ANALYSIS OF LAST MONTH'S RAINFALL DATA

\* \* \* \* \*

THE ROYAL OBSERVATORY HAS CARRIED OUT A MORE COMPLETE ANALYSIS OF THE RAINFALL DATA RELATING TO TROPICAL STORM ELLEN WHICH BYPASSED HONG KONG IN THE SECOND HALF OF AUGUST.

AS A RESULT, THREE GRAPHS SHOWING THE AREA AND TIME DISTRIBUTION OF RAINFALL AND THE RAINFALL BROUGHT BY THIS AND TWO OTHER MAJOR STORMS IN THE PAST TEN YEARS HAVE BEEN PREPARED.

AT THE SAME TIME, A DETAILED TECHNICAL STUDY OF THE SYNOPTIC AND DYNAMICAL ASPECTS OF THE STORM IS ALSO UNDER PREPARATION.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE ROYAL OBSERVATORY SAID THAT THE DISASTROUS LANDSLIP AT SAU MAU PING AND THE WIDESPREAD FLOODING THAT OCCURRED IN THE WAKE OF TROPICAL STORM ELLEN LAST MONTH GAVE RISE TO PUBLIC CONCERN ABOUT THE EFFECT OF HEAVY RAIN ON SOIL SLOPES.

DURING THE PAST TWO WEEKS, HE SAID, THE ROYAL OBSERVATORY RECEIVED A NUMBER OF ENQUIRIES FROM PEOPLE CONCERNED ABOUT THE DISTRIBUTION OF THE RAINFALL BROUGHT BY TROPICAL STORM ELLEN.

ACCORDING TO THE ANALYSIS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID, MORE RAIN WAS RECORDED ON HIGH GROUND AND THE WETTEST AREA WAS LOCATED NEAR MA ON SHAN WITH A TOTAL RAINFALL OF ABOUT 700 MM.

+FROM THIS AREA, A BELT OF HEAVY RAINFALL STRETCHED SOUTHWARDS ACROSS SAU MAU PING AND THE KOWLOON BAY TO THE TYTAM RESERVOIR ON HONG KONG ISLAND,+ HE SAID. +THIS BELT COVERED MOST OF THE URBAN AREAS IN KOWLOON AND THE EASTERN PART OF HONG KONG ISLAND WHERE THE TOTAL RAINFALL RECORDED WAS IN EXCESS OF 550 MM.+

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT MUCH LESS RAIN FELL OVER THE NORTHWESTERN PART OF THE NEW TERRITORIES AND TO THE EAST OF HONG KONG ISLAND.

+THE THREE-DAY RAINFALL (AUGUST 24-26) WAS ONLY 251 MM AT TATHONG POINT LIGHTHOUSE AND 266.1 MM AT NIM WAN TO THE NORTHWEST OF CASTLE PEAK. THESE REPRESENT LESS THAN 40 PER CENT OF THE MAXIMUM RAINFALL RECORDED NEAR MA ON SHAN,+ HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN COMPARED THE MAXIMUM AMOUNTS OF RAINFALL FOR VARIOUS DURATIONS WITH THOSE RAINSTORMS IN 1966 AND 1972.

FOR DURATIONS OF 12 HOURS AND OVER, HE SAID, THE MAXIMUM RAINFALL AMOUNTS RECORDED DURING TROPICAL STORM ELLEN WERE GREATER THAN THOSE IN 1966 AND 1972.

HOWEVER, WHEN SHORTER DURATIONS WERE CONSIDERED, THE 1966 AND 1972 RAINSTORMS WERE CONSIDERABLY WETTER.

THE HIGHEST ONE-HOUR RAINFALL EVER RECORDED, HE POINTED OUT, OCCURRED IN 1966 WITH THE AMOUNT DOUBLE THAT OF 1976.

FOLLOWING IS A TABLE SHOWING THE MAXIMUM RAINFALL AMOUNTS RECORDED AT THE ROYAL OBSERVATORY FOR VARIOUS DURATIONS WITH THE CORRESPONDING FIGURES RECORDED DURING THE HEAVY RAINSTORMS IN 1966 AND 1972. THE HIGHEST FIGURES EVER RECORDED SINCE RECORD BEGAN IN 1884 ARE ALSO INCLUDED.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT ALTHOUGH TROPICAL STORM ELLEN BROUGHT PROLONGED PERIODS OF HEAVY RAIN, IT WAS NOT THE WETTEST RAINSTORM ON RECORD.

