COMMISSION TO CONSIDER CODIFICATION OF CRIMINAL LAW PRINCIPLES

* * * * *

THE LAW REFORM COMMISSION IS TO CONSIDER WHETHER THE GENERAL PRINCIPLES OF HONG KONG'S CRIMINAL LAW SHOULD BE CODIFIED, THE COMMISSION'S CHAIRMAN, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, MR JEREMY MATHEWS, SAID TODAY (MONDAY).

THE COMMISSION WILL NOT BE CONCERNED WITH CODIFICATION OF SPECIFIC OFFENCES AS SUCH BUT RATHER WITH THE GENERAL PRINCIPLES WHICH GOVERN THE CRIMINAL LAW, SUCH AS PROOF, INTERPRETATION OF FAULT AND DEFENCES.

CODIFICATION IS THE ENACTMENT IN A SINGLE PIECE OF LEGISLATION OF ALL THE LAW ON A PARTICULAR SUBJECT. "IT HAS THE ADVANTAGE OF MAKING THE LAW MORE ACCESSIBLE AND, AT THE SAME TIME, MAKING THE TASK OF TRANSLATION MUCH EASIER." MR MATHEWS SAID.

INSTEAD OF HAVING TO SEARCH THROUGH A NUMBER OF DIFFERENT STATUTES AND COURT REPORTS TO ASCERTAIN THE LAW AS AT PRESENT, WHERE THERE IS A CODIFIED SYSTEM IT IS ONLY NECESSARY TO CONSULT THE COMPREHENSIVE CODE.

MR MATHEWS SAID THE LAW COMMISSION IN ENGLAND HAD RECENTLY COMPLETED A DRAFT CRIMINAL CODE BILL FOR ENGLAND AFTER SEVERAL YEARS' WORK.

"WE NOW HAVE AN OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE IMMENSE AMOUNT OF WORK DONE BY THE ENGLISH COMMISSION AND TO STUDY THE ENGLISH CODE TO SEE IF IT IS SUITABLE FOR ADOPTION IN HONG KONG," HE SAID.

THE SUBJECT OF CODIFICATION OF THE GENERAL PRINCIPLES OF THE CRIMINAL LAW HAD BEEN REFERRED TO THE COMMISSION BY THE ATTORNEY GENERAL AND THE CHIEF JUSTICE.

IT IS INTENDED THAT AN EXPERIENCED LAWYER WITH THE COMMISSION SECRETARIAT WILL BE ALLOCATED FULL-TIME TO THE CODIFICATION EXERCISE TO STUDY THE ENGLISH DRAFT CODE AND IDENTIFY AREAS WHERE CHANGES WILL HAVE TO BE MADE FOR HONG KONG.

REGULATIONS ON MARINE TRAFFIC SEPARATION APPROVED

* * * * *

THE SHIPPING AND PORT CONTROL (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 1989 HAVE BEEN APPROVED BY THE GOVERNOR IN COUNCIL, AND WILL COME INTO OPERATION ON SEPTEMBER 1. THE MARINE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED TODAY (MONDAY).

A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID: "THESE REGULATIONS BRING THE LOCAL MARINE TRAFFIC LEGISLATION RELATING TO TRAFFIC SEPARATION SCHEMES AND PRINCIPAL FAIRWAYS INTO LINE WITH INTERNATIONAL REGULATIONS.

"THE CHANGE RELATES TO THE RIGHT OF WAY BETWEEN VESSELS TRAVELLING ALONG TRAFFIC SEPARATION SCHEMES OR PRINCIPAL FAIRWAYS. AND THOSE CROSSING THEM. THE NEW REGULATIONS REMOVE THE FORMER'S IMMUTABLE RIGHT OF WAY. AND REPLACE IT WITH VARIOUS RULES WHICH APPLY DEPENDING UPON THE SITUATION AND THE TYPE OF VESSELS INVOLVED IN A PARTICULAR INSTANCE."

THESE RULES ARE ALREADY WELL KNOWN AND UNDERSTOOD BY MARINERS. THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

"THE MAXIMUM PENALTIES THAT THE MASTER OF A VESSEL IS LIABLE TO INCUR. SHOULD HE CONTRAVENE THESE REGULATIONS. REMAIN UNCHANGED. THAT IS. A FINE OF \$10,000 AND SIX MONTHS' IMPRISONMENT." HE SAID.

