRENTICESHIP CONSISTS OF BASIC AND ON-THE-JOB TRAINING.

IN THE FIRST YEAR, APPRENTICES WILL ATTEND A SIX-MONTH FULL-TIME ENGINEERING CRAFT COURSE AT MORRISON HILL TECHNICAL INSTITUTE, FOLLOWED BY ANOTHER SIX MONTHS OF BASIC TRAINING IN THE APPRENTICE TRAINING CENTRE AT CAROLINE HILL.

IN THE FOLLOWING THREE YEARS, THEY WILL RECEIVE FURTHER TRAINING IN VARIOUS GOVERNMENT WORKSHOPS AND ATTEND PART-TIME DAY-RELEASE COURSES IN TECHNICAL INSTITUTES.

THE COMPREHENSIVE TRAINING PROGRAMME WILL INCLUDE INSTRUCTIONS ON BENCH FITTING, MACHINE TOOLS, WELDING, ELECTRICAL, ELECTRONICS AND SHEET METAL WORK.

+THE TRAINING SCHEME PRACTICALLY COVERS EVERY MAJOR ARTISAN TRADE, THUS PROVIDING APPRENTICES WITH A BROAD ENGINEERING KNOWLEDGE,+ MR WONG SAID.

APPLICATION FORMS FOR THE SCHEME ARE AVAILABLE AT ALL CITY DISTRICT OFFICES AND THE NEW TERRITORIES DISTRICT OFFICES, THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT'S LOCAL EMPLOYMENT SERVICE OFFICES AND THE APPRENTICE TRAINING CENTRE OF THE PWD'S ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL OFFICE.

PERFORMING ARTS ACADEMY

THE COMMISSIONER FOR RECREATION AND CULTURE, MR BARRIE WIGGHAM, TODAY (TUESDAY) WELCOMED THE ANNOUNCEMENT BY THE ROYAL HONG KONG JOCKEY CLUB OF ITS AGREEMENT TO CONDUCT A FEASIBILITY STUDY AND PRELIMINARY DESIGN WORK FOR AN ACADEMY FOR THE PERFORMING ARTS, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GOVERNMENT.

MR WIGGHAM'S COMMENTS FOLLOWED THE CHAIRMAN OF THE JOCKEY CLUB, MR PETER WILLIAMS'S SPEECH AT THE CLUB'S ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING THIS EVENING.

+THE ACADEMY,+ HE SAID, +WILL PROVIDE MUCH NEEDED FACILITIES FOR REHEARSAL AND TRAINING IN THE PERFORMING ARTS, AND WILL BE USED BY A WIDE RANGE OF ORGANISATIONS, BOTH AMATEUR AND PROFESSIONAL.+

+THE GROWTH OF THE PERFORMING ARTS IN HONG KONG IS HAMPERED BY A SEVERE SHORTAGE OF PREMISES FOR THIS PURPOSE, SO THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ACADEMY WILL GREATLY ASSIST THEIR DEVELOPMENT,+ HE SAID.

MR WIGGHAM CONFIRMED THAT LAND ADJACENT TO THE ARTS CENTRE HAD BEEN SUGGESTED AS A POSSIBLE SITE FOR THE ACADEMY, SUBJECT TO THE VIEWS OF THE TOWN PLANNING BOARD.

+IF THE PROJECT PROVES FEASIBLE ON THIS SITE,+ SAID MR WIGGHAM, +WE WOULD LIKE TO SEE LOW RISE BUILDINGS IN A PARK-LIKE SETTING, SO AS TO PRESERVE THE OPEN NATURE OF THE SITE. PUBLIC USE OF THE PARK AREAS WOULD BE ENCOURAGED.+

FORTY-SIX APPOINTED OFFICER CADETS IN PRISONS DEPARTMENT

FORTY-SIX ASSISTANT OFFICERS OF THE PRISONS DEPARTMENT WERE APPOINTED OFFICER CADETS TODAY.

AT A CEREMONY HELD AT THE STAFF TRAINING INSTITUTE IN STANLEY, THE ACTING DEPUTY COMMISSIONER OF PRISONS, MR GARTH HYDES, PRESENTED RANK INSIGNIA AND APPOINTMENT LETTERS TO THE NEWLY PROMOTED OFFICER CADETS.

ADDRESSING THE CEREMONY, MR HYDES TOLD THE OFFICERS THAT THEY MUST NOT WAIVER OR BE INDECISIVE WITH THEIR PAST COLLEAGUES WHO WILL NOW BE SUBJECT TO THEIR ORDERS AND DIRECTIONS.

+NOR MUST YOU SHOW FAVOURITISM AND AT ALL TIMES YOU MUST BE SEEN TO BE IMPARTIAL,+ HE SAID.

MR HYDES POINTED OUT THAT MANY MEN AND WOMEN WHO JOINED THE SERVICE AT THE ASSISTANT OFFICER LEVEL HAD NOW RISEN TO THE MOST SENIOR RANKS.

+THIS APPOINTMENT AS OFFICER CADETS HAS NOW GIVEN YOU THE OPPORTUNITY TO DEVELOP AND ADVANCE IN YOUR CAREERS,+ HE ADDED.

HE ALSO REMINDED THE OFFICERS THAT IN DEALING WITH PRISONERS, THEY MUST BE HUMANE AND ENSURE THAT THEIR SUBORDINATES CARRY OUT THEIR JOB EFFECTIVELY AND WITH COMPASSION.

