EMPLOYERS URGED TO EMPLOY MORE DISABLED  
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LOCAL EMPLOYERS WERE TODAY (TUESDAY) URGED TO EMPLOY MORE DISABLED PEOPLE SO THAT THEIR PRODUCTIVE ABILITY CAN BE TAPPED TO THE FULLEST EXTENT AS AN ADDITIONAL SOURCE OF MANPOWER.

THE PLEA WAS MADE BY MR JOHN SUNG, SENIOR LABOUR OFFICER IN CHARGE OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT'S SELECTIVE PLACEMENT SERVICE (SPS), AT A MEETING OF THE CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR INSTITUTE (HONG KONG BRANCH).

THE SPS WAS ESTABLISHED IN JULY 1980 TO PROVIDE FREE EMPLOYMENT SERVICE FOR THE BLIND, THE DEAF AND THE PHYSICALLY DISABLED SEEKING OPEN EMPLOYMENT.

MR SUNG TOLD THE MEETING THAT SOME OF THE DISABLED REGISTERED WITH THE SPS WERE INTERESTED IN TRAINEE POSTS SO THAT THEY CAN LEARN A SKILL.

+MY PLACEMENT OFFICERS ARE WILLING TO STUDY AND ADVISE YOU ON THE TYPE OF JOBS IN YOUR COMPANY THAT MAY BE PERFORMED BY THE DISABLED,+ HE ADDED.

LAST YEAR, MR SUNG CONTINUED, THE SPS RECORDED 505 PLACEMENTS.

THE STATISTICS MIGHT NOT LOOK IMPRESSIVE, BUT TO THE DISABLED, EACH PLACEMENT ALSO MEANT +PROOF OF HIS ABILITY, REGAINING OF CONFIDENCE AND HOPE AND ACCEPTANCE BY THE COMMUNITY+.

MR SUNG POINTED OUT THAT A MAJOR CRITERION FOR THE JOB-MATCHING PROCEDURE IS +PLACING THE RIGHT PERSON IN THE RIGHT JOB+, AND TO THIS END, PLACEMENT OFFICERS ATTACHED GREAT IMPORTANCE TO +KNOWING OUR CLIENTS+.

THE OFFICERS, DURING +FACE-TO-FACE+ INTERVIEWS WITH JOB-SEEKERS, TRIED TO OBTAIN SUCH INFORMATION AS THE CAUSE OF DISABILITY, EDUCATION, TRAINING, WORKING EXPERIENCE, WORK PREFERENCES AND FUNCTIONAL CAPACITY, ETC.

IF NECESSARY, THE SPS WOULD SEEK ASSISTANCE FROM THE VOCATIONAL ASSESSMENT SERVICE OF THE TECHNICAL EDUCATION AND INDUSTRIAL TRAINING DEPARTMENT IN RESPECT OF PSYCHOLOGICAL APTITUDE AND TECHNICAL TESTS.

MR SUNG WENT ON TO SAY THAT IN 1982 PLACEMENT OFFICERS MADE 562 PROMOTIONAL VISITS TO EMPLOYERS IN COMMERCE, INDUSTRY AND THE SERVICE SECTOR TO IDENTIFY JOBS SUITABLE FOR THE DISABLED.

IF NECESSARY, THE OFFICERS WILL ADVISE THE EMPLOYER AND THE DISABLED JOB-SEEKER OF THE POSSIBILITY OF ADOPTING A TECHNICAL AID AT THE WORKPLACE OR MAKING AN ADAPTATION TO MACHINES OR WORK PREMISES.

IN THE CASE OF A PARTIALLY-SIGHTED CLIENT FOR EXAMPLE, THE PLACEMENT OFFICER WOULD ASSESS WHETHER IT WOULD REQUIRE A MAGNIFIER OR CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION TO ENLARGE THE LETTERS OR OBJECTS THE CLIENT HAS TO HANDLE, OR AN AID TO MAKE USE OF HIS OTHER SENSES, SUCH AS HIS TOUCH OR HEARING, SO THAT HE CAN +SEE+ WITH HIS FINGERS OR EARS.

