EPCOM MEETS UNDER NEW CHAIRMAN

* * * * *

MEMBERS OF THE ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION ADVISORY COMMITTEE (EPCOM), MEETING FOR THE FIRST TIME UNDER THE NEW CHAIRMAN, DR DAVID J. JOHNS, TODAY (MONDAY) SET THE PRIORITIES FOR WORK IN THE POLLUTION CONTROL PROGRAMME FOR THE COMING YEAR.

THEY NOTED A WORK PROGRAMME COVERING A RANGE OF SUBJECTS IN THE FIELDS OF AIR, NOISE, WATER AND SOLID WASTE POLLUTION.

PRIORITIES IN THE AREA OF WATER POLLUTION CONTROL INCLUDE A REVIEW OF THE WATER QUALITY IN TOLO HARBOUR AND THE DRAWING UP OF AN APPROPRIATE ACTION PLAN IN THE LIGHT OF THE FINDINGS OF THE REVIEW- A REVIEW OF POLLUTED NULLAHS AND DEVELOPMENT OF A COMPREHENSIVE CONTROL FRAMEWORK FOR THE PROPER DISPOSAL OF SEWAGE.

IN WASTE MANAGEMENT, CONTROL OF POLLUTION CAUSED BY ANIMAL WASTES IS HIGH ON THE LIST, FOLLOWED BY PROPOSED MEASURES TO CONTROL TOXIC, HAZARDOUS AND DIFFICULT WASTES, AND IMPLEMENTATION OF AN OVERALL REFUSE DISPOSAL STRATEGY.

AIR QUALITY PRIORITIES INCLUDE CONSULTATION WITH INDUSTRY ON PROPOSED CONTROL OF SPECIFIED PROCESSES UNDER THE AIR POLLUTION CONTROL ORDINANCE AND SUBSEQUENT IMPLEMENTATION; THE DECLARATION OF AIR CONTROL ZONES AND AIR QUALITY OBJECTIVES; AND CONTROL OF SULPHUR DIOXIDE AND VEHICULAR EMISSIONS.

REGARDING NOISE POLLUTION, MEMBERS OF THE COMMITTEE TODAY EXPRESSED THEIR VIEWS ON THE DRAFT NOISE CONTROL BILL WHICH DEALS WITH NOISE FROM DOMESTIC, COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL PREMISES, PUBLIC PLACES AND CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES. THE BILL PROVIDES FOR THE COMPREHENSIVE CONTROL OF NOISE POLLUTION AND THE CONSOLIDATION OF EXISTING CONTROLS.

MEMBERS OF EPCOM WILL DECIDE AT THE NEXT MEETING WHETHER TO RECOMMEND PUBLICATION OF THE DRAFT BILL FOR PUBLIC CONSULTATION PRIOR TO ITS FORMAL SUBMISSION TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL.

MEMBERS ALSO STUDIED A PROGRESS REPORT PREPARED BY THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES BRANCH ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF RECOMMENDATIONS MADE BY THE WORKING PARTY ON FLOATING REFUSE.

DAYA BAY FEASIBILITY STUDY RECEIVED

* * * * *

THE GOVERNMENT HAS TODAY RECEIVED FROM THE GUANGDONG NUCLEAR POWER JOINT VENTURE COMPANY COPIES OF THE DAYA BAY FEASIBILITY STUDY DEALING WITH SITE SELECTION, EQUIPMENT STUDY AND SYSTEM DESIGNS.

THESE HAVE BEEN PASSED ON TO MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE STATEMENT MADE BY THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY, MR PIERS JACOBS, IN THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL LAST WEDNESDAY (JULY 23).

THE DAYA BAY FEASIBILITY STUDY WAS JOINTLY CARRIED OUT BY THE GUANGDONG POWER COMPANY AND THE CHINA LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY. THE SECTIONS DEALING WITH SITE SELECTION, EQUIPMENT STUDY AND SYSTEM DESIGNS HAVE BEEN MADE AVAILABLE TO THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL AS A RESULT OF AGREEMENT REACHED BETWEEN LORD KADOORIE, CHAIRMAN OF CHINA LIGHT AND POWER COMPANY AND VICE MINISTER ZHOU PING OF THE MINISTRY OF NUCLEAR INDUSTRY OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA.

A NOTE BY THE GUANGDONG NUCLEAR POWER JOINT VENTURE COMPANY WHICH IS ATTACHED TO EACH SET OF THE REPORTS EXPLAINS THAT CERTAIN PARTS WHICH CONTAIN MATERIAL OF A COMMERCIALY SENSITIVE NATURE OR WHICH THE GOVERNMENT OF THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC CONSIDERS TO BE CONFIDENTIAL TO THE STATE FOR STRATEGIC REASONS HAVE BEEN OMITTED.

U.S. MAKES FIFTH EA CALL

* * * * *

THE TRADE DEPARTMENT TODAY (MONDAY) ANNOUNCED THAT THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT HAS MADE AN EXPORT AUTHORISATION (EA) CALL ON CATEGORY 314 (BROADCLOTH) AND PART OF CATEGORY 320 (POPLIN N.E.S.).

