DEMANDS ON MEDICAL SERVICE

* * * * *

IF THERE IS ANYTHING WRONG WITH THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH SYSTEM IN HONG KONG, IT IS THAT THE GOVERNMENT +STRIVES TO PROVIDE A NON-CONTRIBUTORY AND ALMOST FREE NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE TO THE ENTIRE POPULATION AND ENDS UP IN NOT SATISFYING EVERYONE'S DEMAND+.

THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF MEDICAL AND HEALTH SERVICES, DR S.F. LAM, SAID THIS IN A TALK TO THE ROTARY CLUB OF KOWLOON WEST TODAY.

HE EXPLAINED THAT DURING THE EARLY POST-WAR YEARS HONG KONG'S MEDICAL AND HEALTH CARE WAS LIMITED TO PREVENTING AND CONTROLLING COMMUNICABLE DISEASES.

THIS WAS LATER EXTENDED TO INCLUDE AN EMERGENCY SERVICE TO TREAT ACCIDENT CASES WHILE THE PUBLIC WAS LEFT VERY MUCH TO FEND FOR THEMSELVES IN OBTAINING CURATIVE THERAPY.

AS HONG KONG PROSPERED AND THE POPULATION GREW, SAID DR LAM, THE GOVERNMENT OVER THE YEARS HAD, BY IMPLICATION, VEERED TOWARDS THE POLICY OF PROVIDING A MEDICAL SERVICE FOR ALL WHO NEEDED IT -- ALMOST A FREE NATIONAL HEALTH SERVICE.

+IT HAS ASSUMED THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE HEALTH OF THE PEOPLE AND MADE THE HEALTH SERVICES AVAILABLE TO ALL WHO DEMANDED IT,+ HE SAID.

THE GOVERNMENT NOT ONLY PROVIDED INTEGRATED PREVENTIVE AND CURATIVE MEDICINE, BUT LATELY HAD TAKEN ON THE PROVISION OF REHABILITATION THERAPY AND FACILITIES AS WELL.

WITH THE EXPANDING POPULATION AND GROWING AFFLUENCE, SAID DR LAM, HONG KONG IS NOW FACED WITH A DOUBLE DEMAND ON MEDICAL SERVICES.

+THE POOR WHO ARE UNABLE TO PAY THE FEES IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR MAKE FULL USE OF THE CHEAP OR FREE GOVERNMENT AND GOVERNMENT SUBVENTED SERVICES WHICH ARE PROVIDED FOR FROM PUBLIC FUNDS.

+THE GROWING WELL-TO-DO WHO HAVE MONEY USE THE PAYMENT-FOR-SERVICE PRIVATE SECTOR AND THUS GENERATING A NEW DEMAND, WHICH HAS RESULTED IN MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS BEING ABLE TO CHARGE WHATEVER THEY LIKE AND IN TIME MAKING THEIR SERVICES AVAILABLE TO THE RICHER OR RICH MEMBERS OF THE COMMUNITY,+ SAID DR LAM.

THIS HAS BROUGHT ABOUT A LARGE MIDDLE INCOME GROUP KNOWN AS THE +SANDWICHED SOCIETY+, WHO ARE FINDING IT MORE AND MORE DIFFICULT TO GET MEDICAL TREATMENT OF A STANDARD THEY LIKE AND AT A PRICE THEY CAN AFFORD.

ON THE ONE HAND, THEY DEMAND SOMETHING MORE THAN WHAT THE GOVERNMENT IS PROVIDING AND ON THE OTHER THEY CANNOT AFFORD THE LUXURY OF THE HIGH PRICE MEDICAL SERVICE AVAILABLE IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR.

/+THERE IS

+THERE IS, THEREFORE, AN INCREASING VOCIFEROUS DEMAND FOR THE GOVERNMENT TO PROVIDE MORE AND MORE SERVICES AS INFLATION AND THE INCREASED COST OF LIVING MAKE DEEPER INROADS INTO THEIR PAY PACKET,+ SAID DR LAM.

HE SAID THAT THIS MIDDLE-CLASS DEMAND IS NOT ONLY LIMITED TO THE PROVISION OF MEDICAL SERVICES, BUT EXTENDS TO OTHER SOCIAL SERVICES SUCH AS HOUSING AND EDUCATION.

