WORK TO START ON TSING YI NORTH BRIDGE
* * *

WORK ON THE NORTH TSING YI BRIDGE PROJECT WILL START IN THE MIDDLE OF THIS YEAR AND TAKE THREE YEARS TO COMPLETE.

THE DEPUTY PROJECT MANAGER TSUEN WAN, MR NORMAN TUCKER, SAID THE DETAILED DESIGN WAS BEING COMPLETED BY THE CONSULTING ENGINEERS WITH A VIEW TO INVITING TENDERS EARLY THIS YEAR.

HE SAID THERE HAD BEEN 27 APPLICATIONS TO PRE-QUALIFY TO TENDER, OF WHICH THE CENTRAL TENDER BOARD HAD CHOSEN 10.

MR TUCKER SAID BUILDING THE BRIDGE WAS RELATED TO THE INTAKE OF RESIDENTS INTO A HOUSING ESTATE TO BE BUILT IN THE NORTHERN PART OF TSING YI ON THE RECLAIMED MOON TSAI TONG TYPHOON SHELTER SITE.

HE SAID THE POPULATION OF TSING YI IS ABOUT 54 000, BUT WILL GROW TO MORE THAN 220 000 BY THE EARLY 1990'S.

MR TUCKER SAID THE BALANCED CANTILEVER DESIGNED BRIDGE WILL BE 1.5 KILOMETRES LONG, INCLUDING THE APPROACH ROADS. IT WILL BE CONSTRUCTED OF PRE-STRESSED CONCRETE AND THERE WILL BE A MAIN NAVIGATIONAL SPAN OF 122 METRES. IT WILL BE 20 METRES ABOVE SEA LEVEL.

THE BRIDGE WILL HAVE A DUAL, TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAY WITH CENTRAL DIVIDER AND BE CAPABLE OF HANDLING 3 000 CARS AN HOUR EACH WAY. THERE WILL BE A TWO-METRE-WIDE FOOTPATH ON THE NORTH SIDE AND A RESERVE ON THE SOUTH SIDE OF SIMILAR WIDTH GIVING ACCESS TO UTILITY INSTALLATIONS AND FOR EMERGENCY USES.

THE TOTAL WIDTH OF THE BRIDGE IS 25.4 METRES, WHICH IS TWICE THAT OF THE EXISTING BRIDGE.

IT WILL CONNECT FROM THE TEXACO ROAD INTERSECTION ON THE TSUEN WAN BY-PASS TO A NEW INTERSECTION TO BE BUILT ON NORTH TSING YI, PASSING OVER THE SOUTH END OF NGA YING CHAU AND LANDING ON THE RECLAMATION NOW IN PROGRESS IN THE TYPHOON SHELTER.

THE PROJECT WILL COST MORE THAN \$300 MILLION.

SURVEY SEEKS ECONOMIC, SOCIAL INFORMATION
* * * * *

LETTERS ARE BEING SENT BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT TO SEVERAL THOUSAND HOUSEHOLDS SELECTED THROUGHOUT ALL DISTRICTS IN HONG KONG IN CONNECTION WITH A GENERAL HOUSEHOLD SURVEY.

THE PURPOSE OF THE LETTERS IS TO SEEK THE HOUSEHOLDERS' COOPERATION AND PARTICIPATION IN THE SURVEY BEING CARRIED OUT TO OBTAIN THE LATEST INFORMATION ON THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE POPULATION, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT EXPLAINED TODAY.

INFORMATION BEING SOUGHT WILL INCLUDE PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE POPULATION, SUCH AS AGE, SEX AND EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT, AS WELL AS LABOUR FORCE CHARACTERISTICS, SUCH AS ACTIVITY STATUS, HOURS OF WORK, INDUSTRY, AND OCCUPATION, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

THE SURVEY STARTED IN AUGUST 1981 AND IS CARRIED OUT ON A CONTINUOUS BASIS BY THE PERMANENT FIELD STAFF OF THE DEPARTMENT.

A RANDOM SAMPLE OF SOME 6 000 HOUSEHOLDS IS SELECTED THROUGHOUT ALL DISTRICTS IN HONG KONG FOR PARTICIPATION IN EACH MONTHLY SURVEY. ABOUT HALF OF THE HOUSEHOLDS WERE INTERVIEWED THREE MONTHS EARLIER AND ARE SELECTED AGAIN IN ORDER TO MEASURE MORE ACCURATELY THE CHANGES THAT HAVE OCCURRED SINCE THEN.

ASSISTANT CENSUS AND SURVEY OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT, EACH HOLDING A DEPARTMENTAL IDENTITY CARD WILL VISIT THE SAMPLE HOUSEHOLDS TO COLLECT THE REQUIRED INFORMATION.

