TSUEN WAN BLITZ ON UNAUTHORISED CONVERTED LORRY LOADING
AND PARKING AREAS
* * * * *

THE GOVERNMENT IS STEPPING UP ITS DRIVE AGAINST THE UNAUTHORISED CONVERSION OF CAR PARKS AND LOADING SPACES IN INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS IN THE RAPIDLY-EXPANDING TSUEN WAN NEW TOWN.

A SPECIAL TEAM HAS BEEN SET UP WITHIN THE LEASE ENFORCEMENT UNIT OF THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE TO TACKLE THE PROBLEM DESCRIBED AS +QUITE SERIOUS+ BY THE CHIEF LAND EXECUTIVE OF THE DISTRICT OFFICE, MR. BASIL OLD.

+MANY INDUSTRIAL PROPERTIES IN TSUEN WAN AND KWAI CHUNG HAVE CLAUSES IN THEIR NEW GRANT CONDITIONS THAT REQUIRE THE LESSEES TO PROVIDE PROPER SPACES WITHIN THEIR PROPERTY FOR PARKING, LOADING AND UNLOADING OF VEHICLES,+ MR. OLD SAID.

+HOWEVER, IN A GREAT MANY CASES THIS SPACE HAS BEEN UTILISED FOR INDUSTRIAL, STORAGE, OFFICE OR OTHER PURPOSES.

+AS A RESULT, LORRIES OR CONTAINER TRUCKS HAVE TO LOAD OR UNLOAD THEIR GOODS ON THE STREETS, THUS CAUSING SERIOUS CONGESTION AND DISRUPTION TO THE TRAFFIC IN THE AREAS.+

MR. OLD POINTED OUT THAT A SURVEY CARRIED OUT RECENTLY HAS SHOWN THAT MORE THAN 300 INDUSTRIAL LOTS OR PROPERTIES IN THE DISTRICT WERE FOUND TO HAVE THEIR PARKING SPACES CONVERTED INTO OTHER USE.

+OF THE TOTAL, THE CONDITIONS IN SOME 200 SUCH PROPERTIES ARE QUITE SERIOUS,+ HE NOTED.

+THESE PREMISES ARE MAINLY SITUATED IN WANG LUNG STREET, MA KOK STREET, TAI PA STREET AND CHAI WAN KOK STREET IN TSUEN WAN AND IN TA CHUEN PING STREET, LAM TIN STREET, TAI LIN PAI ROAD AND KWAI CHEONG ROAD IN KWAI CHUNG.

+OUR EFFORTS OVER THE LAST COUPLE OF YEARS HAVE BEEN DIRECTED TOWARDS THE MANY CASES OF BREACH OF USER IN RESIDENTIAL AND COMMERCIAL BUILDINGS, BUT NOW THAT WE HAVE AN ADDITIONAL LAND TEAM, WE ARE ABLE TO TACKLE THE NEXT PRIORITY.+

AS A FIRST STEP TO REMEDY THE SITUATION, A LETTER WOULD BE SENT AS FROM TOMORROW (MONDAY) TO ALL INDUSTRIALISTS IN THE AREA WARNING THEM ABOUT BREACHES OF LEASE CONDITIONS IN THEIR BUILDINGS.

THEY WILL BE GIVEN A REASONABLE TIME TO RECTIFY THE SITUATION AND AFTER THIS GRACE PERIOD, LEASE ENFORCEMENT ACTION WILL BE CARRIED OUT BY THE STAFF OF THE DISTRICT OFFICE ON THESE PREMISES.

+IF WE STILL FIND THAT THERE IS A BREACH OF THE LEASE TERMS AND CONDITIONS, WE WILL SERVE A WARNING NOTICE ON THE LESSEES REQUIRING THEM TO PURGE THE BREACHES WITHIN A STIPULATED PERIOD.

