ADMIRALTY STATION SITE SOLD FOR \$585 MILLION

* * * *

A BUILDING SITE OF 3,983 SQUARE METRES ADJACENT TO THE MASS TRANSIT ADMIRALTY STATION ON HONG KONG ISLAND WAS SOLD AT AN AUCTION TODAY FOR \$585 MILLION.

THE SALE PRICE IS EQUIVALENT TO \$146,874.21 PER SQUARE METRE. THE PURCHASER WAS LIPAK INVESTMENT COMPANY LIMITED.

THE SITE IS FOR NON-INDUSTRIAL PURPOSES, EXCLUDING HOTELS.

A SPECIAL PROVISION IN THE SALE CONDITIONS IS THAT THE PURCHASER WILL BUILD ON THE GROUND FLOOR A BUS TERMINUS TO BE COMPLETED BY MARCH 31, 1980 TO COINCIDE WITH THE OPENING OF THE ADMIRALTY STATION WHICH THE BUS TERMINUS WILL SERVE.

THE SITE WAS ONE OF THE FOUR LOTS OF CROWN LAND OFFERED FOR AUCTION IN THE CITY HALL THEATRE BY THE P.W.D.'S CROWN LANDS AND SURVEY OFFICE.

A SITE OF 1,797 SQUARE METRES AT SA PO ROAD, NEW KOWLOON, WAS SOLD FOR \$51 MILLION TO CHIU TICK INVESTMENTS LTD. THE REALISED PRICE IS EQUIVALENT TO \$28,380.63 PER SQUARE METRE. THE SITE IS FOR NON-INDUSTRIAL PURPOSES, AND MUST BE DEVELOPED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 1982.

ANOTHER SITE AT KAM SHING ROAD, NEW KOWLOON, WAS PURCHASED BY PAK SHUI HON LTD. FOR \$33 MILLION, \$15,306.12 PER SQUARE METRE FOR THE 2,156 SQUARE METRE SITE.

THIS SITE, FOR NON-INDUSTRIAL PURPOSES, MUST ALSO BE DEVELOPED BEFORE SEPTEMBER 30, 1982.

THE FOURTH, A 66.6 SQUARE METRE LOT AT 21 PORTLAND STREET, WAS SOLD TO CATHAY REALTY AND PROPERTY LTD. FOR \$1,050,000, \$15,765.77 PER SQUARE METRE.

THIS SITE MUST BE DEVELOPED WITHIN 36 MONTHS AFTER VACANT POSSESSION OF THE EXISTING BUILDING HAS BEEN OBTAINED.

NEW FLYOVER PROPOSED FOR WEST KOWLOON CORRIDOR

* * * * *

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT PROPOSES TO EXTEND THE WESTERN END OF THE GASCOIGNE ROAD FLYOVER NEAR KANSU STREET TO LINK WITH THE SECTION OF ELEVATED ROAD NOW BEING BUILT AT TAI KOK TSUI.

THE DUAL CARRIAGEWAYS OF THE PROPOSED ELEVATED ROAD WHICH IS PART OF THE WEST KOWLOON CORRIDOR WILL RUN ALONG FERRY STREET AND BRANCH OUT NEAR SHAN TUNG STREET.

THE NORTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY WILL BRANCH OFF WESTWARD ACROSS THE YAU MA TEI RECLAMATION TO CHERRY STREET WHILE THE SOUTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY WILL CONTINUE NORTHWARD ALONG TONG MEI ROAD.

THESE TWO ELEVATED CARRIAGEWAYS WILL THEN LINK WITH THOSE AT TAI KOK TSUI, WHICH ARE CURRENTLY UNDER CONSTRUCTION AT TAI KOK TSUI ROAD AND TUNG CHAU STREET.

THE PROPOSED ELEVATED ROAD MEASURED ABOUT 1,700 METRES IN LENGTH.

IN GENERAL, EACH OF THE DUAL CARRIAGEWAYS WILL PROVIDE TWO TRAFFIC LANES EXCEPT AT THE SECTION IN FERRY STREET WHERE THE CARRIAGEWAY IS WIDENED TO ACCOMMODATE TWO CONNECTING RAMPS. ALTOGETHER FIVE SLIP ROADS WILL BE BUILT IN THIS SECTION TO INTEGRATE THE ELEVATED ROAD WITH THE GROUND LEVEL ROAD SYSTEMS.