ALL INFORMATION COLLECTED IN THE SURVEY WILL BE TREATED AS STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL AND WILL NOT BE REVEALED TO ANY PERSON OR ORGANISATION OUTSIDE THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT, THE SPOKESMAN STRESSED.

VALUE OF GOOD LABOUR TIES STRESSED
* * * * *

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IN MODERN SOCIETY IS BASED ON GOOD LABOUR RELATIONS, THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT COMMISSIONER, MR ADOLF HSU, SAID TONIGHT (MONDAY).

HE SAID THAT THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN EMPLOYEES AND EMPLOYERS WAS CLOSE ALTHOUGH THE PARTIES MIGHT HAVE CONFLICTING VIEWS DUE TO DIFFERENT INTERESTS.

+MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING AND COMPROMISE IS THE WAY TO SOLVE THESE CONFLICTING VIEWS.

+I BELIEVE THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT BOARD'S INDUSTRIAL COMMITTEE AND GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS CONCERNED WILL CONTINUE TO WORK TOWARDS THIS END, SO THAT TSUEN WAN WILL SET AN EXAMPLE TO OTHER NEW TOWNS IN THE PROMOTION OF GOOD LABOUR RELATIONS,+ HE SAID.

MR HSU WAS ADDRESSING A GATHERING AT THE +WORKERS NIGHT+, WHICH MARKED THE END OF THE TSUEN WAN DISTRICT MODEL WORKERS AWARD SCHEME HELD AT THE TSUEN WAN TOWN HALL.

HE POINTED OUT THAT APART FROM BEING THE LARGEST NEW TOWN, TSUEN WAN WAS ALSO AN IMPORTANT INDUSTRIAL TOWN WITH MORE THAN 12 000 FACTORIES IN TSUEN WAN, EMPLOYING SOME 170 000 WORKERS.

+THIS SHOWS THAT INDUSTRY PLAYS A VERY IMPORTANT ROLE IN OUR COMMUNITY, AND SOLVING OR IMPROVING PROBLEMS FACING THE INDUSTRIAL SECTOR HAS BECOME ONE OF GOVERNMENT'S POLICIES.

+IN FACT, CONCERNED DEPARTMENTS HAVE BEEN DOING A GREAT DEAL TO IMPROVE LABOUR RELATIONS AND SOLVE LABOUR DISPUTES, AND THESE EFFORTS HAVE PROVED REWARDING.+

MR HSU SAID A NUMBER OF COMPANIES AND FACTORIES HAD CLOSED LAST YEAR.

+IF THESE CASES WERE NOT DEALT WITH PROPERLY, THEY MIGHT HAVE BROUGHT INSTABILITY TO THE COMMUNITY. IT WAS FORTUNATE THAT DUE TO THE TRADITIONAL GOOD LABOUR RELATIONS AND APPROPRIATE ACTION AND CONCILIATION BY GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS CONCERNED, MANY DISPUTES WERE SETTLED SATISFACTORILY.

+BUT IT WAS NOT GOVERNMENT EFFORTS ALONE THAT HAD BROUGHT ABOUT SATISFACTORY SOLUTIONS TO THESE CASES. ON THE CONTRARY, THIS WAS BASICALLY DUE TO THE FRANK ATTITUDE AND CO-OPERATION BETWEEN EMPLOYEES AND EMPLOYERS. IT IS, THEREFORE, NECESSARY FOR ALL PARTIES CONCERNED TO EXPLORE BETTER WAYS TO FURTHER PROMOTE GOOD LABOUR RELATIONS.+

MR HSU STRESSED THE IMPORTANCE OF, AND NEED FOR, CO-OPERATION AMONG EMPLOYEES, EMPLOYERS, WORKERS UNIONS AND THE GOVERNMENT TO MAINTAIN GOOD LABOUR RELATIONS.

HE SAID THE DISTRICT BOARD'S INDUSTRIAL COMMITTEE HAD BEEN PROVIDING DIFFERENT OPPORTUNITIES FOR REPRESENTATIVES OF EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES TO DISCUSS LABOUR LEGISLATION, POLICIES AND RELATED MATTER.

VIEWS SO EXPRESSED WERE REFERRED TO GOVERNMENT FOR CONSIDERATION.

IN ADDITION, ACTIVITIES WERE ORGANISED TO STRENGTHEN THEIR TIES WITH THE DISTRICT BOARD, AND TO PROMOTE BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THEIR RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS.

THE +WORKERS NIGHT+ FEATURED A VARIETY SHOW BY COMMERCIAL RADIO 1.