+IF THEY FAIL TO DO SO WITHIN THE TIME GIVEN, WE WILL PROCEED TO VEST OR RE-ENTER THE PREMISES UNDER THE PROVISION OF THE CROWN RIGHT (RE-ENTRY AND VESTING REMEDIES) ORDINANCE,+ MR. OLD WARNED.

HE SAID THAT, BY USING THE PARKING SPACES FOR OTHER PURPOSES, IT NOT ONLY LOWERED THE ENVIRONMENTAL STANDARDS OF OTHER OCCUPANTS OF THE BUILDINGS, THEY MIGHT ALSO CAUSE OBSTRUCTIONS OR BECOME A FIRE HAZARD.

+THERE SHOULD BE NO REAL EXCUSE FOR SUCH BREACHES OF THE LEASE TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS IT IS NOW POSSIBLE TO OBTAIN INDUSTRIAL FLOOR SPACE IN TSUEN WAN AND ELSEWHERE,+ MR. OLD ADDED.

NEW FIRE STATION AND AMBULANCE DEPOT FOR TUEN MUN NEW TOWN

FIRE AND AMBULANCE SERVICES IN THE TUEN MUN NEW TOWN WILL BE FURTHER IMPROVED WHEN A NEW DIVISIONAL FIRE STATION AND AN AMBULANCE DEPOT BECOME OPERATIONAL IN A FEW MONTHS TIME.

+CONSTRUCTION WORK ON THE STATION AND THE DEPOT ARE ALREADY 60 PER CENT COMPLETED AND THE SCHEDULED COMPLETION DATE IS IN JUNE,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

+THE PROJECTS ARE PART OF THE DEPARTMENT'S EXPANSION PROGRAMME TO ENSURE ADEQUATE AND SPEEDY FIRE AND AMBULANCE SERVICES IN FAST-DEVELOPING NEW TOWNS,+ SAID THE SPOKESMAN.

+MANY FACTORIES HAVE SPRUNG UP IN TUEN MUN IN RECENT YEARS WHICH CALLED FOR GREATER FIRE PROTECTION TO SAFEGUARD LIFE AND PROPERTY,+ HE SAID.

THE STATION AND THE DEPOT ARE BUILT ON A COMBINED SITE OF 5,000 SQUARE METRES IN PUI TO ROAD, SAN HUI.

THE STATION, TO COST MORE THAN \$5 MILLION, IS THE FIRST STANDARD DESIGNED DIVISIONAL STATION EVER BUILT. A SECOND STANDARD DESIGNED STATION IS NOW BEING BUILT IN SHA TIN NEW TOWN.

THE THREE-STOREY STRUCTURE CONSISTS OF FIVE DOUBLE BAYS FOR 10 FIRE APPLIANCES, OFFICE ACCOMMODATION, A DRILL TOWER AND A YARD, A LECTURE ROOM, STAND-BY QUARTERS, DINING AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES.

THE \$1.2 MILLION AMBULANCE DEPOT HAS FOUR AMBULANCE BAYS AND OTHER SIMILAR FEATURES TO THE FIRE STATION.

AT PRESENT, THE FIRE AND AMBULANCE SERVICES FOR TUEN MUN NEW TOWN ARE PROVIDED BY A TEMPORARY FIRE STATION IN TAI HING ESTATE.

**PWD OFFICERS TO ATTEND WORLD CONGRESS ON WASTE RECYCLING

THREE SENIOR PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT OFFICERS LEFT TODAY (SUNDAY) FOR MANILA TO ATTEND THE SECOND WORLD CONGRESS ON WASTE RECYCLING.

THEY WERE THE PRINCIPAL GOVERNMENT CIVIL ENGINEER, MR. WONG MANG-KI- THE PRINCIPAL GOVERNMENT ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL ENGINEER, MR. GRAHAM OSBORNE AND THE SENIOR ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL ENGINEER, MR. JOHN COLLIER.