THIS IS THE FIFTH EA CALL MADE BY THE U.S. SO FAR THIS YEAR.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE HONG KONG-U.S. BILATERAL TEXTILE AGREEMENT, THE DEPARTMENT HAS SUSPENDED ISSUE OF FURTHER EXPORT AUTHORISATIONS IN RESPECT OF THE CATEGORIES WITH EFFECT FROM 3 PM LAST FRIDAY (JULY 25) PENDING CONSULTATIONS WITH THE U.S. GOVERNMENT.

HOWEVER, THE DEPARTMENT WILL CONTINUE TO APPROVE AND ISSUE EXPORT LICENCES FOR THE CATEGORIES AGAINST VALID EXPORT AUTHORISATIONS APPROVED PRIOR TO THE SUSPENSION.

CHILDREN ASPIRIN WITHDRAWN FROM MARKET

* * * *

THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT TODAY (MONDAY) FORMALLY REQUESTED IMPORTERS AND MANUFACTURERS OF ASPIRIN PRODUCTS TO WITHDRAW VOLUNTARILY CHILDREN ASPIRIN PRODUCTS FROM THE LOCAL MARKET.

THE DEPARTMENT ISSUED THE CALL AFTER IT HAD DECIDED TO ENDORSE THE RECOMMENDATIONS MADE BY THE PHARMACEUTICALS REGISTRATION COMMITTEE OF THE PHARMACY AND POISONS BOARD WHICH HELD A MEETING RECENTLY TO DISCUSS THE ISSUE ON ASPIRIN.

A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THERE HAD BEEN CONFLICTING REPORTS FROM OVERSEAS COUNTRIES INDICATING A POSSIBLE LINK BETWEEN THE REYE'S SYNDROME AND ASPIRIN USED BY CHILDREN.

THE DEPARTMENT HAD WRITTEN TO THE COMMITTEE ON SAFETY OF MEDICINE IN THE UNITED KINGDOM TO SEEK MORE INFORMATION ON THE ISSUE.

AS A RESULT, A DECISION WAS MADE TO INFORM IMPORTERS AND MANUFACTURERS OF ASPIRIN TO WITHDRAW CHILDREN ASPIRIN PRODUCTS FROM SALE VOLUNTARILY, HE SAID.

IN A LETTER SENT OUT BY THE DEPARTMENT, IT WAS POINTED OUT THAT AVAILABLE EVIDENCE INDICATED A POSSIBLE ASSOCIATION BETWEEN THE REYE'S SYNDROME AND ASPIRIN INGESTION AND IT MAY BE A CONTRIBUTORY FACTOR TO THE CAUSATION OF THE DISEASE IN SOME CHILDREN.

SINCE THERE IS EFFECTIVE ALTERNATIVE TREATMENT FOR FEVER IN CHILDREN, ASPIRIN SHOULD NO LONGER BE GIVEN TO CHILDREN UNDER 12 YEARS EXCEPT ON MEDICAL ADVICE.

TO ENSURE THE SAFE USE OF ASPIRIN PREPARATIONS, THE IMPORTERS AND MANUFACTURERS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE INFORMATION ON PRECAUTIONS IN TAKING ASPIRIN, IN BOTH ENGLISH AND CHINESE, EITHER ON THE LABEL OR IN A LEAFLET ATTACHED TO THE PRODUCT.

THE SPOKESMAN REITERATED THE ADVICE THAT CHILDREN UNDER 12 SHOULD NOT BE GIVEN ASPIRIN EXCEPT ON MEDICAL ADVICE AND THE MEDICINE SHOULD BE KEPT OUT OF THE REACH OF CHILDREN AT HOME.

KOWLOON CITY DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS THIS (MONDAY) AFTERNOON VISITED THE URBAN AREA DEVELOPMENT OFFICE (UADO) OF THE TERRITORY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND SAW SOME OF ITS PROJECTS IN THE DISTRICT.

ACCOMPANIED BY STAFF OF THE DISTRICT OFFICE, MEMBERS WENT TO THE UADO AT AUSTIN ROAD WHERE THEY WERE BRIEFED BY THE CHIEF PUBLIC WORKS OFFICER (KOWLOON CITY), DR LAI HON-WAH, ON THE WORK AND ORGANISATION OF THE DEPARTMENT.

THEY ALSO HELD DISCUSSIONS ON VARIOUS PROJECTS WHICH WERE BEING CARRIED OUT IN THE DISTRICT.

AFTER THE BRIEFING, THE PARTY TOURED SITES AT THE CARPENTER ROAD PROJECT IN KOWLOON CITY AND THE PRINCESS MARGARET ROAD FLYOVER RECONSTRUCTION PROJECT.

THE CARPENTER ROAD PROJECT INCLUDED THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN URBAN COUNCIL PLAYGROUND AND THE WIDENING OF THE ROAD TO EASE TRAFFIC CONDITIONS IN THE AREA.

