LORD GLENARTHUR ARRIVES FOR FIVE-DAY VISIT

THE MINISTER OF STATE AT THE FOREIGN AND COMMONWEALTH OFFICE WITH RESPONSIBILITY FOR HONG KONG, LORD GLENARTHUR, ARRIVED TODAY (SATURDAY) FOR A FIVE-DAY VISIT -- HIS FOURTH TO HONG KONG.

HE WAS MET AT THE AIRPORT BY THE GOVERNOR, SIR DAVID WILSON; THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR DAVID FORD; THE SENIOR MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, DAME LYDIA DUNN; THE SENIOR MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, MR ALLEN LEE, AND THE SENIOR BRITISH TRADE COMMISSIONER, MR R.E. HOLLOWAY.

DURING HIS STAY, LORD GLENARTHUR WILL VISIT VIETNAMESE REFUGEE CENTRES, THE HONG KONG CONVENTION AND EXHIBITION CENTRE, JUNK BAY NEW TOWN AND THE HONG KONG UNIVERSITY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY. HE WILL ALSO MEET MEMBERS OF THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE COUNCILS, URBAN AND REGIONAL COUNCILLORS, LOCAL BUSINESSMEN AND SENIOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS.

ACCOMPANYING LORD GLENARTHUR ARE MR ROBIN MCLAREN, THE BRITISH SENIOR REPRESENTATIVE TO THE SINO-BRITISH JOINT LIAISON GROUP, AND MR ALAN PAUL, THE HEAD OF THE HONG KONG DEPARTMENT (DESIGNATE).

THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR HONG KONG AND KOWLOON, MR DAVID LAN, WILL OFFICIATE AT THE CEREMONY, WHICH WILL BE FOLLOWED BY A VARIETY SHOW TO BE BROADCAST LIVE ON COMMERCIAL RADIO FROM 8 PM TO 10 PM.

THE SHOW WILL FEATURE SINGING BY FAMOUS ARTISTES AND THE SHAM SHUI PO ARTS ASSOCIATION YOUTH AND CHILDREN CHOIRS.

DISC JOCKEYS WILL ALSO STAGE A DRAMA ON THE WORK AND ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE SHAM SHUI PO DISTRICT BOARD. IT IS HOPED THAT RESIDENTS, WHILE ENJOYING THE PROGRAMMES, WILL AT THE SAME TIME BE ABLE TO HAVE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE BOARD'S WORK.

AT THE SAME VENUE, THE SHAM SHUI PO DISTRICT COMMITTEE ON THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION IS ORGANISING AN EXHIBITION AND COMPETITION ON CIVIC EDUCATION FROM 2 PM TO 8 PM THAT DAY.

FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF SPECTATORS, FREE SHUTTLE BUS SERVICES WILL BE OPERATED FROM SHEK KIP MEI AND KOWLOON TONG MTR STATIONS, AS WELL AS THE CENTURY CINEMA IN MEI FOO SUN CHUEN TO THE AC HALL FROM 1.30 PM TO 7.30 PM.

THE EXHIBITION IS ONE OF THE THREE FUNCTIONS ORGANISED BY THE SSP DISTRICT COMMITTEE ON THE PROMOTION OF CIVIC EDUCATION TO SUPPORT THE DISTRICT FESTIVAL.

THE FESTIVAL IS ORGANISED BY THE 1988-89 SHAM SHUI PO DISTRICT FESTIVAL CO-ORDINATING COMMITTEE AND THE DISTRICT OFFICE WITH SPONSORSHIP FROM THE DISTRICT BOARD AND THE URBAN COUNCIL. IT AIMS TO PROMOTE LOCAL RESIDENTS' SENSE OF BELONGING TO THE COMMUNITY.

THE CARNIVAL FEATURED TRADITIONAL PERFORMANCES BY AN ART TROUPE FROM XIANGXI, CHINA, ACROBATIC PERFORMANCES BY LOCAL GROUPS AND AN EXHIBITION ON CHINESE HANDICRAFT.

OFFICIATING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY WERE THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR MICHAEL SUEN; KWAI TSING DISTRICT OFFICER, MR PAUL TANG; KWAI TSING DISTRICT BOARD CHAIRMAN, MR LEE WING-TAT; AND CHAIRMAN OF THE FESTIVAL, MR LO YAN-SHING.

FORTY-TWO STAFF MEMBERS OF THE CORRECTIONAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND INMATES OF THE DEPARTMENT'S INSTITUTIONS WILL TAKE PART IN THE COMMUNITY CHEST'S WALK FOR MILLIONS ON HONG KONG ISLAND TOMORROW (SUNDAY).

