REPORT ON SAFETY OF LRT SYSTEM TO BE READY SOON

* * * * *

THE FULL REPORT ON THE SAFETY OF THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT SYSTEM WAS EXPECTED TO BE SUBMITTED BY MR COOKSEY TOWARDS THE END OF THIS WEEK AND THE GOVERNMENT WOULD THEN MAKE AN ASSESSMENT AS TO FUTURE RUNNING OF THE LRT SYSTEM, THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR DAVID FORD SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

SPEAKING TO REPORTERS AFTER OFFICIATING AT A CEREMONY MARKING THE COMPLETION OF PHASE I OF THE LRT SYSTEM, SIR DAVID SAID BOTH THE GOVERNMENT AND KCRC SHARED THE RESIDENTS' CONCERN TO ENSURE THE LRT SYSTEM WOULD BE AS SAFE AS IT POSSIBLY COULD BE.

"EVERYBODY IS ANXIOUS TO DO THE SAME," HE SAID.

"I THINK THAT WHEN WE HAVE HAD A PERIOD OF SCHEDULED RUNNING, EVERYBODY IS MORE USED TO THE SYSTEM AND HAS A GREAT DEAL OF CONFIDENCE IN IT, THEN I THINK EVERYBODY'S FEAR WILL BE PUT TO REST."

SIR DAVID NOTED THAT THE RESPONSE TO MR COOKSEY'S REPORT OF THE ACCIDENT HAS BEEN VERY GOOD.

"EVERYBODY HAS BEEN VERY POSITIVE ABOUT THAT AND HAS PUT IN HAND MR COOKSEY'S RECOMMENDATIONS. I THINK THAT WILL BEAR FRUIT," HE ADDED.

ASKED TO COMMENT ON THE RECENT TALKS IN HANOI ON THE PROBLEM OF VIETNAMESE BOAT PEOPLE, SIR DAVID SAID THAT THEY WERE AS GOOD AS WE COULD POSSIBLY EXPECT FOR THE FIRST ROUND OF TALKS.

HE SAID: "WE DID NOT EXPECT TO ACHIEVE A GREAT BREAKTHROUGH ON THE FIRST ROUND OF TALKS AS MR CLIFT HAD MADE CLEAR BEFORE HE LEFT. BUT I THINK THERE IS NOW A MUCH BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF BOTH SIDES' POSITION."

"I AM SURE THERE WILL BE ANOTHER ROUND OF TALKS. I AM HOPEFUL AT THAT ROUND OF TALKS WE WILL BE ABLE TO MAKE PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THE RETURN OF THE VIETNAMESE ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS TO THEIR OWN COUNTRY."

HE ADDED THAT THE TIME FOR THE NEXT ROUND OF TALKS HAD NOT BEEN DECIDED.

ON THE QUESTION OF PROVIDING ECONOMIC AID TO VIETNAM, SIR DAVID SAID IT WAS FAR TOO EARLY TO SAY AT THIS STAGE WHAT MIGHT BE THE EVENTUAL PACKAGE.

HE SAID THE GOVERNMENT WAS CONCERNED IN STOPPING THE FLOW AND IN MAKING PRACTICAL ARRANGEMENTS FOR THEIR REPATRIATION.

LRT FORMS BACKBONE OF NEW TOWN TRANSPORT SYSTEM -- SIR DAVID
* * * * *

THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT WILL FORM THE BACKBONE OF THE TRANSPORT SYSTEM WITHIN THE TUEN MUN NEW TOWN, AND WILL PROVIDE THE MAJOR LINK BETWEEN TUEN MUN AND YUEN LONG, THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR DAVID FORD, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

SPEAKING AT A CEREMONY MARKING COMPLETION OF PHASE I OF THE LRT SYSTEM -- THE FIRST OF ITS KIND IN HONG KONG, SIR DAVID NOTED THE TUEN MUN-YUEN LONG CORRIDOR HAD A LONG HISTORY AS A MAJOR COMMUNICATION ROUTE TO THE HINTERLAND.

HE SAID OVER THE YEARS, TUEN MUN HAD BECOME AN EMERGING NEW TOWN LARGELY BUILT ON VIRGIN LAND WITH FULL TOWN PLANNING CONTROL.

