STATEMENT BY THE GOVERNOR ON  
THE DEATH OF SIR JOHN BREMRIDGE

FOLLOWING IS A STATEMENT BY THE GOVERNOR, THE RT HON CHRISTOPHER PATTEN, ON THE DEATH OF FORMER FINANCIAL SECRETARY, SIR JOHN BREMRIDGE:

"I WAS SADDENED TO LEARN OF THE DEATH IN ENGLAND OF SIR JOHN BREMRIDGE. FOR MANY YEARS, SIR JOHN WAS A DISTINGUISHED MEMBER OF THE HONG KONG COMMUNITY, AS A BUSINESSMAN, THROUGH HIS MEMBERSHIP OF THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE COUNCILS, AND, FINALLY, AS FINANCIAL SECRETARY FROM 1981 TO 1986.

HE WILL BE REMEMBERED WITH GRATITUDE BY THE COMMUNITY FOR HIS WISE AND FIRM STEWARDSHIP DURING THOSE OFTEN DIFFICULT YEARS, IN PARTICULAR FOR HIS FAR-SIGHTED DECISION TO LINK THE HONG KONG AND U.S. DOLLARS IN 1983. HE WILL BE REMEMBERED ALSO WITH AFFECTION FOR HIS SENSE OF HUMOUR AND FOR HIS UNBOUNDED ENTHUSIASM FOR PROMOTING HONG KONG'S INTERESTS AT HOME AND ABROAD.

SIR JOHN WILL BE GREATLY MISSED BY HIS MANY FRIENDS AND ADMIRERS IN HONG KONG.

ON BEHALF OF THE COMMUNITY, I OFFER MY SINCERE CONDOLENCES TO LADY BREMRIDGE AND HER FAMILY."

IMPORTANCE OF MFN RENEWAL EMPHASISED TO NEW YORK AUDIENCE

\* \* \* \* \*

WITHDRAWAL OF MOST FAVOURED NATION (MFN) STATUS FOR CHINA WOULD CAUSE DAMAGE TO HONG KONG, TO THE UNITED STATES AND MOST OF ALL THOSE IT IS MEANT TO HELP: THOSE IN THE FOREFRONT OF CHANGE IN CHINA, THE HONG KONG COMMISSIONER TO THE UNITED STATES, MR BARRIE WIGGHAM, SAID IN A SPEECH IN NEW YORK ON THURSDAY (MAY 5) NIGHT.

MR WIGGHAM TOLD A CAPACITY MEETING OF THE OVERSEAS PRESS CLUB IN NEW YORK THAT THE ECONOMIC FALL OUT TO HONG KONG FOLLOWING MFN WITHDRAWAL COULD MEAN A LOSS OF UP TO US\$24 BILLION IN TRADE AND SOME 75,000 JOBS - OR THREE PER CENT OF HONG KONG'S WORKFORCE.

AMERICANS TOO WOULD LOSE, MR WIGGHAM SAID, WITH INCREASED COSTS IN CONSUMER GOODS AND MORE THAN \$7 BILLION WORTH OF U.S. EXPORTS TO CHINA AT RISK AND UP TO 200,000 JOBS.

WHILE ASSURING HIS AUDIENCE THAT HONG KONG SHARES THE VIEW THAT MORE SHOULD BE DONE TO ENCOURAGE CHINA TO ABIDE BY ACCEPTED HUMAN RIGHTS STANDARDS, MR WIGGHAM SAID HE DID NOT BELIEVE MFN TO BE AN EFFECTIVE LEVER FOR THIS.

"WE AGREE WITH THE OBJECTIVE. THE QUESTION IS, DO YOU STAND A BETTER CHANCE OF PERSUADING CHINA TO IMPROVE ITS HUMAN RIGHTS RECORD BY REDUCING TRADE, BY ISOLATING CHINA AND BY CUTTING OFF CONTACT WITH THE OUTSIDE WORLD?" MR WIGGHAM QUESTIONED.

/"OR DO .....

"OR DO YOU STAND A BETTER CHANCE OF PERSUADING CHINA IF YOU CONTINUE WITH TRADING AND HELPING TO OPEN UP CHINESE SOCIETY, WHILE AT THE SAME TIME KEEPING HUMAN RIGHTS ON THE AGENDA BUT PURSUING THAT OBJECTIVE, VIGOROUSLY, FROM A DIFFERENT DIRECTION?"

"IN THE LAST FEW YEARS TRADE BETWEEN CHINA AND THE REST OF THE WORLD, AND NOT LEAST WITH THE UNITED STATES, HAS BROUGHT ABOUT ECONOMIC CHANGE IN CHINA, AND WITH IT GREAT CHANGES TO THE LIVES OF ORDINARY PEOPLE IN CHINA," MR WIGGHAM SAID.

"THE CHINESE ENTREPRENEURIAL SPIRIT IS BEING ALLOWED FREER REIGN THAN HAS PROBABLY EVER BEEN THE CASE. TAKE AWAY OPPORTUNITIES AND INCENTIVES AND WHAT HAVE YOU ACHIEVED?" MR WIGGHAM QUESTIONED.