TURNING TO TIME DISTRIBUTION OF RAINFALL, HE SAID THAT THERE WERE TWO PERIODS OF PARTICULARLY HEAVY RAIN -- ONE BETWEEN 11 P.M. ON AUGUST 24 AND 3 A.M. ON AUGUST 25 AND THE OTHER BETWEEN 7 A.M. AND 10 A.M. ON AUGUST 25.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT ONE INTERESTING FEATURE WAS THAT THE RAIN STOPPED ABRUPTLY AT ALL FOUR STATIONS - ROYAL OBSERVATORY, KING'S PARK, KAI TAK AIRPORT AND TATE'S CAIRN - AND THE LANDSLIP AT SAU MAU PING OCCURRED SHORTLY BEFORE THE VERY HEAVY RAIN CAME TO STOP. THIS FEATURE WAS ALSO OBSERVED IN THE 1966 AND 1972 RAINSTORMS.

ON DURATIONS OF RAINFALL, THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT THE 1972 RAINSTORM LASTED LONGER THAN THE ONES IN 1966 AND 1976.

HOWEVER, ALL THE THREE STORMS PRODUCED VERY SIMILAR AMOUNTS OF RAINFALL IN THE FIRST 48 HOURS - FROM 420 MM IN 1972 TO 510 MM IN 1976.

OVERSEAS EXPERT ARRIVES TO INVESTIGATE SAU MAU PING LANDSLIDE  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS, MR. WILLIAM BELL, SAID TODAY THAT THE SECOND OF THE FOUR OVERSEAS EXPERTS TO JOIN THE SAU MAU PING LANDSLIDE INVESTIGATION HAD NOW ARRIVED IN HONG KONG, AND THE REMAINING TWO WERE EXPECTED HERE BY THE END OF THE WEEK.

THE LATEST ARRIVAL IS PROFESSOR NORBERT MORGENSTERN OF THE DEPARTMENT OF CIVIL ENGINEERING AT THE UNIVERSITY OF ALBERTA.

MR. BELL SAID PROFESSOR MORGENSTERN HAD COME TO HONG KONG DIRECT FROM A LECTURE TOUR IN ALASKA, WHERE HE WAS ALSO ENGAGED AS A CONSULTANT ON THE HUGE PIPELINE PROJECT TO LINK ALASKA AND THE UNITED STATES.

PROFESSOR MORGENSTERN HAD UNDERTAKEN EXTENSIVE STUDY OF SOIL MECHANICS AT IMPERIAL COLLEGE, LONDON AND WAS A WORLD RECOGNISED EXPERT ON ENGINEERING AND SOIL PROBLEMS.

WORKING WITH A PROFESSOR FROM LONDON, HE HAD DEVELOPED A THEORY AND COMPUTER PROGRAMME FOR ESTIMATING THE STABILITY OF SLOPES UNDER VARIOUS CONDITIONS.

LAST YEAR HE HAD PRESENTED A PAPER ENTITLED +STABILITY OF SLOPES IN RESIDUAL SOILS+ TO THE 5TH PAN AMERICAN CONFERENCE ON SOIL MECHANICS AND FOUNDATION ENGINEERING AT BUENOS AIRES.

PROFESSOR MORGENSTERN WAS MET AT KAI TAK BY SENIOR REPRESENTATIVES OF BINNIES AND PARTNERS, THE P.W.D. CONSULTANTS INVESTIGATING THE SAU MAU PING LANDSLIDE.

MR. BELL SAID THE TWO OTHER OVERSEAS EXPERTS EXPECTED TO ARRIVE IN HONG KONG THIS WEEK TO JOIN THE INVESTIGATION WERE MR. BRIAN RICHARDS, PRINCIPAL RESEARCH SCIENTIST WITH AUSTRALIA'S COMMONWEALTH SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH ORGANISATION= AND PROFESSOR VICTOR DE MELLO OF THE SAN CARLOS SCHOOL OF ENGINEERING AT BRAZIL'S SAO PAULO UNIVERSITY.

ALL THE EXPERTS, WOULD, IN THE FIRST INSTANCE, BE BRIEFED AND ASKED FOR THEIR COMMENTS ON THE LINES OF BINNIES' INVESTIGATION INTO THE LANDSLIDE, AND PROPOSED REMEDIAL MEASURES.

AFTER THEIR INITIAL CONSULTATIONS AND INVESTIGATIONS, THE OVERSEAS EXPERTS WOULD PROBABLY LEAVE HONG KONG TO DEAL WITH THEIR OTHER COMMITMENTS, AND THEN RETURN TO HONG KONG TO EVALUATE AND DRAW CONCLUSIONS FROM THE EXHAUSTIVE SERIES OF TESTS BEING UNDERTAKEN ON THE SLOPES.