MEANWHILE, YUEN LONG HAD EVOLVED GRADUALLY FROM A RURAL MARKET TOWN INTO AN URBANISED TOWNSHIP, AND YET RETAINING ITS RICH CULTURAL HERITAGE AND LOCAL CHARACTERISTICS.

"THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT SYSTEM WILL PROVIDE AN EXCELLENT COMMUNICATION LINK BETWEEN THESE TWO NEIGHBOURING COMMUNITIES," SIR DAVID SAID.

SIR DAVID ALSO NOTED THAT WHEN TIN SHUI WAI JOINED THE LEAGUE OF NEW TOWNS IN THE AREA, IT WOULD HELP TO FOSTER THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE NORTHWEST NEW TERRITORIES INTO A MAJOR REGIONAL COMMUNITY.

"SO, THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT SYSTEM IS NOT ONLY SIGNIFICANT AS A MEANS OF TRANSPORTATION, BUT IT ALSO SERVES A WIDER COMMUNITY PURPOSE," HE SAID.

REFERRING TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE LRT SYSTEM, SIR DAVID SAID IT WAS ALMOST A DECADE AGO THAT THE GOVERNMENT FIRST CONCEIVED THE IDEA OF DEVELOPING AN EFFICIENT, COMFORTABLE AND POLLUTION-FREE TRANSPORT SYSTEM TO CATER FOR THE NEEDS OF THE DEVELOPING NEW TOWNS IN THE NORTHWEST NEW TERRITORIES REGION.

IN 1984, THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY CORPORATION TOOK ON THE RESPONSIBILITY TO CONSTRUCT AND OPERATE THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT.

SIR DAVID RECALLED THAT THE TURN-KEY CONTRACT FOR THE LRT PROJECT, INCLUDING THE DESIGN, MANUFACTURE, INSTALLATION AND CONSTRUCTION OF THE WHOLE PHASE I OF THE SYSTEM, WAS AWARDED TO LEIGHTON MTA CONSORTIUM OF AUSTRALIA IN AUGUST 1985, WITH A COMPLETION DATE SCHEDULED ON AUGUST 8, THIS YEAR.

UNDER THE CONTRACT, THE CONSORTIUM WAS ALSO RESPONSIBLE FOR THE SUPPLY OF 70 LIGHT RAIL VEHICLES, THE OVERHEAD LINE SYSTEM, COMMUNICATION AND CONTROL EQUIPMENT, FARE COLLECTION EQUIPMENT AND WORKSHOP EQUIPMENT.

"THE CONTRACT WAS COMPLEX AND EXTENSIVE, REQUIRING A MULTI-DISCIPLINARY APPROACH AND A HIGH LEVEL OF CO-ORDINATION AT ALL LEVELS OF THE PLANNING, DESIGN AND INSTALLATION PROCESS," SIR DAVID SAID.

"IT IS A GREAT ACHIEVEMENT THAT SUCH A COMPLEX CONTRACT OF SUCH A SIZE HAS BEEN COMPLETED ON SCHEDULE."

HE CONGRATULATED BOTH THE KCRC AND THE CONSORTIUM AND ALL THE MANY PEOPLE INVOLVED FOR THEIR EFFORTS IN BRINGING THE PROJECT TO FRUITION.

BROADCASTING TOWER TO BE REPLACED

* * * * *

THE FINANCE COMMITTEE HAS APPROVED A FURTHER SUM OF \$13.32 MILLION FOR THE PROVISION OF VERY HIGH FREQUENCY (VHF) RADIO SERVICES IN HONG KONG.

THE FUNDING WILL COVER THE CONSTRUCTION OF A REPLACEMENT BROADCASTING TOWER ON MOUNT GOUGH, AND INCREASED EXPENSES ON THE MAIN TRANSMISSION EQUIPMENT AND ASSOCIATED CIVIL WORKS.

SEVEN VHF RADIO SERVICES WILL BE PROVIDED UNDER THE VHF RADIO SERVICES SCHEME, THE BUDGET OF WHICH IS BROUGHT UP TO \$45.333 MILLION BY THE ADDITIONAL FUNDING.