THE COMMON ADAPTATIONS TO EMPLOYER'S PREMISES ARE RAMPS, HAND RAILS, TOILET FACILITIES, WIDER DOORS AND DOOR HANDLES, FIRE ALARM SYSTEMS FOR THE DEAF, AND TACTILE INDICATORS FOR THE BLIND.

AN EMPLOYER WHO PROVIDES A DISABLED EMPLOYEE WITH SPECIAL AIDS OR MAKES ADAPTATION CAN APPLY FOR REIMBURSEMENTS FROM THE EMPLOYAID SCHEME.

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ARRANGEMENTS FOR GOVERNOR'S DEPARTURE

APPEAL TO UC ELECTION VOTERS  
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THE EASTERN DISTRICT OFFICER, MR H.T. LUI, TODAY (TUESDAY) CALLED ON ALL REGISTERED ELECTORS TO EXERCISE THEIR RIGHTS AND VOTE IN THE URBAN COUNCIL ELECTIONS ON MARCH 8.

IN AN APPEAL LETTER TO THE DISTRICT'S 100 000 VOTERS, MR LUI SAID THE SUCCESS OF THE URBAN DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS IN SEPTEMBER LAST YEAR MARKED ONLY THE INTERMEDIATE STEP IN THE PROCESS OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION.

+THE NEXT AND EQUALLY IMPORTANT STEP WILL BE THE NEW-STYLE URBAN COUNCIL ELECTIONS SCHEDULED FOR TUESDAY (MARCH 8),+ HE SAID.

FOR THE ELECTIONS ALL DISTRICT BOARD VOTERS AND ALL THOSE ON THE URBAN COUNCIL'S ELECTORAL ROLL ARE ELIGIBLE TO VOTE FOR A CANDIDATE FROM WITHIN THEIR RESPECTIVE CONSTITUENCIES.

THE SUCCESSFUL URBAN COUNCILLORS WILL AUTOMATICALLY SIT ON THE RESPECTIVE DISTRICT BOARD, IN ADDITION TO GAINING THEIR SEATS IN THE URBAN COUNCIL, MR LUI SAID.

+IN THIS WAY, THESE ELECTED URBAN COUNCILLORS WILL NOT ONLY BE ABLE TO REPRESENT YOUR INTERESTS ON THE DISTRICT BOARDS BUT ALSO ENSURE THAT YOUR VOICE IS HEARD IN THE URBAN COUNCIL,+ HE ADDED.

HE NOTED THAT WELL OVER 30 PER CENT OF THE 100 000 REGISTERED ELECTORS IN THE DISTRICT VOTED IN LAST YEAR'S DISTRICT BOARD ELECTIONS.

+THIS WAS REALLY AN ACHIEVEMENT BY ANY STANDARD AND REFLECTED THE PEOPLE'S INTEREST IN THE IMPROVEMENT OF GOVERNMENT SERVICES AND THE PROVISION OF FACILITIES IN THEIR OWN DISTRICTS,+ HE SAID.

THE APPEAL LETTER, TOGETHER WITH A SIMPLE GUIDE ON VOTING, A SKETCH MAP SHOWING THE POLLING STATIONS AND A SPECIAL PUBLICATION INTRODUCING ALL NOMINATED CANDIDATES IN THE DISTRICT, WERE SENT TO THE VOTERS.

IN EASTERN DISTRICT THERE ARE TWO CONSTITUENCIES : NORTH POINT COVERING CAUSEWAY BAY, NORTH POINT AND QUARRY BAY; AND SHAU KEI WAN COVERING SHAU KEI WAN AND CHAI WAN.

MORE PEOPLE SEEK HELP FROM TAVA SCHEME  
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THE NUMBER OF APPLICATIONS FOR TRAFFIC ACCIDENT VICTIMS ASSISTANCE (TAVA) LAST YEAR REACHED AN ALL-TIME RECORD OF 7 693.

