PLANS TO EXPAND WELFARE SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY

* * * *

THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR SELWYN ALLEYNE, SAID TODAY 17 OLD PEOPLE'S CARE AND ATTENTION HOMES WERE UNDER ACTIVE PLANNING WHICH, IF PROVIDED ON SCHEDULE, WOULD OVERTAKE THE PLANNING TARGET BY THE MID-1980'S.

THIS PLANNED PROVISION WOULD HAVE A GREAT IMPACT IN CLEARING THE PRESENT WAITING LIST AND RESOLVING THE PROBLEM OF OLD PEOPLE LEFT IN HOSPITALS, HE SAID.

MR ALLEYNE WAS OUTLINING SOME OF THE MAIN POINTS DISCUSSED AND AGREED DURING A RECENT REVIEW OF THE PROGRAMME PLAN ON SERVICES FOR THE ELDERLY, WHEN HE SPOKE AT THE ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE DIOCESAN WELFARE COUNCIL THIS EVENING.

THE REVIEW WAS CARRIED OUT BY A COMMITTEE COMPRISING REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE GOVERNMENT AND THE VOLUNTARY SECTOR, HE SAID.

LISTING THE MAJOR PROPOSALS OF THE REVIEW, HE SAID 10 CARE AND ATTENTION HOMES WITH ABOUT 1 400 PLACES WOULD BECOME OPERATIONAL IN 1982-83, AND A FURTHER SIX HOMES WITH ABOUT 900 PLACES IN 1983-84.

+EVEN TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE HIGH LEVELS OF IMMIGRATION IN RECENT YEARS, THIS PROVISION, IF ACHIEVED ON SCHEDULE, WILL TAKE US OVER THE PLANNING TARGET OF FOUR PLACES PER 1 000 PEOPLE AGED 60 AND OVER,+ HE SAID.

IN THE AREA OF OLD PEOPLE'S HOMES AND HOSTELS WITH MEALS SECTIONS, MR ALLEYNE SAID THE EXISTING PROVISION OF 3 000 PLACES IN 28 HOMES OF BOTH TYPES WAS EXPECTED TO DOUBLE BY 1985-86 AS ANOTHER 40 HOMES WOULD COME INTO OPERATION.

AS WITH CARE AND ATTENTION HOMES, HE ADDED, THE PEAK YEARS ARE LIKELY TO BE 1982-83 AND 1983-84, IN WHICH A TOTAL OF 1 800 PLACES ARE PLANNED.

+WHEN THESE ARE PROVIDED, WE SHALL BE ONLY 120 PLACES FROM OUR TARGET, SO I THINK IT IS SAFE TO SAY THAT, HERE TOO, WE WILL BE ABLE TO ACHIEVE OUR PRESENT TARGETS BY THE MID-1980'S,+ HE SAID.

ON MULTI-SERVICE CENTRES, THE DIRECTOR SAID THAT ALTHOUGH THE 1979 SOCIAL WELFARE WHITE PAPER INDICATED 17 WOULD BE REQUIRED, IT WAS AGREED THAT EXTRA CENTRES WOULD BE PROVIDED IN THOSE DISTRICTS WITH A GENERAL POPULATION OF 500 000 OR MORE.

AT PRESENT, HE SAID, THERE ARE SIX OF THESE DISTRICTS - KWUN TUNG, WONG TAI SIN, KOWLOON CITY, SHAM SHUI PO, TSUEN WAN AND THE EASTERN DISTRICT OF HONG KONG ISLAND.

AS REGARDS HOME HELP SERVICE, HE SAID A UNIFIED SYSTEM WAS PROPOSED TO CATER FOR ALL IN NEED - THE ELDERLY, THE DISABLED AND THOSE WITH OTHER SOCIAL PROBLEMS - ON A DISTRICT BASIS IN ORDER TO AVOID DUPLICATION.

HOWEVER, HE SAID, THE ELDERLY PEOPLE IN NEED OF THIS SERVICE WOULD BENEFIT FROM THE FASTER EXPANSION THAT WAS PROPOSED UNDER THE UNIFIED SYSTEM.