TEN +MODEL WORKERS+ AND WINNERS OF THE INDUSTRIAL CHESS COMPETITION AND SINGING COMPETITION ALSO RECEIVED THEIR PRIZES.

THE TEN MODEL WORKERS WILL ACT AS +WORKERS AMBASSADORS+, PAYING GOODWILL VISITS TO A NUMBER OF INDUSTRIAL UNDERTAKINGS LATER THIS MONTH.

\$28M PAID TO TRAFFIC VICTIMS
* * * *

MORE THAN \$28 MILLION WAS PAID OUT TO TRAFFIC ACCIDENT VICTIMS OR THEIR DEPENDANTS IN 5 608 CASES UNDER THE TRAFFIC ACCIDENT VICTIMS ASSISTANCE SCHEME (TAVA) BETWEEN JANUARY AND NOVEMBER LAST YEAR.

+PAYMENTS AVERAGED \$5 000 A CASE,+ SAID MR SIU KING-CHIU, HEAD OF THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT UNIT THAT ADMINISTERS THE SCHEME.

THERE WERE 6 183 APPLICATIONS FOR ASSISTANCE UNDER THE SCHEME, COMPARED WITH 7 160 IN THE CORRESPONDING PERIOD IN 1982.

MR SIU SAID THAT THE FEWER APPLICATIONS RESULTED PROBABLY FROM THE DECREASED NUMBER OF ROAD ACCIDENT CASUALTIES REPORTED.

HE NOTED HOWEVER THAT THE RATE OF SUCCESSFUL APPLICATIONS HAD INCREASED, FROM 85.2 PER CENT DURING JANUARY-NOVEMBER 1982 TO 90.7 PER CENT IN THE SIMILAR PERIOD IN 1983.

+THE HIGHER RATE OF SUCCESSFUL APPLICATIONS WAS POSSIBLY BECAUSE OF WIDER PUBLICITY CLARIFYING THE THREE-DAY MINIMUM SICK LEAVE REQUIREMENT,+ HE SAID.

+AS A RESULT, THOSE NOT MEETING THIS REQUIREMENT HAVE NOT COME FORWARD TO APPLY.+

MR SIU EXPLAINED THAT WHEN A MAJOR TRAFFIC ACCIDENT OCCURS, +STAFF OF THE TAVA SECTION PROMPTLY REACH OUT TO VICTIMS OR THEIR DEPENDANTS TO HELP THEM APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE.+

THE HIGHEST SINGLE PAYMENT SINCE THE SCHEME WAS LAUNCHED IN 1979 WAS \$40 050, HE SAID

THE TRAFFIC ACCIDENT VICTIMS ASSISTANCE SCHEME, WHICH IS ADMINISTERED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT, PROVIDES EARLY FINANCIAL HELP TO ROAD TRAFFIC ACCIDENT VICTIMS OR THEIR DEPENDANTS, REGARDLESS OF WHO IS AT FAULT IN THE ACCIDENT.

THE THREE LUNAR NEW YEAR FAIRS, TOGETHER WITH FOUR OTHER FAIRS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES, WILL BE HELD BETWEEN JANUARY 26 AND FEBRUARY 2, SAID A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

ON WEDNESDAY, 80 STALLS TO BE ERECTED AT THE FAIR SITE AT TAI PO PLAYGROUND WILL BE AUCTIONED AT THE TAI PO RURAL COMMITTEE AT HEUNG SZE WUI STREET IN TAI PO.

AUCTIONING OF ANOTHER 100 STALLS AT THE COMING SHA TIN FAIR SITE AT THE YUEN WO ROAD PLAYGROUND WILL BE HELD AT THE LEK YUEN COMMUNITY HALL IN LEK YUEN ESTATE ON THURSDAY (JANUARY 5).

THE FRIDAY (JANUARY 6) AUCTION OF 113 STALLS AT SHEUNG SHUI FAIR SITE AT SHEK WU HUI PLAYGROUND WILL BE HELD AT THE NORTH DISTRICT COMMUNITY CENTRE AND TOWN HALL IN SHEUNG SHUI.

ALL AUCTIONS WILL BEGIN AT 9.30 AM AND THE UPSET PRICE FOR EACH STALL IS \$100, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

TEACHING PUPILS GOOD DENTAL HABITS

A TOTAL OF 7 200 PRIMARY ONE SCHOOL STUDENTS FROM 76 SCHOOLS WILL TAKE PART IN A DENTAL +BRUSH-IN+ PROGRAMME STARTING ON WEDNESDAY (JANUARY 4).

