WITH THE SINO-BRITISH JOINT DECLARATION ON HONG KONG'S FUTURE FIRMLY IN PLACE, THE FUTURE SPECIAL ADMINISTRATIVE REGION IS ASSURED OF THE CONTINUATION OF THE SYSTEMS WHICH HAVE MADE HONG KONG'S SUCCESS POSSIBLE, THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY, MR PIERS JACOBS, SAID THIS (SUNDAY) EVENING.

SPEAKING AT THE DINNER PARTY OF THE CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF ARBITRATORS, MR JACOBS SAID, +CONSISTENT WITH THE SPIRIT OF THE JOINT DECLARATION, THE WORK OF THE INSTITUTE WILL CERTAINLY CONTINUE TO FLOURISH AS IT HAS FOR THE PAST 15 YEARS.+

THE HONG KONG BRANCH OF THE CHARTERED INSTITUTE OF ARBITRATORS WAS FORMED IN 1972 AND HAS A MEMBERSHIP OF OVER 600. IT IS INVOLVED IN THE FOSTERING OF THE PRACTICE OF SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES BY ARBITRATION.

+THE INCREASED BUSINESS DEALINGS INVOLVING THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA WILL NO DOUBT INCREASE THE DEMANDS UPON MEMBERS OF THE INSTITUTE,+ HE SAID.

+AND MEMBERS WILL NO DOUBT RISE TO MEET THE EXPECTATIONS FOR SPEEDY AND RELIABLE RESOLUTION OF COMMERCIAL DISPUTES WITH PRECISION AND ZEAL.+

WORK STARTS ON JORDAN VALLEY CONTROLLED TIP

* * * * *

WORK HAS STARTED ON BUILDING A CONTROLLED TIP AT JORDAN VALLEY TO PROVIDE SEVEN HECTARES ON LAND FOR RECREATIONAL AND AMENITY FACILITIES.

THE CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES DEPARTMENT HAS AWARDED A \$9.54 MILLION CONTRACT FOR THE PROJECT WHICH WILL TAKE 20 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

IT INCLUDES CONSTRUCTING AN ACCESS ROAD TO THE TIP, AS WELL AS SURFACE DRAINAGE.

THE SANITARY LANDFILL METHOD WILL BE USED TO BUILD THE TIP TO MINIMISE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT. IT WILL HAVE A DAILY CAPACITY OF 680 TONNES OF REFUSE.

ONE MILLION TONNES OF REFUSE WILL HAVE BEEN DEPOSITED WHEN THE TIP IS FULLY FORMED IN 1989.

TENDERS CALLED FOR NEW CARGO HANDLING AREA FACILITIES

TENDERS ARE BEING SOUGHT BY THE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR CONSTRUCTING FACILITIES FOR A NEW CARGO HANDLING AREA ON THE WESTERN RECLAMATION ON HONG KONG ISLAND.

THE WORK WILL INCLUDE CONSTRUCTING A TWO-STOREY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, A PUBLIC TOILET AND TWO TICKETING BOOTHS.

WORK IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN IN APRIL AND BE COMPLETED IN SEPTEMBER.

THE NEW CARGO HANDLING AREA WILL BE 310 METRES LONG BY 30 METRES WIDE. CONSTRUCTION WILL START ALSO IN APRIL.

WHEN COMPLETED IN EIGHT MONTHS, IT WILL REPLACE AN EXISTING ONE IN THE VICINITY.

NEW MARKET COMPLEX FOR TSUEN WAN

THE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A SIX-STOREY MARKET COMPLEX ON A 3 500-SQUARE-METRE SITE AT THE JUNCTION OF YEUNG UK ROAD AND CHUEN LUNG STREET IN TSUEN WAN.

THREE LOWER FLOORS WILL BE FOR MARKET STALLS AND AN OFFICE WILL BE BUILT ON THE THIRD FLOOR. THERE WILL ALSO BE AN INDOOR GAMES HALL, FOUR SQUASH COURTS, A PHYSICAL TRAINING ROOM, STORE ROOM, CHANGING ROOMS AND TOILETS ON THE REMAINING UPPER FLOORS.

WORK ON THE COMPLEX IS EXPECTED TO START IN APRIL AND TAKE ABOUT 25 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

A REPORT ON THE SURVEY ON CONDITIONS OF WORK FOR WOMEN WORKERS IN TSUEN WAN WILL BE TABLED FOR ENDORSEMENT AT THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT BOARD MEETING ON TUESDAY (MARCH 3) AFTERNOON.

THE SURVEY WAS CONDUCTED BY A WORKING GROUP ON INDUSTRIAL AND COMMERCIAL PROBLEMS UNDER THE INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE COMMITTEE OF THE DISTRICT BOARD.

FOLLOWING DISCUSSION AND ENDORSEMENT, THERE WILL BE A PRESS CONFERENCE TO ANNOUNCE DETAILS ON THE FINDINGS OF THE REPORT.

THE MEETING WILL RESUME AFTER THE PRESS CONFERENCE.

QUESTIONS ON LEGAL MATTERS ARISING FROM THE SALE AND PURCHASE OF PREMISES WILL ALSO BE RAISED.

THE REPORTS OF THE SIX COMMITTEES OF THE BOARD WILL BE TABLED FOR CONSIDERATION.

THE MEETING WILL BE HELD AT THE MAIN CONFERENCE ROOM OF THE REGIONAL COUNCIL ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF THE TSUEN WAN STATION MULTI-STOREY CARPARK BUILDING, 174-208 CASTLE PEAK ROAD IN TSUEN WAN.