+HERE LIES OUR PROBLEM. WITH THE ESCALATING COST OF MEDICAL SERVICE IN THE PRIVATE SECTOR, WE HAVE A MOUNTING DEMAND FROM THE EVER INCREASING MIDDLE INCOME GROUP WHO ARE FINDING IT MORE AND MORE DIFFICULT TO MEET THEIR MEDICAL EXPENSES.

+THIS DEMAND MUST BE MET BY THE GOVERNMENT WHO HAS CONTRACTED BY IMPLICATION TO PROVIDE A MEDICAL SERVICE FOR ALL,+ HE SAID.

HELPERS WANTED FOR 1981 POPULATION CENSUS

* * * * *

THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TEACHERS AND SENIOR FORM STUDENTS TO HELP CONDUCT THE POPULATION CENSUS NEXT YEAR. THE MARINE CENSUS WILL BE TAKEN FROM FEBRUARY 1 TO 4, WHILE THE LAND CENSUS FROM MARCH 6 TO 15.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY THAT ABOUT 800 CHIEF ENUMERATORS, 1 600 FIELD EDITORS AND 11 000 ENUMERATORS WOULD BE REQUIRED TO CARRY OUT THE FIELD OPERATION.

+THESE ARE TEMPORARY POSTS SUITABLE FOR TEACHERS AND SENIOR FORM STUDENTS. THEY WILL BE ENGAGED IN GATHERING INFORMATION ON THE CHARACTERISTICS OF THE POPULATION FOR FUTURE PLANNING BY THE GOVERNMENT IN AREAS SUCH AS HOUSING, EDUCATION, MEDICAL, AND OTHER SOCIAL SERVICES,+ HE SAID.

THE HELPERS IN THE CENSUS WILL ALSO BE RECRUITED FROM THE TWO UNIVERSITIES AND POST-SECONDARY COLLEGES BESIDES SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

TO ENABLE TEACHERS AND STUDENTS TO TAKE UP THIS TASK, A CENSUS HOLIDAY WILL BE INTRODUCED BETWEEN MARCH 5 TO 17. THIS WILL ALSO MAKE AVAILABLE SCHOOL PREMISES FOR USE AS TEMPORARY CENSUS FIELD CENTRES.

SCHOOL TEACHERS AND STUDENTS OF UNIVERSITIES AND POST-SECONDARY INSTITUTIONS WILL BE SELECTED FOR THE MORE RESPONSIBLE DUTIES OF CHIEF ENUMERATOR OF FIELD EDITOR. STUDENTS OF FORM/MIDDLE 4 AND ABOVE WILL BE APPOINTED AS ENUMERATORS.

+APPLICANTS FOR THE JOBS WILL HAVE TO ATTEND A ONE-WEEK TRAINING SESSION COVERING THE GENERAL ASPECTS OF THE CENSUS, ENUMERATION PROCEDURES, AND TECHNIQUES,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE TRAINING WILL BE ESSENTIAL TO ENSURE THAT THE CENSUS IS PROPERLY CONDUCTED.

EXTENSIVE USE OF AUDIO-VISUAL AIDS WILL BE A FEATURE OF THE TRAINING PROGRAMME WHICH WILL END WITH A TEST. ALL THESE WILL TAKE PLACE IN NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER.

+PARTICIPANTS WILL THEN BE CAREFULLY SELECTED BASED ON THE RESULTS OF THE TEST AND WILL BE POSTED, WHEREVER POSSIBLE, TO DISTRICTS NEAR WHERE THEY LIVE,+ THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

STUDENTS AND TEACHERS WHO ARE INTERESTED CAN APPLY THROUGH THEIR SCHOOLS OR APPLY DIRECT TO THE POPULATION CENSUS OFFICE OF THE DEPARTMENT AT PERMANENT COMFORT BUILDING, 3RD FLOOR, 74-77, CONNAUGHT ROAD CENTRAL, TEL 459975 OR 459735.