IN THE

IN THE AREA OF DAY CARE CENTRES, MR ALLEYNE SAID AN EVALUATION WAS BEING CARRIED OUT OF THE TWO EXPERIMENTAL CENTRES SET UP LAST YEAR.

HE SAID IT WAS PROPOSED THAT THE SERVICE SHOULD BE EXPANDED IF THE RESULTS OF THE EVALUATION WERE SATISFACTORY, AND ALREADY FOUR PREMISES HAD BEEN PROVISIONALLY EARMARKED FOR ADDITIONAL CENTRES.

ON SOCIAL CENTRES, HE SAID IT WAS PROPOSED TO AIM AT PROVIDING FEWER BUT LARGER AND BETTER STAFFED CENTRES, AS EXPERIENCE HAD SHOWN THE PRESENT POLICY WAS NOT VERY SATISFACTORY.

THIS MEANS INCREASING THE SIZE OF EACH CENTRE FROM 97 SQUARE METRES TO 169 SQUARE METRES WITH THE PROVISION OF ONE EXTRA SOCIAL WORKER, WHILE REDUCING THE PLANNING RATIO TO ONE FOR EVERY 30 000 POPULATION, HE SAID.

MR ALLEYNE ALSO MENTIONED THE INTRODUCTION BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF A SEPARATE QUOTA FOR ELDERLY APPLICANTS ON THE WAITING LIST FOR PUBLIC HOUSING.

THIS HAS BEEN SET AT AN INITIAL ANNUAL LEVEL OF 300 UNITS PROVIDING ACCOMMODATION FOR ABOUT 900 OLD PEOPLE, AND THE HOUSING AUTHORITY HAS AGREED TO KEEP THE SIZE OF THE QUOTA UNDER REVIEW IN THE LIGHT OF THE SIZE OF THE WAITING LIST, HE SAID.

THE HOUSING AUTHORITY HAS ALSO APPROVED IN PRINCIPLE AN EXTENDED PROGRAMME FOR PROVIDING HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION IN PUBLIC HOUSING, AND IN FUTURE A HOSTEL WITH ABOUT 150 PLACES WILL BE PROVIDED IN EACH ESTATE THAT HAS 3 000 OR MORE HOUSING UNITS, HE ADDED.

HE SAID IT WAS PROBABLE THAT ABOUT AN EXTRA 5 000 HOSTEL PLACES WOULD BE PROVIDED BETWEEN NOW AND 1989, IN ADDITION TO THE 1 625 THAT WOULD BE IN EXISTENCE BY MARCH 1981.

THE DIRECTOR POINTED OUT THAT THE REVIEW OF THE PROGRAMME PLAN HAD BEEN A MOST VALUABLE EXERCISE, AND HAD PROVIDED AN OPPORTUNITY FOR STAFF FROM VARIOUS GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND THE VOLUNTARY SECTOR TO WORK TOGETHER TO REVIEW THE ADEQUACY OF THE SERVICES BEING PROVIDED, AND OF THOSE UNDER PLANNING, AND TO RETHINK THE PHILOSOPHY BEHIND THESE SERVICES.

THE OVERALL CONCLUSION, HE SAID, HAS BEEN THAT THE POLICIES LAID DOWN IN THE WHITE PAPER ARE ON THE RIGHT LINES WITH ONLY MINOR ADJUSTMENTS, AND THERE HAVE BEEN NO DISAGREEMENTS OF ANY SIGNIFICANCE WHICH BEAR WITNESS TO THE HEALTH AND STRENGTH OF THE RELATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT AND THE VOLUNTARY SECTOR.

HE SAID IT WAS INTENDED THAT THE NEXT REVIEW OF THE PROGRAMME PLAN SHOULD TAKE PLACE IN 1982 WHEN HOPEFULLY MORE INFORMATION WOULD BE AVAILABLE FROM THE 1981 CENSUS AND FROM A RESEARCH PROJECT BEING CARRIED OUT BY THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG.

THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE 1980 REVIEW WILL BE MONITORED BY A NEW STANDING COMMITTEE, WHICH WILL BE REPRESENTED BY GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF A REPRESENTATIVE OF THE SOCIAL SERVICES BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT, HE SAID.

PILOT CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRES PUT TO THE FIRE

* * * * *

CENSUS QUESTIONNAIRES CONTAINING PERSONAL DATA ON MEMBERS OF SOME 21 000 HOUSEHOLDS WERE BURNT TO ASHES THIS MORNING AT THE KENNEDY TOWN INCINERATOR UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT STAFF.

THESE QUESTIONNAIRES WERE OBTAINED FROM THE PILOT MARINE CENSUS AND THE PILOT LAND CENSUS CONDUCTED IN FEBRUARY AND MARCH THIS YEAR. THE PILOT CENSUSES WERE CONDUCTED TO PAVE THE WAY FOR THE MAIN POPULATION CENSUS TO BE TAKEN IN FEBRUARY - MARCH NEXT YEAR.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT EXPLAINED THAT UNDER THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS ORDINANCE, INDIVIDUAL INFORMATION SUPPLIED TO THE DEPARTMENT WOULD BE TREATED AS HIGHLY CONFIDENTIAL AND ALL QUESTIONNAIRES CONTAINING PERSONAL PARTICULARS HAD TO BE DESTROYED WITHIN ONE YEAR AFTER THE CENSUS.

HE STRESSED AGAIN THAT WHILE CONDUCTING A CENSUS, STEPS WOULD BE TAKEN TO ENSURE THAT THE STRICTEST SECRECY WAS MAINTAINED THROUGHOUT.

+PERSONAL DATA WILL NEVER BE DISCLOSED TO ANY OTHER GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENT OR PRIVATE ORGANISATION AND ALL CENSUS OFFICERS ARE UNDER AN OATH OF SECRECY NOT TO DISCLOSE SUCH INFORMATION,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+THE BURNING OF THESE QUESTIONNAIRES IS TO REASSURE THE PUBLIC AND TO DISPEL ANY ANXIETY THEY MAY HAVE OVER THEIR USE,+ HE SAID.

AS WITH THOSE IN THE PILOT CENSUSES, THE QUESTIONNAIRES TO BE COMPLETED IN THE COMING MAIN CENSUS WILL BE DESTROYED WITHIN 12 MONTHS AFTERWARDS.

THE DATA COLLECTED WILL BE PROCESSED BY COMPUTER AND NO PERSONAL IDENTIFICATION SUCH AS NAME AND ADDRESS IS KEPT. RESULTS OF THE CENSUS WILL BE PUBLISHED ONLY IN AGGREGATED FORM, AND NO PERSONAL PARTICULARS ARE DISPLAYED.

IN VIEW OF THE IMPORTANCE OF THIS 1981 CENSUS, THE SPOKESMAN CALLED ON THE PUBLIC TO GIVE FULL AND ACCURATE ANSWERS TO THE CENSUS OFFICERS AND ASSURED THEM THAT ALL INFORMATION THEY GIVE WILL BE HANDLED IN STRICT CONFIDENCE.

SOCIAL WELFARE DIRECTOR IMPRESSED BY CARITAS WORK

THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR SELWYN ALLEYNE WAS IMPRESSED BY THE CARITAS' WELFARE WORK FOR THE YOUNG, THE DISABLED AND DRUG ADDICTS DURING HIS VISIT TO TWO OF ITS WELFARE INSTITUTIONS THIS AFTERNOON.

ACCOMPANIED BY THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR, MRS EVELYN DOE, MR ALLEYNE WENT ON AN INSPECTION TOUR OF THE CARITAS LOK HEEP CLUB IN WAN CHAI AND THE CARITAS MULTI-SERVICE CENTRE AT CAINE ROAD.

