REMEMBRANCE CEREMONIES TO BE HELD  
\* \* \* \*

HONG KONG WILL OBSERVE THIS YEAR'S LIBERATION DAY WITH A WREATH-LAYING CEREMONY AT THE CITY HALL ON MONDAY (AUGUST 29).

DURING THE CEREMONY, WHICH WILL BEGIN AT 10.45 AM IN THE GARDEN OF REMEMBRANCE, REPRESENTATIVES OF THE HONG KONG BRITISH FORCES, HONG KONG PRISONERS OF WAR ASSOCIATION, ROYAL HONG KONG REGIMENT (THE VOLUNTEERS), THE MIDDLESEX REGIMENT AND HONG KONG WAR MEMORIAL FUND COMMITTEE WILL LAY WREATHS AT THE SHRINE IN MEMORY OF MEMBERS OF THE HONG KONG VOLUNTEER DEFENCE CORPS WHO DIED IN THE BATTLE OF HONG KONG IN DECEMBER 1941 OR LATER AS PRISONERS OF WAR.

THE COMMANDER BRITISH FORCES, MAJOR-GENERAL DEREK BOORMAN, WILL LAY A WREATH ON BEHALF OF THE HONG KONG BRITISH FORCES.

THE WREATH OF THE PRISONERS OF WAR ASSOCIATION WILL BE LAID BY ITS CHAIRMAN, MR J.V.G. MITCHELL.

REGIMENTAL WREATHS OF THE VOLUNTEERS WILL BE LAID BY ITS HONORARY COLONEL, DR S.M. BARD, AND ITS COMMANDING OFFICER, LIEUTENANT-COLONEL T.C. VILLIERS, AND THAT OF THE MIDDLESEX REGIMENT BY WARRANT OFFICER SECOND CLASS T.W. SAUNDERS.

THE MIDDLESEX REGIMENT AND THE VOLUNTEERS FOUGHT SIDE BY SIDE IN THE BATTLE OF HONG KONG.

THE WREATH OF THE HONG KONG WAR MEMORIAL FUND COMMITTEE WILL BE LAID BY MR F.M. CASTRO, ON BEHALF OF ITS CHAIRMAN, SIR ALBERT RODRIGUES.

THE WREATH-LAYING CEREMONY WILL BE FOLLOWED BY THE SOUNDING OF THE LAST POST, A TWO-MINUTE SILENCE AND REVEILLE, AND THE FIRING OF THREE VOLLEYS OF SALUTE.

THE FIRING PARTY, BUGLER AND SENTRIES, WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE VOLUNTEERS.

REMEMBRANCE CEREMONIES FOR MEMBERS OF THE HONG KONG POLICE RESERVE WILL BE HELD AT LITTLE SAI WAN AND STANLEY CEMETERIES.

PARADES WILL BE STAGED AT BOTH CEMETERIES BY MEMBERS OF THE ROYAL HONG KONG AUXILIARY POLICE, AND WREATHS WILL BE LAID ON BEHALF OF THE COMMANDANT AND OFFICERS OF THE FORCE.

CONTINGENTS WILL ARRIVE AT LITTLE SAI WAN CEMETERY AT 10.30 AM AND AT STANLEY CEMETERY AT 11.30 AM.

CHIEF SUPERINTENDENT/HONG KONG ISLAND (AUX), MR A.M. DA COSTA, WILL GIVE A BRIEF ADDRESS.

SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMME CLOSING

THE TWO-MONTH SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMME BEING HELD IN WONG TAI SIN, NORTH DISTRICT, KWUN TONG AND TAI PO WILL END TOMORROW (SUNDAY).

AT 4.30 PM TOMORROW, THE WONG TAI SIN SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAMME CLOSING CEREMONY WILL BE HELD AT THE S.K.H. CHING SHAN PRIMARY SCHOOL IN CHOI HUNG ESTATE.

PRIOR TO THE CEREMONY, A MODEL CAR RACE AND A PAINTING EXHIBITION WILL BE HELD.

FOR THE PAST TWO MONTHS, MORE THAN 800 ITEMS OF ACTIVITIES HAVE BEEN HELD IN THE DISTRICT, ATTRACTING SOME 140 000 PARTICIPANTS.

IN THE NORTH DISTRICT, A CLOSING CEREMONY IN THE FORM OF A VARIETY SHOW WILL BE HELD AT 7 PM AT THE SHEK WU HUI PLAYGROUND IN SHEUNG SHUI.

FOR THE PAST TWO MONTHS, MORE THAN 200 ACTIVITIES HAVE BEEN HELD, WITH WATER SPORTS BEING THE MOST POPULAR AMONG THE YOUNGSTERS IN THE DISTRICT.

AT 7.30 PM, A PERFORMANCE BY THE KWUN TONG CHILDREN CHORUS AND A LUCKY DRAW AT THE OCEAN PALACE RESTAURANT IN TSIM SHA TSUI WILL MARK THE CLOSING OF THE SUMMER YOUTH ACTIVITIES IN KWUN TONG.

IN TAI PO, THE SUMMER YOUTH ACTIVITIES HAVE BEEN HELD BETWEEN JULY 10 AND AUGUST 28, ATTRACTING ABOUT 30 000 PARTICIPANTS. A CLOSING CEREMONY WILL BE HELD AT 8 PM AT THE TAI PO PLAYGROUND.

ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 30), BOTH THE CENTRAL AND WESTERN AND SHA TIN WILL HOLD THEIR CLOSING CEREMONY.