THE CONGRESS WILL ALSO BE ATTENDED BY DELEGATES FROM THE UNITED STATES, THE UNITED KINGDOM, JAPAN, CANADA, AUSTRALIA, BELGIUM, ITALY, NORWAY, SWITZERLAND, INDIA AND NIGERIA.

THE FOUR-DAY CONGRESS, ENTITLED RECYCLING '79, WILL BEGIN TOMORROW (MONDAY) AT THE PHILIPPINE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTRE.

DURING THE CONGRESS, THE SPEAKERS, ALL RECOGNISED AUTHORITIES IN THEIR RESPECTIVE FIELDS, WILL DISCUSS THE LATEST DEVELOPMENTS IN THEIR PARTICULAR AREA OF RESEARCH IN NEW AND BETTER USES OF SECONDARY RESOURCES.

A TOTAL OF 36 PAPERS WILL BE PRESENTED AT THE CONGRESS. AMONG THEM ARE THOSE ON +MINERAL CONSERVATION THROUGH RECYCLING+, +A COMPOSTING PLANT FOR THE ORGANIC FRACTION OF MUNICIPAL SOLID WASTE+, +DEVELOPMENT OF SEPARATION METHODS AND SYSTEM DESIGN OF THE RECYCLING OF SOLID WASTES+ AND +THE SEPARATION OF WASTE BY ELUTRIATION+.

DURING THEIR STAY IN MANILA, THE HONG KONG DELEGATES WILL VISIT AN EXHIBITION STAGED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE CONGRESS.

SNIFFER DOGS FOR CUSTOMS AND EXCISE SERVICE

THE NAME OF THE GAME IS SCENT.

AND BOTH OLIVER AND DEWARS EXCEL AT IT.

MOST IMPORTANT, THEY ENJOY IT.

WHICH IS WHY OLIVER, A LABRADOR, AND DEWARS, A WEIMARANER, ARE NOW THE +PRIDE AND JOY+ OF THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE SERVICE.

+THIS IS QUITE UNDERSTANDABLE,+ SAYS INSPECTOR POON YEUNG-KWONG, +BECAUSE OF THEIR INCREDIBLE KNACK IN SNIFFING OUT DRUGS CONCEALED IN THE MOST INCONCEIVABLE AND INGENIOUS PLACES.+

RAW OR PREPARED OPIUM, HEROIN, MORPHINE, MARIJUANA OR HASHISH RARELY, IF EVER, ESCAPE THEIR ULTRA-SENSITIVE NOSES.

CITING ONE OF THE MORE EXTREME EXAMPLES, INSPECTOR POON WHO IS IN CHARGE OF THE DOG UNIT SAID, +ONE TEST WE CONDUCTED WAS TO HIDE A SMALL PACKET OF OPIUM INSIDE A HOLLOWED-OUT TABLE TOP TO SEE IF THEY COULD DETECT IT.+

THEY DID — IN RECORD TIME.

AND SPEAKING OF TIME, INSPECTOR POON SAID IT TOOK HIM 12 WEEKS TO TRAIN DEWARS IN AMERICA WHERE HE WAS SENT ON A SPECIAL COURSE BY THE GOVERNMENT. HE RETURNED WITH DEWARS.

+OLIVER WAS ALREADY A VETERAN 'SNIFFER' WHEN HE WAS GIVEN TO US BY THE POLICE,+ INSPECTOR POON SAID.

RECOUNTING HIS EXPERIENCE IN AMERICA, INSPECTOR POON SAID THAT FROM THE VERY BEGINNING, DEWARS AND THE OTHER DOGS TOOK TO THE TRAINING EAGERLY.

THIS WAS BECAUSE THE DOGS TREATED IT LIKE A GAME.

+WHICH WAS EXACTLY THE WAY THE AMERICAN TRAINERS WANTED IT,+ INSPECTOR POON SAID.