THE FIRST OF THE OVERSEAS EXPERTS WHO ARRIVED IN HONG KONG, PROFESSOR JOHN KNILL, PROFESSOR OF ENGINEERING GEOLOGY AT IMPERIAL COLLEGE, LONDON, WHO CAME TO HONG KONG ON SEPTEMBER 9, HAS LEFT TO ATTEND A CONFERENCE IN TEHERAN, AND IS EXPECTED TO RETURN NEXT MONTH.

APPRENTICESHIP ORDINANCE 1976

\* \* \* \* \*

THE COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, MR. IAN PRICE, TODAY REMINDED ALL EMPLOYERS TO ENTER INTO CONTRACTS OF APPRENTICESHIP WITH THEIR YOUNG WORKERS AGED BETWEEN 14 AND 18 YEARS ENGAGED IN ANY OF THE 23 TRADES DESIGNATED UNDER THE APPRENTICESHIP ORDINANCE WITHIN 60 DAYS.

THE APPRENTICESHIP ORDINANCE WHICH CAME INTO OPERATION ON JULY 19 GAVE EFFECT TO COVER THE 23 DESIGNATED TRADES YESTERDAY.

MR. PRICE SAID THAT ALL THE CONTRACTS OF APPRENTICESHIP IN DESIGNATED TRADES SHOULD BE REGISTERED WITH THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT WITHIN 14 DAYS AFTER EXECUTION.

FAILURE TO DO SO MAY RENDER AN EMPLOYER LIABLE TO PROSECUTION, HE ADDED.

+HOWEVER,+ MR. PRICE SAID, +THIS STEP WOULD NOT BE NECESSARY IF A YOUNG PERSON POSSESSES A CERTIFICATE OF COMPLETION OF APPRENTICESHIP IN THE TRADE IN WHICH HE IS EMPLOYED IF AN EMPLOYER HAS BEEN EXEMPTED FROM THE PROVISIONS OF THE ORDINANCE.+

EXEMPTION WOULD NORMALLY BE GRANTED IF THE COMMISSIONER IS SATISFIED THAT THE YOUNG PERSON HAS UNDERGONE SUFFICIENT TRAINING IN THAT TRADE.

MR. PRICE POINTED OUT THAT ALL CONTRACTS OF APPRENTICESHIP MUST BE IN THE SPECIFIED FORM OR IN A FORM SUBSTANTIALLY SIMILAR.

COPIES OF THE SPECIFIED CONTRACT FORM ARE OBTAINABLE FREE OF CHARGE FROM THE APPRENTICESHIP DIVISION OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT AT 99 QUEENSWAY, HONG KONG.

FOR THE BENEFIT OF EMPLOYERS THE 23 DESIGNATED TRADES ARE REPEATED HERewith : VEHICLE MECHANIC, VEHICLE ELECTRICIAN, VEHICLE PANEL BEATER/BODY BUILDER, VEHICLE PAINTER, CONSTRUCTION PLANT MECHANIC, CLOTHING MACHINE MECHANIC, KNITTING MACHINE MECHANIC, ELECTRICAL FITTER, ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES SERVICE MECHANIC, CABLE JOINTER (POWER), OVERHEAD LINESMAN, LIFT ELECTRICIAN, LIFT MECHANIC, REFRIGERATION/AIR CONDITIONING MECHANIC, RADIO/TV MECHANIC, MOULD AND DIE MAKER AND REPAIRER, PRINTING MACHINE OPERATOR (LETTER PRESS), PRINTING COMPOSITOR, PROCESS CAMERA OPERATOR, LITHO OFFSET PLATE-MAKER, PRINTING MACHINE OPERATOR (LITHO OFFSET), BOOKBINDER, AND TEXTILE MECHANIC.

## LAI KING AREA IN N.T. GETS WATER SUPPLY

\* \* \* \*

TAP WATER CAME TO THE DEVELOPING LAI KING AREA IN THE NEW TERRITORIES TODAY WHEN THE RETIRING DIRECTOR OF WATER SUPPLIES, MR. BILL KNIGHT, PUSHED A BUTTON BRINGING A NEW WATER SUPPLY SCHEME INTO OPERATION.

THE SCHEME, WHICH INCLUDES A PUMPING STATION AND FRESH AND SALT WATER SERVICE RESERVOIRS, WAS SPECIALLY DESIGNED BY THE P.W.D.'S WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT TO SERVE FUTURE RESIDENTS OF THE HIGH LEVEL LAI CHI KOK RIDGE AND LAI KING HEADLAND AREAS WHICH ARE BEING DEVELOPED FOR PUBLIC HOUSING.