WITH THE BROADCASTING TOWER ON MOUNT GOUGH REPLACED, ADDITIONAL ANTENNAE PROPOSED FOR RADIO TELEVISION HONG KONG WILL BE INSTALLED.

THE NEW TOWER WILL ALLOW FOR DEVELOPMENT OF THE POLICE BEAT RADIO SYSTEM. THIS ALSO NECESSITATES EXTRA ANTENNAE TO BE FIXED TO THE TOWER.

A DESIGN STUDY, UNDERTAKEN BY A COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS FIRM IN MARCH THIS YEAR, SHOWED THAT THE ADDITION OF 12 ANTENNA PANELS FOR THE VHF SCHEME WOULD HAVE EXCEEDED THE LOAD LIMITS OF THE PRESENT TOWER.

THE FIRM FURTHER ADVISED THAT THE EXISTING MAST COULD NOT BE STRENGTHENED SATISFACTORILY OR ECONOMICALLY, AND REPLACEMENT WAS THEREFORE NECESSARY.

THE EXISTING 41-METRE TOWER HAS BEEN IN USE SINCE 1960 FOR FREQUENCY MODULATION (FM) BROADCASTING.

VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE TO START IN SHA TIN

THIS YEAR'S VOTER REGISTRATION DRIVE IN SHA TIN WILL BE LAUNCHED TOMORROW (MONDAY).

SPOKESMAN FOR THE SHA TIN DISTRICT OFFICE SAID THE GENERAL REGISTRATION DRIVE WOULD LAST UNTIL THE END OF NEXT MONTH.

"EFFORTS WILL BE CONCENTRATED IN PROMOTING REGISTRATION IN HOUSING ESTATES WITH LARGE NUMBER OF RESIDENTS MOVING IN, SUCH AS HENG ON ESTATE, CHEVALIER GARDEN, KAM ON COURT, HIN KENG ESTATE AND CITY ONE," HE SAID.

"AT LEAST 10 LIAISON OFFICERS AND 12 COMMUNITY ORGANISERS HAVE BEEN TASKED TO HELP RESIDENTS REGISTER DURING THE CAMPAIGN PERIOD.

"RESIDENTS CAN ALSO GET REGISTRATION FORMS FROM THE SHA TIN DISTRICT OFFICE, THE DISTRICT OFFICE'S PUBLIC ENQUIRY CENTRES AT KCR HOUSE AND HENG ON ESTATE, THE EIGHT ESTATE COMMUNITY CENTRES AND ALL PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE OFFICES IN THE DISTRICT.

"THEY CAN SIMPLY FILL IN THE FORMS AND PUT THEM IN POST BOXES. THE FORMS WILL BE AUTOMATICALLY SENT TO THE REGISTRATION AND ELECTORAL DIVISION AND NO POSTAL FEE IS NEEDED."

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT ACCORDING TO THE 1987 FINAL REGISTER, THERE WERE 90,294 REGISTERED VOTERS IN SHA TIN.

"WITH THE RAPID GROWTH OF POPULATION IN SHA TIN, WE MUST EMPHASISE THAT RESIDENTS MUST REGISTER THEIR PRESENT RESIDENTIAL ADDRESS IF THEY WANT TO VOTE IN THE SHA TIN CONSTITUENCIES IN THE URBAN COUNCIL/REGIONAL COUNCIL ELECTIONS NEXT MARCH," HE SAID.

GENERALLY SPEAKING, PEOPLE WHO HAVE ATTAINED THE AGE OF 21 YEARS BEFORE DECEMBER 31, 1988 AND HAVE LIVED IN HONG KONG FOR SEVEN YEARS CAN REGISTER AS A VOTER.

DB COMMITTEE TO DISCUSS CHANGE IN DRIVING LICENCES

THE TRAFFIC AND TRANSPORT COMMITTEE OF THE SOUTHERN DISTRICT BOARD WILL DISCUSS A TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT PROPOSAL TO REMOVE THE DRIVER'S PHOTOGRAPH FROM DRIVING LICENCES AT ITS MEETING TOMORROW (MONDAY).