THE PROGRAMME IS ORGANISED BY THE MACLEHOSE ORAL HEALTH EDUCATION UNIT OF THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT EXPLAINED THAT THE AIM IS TO PROMOTE ORAL HEALTH EDUCATION AND TO ESTABLISH GOOD ORAL HABITS AMONG CHILDREN.

THE SEVEN-MONTH PROGRAMME CONSISTS OF TALKS ON DENTAL HEALTH AND PROPER TEETH-BRUSHING DEMONSTRATIONS FOR PRIMARY ONE PUPILS AT SELECTED SCHOOLS IN HONG KONG, KOWLOON AND THE NEW TERRITORIES.

DURING THE TIME, DENTAL THERAPISTS WILL ALSO VISIT THESE SCHOOLS TO TEACH STUDENTS INDIVIDUALLY HOW TO BRUSH THEIR TEETH PROPERLY. THE VISITS WILL CONTINUE UNTIL THE YOUNGSTERS LEARN THE UP-TO-DATE TECHNIQUE.

THE WHOLE PROGRAMME WILL END AT THE END OF THE SCHOOL YEAR, IN JULY 1.

SPONSORED BY THE DISTRICT BOARD, THE FOURTH YUEN LONG ARTS FESTIVAL WILL ALSO HAVE FILM SHOWS, SEMINARS AND EXHIBITIONS.

THE PERFORMING GROUPS WILL INCLUDE THE HONG KONG PHILHARMONIC ORCHESTRA, HONG KONG CHAMBER ORCHESTRA, HONG KONG ACADEMY BALLET COMPANY, SEALS THEATRE, CITY CONTEMPORARY DANCE COMPANY, CHOR FUNG MING CANTONESE OPERA TROUPE AND THE YUEN LONG CHILDREN'S CHOIR.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE ORGANISING COMMITTEE ADVISED LOCAL PEOPLE TO BOOK EARLY FOR THE PERFORMANCES AND SHOWS WHICH WILL BEGIN FROM FEBRUARY 17.

NEW MARKET FOR NORTH KWAI CHUNG
* * *

FINISHING TOUCHES ARE BEING PUT TO A MODERN MARKET AT THE NORTHERN PART OF KWAI CHUNG WHICH WILL BE OPEN SOON.

THE FOUR-STOREY MARKET COMPLEX IS BUILT ON A SITE OF ABOUT 1 450 SQUARE METRES AT THE JUNCTION OF SHEK YAM ROAD AND TUNG CHI STREET.

IT WILL BE ONE OF THE FIRST MULTI-PURPOSE MARKET BUILDINGS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WHICH HOUSES A MARKET FACILITY, PUBLIC LIBRARY AND A REST GARDEN TO BE COMPLETED THIS YEAR, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT SAID.

/THE MARKET

THE MARKET WILL OCCUPY THE GROUND AND FIRST FLOORS OF THE BUILDING. THE PUBLIC LIBRARY WILL BE ON THE SECOND AND THIRD FLOORS, AND THE SMALL REST GARDEN ON THE ROOF-TOP OF THE COMPLEX.

COSTING ABOUT \$23 MILLION, THE BUILDING IS DESIGNED AND BUILT BY THE ARCHITECTURAL OFFICE OF THE BUILDING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.

ON COMPLETION, THE MARKET FACILITIES AND A SMALL REST GARDEN ON THE ROOF-TOP OF THE BUILDING WILL BE HANDED OVER TO THE NTSD FOR MANAGEMENT.

THE MARKET WILL HAVE A TOTAL FLOOR AREA OF ABOUT 3 000 SQUARE METRES, ACCOMMODATING 225 STALLS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

OF THE STALLS, 32 ARE DESIGNATED FOR THE SALE OF FISH, MEAT AND POULTRY, WHILE THE OTHER 193 MINI-STALLS ARE FOR VEGETABLES, FRUITS, GROCERY AND HABERDASHERY.

THE MARKET HAS THREE DIRECT ENTRANCES AND A SPECIALLY BUILT FOOTBRIDGE CONNECTED TO TUNG CHI STREET.

TWO ESCALATORS ARE PROVIDED ON THE GROUND FLOOR LEADING TO THE FIRST FLOOR IN ADDITION TO A GOODS LIFT.

THE MARKET WILL TAKE IN ALL ELIGIBLE TRADERS CURRENTLY PLYING AT THE SHEK YAM ROAD TEMPORARY MARKET AND TAI LOONG STREET TEMPORARY MARKET IN KWAI CHUNG, THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

THE TWO TEMPORARY MARKET STRUCTURES WILL LATER BE DEMOLISHED TO MAKE WAY FOR A NEW SITTING OUT AREA.