PART-TIME LECTURERS SOUGHT FOR ADULT EDUCATION

THE ADULT EDUCATION SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT IS INVITING APPLICATION FOR PART-TIME LECTURERS IN VARIOUS COURSES TO BE OPERATED IN THE 1987-88 SESSION STARTING IN SEPTEMBER.

THE ADULT EDUCATION SECTION RUNS A NUMBER OF COURSES INCLUDING THOSE AT THE EVENING SCHOOL OF HIGHER CHINESE STUDIES, TEACHERS' COURSES, ENGLISH COURSE, GOVERNMENT EVENING SECONDARY SCHOOL COURSE, AND ADULT EDUCATION COURSE (GENERAL AND PRACTICAL BACKGROUND). IT ALSO RUNS COURSES IN ADULT EDUCATION AND RECREATION CENTRES IN VARIOUS DISTRICTS.

APPLICANTS SHOULD HAVE A GENUINE INTEREST IN TEACHING YOUNG ADULTS PART-TIME IN THE EVENING. EXPERIENCE IN TEACHING THE RELEVANT COURSE WOULD BE AN ADVANTAGE.

APPLICANTS SHOULD BE QUALIFIED TEACHERS IF THEY ARE SEEKING POSTS IN THE EVENING SCHOOL OF HIGHER CHINESE STUDIES, TEACHERS' COURSES, ENGLISH COURSE, GOVERNMENT EVENING SECONDARY SCHOOL COURSE, AND ADULT EDUCATION COURSE (GENERAL BACKGROUND).

APPLICANTS WHO POSSESS A DIPLOMA OR CERTIFICATE IN EDUCATION OR ADVANCED CERTIFICATE IN TEACHER TRAINING WITH EXPERIENCE IN TEACHING AT SENIOR SECONDARY OR POST-SECONDARY LEVELS WOULD FIND IT AN ADVANTAGE.

TEACHING POSTS IN DRESSMAKING, SEWING AND KNITTING, COOKERY AND WOODWORK IN THE ADULT EDUCATION COURSES (PRACTICAL BACKGROUND) ARE CONFINED TO APPLICANTS WHO ARE QUALIFIED TEACHERS WITH SPECIAL TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE IN THE RESPECTIVE SUBJECTS.

HOLDERS OF A SECONDARY EDUCATION CERTIFICATE OR EQUIVALENT AND WITH SPECIAL SKILLS IN VARIOUS SUBJECTS OR HOBBY GROUPS ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR POSTS AS HOBBY INSTRUCTORS IN THE ADULT EDUCATION AND RECREATION CENTRES. SUBJECTS INCLUDE SINGING, MUSIC, DANCING, AEROBICS, PAINTING, HAIR-STYLING, HANDICRAFTS AND ALSO JAPANESE AND PUTONGHUA.

SERVING TEACHERS WITH ABILITY AND EXPERIENCE IN ORGANISING RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES OR EXPERIENCED COMMUNITY WORKERS WILL BE GIVEN PRIORITY.

FINAL YEAR UNDERGRADUATES OF THE TWO UNIVERSITIES MAY ALSO APPLY BUT THEIR APPOINTMENTS ARE SUBJECT TO SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION OF THEIR DEGREE COURSES.

EXISTING PAYMENTS FOR PART-TIME LECTURING ARE \$145 PER HOUR FOR POST-SECONDARY LEVEL, \$120 FOR SENIOR SECONDARY LEVEL, \$95 FOR JUNIOR SECONDARY LEVEL, \$85 FOR PRIMARY LEVEL AND \$80 FOR HOBBY GROUPS.

ELDERLY RESIDENTS LIVING IN REMOTE AREAS OF SHA LO WAN AND SHUM SHEK ON LANTAU ISLAND TODAY (SUNDAY) RECEIVED FREE MEDICAL CHECK-UPS IN A PROGRAMME OPERATED JOINTLY BY THE ISLANDS DISTRICT OFFICE AND THE MEDICAL SOCIETY OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG.

ABOUT 70 VILLAGERS AGED OVER 65 WERE GIVEN BLOOD PRESSURE TESTS AND SCREENING FOR DIABETES.

THE DISTRICT OFFICE AND THE MEDICAL SOCIETY CARRIED OUT A SIMILAR PROJECT IN TUNG CHUNG LAST SUMMER AND DECIDED TO EXTEND THE PROGRAMME TO INCLUDE VILLAGES IN TAI O BECAUSE IT HAD PROVED USEFUL FOR THE ELDERLY, A DISTRICT OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID.

TRAINING SESSIONS ARE CONDUCTED ON SATURDAY AFTERNOONS FROM 2.30 PM TO 4.30 PM. FEES ARE \$100 PER SEASON.

THE CHILDREN'S CHOIR, WITH A MEMBERSHIP OF 130, WAS SET UP IN 1975 BY THE MONG KOK DISTRICT CULTURAL RECREATIONAL AND SPORTS ASSOCIATION TO ALLOW CHILDREN TO OBTAIN SYSTEMATIC AND FORMAL TRAINING IN MUSIC.

APART FROM CLASSROOM TRAINING, THE CHOIR HAS BEEN ACTIVELY TAKING PART IN MUSIC FESTIVALS AND VARIETY SHOWS TO IMPROVE ITS PERFORMING SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE.