+IN ADDITION TO THE EXPERIENCE OF INTERVIEWING PEOPLE AND HELPING A COMMUNITY PROJECT, PARTICIPANTS WILL RECEIVE A TRAINING BONUS ON PASSING THE TEST AND AN HONORARIUM RANGING FROM \$600 TO \$800 FOR THEIR SERVICE IN THE CENSUS,+ THE SPOKESMAN NOTED.

HE SAID HOWEVER THAT IT IS OF THE UTMOST IMPORTANCE THAT APPLICANTS SHOULD NOT WITHDRAW DURING THEIR TRAINING OR THE ACTUAL CENSUS OPERATION AS IT WILL THEN BE VERY DIFFICULT TO FIND OTHERS TO REPLACE THEM.

+APPLICANTS SHOULD BEAR THIS IN MIND WHEN VOLUNTEERING FOR THE WORK,+ HE STRESSED.

APPEAL FOR GREATER UNDERSTANDING OF CANCER

* * * *

HEALTH EDUCATION PLAYS AN IMPORTANT ROLE IN CONTROLLING CANCER, HONG KONG'S TOP KILLER DISEASE WHICH CLAIMED OVER 6 000 LIVES LAST YEAR.

TO COMBAT THIS DISEASE THERE MUST BE CONCERTED EFFORT BY THE MASS MEDIA, PROFESSIONAL BODIES, MEDICAL PERSONNEL AND SCHOOLS TO EDUCATE THE PUBLIC ON WHAT IT IS ALL ABOUT.

THIS APPEAL WAS MADE BY DR S.C. LEUNG, SENIOR MEDICAL AND HEALTH OFFICER OF THE CENTRAL HEALTH EDUCATION UNIT, MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT, AT A LIONS CLUB MEETING TODAY.

DR LEUNG POINTED OUT THAT FINDINGS FROM PAST STUDIES SHOWED THAT THERE WAS UNIVERSAL MISCONCEPTION OF THE FATALITY OF CANCER AND TERROR OF PROLONGED SUFFERING ASSOCIATED WITH THE DISEASE.

+THESE FEARS STEMMED FROM THE TIME WHEN CANCER WAS RARELY CURED, BUT WITH TODAY'S ADVANCED TECHNIQUES IN EARLY DETECTION AND SUCCESSFUL TREATMENT, A MORE POSITIVE APPROACH TOWARDS CANCER AND A MORE REALISTIC ATTITUDE SHOULD BE CULTIVATED,+ SHE SAID.

IN HONG KONG, CANCER TOPPED THE LIST OF MAJOR CAUSES OF DEATH LAST YEAR AND ACCOUNTED FOR OVER 25 PER CENT OF ALL FATALITIES. AMONG ALL FORMS OF THE DISEASE, LUNG CANCER CLAIMED OVER 1 600 LIVES, MORE THAN DOUBLE ITS TOLL TEN YEARS AGO.

DR LEUNG POINTED OUT THAT EDUCATION ON THE PREVENTION, SYMPTOMS, AND TREATMENT OF CANCER WAS NECESSARY TO INCREASE THE PUBLIC'S AWARENESS OF THE DISEASE.

+THE PUBLIC SHOULD BE TAUGHT THAT RECOGNISING SYMPTOMS AND SEEKING MEDICAL ADVICE IN TIME ARE KEYS TO THE SUCCESS OF TREATMENT,+ SHE SAID.

HEALTH EDUCATION THROUGH THE PRESS, RADIO AND TELEVISION IS ONE EFFECTIVE MEANS TO BRING HOME THE MESSAGE.

IN ORDER TO PLAN, ORGANIZE AND COORDINATE ALL EDUCATION ACTIVITIES, THE CENTRAL HEALTH EDUCATION UNIT WAS ESTABLISHED, AND HAS INVOLVED MANY PROFESSIONAL BODIES IN MOUNTING EXHIBITIONS FOR THE DISSEMINATION OF ANTI-CANCER INFORMATION.

EDUCATION ON THE IMPORTANCE OF KEEPING HEALTHY HABITS IS EQUALLY IMPORTANT, SAID DR LEUNG.

ANTI-SMOKING EDUCATION AMONG SCHOOL CHILDREN, FOR INSTANCE, SHOULD BE INCLUDED IN ANY CANCER EDUCATION PROGRAMME, SHE SUGGESTED.

