## 48 NOMINATIONS RECEIVED FOR LEGCO ELECTIONS

\* \* \* \* \*

FORTY-EIGHT NOMINATIONS FOR THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ELECTIONS IN SEPTEMBER WERE RECEIVED ON THE FIRST DAY OF NOMINATION TODAY (MONDAY).

THIRTEEN NOMINATIONS WERE SUBMITTED FOR THE FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCY ELECTIONS TO BE HELD ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12, AND 35 FOR THE DIRECT ELECTIONS TO BE HELD ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 15.

THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS WERE REGISTERED IN FOUR FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCIES WITH EACH RECEIVED TWO NOMINATIONS. THEY WERE LABOUR, TEACHING, ENGINEERING AND TOURISM.

THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS FOR THE DIRECT ELECTIONS WAS SEVEN FOR NEW TERRITORIES EAST.

THE NOMINATION PERIOD WILL END ON AUGUST 12.

THERE ARE 21 SEATS IN THE 20 FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCIES, WITH TWO SEATS FOR THE LABOUR CONSTITUENCY. AS FOR THE DIRECT ELECTIONS, ALL NINE GEOGRAPHICAL CONSTITUENCIES ARE DOUBLE SEAT.

STATEMENT ON VM'S FIRST ASYLUM POLICY  
\* \* \* \* \*

IN RESPONSE TO PRESS REPORTS THAT THE GOVERNMENT WILL ABANDON THE POLICY OF FIRST ASYLUM FOR VIETNAMESE MIGRANTS BY THE END OF THIS YEAR, THE REFUGEE CO-ORDINATOR, MR CLINTON LEEKS, ISSUED THE FOLLOWING STATEMENT TODAY (MONDAY):

"WE CONTINUE TO BELIEVE THAT THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF ACTION (CPA) REMAINS THE BEST MEANS OF RESOLVING THE PROBLEM OF VIETNAMESE MIGRANTS.

"BUT WE HAVE ALSO MADE CLEAR, INCLUDING AT THE FOURTH STEERING COMMITTEE MEETING IN GENEVA ON APRIL 30 AND MAY 1, THAT HONG KONG CANNOT CONTINUE TO BEAR THE FULL WEIGHT OF THE CPA ALONE.

"THE CPA IS UNDER-FUNDED INTERNATIONALLY. ALMOST ALL ARRIVALS ARE NOW COMING TO HONG KONG, AND THE INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY HAVE FAILED TO FIND A DURABLE MEANS OF RETURNING NON-REFUGEES TO VIETNAM.

"IN THESE CIRCUMSTANCES, OUR CAMPS ARE NOW SERIOUSLY OVERCROWDED AND THIS SITUATION IS LIKELY TO GET WORSE.

"IF IT DOES, WE WILL REACH A SITUATION WHERE WE CAN NO LONGER MAINTAIN THE PRINCIPLE OF FIRST ASYLUM UNDER THE CPA.

"HENCE IT IS OF CRITICAL IMPORTANCE TO HAVE AN EARLY PROGRESS ON THE ESTABLISHMENT IN VIETNAM OF INTERNATIONALLY MANAGED CENTRES IN ORDER TO RELIEVE PART OF THE BURDEN ON HONG KONG AND TO ACHIEVE A REAL SOLUTION TO THE PROBLEM AS A WHOLE."

MR ELLIOTT, AGED 51, WILL WORK IN THE CHIEF SECRETARY'S OFFICE AND WILL ADVISE THE GOVERNMENT ON BROAD STRATEGIES AIMED AT PROMOTING HONG KONG AS AN INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL AND BUSINESS CENTRE.

SINO-BRITISH LAND COMMISSION

THE TWO SIDES OF THE SINO-BRITISH LAND COMMISSION HAVE AGREED THAT THE COMMISSION'S TWENTY-THIRD MEETING WILL BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY (JULY 31).

THE MEETING WILL DISCUSS THE AVERAGE COST OF LAND PRODUCTION FOR THE 1991/92 FINANCIAL YEAR AND THE LAND REQUIREMENT FOR HONG KONG HOUSING AUTHORITY'S SCHEME TO SELL PUBLIC RENTAL FLATS TO SITTING TENANTS.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES ARE EXPECTED TO POSSESS HIGH ACADEMIC PROWESS AND LEADERSHIP QUALITIES.