THIS FIGURE WAS UP BY 2 043 APPLICATIONS OVER 1981 AND BY 2 922 APPLICATIONS OVER 1980.

+THE MAIN REASON COULD WELL BE THE INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF TRAFFIC ACCIDENT CASUALTIES,+ EXPLAINED MR SIU KING-CHIU, HEAD OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S TAVA SECTION.

+BUT IT MIGHT ALSO BE DUE TO THE GROWING PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE ASSISTANCE SCHEME, TO THE REDUCTION OF THE SICK LEAVE REQUIREMENT FROM SEVEN DAYS TO THREE AND TO EFFORTS BY SWD STAFF TO CONTACT CASUALTIES OR THEIR RELATIVES,+ HE SAID.

PAYMENTS TO ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS LAST YEAR TOTALLED \$31.8 MILLION.

FROM THE START OF THE SCHEME IN MID-1979 TO THE END OF JANUARY 1983, THE DEPARTMENT HAD PAID OUT NEARLY \$80.6 MILLION.

+AT PRESENT, ABOUT 300 APPLICATIONS ARE BEING PROCESSED AND THE APPLICANTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO RECEIVE PAYMENTS SHORTLY,+ SAID MR SIU.

THE SCHEME, WHICH REQUIRES NO MEANS TEST, OFFERS QUICK CASH RELIEF FOR TRAFFIC ACCIDENT VICTIMS OR THEIR DEPENDANTS REGARDLESS OF WHO WAS AT FAULT, PROVIDED THE ACCIDENT HAS BEEN REPORTED TO THE POLICE.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE MADE WITHIN SIX MONTHS OF THE ACCIDENT AT THE SWD'S TAVA SECTION AT THE WORLD TRADE CENTRE, 14TH FLOOR, 280 GLOUCESTER ROAD, CAUSEWAY BAY. ENQUIRIES CAN BE MADE BY CALLING 5-779421 OR 5-7903650.

AT A PRESS CONFERENCE TODAY (TUESDAY), CHAIRMAN OF THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE, MR HARDY TSOI, SAID ABOUT \$60 000 WOULD BE SPENT ON THE DRAMA MONTH, THE FIRST SUCH EVENT BEING ORGANISED IN THE DISTRICT.

THE PROGRAMME WILL INCLUDE PERFORMANCES BY THE RENOWNED CHUNG YING THEATRE COMPANY WHO WILL STAGE +WOLF-BOY+ AND +STRONGER THAN SUPERMAN+ IN THE LITTLE FLOWER SCHOOL AND HOLY SPIRIT SCHOOL FOR ABOUT 800 SCHOOL CHILDREN.

FOR THE GROWN-UPS, THE THESPIANS DRAMA SOCIETY AND STUDENTS FROM THE CHINESE UNIVERSITY WILL PRESENT A SHORTENED VERSION OF EUGENE O'NEILL'S NOBEL PRIZE WINNING PIECE +AH! WILDERNESS+.

THE PLAY WILL BE DIRECTED BY MR HARDY TSOI AND TO BE HELD AT THE SIR RUN RUN SHAW HALL OF THE CHINESE UNIVERSITY FOR THREE NIGHTS, BEGINNING MARCH 24.

THERE WILL ALSO BE SEMINARS AND A LECTURE FOR TEACHERS AND STUDENTS WHO ARE INTERESTED IN DRAMA.

PRINTING INDUSTRY MANUAL OF TRADE TEST GUIDELINES PUBLISHED  
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A MANUAL OF TRADE TEST GUIDELINES FOR THE PRINCIPAL CRAFT JOBS IN THE PRINTING INDUSTRY WAS PUBLISHED TODAY.

THE MANUAL, PREPARED BY THE PRINTING INDUSTRY TRAINING BOARD OF THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL, WAS DESIGNED TO ASSIST EMPLOYERS WITH THE ASSESSMENT OF THEIR APPRENTICES' AND WORKERS' PRACTICAL SKILLS BY THE APPLICATION OF A TRADE TEST.