HALF-YEAR FIGURES ON COUNTERFEIT GOODS SEIZURES

* * * * *

CUSTOMS OFFICERS ARE SPARING NO EFFORTS IN CLAMPING DOWN ON THE ILLICIT TRADE IN COUNTERFEIT GOODS AND PIRATED VIDEO TAPES, WITH ABOUT \$7 MILLION WORTH OF SUCH GOODS SEIZED IN THE FIRST HALF OF THIS YEAR.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (MONDAY) THAT COUNTERFEIT WATCHES TOOK UP THE GREATEST SLICE OF THE SEIZURE IN THE PERIOD.

"IN THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF THIS YEAR, CUSTOMS OFFICERS SEIZED MORE THAN 20,000 FAKE WATCHES WITH A TOTAL VALUE OF OVER \$4.2 MILLION. THE SEIZURE IN THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR WAS ABOUT 33,000 WATCHES VALUED AT \$3.6 MILLION." THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

IN RESPECT OF COUNTERFEIT LEATHERWARE ITEMS, HE SAID, THE TOTAL VALUE OF THE SEIZURE WAS OVER \$1.7 MILLION, COMPARED WITH \$2.3 MILLION IN THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR.

"FIGURES ALSO SHOW THAT A TOTAL OF 4,000 INFRINGING VIDEO TAPES WORTH MORE THAN \$880,000 WERE SEIZED BY CUSTOMS OFFICERS IN THE FIRST HALF OF THIS YEAR.

"IN THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR, THE SEIZURE WAS ABOUT 4,300 PIECES VALUED AT \$900,000," HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID CUSTOMS OFFICERS WOULD MAINTAIN THEIR VIGILANCE AND TAKE TOUGH ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST THOSE ENGAGED IN SUCH ILLEGAL BUSINESS.

HE NOTED THAT AFTER THE REORGANISATION OF THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT ON AUGUST 1 THIS YEAR, THE FIGHT AGAINST ILLEGAL ACTIVITIES ENCROACHING ON COPYRIGHT AND TRADE DESCRIPTIONS HAD BECOME THE RESPONSIBILITY OF A NEWLY CONSTITUTED INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY BUREAU UNDER THE INVESTIGATION BRANCH.

"IT IS HOPED THAT WITH THE RESTRUCTURING, A MORE CONCERTED EFFORT COULD BE MADE IN CURBING COUNTERFEITING AND PIRACY ACTIVITIES," HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN STRESSED THAT THOSE ENGAGED IN SUCH ILLEGAL BUSINESS WOULD FACE A TOUGH PENALTY.

"OFFENCES UNDER THE COPYRIGHT ORDINANCE CARRY A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$50,000 AND TWO YEARS IMPRISONMENT, WHILE THOSE CONTRAVENING THE TRADE DESCRIPTIONS ORDINANCE ARE LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$500,000 AND IMPRISONMENT FOR FIVE YEARS," HE SAID.

IN THE FIRST HALF OF THIS YEAR, MORE THAN 400 PERONS AND COMPANIES WERE SUCCESSFULLY PROSECUTED FOR OFFENCES UNDER THE TWO ORDINANCES.

THE TOTAL FINES IMPOSED AMOUNTED TO OVER \$4.8 MILLION WHILE THE JAIL SENTENCES RANGED FROM TWO TO 27 MONTHS.

SWD NT REGIONAL OFFICE TO BE SPLIT

THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S REGIONAL OFFICE (NEW TERRITORIES) WILL BE SPLIT INTO TWO REGIONS FROM FRIDAY (SEPTEMBER 1) TO FURTHER IMPROVE ITS SERVICES THERE.

FROM FRIDAY, THE REGIONAL OFFICE (NT WEST) WILL SERVE TSUEN WAN, KWAI TSING AND TUEN MUN DISTRICTS WHILE THE REGIONAL OFFICE (NT EAST) WILL SERVE YUEN LONG, NORTH, TAI PO AND SHA TIN DISTRICTS.

THE REGIONAL OFFICE (NT WEST) IS TEMPORARILY LOCATED IN PRINCESS ALEXANDRA COMMUNITY CENTRE, 60 TAI HO ROAD, TSUEN WAN. IT WILL MOVE TO A PERMANENT OFFICE LATER THIS YEAR. THE REGIONAL OFFICE (NT EAST) WILL CONTINUE TO OPERATE IN THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY BUILDING IN SHA TIN.