MR WIGGHAM SAID HE DID NOT BELIEVE SELECTIVE OR TARGETTED NON-RENEWAL WAS A VIABLE OPTION. THAT ROUTE MIGHT LOOK ATTRACTIVE TO THOSE LOOKING FOR THE SO-CALLED MIDDLE WAY BUT WOULD STILL CREATE UNCERTAINTY AND RETALIATION - AND WOULD NOT HELP HONG KONG.

"A TRADE WAR NEVER DOES ANYONE ANY GOOD AND I DO NOT SEE HOW, BY TAMPERING WITH MFN, YOU BENEFIT THE CAUSE OF HUMAN RIGHTS."

MR WIGGHAM SAID HONG KONG AND THE UNITED STATES SHARE THE SAME OBJECTIVE OVER HUMAN RIGHTS; "WE SIMPLY DISAGREE OVER THE MEANS," HE SAID.

"HONG KONG IS PROUD OF ITS HUMAN RIGHTS RECORD. WE REGARD OURSELVES AS HAVING A VERY FREE SOCIETY AND THESE ARE THE VERY FREEDOMS THAT WE WANT TO PROTECT AND MAINTAIN AFTER 1997."

HK DRINKING WATER FREE FROM HELICOBACTER PYLORI

\* \* \* \* \*

HELICOBACTER PYLORI HAS NOT BEEN FOUND IN DRINKING WATER IN HONG KONG, A WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

"THE DRINKING WATER IN HONG KONG COMPLIES CHEMICALLY AND BACTERIOLOGICALLY WITH THE GUIDELINE VALUES FOR DRINKING WATER PUBLISHED BY THE WORLD HEALTH ORGANISATION AND THIS COMPLIANCE IS CONFIRMED BY A COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAMME OF SAMPLING AND ANALYSIS," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN WAS COMMENTING ON A RECENT NEWSPAPER REPORT THAT DRINKING WATER IN HONG KONG CONTAINED THE BACTERIUM HELICOBACTER PYLORI, WHICH CAUSED DUODENAL ULCER.

AFTER CONSULTATION WITH THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND THE MEDICAL EXPERTS NAMED IN THE REPORT: PROFESSOR S K LAM OF HONG KONG UNIVERSITY, DR HUI WAI-MO FORMERLY OF THE SAME UNIVERSITY, AND DR JOSEPH J Y SUNG OF CHINESE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG, THE SPOKESMAN MADE THE FOLLOWING CLARIFICATION BASED ON THE OPINION OF ALL THESE PARTIES IN ORDER TO REMOVE MISCONCEPTION AND ALLAY PUBLIC CONCERNS:

- \* IT IS GENERALLY ACCEPTED THAT HELICOBACTER PYLORI MAY CONTRIBUTE TO THE CAUSATION OF DUODENAL ULCER, BUT THERE IS NO DIRECT PROOF OF CAUSE AND EFFECT;
- \* THE BACTERIUM SURVIVES IN THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT, BUT IS READILY KILLED BY CHLORINE DURING WATER TREATMENT OR BY BOILING. THE FULLY TREATED DRINKING WATER IN HONG KONG IS DISINFECTED WITH CHLORINE AND HAS A CHLORINE RESIDUAL IN THE DISTRIBUTION SYSTEM THAT ENSURES THE ELIMINATION OF HELICOBACTER PYLORI WHICH HAS NOT BEEN FOUND IN HONG KONG DRINKING WATER; AND
- \* THE EXACT MODE OF TRANSMISSION OF HELICOBACTER PYLORI IS STILL UNCLEAR, BUT PROBABLY FROM PERSON TO PERSON. CONTAMINATED WATER IS SUSPECTED TO BE A POSSIBLE PATHWAY IN ONE SINGLE STUDY ON HELICOBACTER PYLORI INFECTION IN ONE SOUTH AMERICAN CITY ONLY. THERE IS NO DIRECT PROOF THAT DRINKING WATER IS RESPONSIBLE FOR TRANSMISSION.

STUDENTS TO SEE THE WORLD OF WORK

SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS WILL BE ABLE TO SEE FOR THEMSELVES THE REAL WORKING ENVIRONMENT IN THE PRIVATE AND PUBLIC SECTORS IN THE "VISITS TO WORK PLACES" PROGRAMME ORGANISED BY THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT'S CAREERS ADVISORY SERVICE (CAS).

"THE PROGRAMME IS ORGANISED BY THE DEPARTMENT WHICH AIMS AT HELPING SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS TO GAIN A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORLD OF WORK SO THAT THEY CAN MAKE BETTER PLANS FOR THEIR FUTURE," SENIOR LABOUR OFFICER MRS CLARE SIU SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

MRS SIU DISCLOSED THAT DURING MAY AND JUNE, MORE THAN 600 SECONDARY 4 TO SECONDARY 7 STUDENTS FROM 18 SCHOOLS WILL VISIT VARIOUS ESTABLISHMENTS IN THE PUBLIC AND PRIVATE SECTORS.