THE TEST IS RECOMMENDED AS A MEASURE TO ASCERTAIN THE SKILL STANDARD OF A CANDIDATE AND TO ENABLE HIM TO HAVE PROVEN EVIDENCE OF HIS ATTAINMENT.

THE TRAINING BOARD APPEALS TO EMPLOYERS TO GIVE PROPER RECOGNITION TO EMPLOYEES WHO HAVE ATTAINED A REQUIRED STANDARD AFTER PASSING THE TRADE TESTS.

THE MANUAL, IN ENGLISH AND CHINESE, IS ON SALE AT \$22 A COPY AT THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE, CONNAUGHT PLACE, CENTRAL.

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COUNTRY PARK PHOTOGRAPHS ON EXHIBITION  
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THE DIRECTOR OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES, DR JOHN RIDDELL-SWAN, TODAY (TUESDAY) EXPRESSED HIS SYMPATHY TO THE PEOPLE OF AUSTRALIA IN THEIR LOSSES IN THE RECENT DEVASTATING BUSH FIRES.

HE SAID THE BUSH FIRES IN AUSTRALIA SERVE AS A REMINDER OF THE DESTRUCTIVE POWERS OF FIRES AND THE NEED TO BE PERPETUALLY ON GUARD.

DR RIDDELL-SWAN MADE THE COMMENT IN HIS CAPACITY AS THE COUNTRY PARKS AUTHORITY (CPA) DURING THE OPENING OF A SPECIAL EXHIBITION OF COUNTRY PARKS PHOTOGRAPHS AT THE LANDMARK.

THE EXHIBITION WHICH LASTS UNTIL WEDNESDAY NEXT WEEK (MARCH 9) IS BEING PRESENTED BY THE CPA, THE PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY OF HONG KONG AND A PROFESSIONAL PHOTOGRAPHER, MR HO KING-TONG.

DR RIDDELL-SWAN SAID: +THE COUNTRY PARKS PROVIDE A DRAMATIC CONTRAST TO THE BUSTLE OF CITY LIFE AND MORE THAN EIGHT MILLION VISITS WERE MADE LAST YEAR.

+SUCH HEAVY VISITOR LOADINGS BRING MANAGEMENT PROBLEMS OF WHICH LITTERING AND HILL FIRES ARE THE MOST SEVERE, REQUIRING ALLOCATIONS OF RESOURCES AND ATTENTION.

+MENTION OF HILL FIRES ENABLES ME TO EXPRESS MY DEEP SYMPATHY WITH THE PEOPLE OF AUSTRALIA, ESPECIALLY FORESTRY AND PARKS SERVICE COLLEAGUES, IN THEIR LOSSES IN THE RECENT DEVASTATING BUSH FIRES.+

HE SAID THE EXCELLENCE OF THE PHOTOGRAPHS ON DISPLAY WAS A CREDIT TO THE TECHNICAL SKILLS OF THE EXHIBITORS WHO FOUND THAT LANDSCAPE PHOTOGRAPHY WAS A CHALLENGING SUBJECT WORTHY OF SERIOUS ATTENTION BY PROFESSIONALS AND AMATEURS ALIKE.

TWO LOTS OF PHOTOGRAPHS ARE ON DISPLAY AT THE EXHIBITION, BEING HELD AT THE WESTERN FOOTBRIDGE OF THE LANDMARK LINKING WITH ALEXANDRA HOUSE.

ONE LOT COMPRISES PHOTOGRAPHS TAKEN BY MR HO, WHO WAS COMMISSIONED BY THE CPA TO TAKE PICTURES FOR THE 1983 CALENDAR PRESENTED BY THE PUBLISHING FIRM, LONGMANS. THE OTHER PHOTOGRAPHS WERE TAKEN BY +SHUTTERBUGS+ WHO WENT ON EIGHT OUTINGS TO THE COUNTRY PARKS ORGANISED BY THE PHOTOGRAPHIC SOCIETY OF HONG KONG LAST YEAR.