APPEAL TO RESIDENTS TO HELP FIGHT CRIME

RESIDENTS OF TAI PO SHOULD CONTINUE TO HELP THE POLICE IN FIGHTING CRIME IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN THE DISTRICT'S GOOD LAW AND ORDER RECORD, MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE AND LEGISLATIVE COUNCILS, MRS ROSANNA TAM, SAID THIS (SATURDAY) MORNING.

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE TAI PO DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME CARNIVAL AND THE TAI PO POLICE STATION OPEN DAY, MRS TAM NOTED THAT THE DISTRICT HAD THE LOWEST CRIME RATE IN THE TERRITORY.

HOWEVER, SHE ADDED THAT WITH THE DISTRICT'S RAPID DEVELOPMENT AND GROWTH IN POPULATION, THERE HAD BEEN A SLIGHTLY UPWARD TREND IN THE CRIME RATE. THEREFORE, RESIDENTS' SUSTAINED CO-OPERATION WAS VITAL IN THE FIGHT AGAINST CRIME, SHE SAID.

MRS TAM ALSO NOTED THAT TODAY'S CARNIVAL AND OPEN DAY WERE EDUCATIONAL IN THAT THEY COULD ENABLE RESIDENTS TO GET A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE POLICE FORCE AND THEIR WORK.

SHE BELIEVED THE EVENT COULD HELP PROMOTE THE FIGHT CRIME MESSAGE AND ENHANCE THE RELATIONS BETWEEN THE POLICE AND THE GENERAL PUBLIC.

TODAY'S EVENT WAS ORGANISED BY THE TAI PO DISTRICT FIGHT CRIME CAMPAIGN WORKING GROUP.

THE CARNIVAL FEATURED SHORT PLAYS, GAME STALLS, DANCING AND BRASS BAND PERFORMANCES, AND AN EXHIBITION OF THE ENTRIES IN A POSTER DESIGN AND A COLOURING CONTEST PUBLICISING THE ANTI-SHOPTHEFT MESSAGE.

PIONEER PROJECT IN NORTH DISTRICT COMES TO FRUITION

A PIONEER MOVE BY THE WORKS SECTION OF THE NORTH DISTRICT OFFICE CAME TO FRUITION RECENTLY WITH THE COMPLETION OF A RECONSTRUCTED VAN TRACK IN TSUNG PAK LONG VILLAGE, SHEUNG SHUI.

"THE \$0.8 MILLION PROJECT WAS DONE ON A CONTRACT AWARDED LAST MARCH TO A COMPANY ON THE LANDS AND WORKS BRANCH'S LIST OF APPROVED CONTRACTORS," A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NORTH DISTRICT OFFICE SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

"IT IS THE FIRST CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION WORKS CONTRACT OF THIS VALUE AT THE DISTRICT LEVEL AWARDED BY A DISTRICT OFFICE WORKS SECTION," HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN EXPLAINED THAT IN THE PAST ONLY CONTRACTORS ON THE CNTA'S DISTRICT CONTRACTORS LIST WERE EMPLOYED ON CONTRACTS WORTH UP TO \$0.5 MILLION.

WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF A NEW SET OF PROCEDURES IN APRIL 1987, DISTRICT OFFICE WORKS SECTIONS WERE EMPOWERED TO AWARD CONTRACTS VALUED AT BETWEEN \$0.5 MILLION AND \$1.5 MILLION TO CONTRACTORS ON THE LANDS AND WORKS BRANCH'S LIST, HE SAID.

THE \$0.8 MILLION PROJECT AT TSUNG PAK LONG, WHICH WAS DESIGNED AND SUPERVISED BY THE WORKS SECTION OF THE NORTH DISTRICT OFFICE, IS PART OF THE URBAN FRINGE IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMME IN THE DISTRICT.

THE PROJECT INVOLVED THE RECONSTRUCTION OF A VAN TRACK TO PROVIDE A 3.5-METRE-WIDE CARRIAGEWAY WITH PASSING PLACES AND TURNING AREAS, AND ASSOCIATED DRAINAGE.

ON COMPLETION, THE TRACK PROVIDES IMPROVED ACCESS FROM CASTLE PEAK ROAD VIA AN EXISTING SERVICE ROAD TO TSUNG PAK LONG.

LAST WEEK, IT WAS OFFICIALLY HANDED OVER TO THE HIGHWAYS DEPARTMENT FOR MAINTENANCE.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT TODAY (SATURDAY) ANNOUNCED THAT WATER SUPPLY TO THE FOLLOWING DISTRICTS WILL BE INTERRUPTED TO FACILITATE WATER WORKS:
