BETTER OPPORTUNITIES FOR INVESTMENT IN TAI PO

* * * * *

IMPROVEMENTS TO TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT AS WELL AS TO OTHER COMMUNITY FACILITIES IN AND AROUND TAI PO HAVE MADE THE DISTRICT A BETTER PLACE IN WHICH TO LIVE AND ALSO CREATED OPPORTUNITIES FOR COMMERCIAL INVESTMENT, THE REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, DR JAMES HAYES, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING OF THE +EXHIBITION ON COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT IN TAI PO+ HELD AT THE NEW WORLD CENTRE, DR HAYES SAID: +WITH THE MOST MODERN AND EFFICIENT ROAD AND RAIL NETWORKS IN HONG KONG, TAI PO IS WITHIN 30 MINUTES OF URBAN KOWLOON AS WELL AS OTHER AREAS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

+THE ENVIRONMENTAL, AMENITY, EDUCATION, MEDICAL SERVICE AND CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL FACILITIES HAVE DEVELOPED SATISFACTORILY IN TAI PO WHICH IS NOW AN IDEAL HOME FOR EVERYONE.+

+CONTINUOUS COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT AND INFLOW OF OUTSIDE INVESTMENT WILL HELP THE PEOPLE TO BUILD A MORE PROSPEROUS COMMUNITY.+

THE EXHIBITION, AIMED AT PROMOTING COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENT IN TAI PO, IS SPONSORED BY THE TAI PO DISTRICT BOARD AND ORGANISED BY THE BOARD'S PROMOTION AND PUBLICITY COMMITTEE.

IT PROVIDES INFORMATION AND FIGURES ON POPULATION, AGE GROUPS, AND AVAILABILITY OF COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL PREMISES IN THE DISTRICT.

IT ALSO GIVES TAI PO RESIDENTS THE OPPORTUNITY TO LEARN MORE ABOUT THEIR OWN COMMUNITY AND HELPS INVESTORS TO ANALYSE THE SITUATION WHEN PLANNING INVESTMENT STRATEGY.

THE EXHIBITION WILL RUN AT THE NEW WORLD CENTRE UNTIL MONDAY, AFTER WHICH IT WILL MOVE TO THE TAI PO COMMUNITY CENTRE AT HEUNG SZE WUI STREET FOR THREE DAYS STARTING FROM MAY 17.

CALL TO KEEP UP COMMUNITY SPIRIT

THE DEPUTY REGIONAL SECRETARY FOR HONG KONG AND KOWLOON, MR KEVIN MAK, THIS (SATURDAY) EVENING CALLED ON MEMBERS OF THE KWUN TONG COMMUNITY TO KEEP UP THEIR CO-OPERATIVE SPIRIT AND TOGETHER BUILD AN EVEN BETTER FUTURE FOR THE DISTRICT.

MR MAK, WHO HAD BEEN KWUN TONG DISTRICT OFFICER UNTIL MID-APRIL, WAS SPEAKING AT A +KWUN TONG COMMUNITY CELEBRATION DINNER+ ORGANISED TO FAREWELL HIM AND TO WELCOME THE NEW DISTRICT OFFICER, MR EDDY CHAN.

LOOKING BACK ON HIS THREE YEARS IN KWUN TONG, MR MAK SAID HE WAS MOST IMPRESSED BY THE CO-OPERATION AND COHESIVENESS OF THE LOCAL COMMUNITY.

+WITH THE IMPLEMENTATION OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION, THIS CIVIC SPIRIT HAS BECOME EVEN STRONGER, WITHOUT WHICH MANY ACHIEVEMENTS WOULD HAVE BEEN IMPOSSIBLE,+ HE SAID.

HIS SUCCESSOR, MR CHAN, SAID: +STEPPING INTO THE SECOND HALF OF THE 1980'S, KWUN TONG IS ALREADY SET FOR A NEW METAMORPHOSIS, AS MANY MAJOR PROJECTS ARE IN THE PIPELINE.+

+THE CO-OPERATION AND SUPPORT FROM THE COMMUNITY IS AN IMPORTANT CATALYST TO THIS METAMORPHOSIS,+ HE ADDED.

CITING THE EASTERN HARBOUR CROSSING PROJECT AS MOST SIGNIFICANT, MR CHAN SAID IT WOULD NOT ONLY AFFECT THE TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT PATTERNS OF KWUN TONG AND THE WHOLE TERRITORY, BUT GIVE NEW IMPETUS TO LOCAL DEVELOPMENT.

HE SAID THE COMPANY RESPONSIBLE FOR THE TUNNEL PROJECT HAD BEEN INVITED TO PROVIDE DATA FOR THE EAST KOWLOON TRAFFIC STUDY, SO THAT A MORE ACCURATE ASSESSMENT AND RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE DISTRICT'S TRAFFIC DEVELOPMENTS UP TO 1996 COULD BE ARRIVED AT.

+THE LANDS AND WORKS BRANCH IS ALSO SEEKING COMMENTS FROM DEPARTMENTS CONCERNED TO REVIEW THE DEVELOPMENT PLANS FOR CHA KWO LING, WHICH WILL BE THE TUNNEL'S LANDING POINT IN KOWLOON,+ HE SAID.

WITH VARIOUS HOUSING PROJECTS IN HAND SUCH AS TSUI PING ROAD ESTATE, LAM TIN AND JORDAN VALLEY NORTH, PLUS OTHER DEVELOPMENTS, KWUN TONG WAS READY TO MEET AN EXCITING FUTURE, MR CHAN ADDED.

TWO MEMBERS OF THE INDUSTRY DEPARTMENT WERE DUE TO LEAVE TONIGHT (SATURDAY) ON A THREE-WEEK INDUSTRIAL INVESTMENT PROMOTION MISSION TO AUSTRALIA.

PRINCIPAL CONSULTANT, MR C.L. CHU, AND MR TOMMY LAI, A CONSULTANT FROM THE DEPARTMENT'S +ONE STOP UNIT+, WILL VISIT SYDNEY, NEWCASTLE AND BRISBANE.

THE DEPUTY DIRECTOR (TRAFFIC), ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE FORCE, MR JOHN CLEMENCE, TODAY (SATURDAY) JOINED 30 MISS HONG KONG SEMI-FINALISTS TO HELP EDUCATE SCHOOL CHILDREN ON ROAD SAFETY.

THE EXERCISE WAS HELD AS PART OF THIS YEAR'S ROAD SAFETY CAMPAIGN, AND ALSO TAKING PART WAS THE ASSISTANT DIRECTOR (PUBLICITY) OF INFORMATION SERVICES, MR GEORGE YUEN.

ABOUT 40 SCHOOL CHILDREN WERE TAKEN ON A GUIDED TOUR OF THE SAU MAU PING ROAD SAFETY TOWN AND SHOWN THE PROPER WAY TO CROSS THE ROAD.

EARLIER, BOTH THE CONTESTANTS AND THE CHILDREN WERE TOLD ABOUT THE ROAD SAFETY CODE BY THE ROAD SAFETY TOWN'S STAFF.

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT STATISTICS SHOW THAT CHILDREN AGED BELOW THE AGE OF 14 ARE A HIGH RISK GROUP IN ROAD ACCIDENTS. THE ROAD SAFETY TOWN HELPS TO EDUCATE THE YOUNG WITHIN THIS AGE GROUP ON VARIOUS ROAD SAFETY ASPECTS.

THE ROAD SAFETY TOWN IS MAINTAINED BY GOVERNMENT AND VISITS TO IT ARE ORGANISED THROUGH THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AND THE ROYAL HONG KONG POLICE FORCE.

A RENOVATION PROGRAMME IS NOW BEING PLANNED FOR THE 16-YEAR-OLD ROAD SAFETY TOWN AND THE COST WILL BE MET BY SPONSORSHIP FROM THE PRIVATE SECTOR.

ABOUT 600 PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM WAN CHAI DISTRICT ATTENDED A SEMINAR ON SECONDARY EDUCATION AT THE LINGNAN MIDDLE SCHOOL THIS (SATURDAY) MORNING.

THE SEMINAR, SPONSORED BY THE WAN CHAI DISTRICT BOARD, WAS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE WAN CHAI DISTRICT HEADMASTERS' CONFERENCE AND THE ST. JAMES' SETTLEMENT.

READY TO COMBAT OIL POLLUTION
* * * *

WITH THE ADVENT OF THIS YEAR'S SWIMMING SEASON, THE URBAN COUNCIL IS TOPPING UP ITS STOCKS OF OIL BOOM AND OIL SORBENT IN THE EVENT OF OIL SPILLS.

AT ITS LAST MEETING, THE COUNCIL'S TENDER BOARD APPROVED A TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF 20 BALES OF OIL BOOM AT A TOTAL COST OF \$26 840 AND ANOTHER TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF 118 SHEETS OF OIL SORBENT AT A TOTAL COST OF \$88 382.

A COUNCIL SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY: +THE OIL BOOM AND OIL SORBENT WILL BE HELD IN RESERVE IN CASE OF OIL POLLUTION SUCH AS HAPPENED LAST JULY, WHEN 11 OF THE 12 BEACHES ON HONG KONG ISLAND WERE POLLUTED.

+THE OIL BOOM IS USED TO STOP OIL FROM SPILLING ON TO A BIGGER PATCH OF BEACH WHILE THE OIL SORBENT IS USED FOR ABSORBING OIL SPILLS AND PROTECTING SHORELINES AGAINST EFFLUENT DISCHARGES.

+THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THAT THE COUNCIL HAS PURCHASED AN OIL BOOM. THESE ARE ALREADY WIDELY USED IN OTHER COUNTRIES FOR CONTAINING OIL SPILLS.+

IN A FURTHER OIL-RELATED DEVELOPMENT, A TENDER FOR THE SUPPLY OF 1 000 PAIRS OF JUNGLE BOOTS AT A TOTAL COST OF \$60 000 WAS ALSO APPROVED BY THE TENDER BOARD.

THESE HEAVY DUTY BOOTS WOULD BE WORN BY LIFEGUARDS IN OIL CLEARANCE OPERATIONS TO PROTECT THEIR FEET FROM CONSTANT IMMERSION IN OIL.