+THEIR METHOD WAS TO ENSURE THAT THE DOGS ENJOYED THEIR WORK,+ INSPECTOR POON EMPHASISED.

SO GAMES WERE DEvised THROUGHOUT THE TRAINING PERIOD — WITH TOWELS.

INSPECTOR POON EXPLAINED, +DURING THE FIRST WEEK, WE TAUGHT THEM THE TECHNIQUE OF RETRIEVING WITH THIS DIFFERENCE: ONCE THEY BROUGHT BACK THE TOWEL, THE HANDLERS ENGAGED IN A 'TUG-OF-WAR' WITH THEM.

/+THIS

+THIS 'TOWEL GAME' PROVED TO BE EXTREMELY POPULAR WITH THE DOGS PARTICULARLY WHEN THEY WON MOST OF THE TIME.+

THERE WAS ANOTHER REASON WHY THE HANDLERS 'DELIBERATELY' ALLOWED THE DOGS TO WIN -- TO ENHANCE THE BOND BETWEEN THE TWO.

FOR A COMMON SAYING AMONG DOG HANDLERS GOES LIKE THIS :
+THE FEELINGS OF THE HANDLER GOES DOWN THE LEASH.+

+IT IS IMPORTANT THAT HANDLERS ARE GENUINELY FOND OF DOGS,+
INSPECTOR POON STRESSED.

WITH THIS GUIDING PRINCIPLE, THE GAME MERRILY CONTINUED.

THE SECOND STAGE OF THE TRAINING WAS CRUCIAL, INSPECTOR POON SAID.

+NARCOTICS WERE WRAPPED INSIDE THE TOWELS AND PLACED INTO A CARTON. THE DOGS MUST THEN LEARN NOT ONLY TO RETRIEVE THE CLOTH BUT ALSO THE DRUGS. THIS EXERCISE ENABLES THEM TO IDENTIFY THE SCENT OF DIFFERENT TYPES OF DRUGS.+

THIS TRAINING WAS REPEATED FOR SEVERAL WEEKS.

BUT AS IT PROGRESSED, THE TOWEL WAS DISCARDED WITH THE DOGS HAVING TO DETECT NARCOTICS SCATTERED ALL OVER THE SPRAWLING TRAINING GROUND.

+ONLY WHEN DOGS HAD RETRIEVED 'ALL' THE DRUGS -- AND THEY WERE HIDDEN IN SUCH UNLIKELY PLACES AS TREE BRANCHES, BENEATH PILES OF STONES AND UNDERNEATH BOULDERS -- WOULD THEY BE SHOWERED WITH AFFECTION. AND, OF COURSE, THEIR FAVOURITE TOWEL GAME,+ INSPECTOR POON SAID.

AT PRESENT, ONLY OLIVER AND DEWARS COMPRISE THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE SERVICE'S DOG UNIT.

+ITS A PILOT SCHEME BUT WE ARE VERY CONFIDENT THAT BOTH DOGS WILL CONTRIBUTE GREATLY IN OUR EFFORT TO STAMP OUT THE ILLICIT DRUG TRADE,+ INSPECTOR POON SAID.

OLIVER AND DEWARS ARE ALREADY WORKING AT VARIOUS CHECK-POINTS INCLUDING THE POST OFFICE, CONTAINER TERMINALS AND AT KAI TAK AIRPORT.

+THESE TWO 'EAGER BEAVERS' REALLY LOOK FORWARD TO THEIR DAILY ASSIGNMENTS,+ INSPECTOR POON SAID.

WHO CAN BLAME THEM.

AFTER ALL, ITS ONLY A GAME TO THEM.

CAS TAKES LEAD IN CONTROLLING MOUNTAIN RESCUE

* * * * *

JUST HOW GOOD IS OUR CIVIL AID SERVICES' MOUNTAIN RESCUE TEAMS?