A SENIOR TRANSPORT OFFICER, MR LEUNG WING-HONG, WILL BRIEF MEMBERS ON THE EFFECTS THAT THE NEW MEASURE WILL BRING ABOUT ON MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

THE COMMITTEE WILL ALSO CONSIDER THE LAYOUT PLAN OF A CARPARK AT ABERDEEN WATERFRONT NEAR THE FERRY PIERS WHICH WILL BE CONSTRUCTED IN CONNECTION WITH THE TIN WAN INTERCHANGE PROJECT IN 1989.

DURING THE MEETING, QUESTIONS WILL BE RAISED ON THE TRAFFIC PROBLEMS CREATED BY KERBSIDE LOADING AND UNLOADING ACTIVITIES OUTSIDE FULLAGAR INDUSTRIAL BUILDING AND THE RELOCATION OF A NON-STOPPING RESTRICTION SIGN IN ABERDEEN MAIN ROAD.

ANOTHER ITEM ON THE AGENDA IS THE 1987 ACTION PROGRAMME REVIEW ON PEDESTRIAN PROBLEM SPOTS IN SOUTHERN DISTRICT.

NOMINATIONS INVITED FOR COMMONWEALTH YOUTH SERVICE AWARDS

NOMINATIONS ARE NOW OPEN FOR YOUNG PEOPLE WHO HAVE PLANNED AND CARRIED OUT OUTSTANDING COMMUNITY PROJECTS TO REPRESENT HONG KONG IN THE COMMONWEALTH YOUTH SERVICE AWARDS SCHEME.

THE SCHEME WAS LAUNCHED BY THE COMMONWEALTH YOUTH PROGRAMME IN THE UNITED KINGDOM IN 1985 AS AN ENDURING COMMEMORATION OF THE INTERNATIONAL YOUTH YEAR.

/IN HONG KONG,

IN HONG KONG, THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION IS CO-ORDINATING THE SELECTION OF THE BEST TWO COMMUNITY PROJECTS TO REPRESENT THE TERRITORY.

"THE SCHEME WAS CREATED TO RECOGNISE AND REWARD CONTRIBUTIONS MADE BY YOUNG PEOPLE TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF THEIR SOCIETIES," A CNTA SPOKESMAN SAID.

"IT AIMS TO FOSTER CO-OPERATION AND EXCHANGE OF IDEAS AND EXPERIENCES AMONG YOUNG PEOPLE OF THE COMMONWEALTH," HE SAID.

EACH YEAR, THE SCHEME OFFERS UP TO FIVE AWARDS WITH NOT MORE THAN TWO AWARDS TO COUNTRIES OF ANY ONE REGION.

THE WINNING TEAM WILL BE GIVEN A GRANT OF 1,000 POUND STERLING TO BE USED TO FURTHER THE TEAM'S WORK PLUS A MEDALLION AND CERTIFICATE TO BE AWARDED TO EACH MEMBER OF THE TEAM.

FOR PROJECTS TO BE SELECTED, THEY SHOULD BE EXAMPLES OF EFFECTIVE TEAM WORK BY A SMALL GROUP OF YOUNG PEOPLE, NORMALLY NOT MORE THAN 20 PEOPLE AGED BETWEEN 15 AND 24, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

"THESE PROJECTS SHOULD DEMONSTRATE THEIR POTENTIAL IN EFFECTIVE PLANNING, ABILITY TO EXECUTE THEIR PLANS AND CO-OPERATION AMONG MEMBERS," HE ADDED.

"PARTICIPANTS SHOULD BE ABLE TO ACHIEVE BROAD OBJECTIVES AND RESPOND TO LOCAL NEEDS THROUGH THEIR PROJECTS, SHOWING INNOVATION AND FLEXIBILITY.

"IN ADDITION, THE PROJECTS SHOULD HAVE LONG-TERM EFFECTIVENESS AND PROVIDE A MODEL OR INSPIRATION TO OTHER PLACES IN THE COMMONWEALTH," HE SAID.

NOMINATIONS ARE BEING INVITED FROM THE CHILDREN AND YOUTH DIVISION OF THE HONG KONG COUNCIL OF SOCIAL SERVICE, THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT AND THE DISTRICT OFFICES. THEY SHOULD REACH THE CNTA BY NOVEMBER 18 THIS YEAR.

TWO PROJECTS WILL BE SELECTED TO REPRESENT HONG KONG IN DECEMBER AND THE AWARDS WILL BE ANNOUNCED IN APRIL NEXT YEAR.