+ONLY THROUGH A THOROUGH UNDERSTANDING OF THE DISEASE COULD WE DISSIPATE FEAR AND TAKE SPECIFIC ACTIONS TO COMBAT THE PHYSICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL DISABILITIES BROUGHT BY CANCER,+ SHE ADDED.

THE CENTRAL HEALTH EDUCATION UNIT, USING SUITABLE AUDIO-VISUAL SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIALS, HAS HELPED SCHOOLS AND TEACHERS TO INCLUDE CANCER EDUCATION IN THEIR CURRICULUM.

DR LEUNG ALSO CALLED ON MEDICAL, NURSING AND PARAMEDICAL PROFESSIONALS TO PLAY THE ROLE OF CANCER EDUCATORS, AS FACE-TO-FACE EDUCATION IS LIKELY TO HAVE FAR MORE MOTIVE POWER THAN OTHER APPROACHES.

GRANTS FOR INNOVATIVE SOCIAL WELFARE PROJECTS

* * * * *

YOUTH GROUPS WHO NEED MONEY TO CARRY OUT COMMUNITY SERVICE PROJECTS INITIATED BY THEMSELVES MAY NOW APPLY FOR SUBSIDIES UNDER A SCHEME ADMINISTERED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.

THE DEPARTMENT IS INVITING APPLICATIONS FOR GRANTS UNDER THE +OPPORTUNITIES FOR YOUTH SCHEME+ WHICH ENCOURAGES YOUNG PEOPLE TO START AND IMPLEMENT INNOVATIVE SERVICE PROJECTS.

OVER \$88 000 WERE ALLOCATED IN 1979-80 FOR 82 APPROVED PROJECTS, WHICH BROUGHT TO \$639 000 THE AMOUNT OF GRANTS GIVEN TO A TOTAL OF 505 PROJECTS SINCE THE SCHEME WAS SET UP IN 1974.

PREVIOUS EFFORTS COVERED SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY AND THE DISABLED, YOUNG PEOPLE, RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES AND WORKS PROJECTS. THEY WERE CARRIED OUT BY 17 700 YOUNG PEOPLE AND BENEFITTED AN ESTIMATED 856 000 PEOPLE.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY THAT ANY GROUP OF AT LEAST SEVEN MEMBERS AGED BETWEEN 15 AND 25 AND SPONSORED BY A SCHOOL, YOUTH AGENCY OR BUSINESS ORGANISATION, MAY APPLY FOR A GRANT.

GROUPS WHICH ARE NOT SO SPONSORED MAY ALSO APPLY PROVIDED THEIR PLANS HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE DEPARTMENT'S COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICERS.

THE DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION IS OCTOBER 12, HE SAID. ENQUIRIES ABOUT THE SCHEME AND APPLICATIONS CAN BE MADE AT THE COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICES IN THE VARIOUS DISTRICTS.

A PROJECT SHOULD BE GEARED TOWARDS THE NEED OF THE COMMUNITY, AND SHOULD PREFERABLY BE SPREAD OVER A PERIOD OF TIME.

IT WILL BE ASSESSED FOR ITS YOUTH INVOLVEMENT, COMMUNITY BENEFIT, INNOVATION, FEASIBILITY AND OPTIMUM USE OF RESOURCES, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE MAXIMUM GRANT FOR EACH APPROVED PROJECT IS NORMALLY \$2 500, AND THE COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICERS WILL MAINTAIN CLOSE WORKING LIAISON WITH PARTICIPATING GROUPS.

SAI KUNG WATERFRONT GETS NEW FEATURE

* * * * *

A HUGE CONCRETE DOLOS, THOUSANDS OF WHICH ARE IN USE AT HIGH ISLAND RESERVOIR TO COUNTER WAVE ENERGY, HAS BEEN PUT IN PLACE AT SAI KUNG NEW TOWN WATERFRONT AS A MEMORIAL AND DECORATIVE CENTREPIECE.