COSTING \$3 MILLION, THE SCHEME WAS COMPLETED A FEW WEEKS AGO - WELL AHEAD OF THE NEW LAI YIU ESTATE WHOSE 20,000 TENANTS WILL BE THE FIRST TO BENEFIT FROM THE NEW SUPPLY.

THE ESTATE IS NOW NEARING COMPLETION AND THE FIRST TENANTS ARE EXPECTED TO MOVE IN BY DECEMBER.

OPENING THE NEW SUPPLY SYSTEM, MR. KNIGHT SAID ITS COMPLETION MARKED ANOTHER MILESTONE IN THE GOVERNMENT'S EFFORTS TO EXTEND THE SUPPLY OF POTABLE WATER IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

HE SAID IT HAD BEEN NECESSARY TO BUILD THE PUMPING STATION AND THE TWO SERVICE RESERVOIRS BECAUSE THE DEVELOPMENT AREA WAS TOO HIGH TO BE REACHED BY WATER FROM EXISTING SYSTEMS.

+WITH THIS NEW SCHEME, RESIDENTS OF LAI YIU AS WELL AS THOSE OF OTHER HOUSING ESTATES AND INSTITUTIONS TO BE DEVELOPED IN THIS AREA, CAN NOW BE ASSURED OF A WHOLESOME AND ADEQUATE SUPPLY OF WATER FOR THEIR NEEDS,+ SAID MR. KNIGHT.

HE SAID THE RESIDENTS WOULD BE RECEIVING THEIR SUPPLY DIRECTLY FROM THE NEW FRESH WATER SERVICE RESERVOIR WHICH WOULD BE FED WITH WATER PUMPED FROM THE EXISTING TRUNK MAINS BELOW WHICH CONNECT WITH THE TSUEN WAN TREATMENT WORKS.

CONSTRUCTION WORK ON THE SCHEME BEGAN IN MARCH LAST YEAR AND WAS CARRIED OUT BY THE SUN SUN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY UNDER THE OVERALL SUPERVISION OF THE P.W.D.'S WATERWORKS OFFICE WHICH SUPPLIED AND INSTALLED THE PUMPING EQUIPMENT.

THE FRESH WATER SERVICE RESERVOIR HAS A TOTAL CAPACITY OF FIVE MILLION LITRES. THE PUMPING STATION HOUSES TWO ELECTRIC PUMP SETS, EACH WITH AN OUTPUT OF NINE MILLION LITRES PER DAY.

THE SALT WATER SERVICE RESERVOIR, WHICH WILL PROVIDE FLUSHING WATER SUPPLY TO THE AREA, HAS A CAPACITY OF 0.7 MILLION LITRES.

MR. KNIGHT SAID HE WAS PARTICULARLY PLEASED TO INAUGURATE SUCH AN IMPORTANT WATER SCHEME ON THE EVE OF HIS RETIREMENT THIS MONTH AFTER 25 YEARS WITH THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT.

HE CONGRATULATED THE CONTRACTORS AND THE STAFF OF THE WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT FOR COMPLETING THE SCHEME IN GOOD TIME SO THAT THE FUTURE RESIDENTS OF THE AREA COULD BE ASSURED OF REGULAR SUPPLIES BEFORE MOVING IN.

MR. KNIGHT ALSO THANKED THE STAFF OF THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT OFFICE FOR THEIR ASSISTANCE IN THE NEGOTIATIONS FOR THE LAND REQUIRED.

THE LOT WAS SOLD TO THE ASIA PROPERTY COMPANY FOR \$960,000 AFTER STRONG BIDDING AT AN AUCTION CONDUCTED BY THE SENIOR ESTATE SURVEYOR OF THE SAI KUNG DISTRICT, MR. DEREK DEAR.

BIDDING STARTED AT \$300,000.

NOTE TO EDITORS:

THE DIRECTOR OF HOME AFFAIRS, MR. JOHN WALDEN, WILL TAKE A CLOSER LOOK AT THE SERVICES FOR THE AGED OFFERED BY THE DAVID TRENCH HOME FOR THE AGED AT BRICK HILL, ABERDEEN, ON THURSDAY (SEPTEMBER 23) AT 11 A.M.

THE INSTITUTION WAS BUILT BY THE TUNG WAH GROUP OF HOSPITALS WHICH IS ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR ITS MANAGEMENT. OCCUPYING AN AREA OF 47,930 SQ. FT., IT CAN ACCOMMODATE MORE THAN 200 ELDERLY PEOPLE OF BOTH SEXES WHO ONLY HAVE TO PAY A NOMINAL FEE OF \$90 EACH PER MONTH.

THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE IS NECESSARY IN ORDER TO ENABLE DEMOLITION OF A POST OFFICE CONVEYOR BELT.