A PRINCIPAL SOCIAL WORK OFFICER, MR ANTHONY CHAN WAI-KWAN, HAS BEEN APPOINTED REGIONAL OFFICER (NT WEST) WHILE THE PRESENT REGIONAL OFFICER (NT), MR CARLOS LEUNG, WILL HAVE HIS POST RETITLED REGIONAL OFFICER (NT EAST) AND CONTINUE TO BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SERVICES THAT ARE PROVIDED IN THE NT EAST REGION.

MR CHAN, AGED 48, JOINED THE DEPARTMENT AS AN ASSISTANT SOCIAL WORK OFFICER IN 1962. HE WAS A DISTRICT SOCIAL WELFARE OFFICER (TSUEN WAN/KWAI TSING) BEFORE BEING TRANSFERRED BACK TO DEPARTMENTAL HEADQUARTERS TO HEAD THE YOUTH AND CORRECTIONS SECTION.

A SWD SPOKESMAN SAID: "AS THE POPULATION IN THE NEW TERRITORIES IS EXPECTED TO INCREASE STEADILY, MORE SERVICE UNITS ARE EXPECTED TO BE ESTABLISHED.

"FOR 1989-90, OUT OF THE 162 NEW SERVICE UNITS WHICH WILL BE ESTABLISHED. 84 WILL BE IN THE NEW TERRITORIES. THIS WILL INCREASE THE WORKLOAD AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE REGIONAL OFFICER.

"THE NEW ARRANGEMENT IS TO ALLEVIATE THE HEAVY BURDEN OF THE EXISTING REGIONAL OFFICER (NT) AND TO TAKE BETTER CARE OF FUTURE EXPANSION OF WELFARE SERVICES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

"IT WILL ALSO ENABLE THE CONCERNED REGIONAL OFFICERS TO DEVOTE ADEQUATE ATTENTION TO COMMUNITY NEEDS AND DEVELOPMENT. THE CO-ORDINATION AND MONITORING OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND SUBVENTED AGENCIES IN THEIR OWN REGION, SO THAT SOCIAL WELFARE POLICIES AS WELL AS DEPARTMENTAL OBJECTIVES ARE ACHIEVED."

HEAVIER FINES IMPOSED ON LABOUR OFFENDERS

* * * * *

LABOUR LAW OFFENDERS NOW HAVE TO PAY MORE FOR THEIR WRONGDOINGS AS HEAVIER FINES WERE IMPOSED BY THE COURTS FOR BREACHES OF LABOUR LEGISLATIONS IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE YEAR.

LABOUR DEPARTMENT STATISTICS SHOWED THAT THE AVERAGE FINE IN LABOUR PROSECUTIONS DURING THE PERIOD WAS \$3,353, AN INCREASE OF 19 PER CENT OVER THE SAME PERIOD LAST YEAR.

UP TO JUNE THIS YEAR, THE DEPARTMENT BROUGHT 2,273 CASES TO THE COURTS, OF WHICH 2,226 CASES LED TO CONVICTIONS, AND RESULTING IN TOTAL FINES OF \$7.43 MILLION.

"THIS REPRESENTED A SIGNIFICANT INCREASE OVER THE 1,983 PROSECUTIONS AND \$5.56 MILLION FINES IMPOSED IN THE FIRST HALF OF 1988," A LABOUR DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID.

"THE TREND OF IMPOSING HEAVIER FINES WILL CERTAINLY MAKE EMPLOYERS TAKE WORKERS' SAFETY AND WELFARE MORE SERIOUSLY," HE ADDED.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO NOTED THAT MORE THAN 57 PER CENT OF THE CONVICTED CASES IN THE PERIOD WERE RELATED TO INDUSTRIAL SAFETY OFFENCES.

OF THE CONVICTED CASES IN WHICH CONVICTIONS WERE RECORDED, 848 CONCERNED BREACHES OF THE FACTORIES AND INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS ORDINANCE AND ITS SUBSIDIARY REGULATIONS AND 424 RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION SITES (SAFETY) REGULATIONS, WITH FINES AMOUNTING TO \$3.09 MILLION AND \$2.92 MILLION RESPECTIVELY.