SAI KUNG DISTRICT OFFICER, MR COLIN BOSHER, SAID THE DOLOS, DONATED BY THE RESERVOIR CONTRACTOR, WAS INTENDED TO REMIND THE PUBLIC OF THE HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE AND HUGENESS OF THE RESERVOIR SCHEME.

A SPECTACULAR PART OF THE PROJECT WAS THE EAST DAM WHICH HAS BEEN COMPLETELY COVERED WITH DOLOSSE TO DISSIPATE THE FORCE OF OCEAN WAVES, MR BOSHER SAID.

THEY ARE SHAPED LIKE THE LETTER H WITH ONE ARM TWISTED THROUGH 90 DEGREES, AND WEIGH 25 TONNES EACH. DOLOS IS AN AFRIKAANS WORD MEANING +SHEEP'S KNUCKLE+.

ABOUT 7 000 WERE PLACED AT THE RESERVOIR.

MR BOSHER SAID TRANSPORTATION OF THE DOLOS HAD PRESENTED A REAL PROBLEM, BUT THE CONTRACTOR HAD KINDLY AGREED TO PROVIDE A LIGHTER AND CRANE TO HAVE IT TRANSPORTED AND PLACED ON A RAISED PLATFORM SPECIALLY DESIGNED FOR IT.

MR BOSHER SAID IN MANY WAYS THE DOLOS COULD BE REGARDED AS A FORM OF ART AND THERE WERE PROPOSALS TO HAVE IT POLISHED AND PAINTED.

/IN THE

IN THE MEANTIME, TREES AND FLOWERS ARE BEING PLANTED ALONG THE WATERFRONT TO CONVERT THE AREA INTO A PROMENADE.

ALSO TO BE PROVIDED WILL BE COVERED SEATING PLACES AND A TRAFFIC-FREE WALKWAY.

THE PROMENADE WOULD BE AN IDEAL PLACE FOR SPECTATORS TO WATCH FUNCTIONS SUCH AS THE DRAGON BOAT RACES AND CROSS HARBOUR SWIM. PROMENADE CONCERTS COULD ALSO BE HELD THERE, MR BOSHER SAID.

SAI KUNG DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD PROVIDED NEARLY \$17 000 TO BUILD THE PLATFORM FOR THE DOLOS AND ANOTHER \$5 400 FOR TREE PLANTING ALONG THE PROMENADE.

COURSES BY MUSIC EDUCATOR FOR TEACHERS

MISS CECILIA VAJDA, A DISTINGUISHED MUSIC EDUCATOR AND CHOIR CONDUCTOR, WILL BE ON A TWO-WEEK VISIT TO HONG KONG NEXT MONTH AT THE INVITATION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

DURING HER STAY, SHE WILL CONDUCT A SERIES OF IN-SERVICE COURSES FOR MUSIC TEACHERS BASED ON THE KODALY CHORAL MUSIC METHOD.

THIS METHOD WAS DEVISED BY KODALY, A HUNGARIAN COMPOSER AND MUSIC EDUCATOR, TO SUIT THE NEEDS OF ORDINARY SCHOOLS WITH ONE OR TWO MUSIC LESSONS A WEEK WHEN STUDENTS CAN GAIN A BASIC KNOWLEDGE OF MUSIC CULTURE AND DEVELOP MUSICAL LITERACY THROUGH SINGING.

MISS VAJDA IS A FORMER PROFESSOR OF SCHOOL MUSIC AT THE LISZT ACADEMY OF MUSIC IN BUDAPEST AND CHORUS DIRECTOR OF THE HUNGARIAN RADIO CHOIR.

IN 1967 SHE WAS INVITED TO INTRODUCE THE PRINCIPLES AND PRACTICE OF THE KODALY CHORAL METHOD TO YEHUDI MENUHIN'S MUSIC SCHOOL IN ENGLAND. SUBSEQUENTLY SHE ESTABLISHED A KODALY TEACHING CENTRE IN SWANSEA WHERE TEACHERS FROM ALL OVER BRITAIN CAN STUDY THE SYSTEM.

WHILE IN HONG KONG, MISS VAJDA WILL ALSO RUN CHORAL CONDUCTING CLASSES FOR TEACHERS AND AMATEUR CHOIR CONDUCTORS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE HONG KONG ARTS CENTRE.