HE WAS BRIEFED ON THE DAILY OPERATIONS OF THE INSTITUTIONS BY THE PRESIDENT OF CARITAS, THE REV FR FRANCIS LERDA, AND THE LOK HEEP CLUB CHAIRMAN, MR FRANCIS YANG.

THE CLUB HELPS TO REHABILITATE DRUG ADDICTS AND EX-ADDICTS THROUGH CASEWORK COUNSELLING, GROUP SERVICE AND VOLUNTEER WORK.

IT ALSO SERVES AS A YOUTH CENTRE WHERE MEMBERS CAN DROP IN TO JOIN SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES.

AT THE CARITAS MULTI-SERVICE CENTRE, MR ALLEYNE SHOWED KEEN INTEREST IN AN INTEGRATED APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAMME UNDER WHICH ABLE-BODIED AND DISABLED PERSONS WERE TRAINED TOGETHER IN PRINTING, CARPENTRY AND MAINTENANCE OF HOME APPLIANCES.

THE CENTRE PROVIDES A VARIETY OF SERVICES INCLUDING CHILD CARE, SERVICES FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH, OUTREACHING YOUTH WORK AND FAMILY SERVICES.

402 TRADE UNIONS UNDER REGISTRATION IN 1979-80

ALTOGETHER 402 TRADE UNIONS WERE REGISTERED WITH THE REGISTRAR OF TRADE UNIONS BETWEEN APRIL 1, 1979 AND MARCH 31, 1980.

THE TOTAL COMPRISED 345 EMPLOYEES' UNIONS, 41 ASSOCIATIONS OF EMPLOYERS, 15 MIXED ORGANISATIONS OF EMPLOYEES AND EMPLOYERS AND ONE TRADE UNION FEDERATION.

IN ADDITION, THERE WAS A TOTAL OF 368 SUBSIDIARY UNDERTAKINGS OF TRADE UNIONS AS COMPARED WITH 361 IN THE PREVIOUS YEAR. THESE COMPRISED 77 BRANCHES, FIVE SCHOOLS, 41 CLINICS AND 245 BUSINESS UNDERTAKINGS.

DURING THE YEAR, 17 NEW UNIONS WERE REGISTERED AND SIX UNIONS WERE DE-REGISTERED - ONE AT ITS OWN REQUEST, ONE BY DISSOLUTION AND FOUR FOR HAVING BEEN AMALGAMATED.

OF THE 17 NEW UNIONS REGISTERED, 15 WERE FORMED BY CIVIL SERVANTS.

LADY MACLEHOSE WILL OFFICIALLY OPEN THE NEW EXTENSION OF THE SHENG KUNG HUI LADY MACLEHOSE CENTRE IN KWAI CHUNG ON WEDNESDAY (DECEMBER 10).

IT IS THE ONLY COMMUNITY CENTRE IN THE DISTRICT PROVIDING A MULTITUDE OF SERVICES -- RANGING FROM GROUP WORK TO INDUSTRIAL SOCIAL WORK, AND CATERING TO NEW-BORN BABIES AS WELL AS THE ELDERLY.

THE NEW EXTENSION WILL HAVE FACILITIES FOR A SOCIAL CENTRE FOR THE ELDERLY AND A DAY CRECHE AND NURSERY FOR CHILDREN FROM THREE MONTHS TO FIVE YEARS OLD.

THE OPENING CEREMONY WILL TAKE PLACE AT 6 PM AT THE CENTRE AT 22 WO YI HOP ROAD, NORTH KWAI CHUNG.

MEDIA REPRESENTATIVES ARE WELCOME TO COVER THE CEREMONY. LADY MACLEHOSE IS EXPECTED TO ARRIVE AT 5.40 PM.

LUNAR NEW YEAR FAIRS WILL BE HELD IN SIX DISTRICTS OF THE NEW TERRITORIES, AND SOME 780 STALLS WILL BE PUT UP FOR PUBLIC AUCTION SOON.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY THE FAIRS WOULD BE HELD BETWEEN JANUARY 29 AND FEBRUARY 5 TO COINCIDE WITH THE LUNAR YEAR END CELEBRATIONS.