/THERE WERE

THERE WERE ALSO 906 CONVICTIONS FOR VIOLATION OF WELFARE PROVISIONS UNDER THE WOMEN AND YOUNG PERSONS (INDUSTRY) REGULATIONS. EMPLOYMENT OF CHILDREN REGULATIONS. AND EMPLOYMENT, LABOUR RELATIONS AND EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ORDINANCES, RESULTING IN FINES TALLING \$1.35 MILLION.

THE REMAINING 48 CASES WERE RELATED TO OFFENCES UNDER THE BOILERS AND PRESSURE VESSELS ORDINANCE. PART IV B OF THE IMMIGRATION ORDINANCE CONCERNING EMPLOYEE RECORDS AND THE CONTRACTS FOR EMPLOYMENT OUTSIDE HONG KONG ORDINANCE. TOTAL FINES IMPOSED IN THESE CATEGORIES AMOUNTED TO \$87,800.

MEDICAL SCHEME FOR THE ELDERLY IN SOUTHERN

* * * * *

ELDERLY PEOPLE WHO ARE LIVING OR WORKING IN THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT CAN NOW JOIN A COMMUNITY MEDICAL SCHEME ORGANISED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD.

"THE SCHEME PROVIDES LOCAL RESIDENTS AGED 60 OR ABOVE WITH FASTER AND CHEAPER MEDICAL CARE FROM PRIVATE DOCTORS AND DENTISTS," A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DISTRICT BOARD SAID TODAY (MONDAY).

THE BENEFITS INCLUDE PRIORITY IN TREATMENT AND REDUCED CONSULTING FEES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS WHEN THEY VISIT ANY OF THE 20 PRIVATE REGISTERED DOCTORS OR DENTISTS ENLISTED IN THE SCHEME. THESE MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS HAVE CLINICS IN DIFFERENT PARTS OF THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT.

THE SCHEME WAS INITIATED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD'S SOCIAL SERVICES COMMITTEE IN 1986 AND HAS SINCE PROVED QUITE POPULAR, ATTRACTING ABOUT 1,000 PARTICIPANTS EACH YEAR.

"THE PARTICIPATION RATE SO FAR THIS YEAR IS EVEN BETTER WITH THE FIGURE RISING TO ABOUT 1,200. NEVERTHELESS, WE WOULD WELCOME MORE TO TAKE PART," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

APPLICATIONS TO JOIN THE SCHEME CAN BE MADE IN PERSON TO THE PUBLIC ENQUIRY SERVICE CENTRE OF THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT OFFICE AT ABERDEEN CENTRE, AND ITS SUB-OFFICES AT LEI TUNG ESTATE, WAH FU ESTATE AND STANLEY VILLAGE ROAD.

APPLICANTS SHOULD BRING WITH THEM THEIR IDENTITY CARDS AND DOCUMENTS WHICH CAN PROVE THAT THEY RESIDE OR WORK IN THE DISTRICT. THOSE RECEIVING ANY FORM OF ALLOWANCES FROM THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT SHOULD ALSO BRING ALONG THE RELEVANT DOCUMENTS.

MEMBERS WHOSE REGISTRATION EXPIRED IN DECEMBER LAST YEAR MAY RENEW THEIR REGISTRATION WITH THE DISTRICT OFFICE.

/ALL ELIGIBLE

ALL ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS WILL BE ISSUED WITH A REGISTRATION CARD FREE OF CHARGE.

"TO SAVE PARTICIPANTS THE TROUBLE OF HAVING TO RENEW THEIR REGISTRATION EVERY YEAR AS HAS BEEN REQUIRED IN THE PAST, THEY WILL NOW BE ISSUED WITH A REGISTRATION CARD VALID FOR TWO-AND-A-HALF YEARS UNTIL JUNE 1991." THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

A "BLOCK REGISTRATION" MEASURE IS ALSO INTRODUCED TO ENABLE ELDERLY PEOPLE TO FILE THEIR APPLICATIONS THROUGH MUTUAL AID COMMITTEES OR VOLUNTARY AGENCIES INSTEAD OF APPLYING TO THE DISTRICT OFFICE IN PERSON.

THESE ORGANISATIONS CAN THEN FILE THE APPLICATIONS WITH THE DISTRICT OFFICE ON THE APPLICANTS' BEHALF.
