ARCHITECTS VISIT SPACE MUSEUM

SOME 30 MEMBERS OF THE HONG KONG INSTITUTION OF ARCHITECTS THIS (SATURDAY) MORNING VISITED THE HONG KONG SPACE MUSEUM.

THEY WERE ACCOMPANIED BY MR. KENNETH KAN, SENIOR ARCHITECT, AND MR. KWAN PAK-LAM, PROJECT ARCHITECT, OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

THE \$20 MILLION PROJECT, FINANCED BY THE URBAN COUNCIL, IS ABOUT 70 PER CENT COMPLETE.

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED TODAY (SATURDAY) THAT FROM 10 A.M. ON MONDAY (JUNE 18), THE FOLLOWING RESTRICTIONS WILL BE IMPOSED AT THE JUNCTION BETWEEN TONG MEI ROAD AND ARGYLE STREET:

- * ALL SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC IN TONG MEI ROAD, INCLUDING FRANCHISED BUSES, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM TURNING RIGHT INTO CHERRY STREET AND WILL BE DIVERTED TO TONG MEI ROAD, MONG KOK ROAD AND NATHAN ROAD BEFORE TURNING INTO ARGYLE STREET WESTBOUND=
- * KOWLOON BUS ROUTES 37, 44A, 51 AND 72 WILL BE DIVERTED TO LAI CHI KOK ROAD, SHANGHAI STREET, ARGYLE STREET BEFORE TURNING INTO CHERRY STREET AND BUS STOPS WILL BE SET UP ALONG THE DIVERTED ROUTES=
- * ALL NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC IN FERRY STREET-TONG MEI ROAD WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM TURNING INTO ARGYLE STREET EASTBOUND AND WILL BE DIVERTED TO TONG MEI ROAD, MONG KOK ROAD AND SHANGHAI STREET BEFORE TURNING INTO ARGYLE STREET EASTBOUND.
