BUILDING PROGRAMME 1978/79

I. BUILDING OR EXTENSIONS TO EXISTING BUILDINGS COMPLETED

A. Government

(1) Tang Shiu Kin Hospital, Improvements to the Operating Theatre - Improvements to existing facilities to permit a wider range of surgical operations to be undertaken at the hospital. Emergency generator and air-conditioning installations were included. Work completed in September, 1978.

(2) Dental Therapist Training School & Clinic - A 9-storey complex to provide a training school for dental therapists - a dental clinic, a school children dental clinic, and a new accommodation for reprovisioning of the head office of the Government Dental Service. Completed in October, 1978.

B. Government-assisted

(1) Nam Long Hospital Extension - A new block to provide offices, quarters, and staff canteen. Completed in May, 1978.

(2) Caritas Medical Centre Extension - Construction of 13-storey building to provide 288 beds for the geriatric and another 288 beds for the mentally retarded, with associated physiotherapy, occupational therapy services and other ancillary facilities included. Work completed in March, 1979.

(3) Yan Chai Hospital Extension, Stage I - Erection of 3 additional storeys on top of existing building to provide another 50 beds and staff quarters. Construction work completed in March, 1979.

II. PROJECTS UNDER CONSTRUCTION

A. Government

(1) Psychiatric Wing, Princess Margaret Hospital - A new mental hospital of 1,336 beds, and will include two ward blocks and a clinical and services block. Expected completion date is July, 1980.

(2) Additional staff quarters, Queen Mary Hospital, Phase II - to provide a 20-storey block of 80 units, Type I and Type II, of married quarters for medical and clinical lecturers. Expected completion date is October, 1979.

- (3) Extension and Improvements to Fanling Hospital - Phase I of the project includes a 5-storey extension built to accommodate a casualty unit, a x-ray unit, a family health service centre and staff quarters. Expected completion day is November, 1979. Phase II of the project includes alterations and additions to the existing hospital facilities, and 46 beds would be added. Expected completion date is December, 1980.
- (4) Sai Kung Dispensary, temporary reprovisioning of the general out-patient department - The general out-patient department of the Sai Kung Dispensary would be temporarily reprovisioned into two shop units in Sai Kung town. The fitting out work is expected to be completed by end of June, 1979.

B. Government-assisted

- (1) Kwong Wah Hospital - New Wing - An 11-storey clinical pathology building with a mortuary, an x-ray department, occupational therapy, physiotherapy and medical social services, a 40-bed orthopaedic ward, laboratory facilities for various pathological services. Expected completion date is 1980.
- (2) Dental teaching beds, Tung Wah Hospital - Conversion and upgrading of existing facilities of some 220 beds at the Centenary Building of the Hospital for use as teaching beds. Expected completion date is 1980.