THESE ESTABLISHMENTS INCLUDE HOTELS, BANKS, DEPARTMENT STORES, PUBLIC UTILITY COMPANIES, TRAINING INSTITUTES AND GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS.

"WE HOPE THAT THROUGH VISITS TO VARIOUS ESTABLISHMENTS, STUDENTS CAN OBTAIN FIRST-HAND AND UP-TO-DATE INFORMATION ON DIFFERENT CAREERS," MRS SIU SAID.

THE FIRST GROUP OF 20 STUDENTS VISITED THE OMNI HONG KONG HOTEL IN TSIM SHA TSUI YESTERDAY (FRIDAY) TO GAIN AN UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORK INSIDE A HOTEL.

"DURING THE VISIT, STUDENTS WERE TAKEN ON A GUIDED TOUR TO SEE THE WORK OF THE HOTEL STAFF IN RESTAURANTS AS WELL AS IN THE HOTEL ROOMS.

"THEY WERE ALSO BRIEFED BY THE MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL OF THE HOTEL ON THE DUTIES OF HOTEL STAFF, TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES, EMPLOYMENT TERMS AND CAREER PROSPECTS," SHE ADDED.

APART FROM THIS RECURRENT CAREERS EDUCATION ACTIVITY, MRS SIU SAID THE CAS ORGANISED A LARGE VARIETY OF CAREERS FUNCTIONS, INCLUDING ANNUAL EXHIBITIONS, QUIZZES AND SEMINARS.

IT ALSO PROVIDES CAREERS INFORMATION THROUGH ITS CAREERS INFORMATION CENTRES (CICS) TO ASSIST YOUNG PEOPLE IN CHOOSING A CAREER BEST SUITED TO THEIR TALENTS, INTEREST AND ABILITIES.

"EACH CIC HAS A REFERENCE LIBRARY, AN AUDIO-VISUAL UNIT WITH SLIDE PRESENTATION, CASSETTE RECORDINGS AND VIDEO TAPES ON CAREERS, AS WELL AS FREE ENQUIRY SERVICE FOR YOUNG PEOPLE SEEKING INFORMATION ON CAREERS AND TRAINING," MRS SIU SAID.

"YOUNG PEOPLE SEEKING CAREERS INFORMATION ARE WELCOME TO VISIT THE CICS WHICH ARE LOCATED AT THE SOUTHOEN CENTRE IN WAN CHAI AND THE MONG KOK GOVERNMENT OFFICES," SHE ADDED.

#### VOLUNTEERS WANTED TO HELP OFFENDERS

THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT IS LOOKING FOR VOLUNTEERS TO HELP WITH THE REHABILITATION OF OFFENDERS.

PEOPLE AGED 21 OR ABOVE WITH SECONDARY SCHOOL EDUCATION, MATURE PERSONALITY AND INTEREST IN THE REHABILITATION OF OFFENDERS, ARE INVITED TO JOIN THE VOLUNTEER SCHEME FOR PROBATIONERS (VSP).

SOME 500 VOLUNTEERS HAVE TAKEN PART IN THE SCHEME WHICH COMMENCED IN 1976.

A SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN TODAY (SATURDAY) SAID THAT THE SCHEME AIMED TO PROMOTE INTEREST AND CONCERN OF THE PUBLIC TOWARDS HELPING AND REHABILITATING OFFENDERS AND BY SO DOING BRING GREATER COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT AND STRONGER COMMUNITY ACTION AGAINST CRIME.

"IT ALSO HELPS TO MEET THE SPECIFIC NEEDS OF SUITABLE PROBATIONERS THROUGH SERVICE OFFERED BY VOLUNTEERS AND COMPLEMENT THE EFFORTS OF PROBATION OFFICERS IN THE SOCIAL REHABILITATION OF PROBATIONERS," HE ADDED.

THE PERIOD OF SERVICE IS NORMALLY SIX MONTHS, BUT A VOLUNTEER MAY SERVE FOR FURTHER TERMS FOR THE SAME OR OTHER OFFENDERS.

"SELECTED VOLUNTEERS WILL BE GIVEN A THOROUGH BRIEFING BEFORE THEY START TO ASSIST THE PROBATION OFFICERS BY BEFRIENDING, HELPING AND ADVISING PROBATIONERS ON A PERSONAL BASIS," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

FORMER VOLUNTEERS OF THE SCHEME ARE WELCOMED TO APPLY AGAIN.

APPLICATION FORMS ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT THE CENTRE FOR VSP ON THE SEVENTH FLOOR, WU CHUNG HOUSE, 213 QUEEN'S ROAD EAST, WAN CHAI AND PROBATION OFFICES ATTACHED TO THE MAGISTRACIES, COMMUNITY CENTRES AS WELL AS CHILDREN AND YOUTH CENTRES.