+MANY OF YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO HAVE CONTACTS WITH THE PUBLIC AND THAT THE WAY YOU PRESENT YOURSELF AND DEAL WITH PEOPLE WILL REFLECT ON THE DEPARTMENT AS A WHOLE,+ HE STRESSED.

THE NEWLY APPOINTED OFFICER CADETS COMPRISED 43 MEN AND THREE WOMEN WHOSE AVERAGE LENGTH OF SERVICE WITH THE DEPARTMENT IS ABOUT FIVE YEARS.

ALL OF THEM WILL UNDERGO DEVELOPMENTAL TRAINING IN VARIOUS PENAL INSTITUTIONS AND IN THE STAFF TRAINING INSTITUTE SO THAT THEY MAY CARRY OUT THEIR WORK EFFECTIVELY.

IF THEY PASS THE REQUIRED EXAMINATIONS AND WORK HARD, THEY WOULD BE CONSIDERED FOR PROMOTION TO THE OFFICER RANK IN DUE COURSE.

LIFE GUARDS SAVED 1 036 IN 1980

ONE THOUSAND AND THIRTY-SIX LIVES WERE SAVED IN 1980 BY HONG KONG LIFE GUARDS, WHO INCLUDE FISHERMEN, THE DIRECTOR OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES, MR JOHN RIDDELL-SWAN, SAID TODAY.

THIS EFFORT, COLLECTIVELY, SHOWED ALSO THAT HONG KONG PEOPLE WERE BECOMING MORE CIVIC-MINDED AND WILLING TO PUT SELF-SACRIFICE ABOVE SELF-INTEREST, MR RIDDELL-SWAN TOLD MEMBERS OF THE HONG KONG LIFE GUARD CLUB AT A PRESENTATION CEREMONY THIS AFTERNOON OF +RESCUE-STAR+ AWARDS BY THE CLUB FOR THE LIFE-SAVING EFFORTS OF ITS MEMBERS.

MR RIDDELL-SWAN SAID THAT SINCE 1962 THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT HAD WORKED CLOSELY WITH THE CLUB TO PROMOTE LIFE-SAVING OF FISHERMEN AT SEA. NOW FISHERMEN WERE REGULARLY AMONG RECIPIENTS OF +THE RESCUE STAR+.

+THESE AWARDS ARE MADE BY THE CLUB IN RECOGNITION OF THE GALLANTRY OF THE INDIVIDUAL RECIPIENTS, BUT AT THE SAME TIME COLLECTIVELY THEY SIGNIFY AN INCREASED CIVIC-MINDEDNESS IN THE COMMUNITY AND A WILLINGNESS TO PUT SELF-SACRIFICE ABOVE SELF-INTEREST,+ HE SAID.

FOURTEEN FISHERMEN WERE AMONG THE 44 PEOPLE WHO RECEIVED THE RESCUE STAR THIS YEAR.

MR RIDDELL-SWAN PAID TRIBUTE TO THE WORK OF THE CLUB FOR ITS ROLE IN PROVIDING LIFE-SAVING SERVICE TO SWIMMERS AT SWIMMING POOLS, BATHING BEACHES AND LAUNCH PARTIES.

LAST YEAR 10 596 LIFE GUARDS PERFORMED PATROL DUTIES REGULARLY AND AT SPECIAL EVENTS.

+THE SUCCESS OF THESE PATROLS CAN BE MEASURED BY THE NUMBER OF LIVES SAVED WHICH DURING THE YEAR AMOUNTED TO A TOTAL OF 1 036. THIS BRINGS THE GRAND TOTAL OF LIVES SAVED TO OVER 13 500 SINCE THE CLUB WAS FORMED IN 1956,+ HE SAID.

A 33-YEAR-OLD PLASTICS FACTORY SUPERVISOR, MR LAU CHAI-MING, WON THE FIRST PRIZE OF A \$4 500 PHILIPS COLOUR TELEVISION SET IN THE THIRD ROUND OF THE INDUSTRIAL SAFETY QUIZ COMPETITION HELD DURING THE +HAPPY HOUR+ PROGRAMME ON REDIFFUSION TELEVISION LAST (MONDAY) NIGHT.

IN THE KEENLY CONTESTED COMPETITION, MR LAU BEAT EIGHT OTHER CONTESTANTS WHO SHARED AMONG THEMSELVES OTHER PRIZES WORTH MORE THAN \$10 000.

MR LEE CHIU-FAI, A 34-YEAR-OLD ELECTRICAL TECHNICIAN, WON THE SECOND PRIZE OF AN AIR TICKET TO JAPAN, PLUS FREE BOARD AND LODGING, WHILE THE THIRD PRIZE OF AN AIR TICKET TO THAILAND WENT TO MR CHUNG SZE-KWAN, A 25-YEAR-OLD PRINTING COMPANY MANAGER.

THE OTHER PRIZES OF AN AIR TICKET TO THE PHILIPPINES, AN RTV MINIATURE 24K GOLD SAFETY HELMET, AN ATARI VIDEO ELECTRONIC TV GAME AND THREE STEREO CASSETTE PLAYERS WERE SHARED AMONG MISS LAU KAN-YEE, MR CHEUNG PAK-CHEUNG, MR YIU LAU-YAN, MR CHAN KWONG, MISS CHUNG MO-LING AND MR NG WAI-KEUNG.

THE AIR TICKETS WERE DONATED BY HONG KONG DAILY NEWS AND THE TV GAME BY KONG KING TRADING COMPANY.

THE GRAND FINALE OF THE COMPETITION IS SCHEDULED TO BE HELD AT THE END OF NEXT (OCTOBER) MONTH, WITH 15 CORRECT ENTRIES TAKING PART.