IN CONJUNCTION WITH THIS PROJECT, PART OF FERRY STREET, TONG MEI ROAD AND TUNG CHAU STREET WILL BE RECONSTRUCTED. A PEDESTRIAN SUBWAY ACROSS FERRY STREET NEAR SHAN TUNG STREET WILL ALSO BE BUILT TO FACILITATE PEDESTRIAN MOVEMENTS AT THE SAME TIME.

WHEN COMPLETED THIS SECTION OF THE ELEVATED ROAD ALONG WITH GASCOIGNE ROAD AND THE SECTION IN TAI KOK TSUI WILL SERVE AS A FAST TRAFFIC ROUTE BETWEEN HUNG HOM AND SHAM SHUI PO.

THE ELEVATED ROAD WILL BE EXTENDED EVENTUALLY ALONG WITH THE CHEUNG SHA WAN WATERFRONT TO JOIN WITH LAI CHI KOK ROAD IN THE NORTH TO COMPLETE THE WEST KOWLOON CORRIDOR.

A NOTICE CONCERNING THE PROPOSED UNDERTAKING WAS PUBLISHED IN TODAY'S GOVERNMENT GAZETTE.

ANY PERSON OBJECTING TO THE PROPOSED PROJECT MUST SEND HIS OBJECTION IN WRITING TO THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS SO AS TO REACH HIS OFFICE NOT LATER THAN SEPTEMBER 4, 1978.

EMPLOYMENT OF DISABLED PERSONS IN GOVERNMENT ENCOURAGED
* * * * *

THE SECRETARY FOR THE CIVIL SERVICE, MR. MARTIN ROWLANDS, HAS ASKED HEADS OF GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS TO GIVE DISABLED PERSONS APPLYING FOR GOVERNMENT JOBS +AN APPROPRIATE DEGREE OF PREFERENCE OVER OTHER APPLICANTS.+

IN A CIRCULAR RECENTLY, MR. ROWLANDS SAID: +WHEN ALL OTHER FACTORS ARE EQUAL, DISABLED PERSONS APPLYING FOR GOVERNMENT POSTS AND FOUND SUITABLE FOR EMPLOYMENT SHOULD BE GIVEN AN APPROPRIATE DEGREE OF PREFERENCE OVER OTHER APPLICANTS.+

THE CIRCULAR ALSO SAYS THAT DEPARTMENTS EMPLOYING DISABLED PERSONS SHOULD ARRANGE WITH THE MAINTENANCE BRANCH OF THE ARCHITECTURAL OFFICE, PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, FOR ANY NECESSARY ALTERATIONS TO OFFICE PREMISES AND FITTINGS, SUCH AS TOILET FACILITIES, TO BE CARRIED OUT FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF DISABLED OFFICERS.

MR. ROWLANDS SAID HE BELIEVED THE CIVIL SERVICE SHOULD SET A GOOD EXAMPLE BY PROVIDING EMPLOYMENT FOR AS MANY DISABLED PEOPLE AS POSSIBLE. +WE ALREADY EMPLOY ABOUT 450 DISABLED PEOPLE, BUT I SHALL BE ASKING ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS TO EXAMINE WAYS OF INCREASING THIS NUMBER,+ HE SAID.

HIGH-CLASS SILVERSTRAND RESIDENTIAL SITE FOR SALE

THE GOVERNMENT IS TO AUCTION A HIGH-CLASS RESIDENTIAL SITE AT SILVERSTRAND IN CLEARWATER BAY ON AUGUST 22 THIS YEAR.

THE AUCTION WILL BE HELD AT THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT OFFICE, SAN PO KONG GOVERNMENT OFFICES, PRINCE EDWARD ROAD, STARTING AT 3 P.M.

THE ACTING SENIOR ESTATE SURVEYOR OF THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT OFFICE, MR. GREGORY LAI, TODAY SAID: +THE SITE ENJOYS VERY GOOD SEA VIEWS AND IS LOCATED IN A HIGH-CLASS RESIDENTIAL AREA.