NEW SCOREBOARD SYSTEM FOR HK STADIUM

* * * *

A MUCH LARGER COMPUTER-CONTROLLED ELECTRONIC SCOREBOARD SYSTEM WILL BE INSTALLED AT THE HONG KONG STADIUM TO REPLACE THE EXISTING MECHANICAL CLOCK DISPLAY WHICH HAS BEEN IN USE FOR OVER 30 YEARS.

WORK HAS BEGUN FOLLOWING THE RECENT AWARD OF A \$5.2 MILLION CONTRACT FOR THE SUPPLY AND INSTALLATION OF THE SOPHISTICATED MULTI-FUNCTION SYSTEM BY THE ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

IT IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BEFORE FEBRUARY 15 NEXT YEAR.

EMSD ELECTRONICS ENGINEER, MR Y.W. TSANG, SAID THE NEW DISPLAY BOARD WOULD MEASURE 15 METRES WIDE BY EIGHT METRES HIGH. "IT WILL CONSIST OF AN ANALOGUE REAL TIME CLOCK, A 45-MINUTE SOCCER CLOCK, A DIGITAL GAME CLOCK, AND A 112 BY 160 DOTS DISPLAY MATRIX," HE SAID.

"IT CAN DISPLAY BOTH CHINESE CHARACTERS AND ENGLISH LETTERS, SOCCER SCORES, TIMING AND SCORES FOR TRACK AND FIELD EVENTS.

"IT CAN ALSO PERMIT SIMPLE ANIMATION AND GRAPHIC DISPLAY FOR PRESENTING ANNOUNCEMENTS AND ADVERTISEMENT."

MR TSANG ADDED THAT INSTEAD OF USING CONVENTIONAL INCANDESCENT LAMPS AS DISPLAY ELEMENTS, THE DISPLAY BOARD WOULD EMPLOY REFLECTIVE DISPLAY ELEMENTS -- A NEW DISPLAY TECHNOLOGY WITH MAJOR ADVANTAGES OF LOWER POWER CONSUMPTION, LONGER LIFETIME AND WIDER VIEWING ANGLE.

DOLPHINS FOR NEW SHAU KEI WAN TYPHOON SHELTER

THE GOVERNMENT INTENDS TO CONSTRUCT DOLPHINS FOR THE NEW SHAU KEI WAN TYPHOON SHELTER TO PROVIDE CONTROL OVER THE MOORING AND MOVEMENT OF VESSELS WITHIN THE SHELTER.

THE WORK WILL BE CARRIED OUT WITHIN THE LIMIT OF APPROXIMATELY 1.705 HECTARES OF FORESHORE AND SEABED NORTH OF THE EXISTING ALDRICH BAY TYPHOON SHELTER.

WORK IS EXPECTED TO COMMENCE IN FEBRUARY NEXT YEAR AND TAKE ABOUT ONE YEAR TO COMPLETE.

TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURES IN SHA TIN

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED THAT SECTIONS OF LION ROCK TUNNEL ROAD SOUTHBOUND WILL BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED TO TRAFFIC DURING THE NIGHT TIME FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE WORK.

DETAILS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

- * A 20-METRE LONG SLOW LANE NEAR SUN TIN WAI ESTATE WILL BE CLOSED FROM 9.30 PM TO 6 AM THE FOLLOWING DAY ON AUGUST 10 (WEDNESDAY) AND 11.
- * A 80-METRE LONG FAST LANE NEAR SUN TIN WAI ESTATE WILL BE CLOSED FROM 9.30 PM ON AUGUST 13 TO 6 AM THE NEXT MORNING.
- * THE SLOW LANE SOUTH OF SUN TIN WAI ESTATE, WITH A LENGTH OF ABOUT 50 METRES, WILL BE CLOSED BETWEEN 9.30 PM AND 6 AM THE NEXT DAY ON AUGUST 18 AND 19.
- * THE SLOW LANE NEAR HUNG MUI KUK INTERCHANGE, WITH A LENGTH OF ABOUT 60 METRES, WILL BE CLOSED FROM 9.30 PM TO 6 AM THE NEXT MORNING ON AUGUST 23 AND 24.