FOR CENTRAL AND WESTERN, A VARIETY SHOW AND A LUCKY DRAW WILL BE HELD AT 10.30 AM AT THE CITY HALL CONCERT HALL.

IN SHA TIN, A VARIETY SHOW WITH SINGING AND DANCING PERFORMANCES WILL BE HELD AT 7.30 PM AT THE KIANGSU-CHEKIANG COLLEGE IN WO CHE ESTATE.

ANTI-FLY OPERATION LAUNCHED IN SHA TIN

TEAMS FROM THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT HAVE APPLIED LARVICIDE TO MORE THAN 150 POTENTIAL FLY-BREEDING SPOTS THROUGHOUT SHA TIN OVER THE LAST THREE WEEKS IN AN ANTI-FLY OPERATION.

THE FOUR WEEK-LONG OPERATION WILL END NEXT WEEK. BUT ALREADY, IT HAS IMPROVED THE ENVIRONMENT OF THE NEW TOWN AND THE SURROUNDING VILLAGES, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID.

+THIS FIRST ANTI-FLY OPERATION IN SHA TIN IS ALSO AIMED AT PROTECTING THE PUBLIC AGAINST DISEASES, PARTICULARLY THOSE TRANSMITTED THROUGH FLIES DURING THE HOT, HUMID SUMMER,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

SPECIAL ANTI-FLY TREATMENT IS ALSO BEING GIVEN TO REFUSE COLLECTION POINTS, BIN SITES, OPEN SPACE, RURAL VILLAGES, TEMPORARY HOUSING AREAS, HOUSING ESTATES, AND MARKETS.

NEXT WEEK, PEST CONTROL STAFF WOULD EXTEND THIS TREATMENT TO SUI WO COURT, WORLD WIDE GARDEN, SUN TSUI ESTATE, MA ON SHAN VILLAGE, HUNG MUI KOK, HEUNG FAN LIU VILLAGE AND PAK TIN, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

DURING THE EXERCISE THESE OFFICERS WILL ALSO VISIT RESIDENTS TO OFFER TECHNICAL ADVICE ON EFFECTIVE MEASURES TO DEAL WITH THE NUISANCE PRESENTED BY FLIES.

AS FLIES ONLY BREED IN UNHYGIENIC ENVIRONMENTS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE MOST EFFECTIVE MEASURE AGAINST THEM IS TO KEEP ALL PLACES CLEAN.

HE URGED THE PUBLIC TO MAKE FULL USE OF LITTER CONTAINERS AND TO DISPOSE OF DOMESTIC REFUSE PROPERLY.

MEANWHILE, HEALTH STAFF OF ALL THE NINE DISTRICTS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES ARE READY TO ASSIST THE PUBLIC IN DEALING WITH THE FLY NUISANCE, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE PLANNED

THE ENGINEERING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROPOSES TO CONSTRUCT A PEDESTRIAN BRIDGE ACROSS CLEARWATER BAY ROAD NEAR PING SHEK ESTATE.

THE COVERED FOOTBRIDGE WILL LINK THE PROPOSED NGAU CHI WAN MARKET WITH PING SHEK ESTATE AND THE SOUTHERN FOOTPATH OF CLEARWATER BAY ROAD NEAR THE ENTRANCE TO THE CHOI HUNG M.T.R. STATION.

IT WILL PROVIDE AN UNRESTRICTED, SAFE PEDESTRIAN FACILITY ACROSS CLEARWATER BAY ROAD.

A NOTICE CONCERNING THE PROPOSED WORKS IS PUBLISHED IN THE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE.

A PLAN SHOWING THE PROPOSED WORKS CAN BE SEEN AT THE CENTRAL AND WESTERN DISTRICT OFFICE, CENTRAL ENQUIRY SUB-OFFICE, CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES, WEST WING MAIN ENTRANCE LOBBY; THE DISTRICT LANDS OFFICE, KOWLOON EAST, KOWLOON CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES, 9TH FLOOR, 405 NATHAN ROAD AND THE WONG TAI SIN DISTRICT OFFICE, SAN PO KONG GOVERNMENT OFFICES BUILDING, 4TH AND 5TH FLOORS, KING FUK STREET, SAN PO KONG, KOWLOON.

ANY PERSON OBJECTING TO THE PROPOSAL MUST SEND HIS OBJECTION IN WRITING TO THE SECRETARY FOR LANDS AND WORKS, MURRAY BUILDING, 20TH FLOOR, GARDEN ROAD, HONG KONG, NOT LATER THAN OCTOBER 25.

RESTRICTED ZONES IN KOWLOON TONG

\* \* \* \*

FROM 10 AM ON MONDAY (AUGUST 29), THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF ROADS WILL BE DESIGNATED AS RESTRICTED ZONES FROM 7 AM TO 10 AM AND FROM 4 PM TO 7 PM DAILY:-

- (1) HEREFORD ROAD BETWEEN OXFORD ROAD AND LA SALLE ROAD;  
AND
- (2) LA SALLE ROAD FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH HEREFORD ROAD  
TO ABOUT 35 METRES SOUTH OF THE JUNCTION.

WITHIN THE RESTRICTED ZONES, ALL MOTOR VEHICLES EXCEPT FRANCHISED BUSES AND THOSE AUTHORISED IN WRITING BY THE AUTHORITY, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM PICKING UP OR SETTING DOWN PASSENGERS, OR LOADING OR UNLOADING GOODS.