+IT IS VERY ATTRACTIVE BEING IN THE NEW TERRITORIES, BUT ONLY 20 MINUTES DRIVE FROM THE KOWLOON URBAN AREA.+

THE LOT OCCUPIES AN AREA OF ABOUT 1,858 SQUARE METRES AND CARRIES A BUILDING COVENANT OF \$750,000 OVER 36 MONTHS, HE SAID. THE LOT WILL BASICALLY BE RESTRICTED TO TWO-STOREY BUILDINGS.

MR. LAI SAID KEEN BIDDING IS EXPECTED JUDGING FROM THE NUMBER OF ENQUIRIES RECEIVED.

+LAND DEVELOPERS HAVE SHOWN CONTINUING INTEREST IN RESIDENTIAL SITES IN SAI KUNG AND WE HAVE A NUMBER OF SITES TO BE DISPOSED OFF BY AUCTION,+ MR. LAI SAID.

HE ADDED THAT THE LAST AUCTION OF AN ADJACENT SITE AT SILVERSTRAND IN SEPTEMBER LAST YEAR FETCHED THE EQUIVALENT OF MORE THAN \$100 PER SQUARE FOOT.

IMPROVEMENTS TO PRINCESS MARGARET ROAD FLYOVER

* * * *

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT PROPOSES TO IMPROVE THE PRINCESS MARGARET ROAD FLYOVER FROM A THREE-LANE CARRIAGEWAY TO A DUAL TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAY.

THE WORK INVOLVES EXTENDING THE EXISTING FLYOVER BY ABOUT 12 METRES AT THE SOUTHERN END.

A P.W.D. SPOKESMAN SAID: +NO MAJOR RE-ALIGNMENT OF THE EXISTING FLYOVER WILL BE INVOLVED, BUT THE IMPROVEMENT WILL INCLUDE THE PROVISION OF A CENTRAL DIVIDER AND WIDENING ON THE CURVES.+

TO ALLOW FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE FLYOVER, LIMITED CHANGES IN ALIGNMENT AND LEVEL ARE NECESSARY AT GROUND LEVEL AT A NUMBER OF LOCATIONS ON PRINCESS MARGARET ROAD, ARGYLE STREET AND WATERLOO ROAD.

MORE EXTENSIVE ALTERATIONS IN ALIGNMENT AND LEVEL ARE NECESSARY AT GROUND LEVEL IN WATERLOO ROAD BELOW THE SLOPE TO THE REAR OF NOS. 2-14 BRAGA CIRCUIT, WHERE A RETAINING WALL WILL BE CONSTRUCTED.

THE NORTH-BOUND CARRIAGEWAY BETWEEN PRINCESS MARGARET ROAD FLYOVER AND THE WATERLOO ROAD FLYOVER WILL BE WIDENED TO FOUR LANES TO FACILITATE THE TRAFFIC FLOW BETWEEN THE TWO FLYOVERS.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID: +IMPROVEMENT OF THE FLYOVER IS NECESSARY DUE TO THE GENERAL INCREASE IN TRAFFIC SINCE THE FLYOVER WAS FIRST BUILT IN 1966.+

LION DANCE STEALS SHOW IN COMMONWEALTH CARNIVAL

WHEN 200-POUND CANADIANS STARTED TO CLIMB ON THE HONG KONG LIONS TODAY (FRIDAY) IN CHURCHILL SQUARE, EDMONTON, THE SLIGHT-BUILT DANCERS PERSPIRING INSIDE THEIR SHAGGY LION COSTUMES DECIDED TO CALL A HALT.

THE AMICABLE HONG KONG DANCERS HAD NO HARD FEELINGS WHEN THEY CAME UP FOR AIR IN THE MIDST OF A PRESSING THROG OF ADMIRERS. THEY ATTRIBUTED THE OVER-ENTHUSIASM OF THEIR OVERWEIGHT RIDERS TO THE HIGH DEGREE OF EXCITEMENT THEY HAD GENERATED AMONG ONLOOKERS.

THE EXCITEMENT BEGAN AS SOON AS THE HONG KONG SCHOOLS DANCE TEAM TOOK TO THE OPEN-AIR STAGE, IN THE MIDST OF A PERFORMANCE GIVEN BY GROUPS FROM ABOUT 20 COUNTRIES CONTRIBUTING TO THE COMMONWEALTH CARNIVAL, WHICH FOLLOWED IMMEDIATELY UPON THE OPENING OF THE COMMONWEALTH GAMES.

WHEN THE DISTINCTIVE STRINGS OF TRADITIONAL CHINESE MUSIC ISSUED OVER THE LOUDSPEAKERS, AND A RAINBOW OF COLOUR WASHED OVER THE PODIUM WITH THE ARRIVAL OF THE HONG KONG TROUPE IN THEIR EXOTIC COSTUMES, THE CROWD OF ABOUT 5,000 ASSEMBLED IN THE SQUARE PRESSED FORWARD FOR A BETTER VIEW.

SO GREAT WAS THE PRESS THAT IT TEMPORARILY DISCONNECTED THE LOUDSPEAKER WIRING, INTERRUPTING THE MUSIC FOR THE SPECTACULAR SONG OF THE SUNFLOWERS, WHICH HAD ALREADY BECOME ESTABLISHED AS THE TROUPE'S MOST POPULAR ITEM.

HOWEVER, THE PERFORMERS WERE SO WELL VERSED IN THEIR MOVEMENTS THAT THEY CARRIED ON REGARDLESS UNTIL THE MUSIC RETURNED, BRINGING GALES OF APPLAUSE FROM THE SPECTATORS.

FOR ONCE, BEAUTY GAVE WAY TO THE BEAST IN THE POPULARITY VOTE, BECAUSE THE FOLLOWING LION DANCE UNQUESTIONABLY STOLE THE SHOW FROM ALL THE OTHER ITEMS PRESENTED IN THIS DIVERSE SHOWCASE OF COMMONWEALTH CULTURE.

CHILDREN IN THE AUDIENCE RODE THEIR PARENTS' SHOULDERS AND HOOTED WITH DELIGHT AT THE ANTICS OF THE PRANCING, ROLLING, EYE-BLINKING LIONS.

AFTER THE JOINING OF HANDS BY ALL PARTICIPATING GROUPS ON STAGE FOR THE GRAND FINALE, THE LIONS DESCENDED FROM THE PLATFORM AND WERE SWALLOWED UP IN THE CROWD.

COMMENTED LION DANCER HA CHAK-SHUN AT THE END OF THIS EXHAUSTING EXPERIENCE: +AT FIRST IT WAS FUN GIVING THE KIDS A RIDE AND POSING FOR PICTURES. BUT LATER SOME OF THE ADULTS GOT CARRIED AWAY, AND WE SIMPLY HAD TO GIVE UP WHEN HEFTY 200 POUNDS BEGAN CLIMBING ONTO OUR SHOULDERS. I THINK THEY SIMPLY DIDN'T REALISE WHO WAS INSIDE THOSE GREAT SHAGGY COSTUMES.+

/EARLIER IN THE DAY,

EARLIER IN THE DAY, THE HONG KONG TEAM WAS FEATURED IN THE BARBARA KELLY SHOW, SCREENED BY ITV, EDMONTON'S LEADING TELEVISION STATION. MISS KELLY INTERVIEWED THE TEAM'S OFFICIALS AND THREE OF THE DANCERS, AND HER SHOW FEATURED FOUR OF THE ROUTINES FROM THEIR REPERTOIRE: THE RICE POUNDING DANCE, SABAYEE, THE BOW DANCE AND FLOWER DRUM DANCE.

ONE OF THE TEAM OFFICIALS LATER DESCRIBED THEIR RECEPTION AS +FANTASTIC, SIMPLY FANTASTIC+. QUITE APART FROM THE WARMTH OF THE CANADIAN RESPONSE, THE TEAM WAS STRUCK BY THE RESPONSE OF THE LOCAL CHINESE COMMUNITY, WHO NUMBER ABOUT 1,500.

SHEK WU HUI SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS

* * * * *

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT MAY INVITE TENDERS WITHIN THE NEXT SIX MONTHS FROM PREQUALIFIED CONTRACTORS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE ROAD, DRAINAGE AND BUILDING WORKS OF PHASE I OF THE SHEK WU HUI SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS.

THE SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS IS PART OF THE DEVELOPMENT IN FAN LING AND SHEK WU HUI AND WILL BE BUILT ON A SITE OF ABOUT 10 HECTARES, ADJACENT TO AND INCORPORATING THE EXISTING PILOT TREATMENT PLANT.