IN THE WORDS OF SQUADRON LEADER JOHN VERNON, INSPECTOR OF LAND RESCUE FROM THE BRITISH MINISTRY OF DEFENCE : +THE CAS MRT IS NOW WELL ESTABLISHED AND HAS TAKEN THE LEAD IN CONTROLLING MOUNTAIN RESCUE.+

SQUADRON LEADER VERNON'S COMMENT CAME AFTER HE INSPECTED A SERIES OF EXERCISES CARRIED OUT BY THE UNIT IN VARIOUS HILLY AND COUNTRYSIDE AREAS THROUGHOUT HONG KONG BETWEEN NOVEMBER 20 AND 25 LAST YEAR.

+THROUGHOUT THE VISIT IT WAS EVIDENT THAT THE TEAM IS GAINING A MORE INDEPENDENT, SELF-RELIANT APPROACH TO RESCUE. THIS IS APPARENTLY GENERATED BY THE PERSONNEL WHO HAVE RECEIVED TRAINING IN THE UNITED KINGDOM,+ HE ADDED.

DURING HIS BIENNIAL INSPECTION, WHICH COINCIDED WITH THE ANNUAL CAS MRT TRAINING COURSE, SQUADRON LEADER VERNON SAW THE TEAMS CONDUCT CROSS-COUNTRY EXPEDITIONS, NIGHT NAVIGATION, MOUNTAIN SEARCH AND RESCUE AND DEMONSTRATIONS OF MOUNTAIN AND CLIFF RESCUE TECHNIQUES.

THESE TOOK PART ON HONG KONG ISLAND, KOWLOON AND THE NEW TERRITORIES, INCLUDING LANTAU ISLAND.

ON THE EXERCISE AS A WHOLE, SQUADRON LEADER VERNON SAID THE UNIT HAD EXHIBITED A GOOD STANDARD OF TRAINING AND FITNESS, ADDING THAT TEAM WORK AND INDIVIDUAL SKILLS WERE ALSO OF A HIGH STANDARD.

HE ALSO NOTED THAT THERE WAS +A GENERAL AIR OF SELF-CONFIDENCE AND THE TEAM IS NOW IN A POSITION WHERE IT IS ABLE TO VET THE SKILLS OF MOUNTAINEERS WHO MAY BE CALLED UPON TO ASSIST THEM IN ANY MAJOR OPERATION.+

IN HIS REPORT, SQUADRON LEADER VERNON SAID THAT ONLY IN ONE AREA HAD ACTION NOT BEEN COMPLETED -- RADIO COMMUNICATIONS.

+THE PROBLEM OF POOR RADIO SERVICEABILITY HAS HAMPERED THE TEAMS FOR SOME YEARS AND IT WILL ONLY BE OVERCOME WITH THE ISSUE OF IMPROVED EQUIPMENT,+ HE SAID.

COMMENTING ON THIS, MR. JOHN FORTUNE, DIRECTOR OF OPERATIONS, CAS, AGREED WITH SQUADRON LEADER VERNON THAT IT WAS REGRETTABLE THAT THE TEAM WAS STILL USING THE PYE BANTAM RADIOS WHICH WERE THE SUBJECT OF CRITICISM IN THE LAST REPORT.

+THE RADIOS WE ARE LOOKING FOR MUST BE WEATHER-PROOF AND STRONGLY-CONSTRUCTED- AND IN FACT DURING THE PAST TWO YEARS WE HAVE APPROACHED FIVE DIFFERENT MANUFACTURERS TO LOOK FOR A SUITABLE TYPE,+ HE EXPLAINED.

GREATER NUMBERS USING THE MOUNTAINS IN HONG KONG AND THE EVER
INCREASING NEED FOR THE MOUNTAIN RESCUE TEAMS.+

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN HAPPY VALLEY

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT SPECIAL TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE MADE IN HAPPY VALLEY FROM TUESDAY (MARCH 20) TO WEDNESDAY TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CANAL ROAD FLYOVER.