TODAY'S VISIT IS PART OF AN ON-GOING PROGRAMME ARRANGED BY THE DISTRICT OFFICE TO ENABLE BOARD MEMBERS TO FAMILIARISE THEMSELVES WITH THE OPERATION OF VARIOUS GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS.

WATER STORAGE FIGURE
* * *

STORAGE IN HONG KONG'S RESERVOIRS AT 9 AM TODAY (MONDAY) STOOD AT 63.2 PER CENT OF CAPACITY OR 370.521 MILLION CUBIC METRES.

THIS TIME LAST YEAR THE RESERVOIRS CONTAINED 353.500 MILLION CUBIC METRES OF WATER, REPRESENTING 60.3 PER CENT OF CAPACITY.

POLICE STATION BEING RENOVATED
* * * *

THE OLD SHEK KIP MEI POLICE STATION AT TAI HANG SAI STREET IS TO BE RENOVATED, BRINGING ITS FACILITIES INTO LINE WITH THOSE OF OTHER DIVISIONAL POLICE STATIONS.

THE THREE-STOREY STATION WAS BUILT AROUND 20 YEARS AGO, AND THE STANDARD OF EXISTING FACILITIES IS CONSIDERED OUTDATED IN THE FACE OF PRESENT POLICING REQUIREMENTS.

THE RENOVATION WORK WILL PROVIDE FOR BETTER USE OF THE BUILDING'S SPACE. IT INVOLVES IMPROVEMENT TO THE REPORT ROOM, CELLS, CID OFFICES, BARRACKS AND LAUNDRY.

TENDERS FOR THE PROJECT ARE NOW BEING INVITED.

DURING THE RENOVATION WORK, WHICH IS EXPECTED TO START IN OCTOBER AND BE COMPLETED BY JUNE NEXT YEAR, THE POLICE STATION WILL CONTINUE TO SERVE THE PUBLIC.

THE STATION HAS RECENTLY BEEN EXPANDED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF A THREE-STOREY ANNEXE WHICH WAS OPENED IN APRIL.

THE ANNEXE, BUILT AT A COST OF \$3.7 MILLION, PROVIDES A FLOOR AREA OF ABOUT 1 500 SQUARE METRES FOR DINING AND RECREATION, LIVING QUARTERS AND CHANGING FACILITIES.

CABLE TO BE LAID AT DEEP WATER BAY

* * * *

THE GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO PERMIT HONG KONG ELECTRIC COMPANY TO LAY SECTIONS OF A 132-KILOVOLT CABLE WITHIN TWO AREAS OF FORESHORE AND SEABED AT DEEP WATER BAY.

THIS IS PART OF THE SECOND PHASE OF THE NEW CABLE ROUTE TO LINK WONG CHUK HANG ZONE SUBSTATION TO THE PROPOSED CHUNG HOM KOK ZONE SUBSTATION. THE CABLE IS TO MEET THE INCREASING DEMAND FOR POWER IN THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OF HONG KONG ISLAND.

A TOTAL OF 1 290 SQUARE METRES OF FORESHORE AND SEABED WILL BE AFFECTED IN TWO AREAS NORTHWEST AND SOUTHEAST OF THE BAY.

THE CABLE WILL REST IN AN ELEVATED REINFORCED CONCRETE STRUCTURE IN THE NORTHWEST. IN THE SOUTHEAST IT WILL BE PLACED IN A COVERED TROUGH TO BE INCORPORATED INTO EXISTING PAVED AREAS NEAR THE BEACH.

WORK ON THE SOUTHEASTERN SIDE OF THE BAY IS EXPECTED TO START IN OCTOBER AND BE COMPLETED BY JUNE NEXT YEAR, WHILE WORK ON THE NORTHWEST SECTOR SHOULD ALSO START IN OCTOBER AND TAKE 12 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

PLANS CAN BE INSPECTED AT THE BUILDINGS AND LANDS DEPARTMENT SURVEY OFFICE, OR THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OFFICE. OBJECTIONS TO THE PROJECT SHOULD BE SUBMITTED IN WRITING TO THE DIRECTOR OF BUILDINGS AND LANDS BY SEPTEMBER 24.

TEMPORARY MEASURES IN TSUEN WAN ROAD

* * * * *

THE KERBSIDE LANE OF THE KOWLOON BOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF TSUEN WAN ROAD, BETWEEN THE SLIP ROAD FROM TEXACO ROAD AND THE SLIP ROAD TO KWAI TSING ROUNDABOUT, WILL BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED FROM 9 AM ON FRIDAY (AUGUST 1) FOR ABOUT FOUR MONTHS.

THIS MEASURE WILL FACILITATE CONSTRUCTION OF KWAI CHUNG PARK.

DURING THE CLOSURE, ALL VEHICLES ON THIS SECTION OF TSUEN WAN ROAD WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE SLIP ROAD TO KWAI TSING ROUNDABOUT ON THEIR JOURNEYS TO KWAI CHUNG OR TSING YI.