THE PROJECT WILL SERVE A POPULATION OF ABOUT 127,000 AND THE ASSOCIATED INDUSTRIES IN THE NEW DEVELOPMENT, AND TREAT SEWAGE BROUGHT BY A SYSTEM OF SEWERS AND PUMPING STATIONS FROM ALL THE URBANISED AREAS OF FAN LING AND SHEK WU HUI, USING THE LATEST METHODS OF SEWAGE TREATMENT.

CONTRACTORS WITH PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE OF MAJOR SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS CONSTRUCTION WHO WISH TO HAVE MORE INFORMATION ON THE REQUIREMENTS FOR PREQUALIFICATION FOR THE CIVIL ENGINEERING AND BUILDING WORKS SHOULD CONTACT MESSRS. MAUNSELL CONSULTANTS ASIA, 2 TUNG LO WAN HILL, 1ST FLOOR, SHA TIN, NEW TERRITORIES.

SEPARATE CONTRACTS ARE TO BE LET FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL EQUIPMENT, FOR WHICH TENDERS WILL BE INVITED OVER THE NEXT SIX MONTHS FROM INTERNATIONAL CONTRACTORS.

IT IS EXPECTED THAT THE CONTRACT FOR STAGE I OF THE ROAD, DRAINAGE AND BUILDING WORKS WILL START IN APRIL NEXT YEAR AND BE COMPLETED BY JULY 1981, ALTHOUGH PARTS OF THE WORKS WILL BE IN OPERATION BY MAY 1981.

THE WORKS ARE BEING DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTION WILL BE SUPERVISED BY MAUNSELL CONSULTANTS ASIA IN ASSOCIATION WITH WATSON (HONG KONG) ON BEHALF OF THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

WOMAN WHO HELPED PIONEER SPECIAL EDUCATION RETIRES

A WOMAN WHO PLAYED A MAJOR ROLE IN BUILDING UP THE SPECIAL EDUCATION SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT IS RETIRING AFTER 25 YEARS OF GOVERNMENT SERVICE.

SHE IS MISS J.E. ROWE, WHO THIS AFTERNOON WAS PRESENTED WITH A HI-FI SET BY THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, MR. KENNETH TOPLEY, AT A FAREWELL CEREMONY HELD AT EDUCATION DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS IN LEE GARDENS.

IN MAKING THE PRESENTATION, MR. TOPLEY PRAISED MISS ROWE FOR THE HIGH PROFESSIONAL STANDARDS SHE SET IN DEVELOPING A CORPS OF EXPERTS PROVIDING EDUCATIONAL FACILITIES FOR THE DEAF, THE BLIND AND PARTIALLY-SIGHTED, THE MALADJUSTED AND SOCIALLY DEPRIVED, THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED, SLOW LEARNERS AND CHILDREN SUFFERING FROM SPEECH DIFFICULTIES.

MR. TOPLEY SAID THE EXAMPLE AND FAR-SIGHTEDNESS THAT MISS ROWE HAD BROUGHT TO HER POSITION AS THE PRINCIPAL EDUCATION OFFICER IN CHARGE OF SPECIAL EDUCATION HAD BEEN OUTSTANDING.

MISS ROWE JOINED THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AS A TEMPORARY SCHOOL MISTRESS IN MID-1953.

SHE WAS APPOINTED AS EDUCATION OFFICER IN 1955 AND WAS PROMOTED TO SENIOR EDUCATION OFFICER IN 1965 AND TO PRINCIPAL EDUCATION OFFICER IN 1971. SHE RECEIVED THE MBE IN 1972.

MISS ROWE HAS PLAYED A LEADING ROLE IN COMMUNITY ACTIVITIES DURING HER TIME IN HONG KONG.

SHE IS A FOUNDER MEMBER OF THE JOINT COUNCIL FOR THE PHYSICALLY AND MENTALLY HANDICAPPED AND IS A BRANCH MEMBER AND SCHOOL MANAGER FOR THE HONG KONG RED CROSS.

SHE ALSO IS A FOUNDER MEMBER AND PAST PRESIDENT OF THE SOROPTIMIST CLUB OF HONG KONG.

MISS ROWE WILL VISIT CHINA, AUSTRALIA AND THE UNITED STATES BEFORE RETURNING TO HER HOME IN BECKENHAM, KENT.
