## NEW CENTRE FOR AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL

\* \* \* \* \*

A NEW SOPHISTICATED AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL CENTRE AT KAI TAK, HONG KONG'S INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, WILL BE COMMISSIONED ON WEDNESDAY (JUNE 4) AFTER TWO MONTHS' OPERATIONAL EVALUATION.

THE CENTRE IS EQUIPPED WITH ADVANCED AND MODERN ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT FOR AIR TRAFFIC CONTROLLERS TO DIRECT AIRCRAFT WITHIN HONG KONG'S FLIGHT INFORMATION REGION/AREA OF RESPONSIBILITY.

INSIDE THE NEW CENTRE ARE VARIOUS TYPES OF RADAR SCREENS AND RADIO COMMUNICATION SYSTEMS.

THEY INCLUDE TWO PRECISION APPROACH DISPLAYS FOR SHOWING SHORT-RANGE RADAR INFORMATION FROM THE PRECISION APPROACH RADAR, AND THREE VERTICAL DISPLAYS FOR THE APPROACH SURVEILLANCE RADAR.

THE PRECISION APPROACH RADAR COVERS A RANGE OF 16 KILOMETRES OF THE FINAL APPROACH WHILE THE APPROACH SURVEILLANCE RADAR COVERS SOME 60 NAUTICAL MILES.

THERE ARE THREE OTHER HORIZONTAL RADAR DISPLAYS FOR SCREENING DATA COLLECTED BY THE ROUTE SURVEILLANCE RADAR AND THE SECONDARY SURVEILLANCE RADAR WHICH COVER A RANGE OF OVER 250 NAUTICAL MILES.

A NETWORK OF CLOSED CIRCUIT TELEVISION PROVIDES THE CONTROLLERS WITH WEATHER AND WINDSHEAR INFORMATION AS WELL AS AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL CLEARANCE INFORMATION.

THERE ARE ALSO OVERHEAD STATIC DISPLAYS OF AIR ROUTES, APPROACH AND DEPARTURE PROCEDURES AND NAVIGATION AID INFORMATION.

+THE NEW CENTRE IS SIMILAR IN FUNCTION TO THE EXISTING ONE EXCEPT THAT IT PROVIDES MORE CONTROL POSITIONS AND AN INCREASED NUMBER OF AIR-TO-GROUND RADIO COMMUNICATION CHANNELS AS WELL AS IMPROVED INTERNAL COMMUNICATION WITHIN THE CENTRE AND BETWEEN THE CENTRE AND THE CONTROL TOWER,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE AIR TRAFFIC SERVICES DIVISION SAID.

+IT IS MORE ROOMY AND PROVIDES A BETTER WORKING ENVIRONMENT FOR THE AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL STAFF,+ HE ADDED.

THE CENTRE PROVIDES VARIOUS TYPES OF AIR TRAFFIC CONTROL FUNCTIONS FOR IN-COMING AND OUT-GOING FLIGHTS, INCLUDING APPROACH AND DEPARTURE CONTROL, AREA CONTROL, FLIGHT INFORMATION AND ALERTING SERVICES.

GETTING WELL THROUGH OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY

\* \* \* \*

A HALF-PARALYSED MAN ABLE TO COOK FOR HIMSELF, A DRIVER WITH HAND AND LEG INJURIES ABLE TO DRIVE AGAIN .... THESE ARE ONLY TWO EXAMPLES OF WHAT OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY CAN DO TO REHABILITATE PATIENTS SUFFERING FROM DISABILITIES.

LAST YEAR, OVER 13 000 OF THEM, REPRESENTING AN INCREASE OF 11 PER CENT OVER THE PREVIOUS YEAR, WERE THUS TREATED.

+OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY IS INCREASINGLY AVAILABLE IN HOSPITALS, OUT-PATIENT CLINICS, REHABILITATION CENTRES AND OTHER MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS IN HONG KONG,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY.

IT CAN BE APPLIED TO PHYSICAL OR PSYCHIATRIC ILLNESSES AND TREATMENT VARIES WIDELY DEPENDING ON INDIVIDUAL NEEDS. IN GENERAL, PATIENTS MAY BE ASKED TO ENGAGE IN ANY ONE OF A NUMBER OF ACTIVITIES SUCH AS HANDICRAFT, COOKERY, CLERICAL WORK OR RECREATIONAL PURSUITS.

THE AIM IS TO HELP THEM ATTAIN MAXIMUM PHYSICAL AND PSYCHOLOGICAL RECOVERY SO THAT THEY CAN AGAIN CONTRIBUTE CONSTRUCTIVELY TO THE COMMUNITY AND LIVE HAPPY, PURPOSEFUL LIVES, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY IS CONCERNED WITH THE PATIENT AS A WHOLE, NOT MERELY HIS INJURY. IN PRESCRIBING TREATMENT, HIS AGE, SEX, SOCIAL BACKGROUND, JOB REQUIREMENT AND EDUCATIONAL LEVEL ARE ALL TAKEN INTO ACCOUNT,+ HE SAID.

+THE BASIC OBJECTIVE IS TO ENABLE HIM TO RETURN TO HIS PREVIOUS JOB BUT WHEN THE INJURY IS SUCH THAT THIS IS NOT POSSIBLE, HIS MENTAL AND PHYSICAL FITNESS IS ASSESSED FOR A TOTALLY DIFFERENT, YET ACCEPTABLE AND REWARDING ACTIVITY, OR FOR TRAINING IN A NEW OCCUPATION,+ HE EXPLAINED.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT THE HONG KONG POLYTECHNIC HAS STARTED A TRAINING SCHEME IN OCTOBER, 1978 TO PREPARE YOUNG PEOPLE FOR A CAREER IN THIS PARAMEDICAL FIELD.

THE THREE YEAR COURSE COVERS MEDICAL SUBJECTS AND CLINICAL TRAINING IN WHICH THE STUDENT CAN GAIN AN INSIGHT INTO THE EFFECTS OF ILLNESS ON INDIVIDUALS OF DIFFERENT PERSONALITY AND BACKGROUND, AND OBTAIN EXPERIENCE IN OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY TECHNIQUES.

THE SCOPE OF OCCUPATIONAL THERAPY IS LIMITLESS, RESTRICTED ONLY BY THE INDIVIDUAL ABILITY AND INITIATIVE OF THE THERAPIST -- AND THE COOPERATION OF THE PATIENT, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

AS A MEMBER OF THE TREATMENT TEAM, THE OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST HAS AN IMPORTANT CONTRIBUTION TO MAKE TOWARDS THE SUCCESSFUL REHABILITATION OF THE PATIENT, HE STRESSED.

SOCIAL STUDIES DESERVE GREATER EMPHASIS

THE DIRECTOR OF EDUCATION, MR KENNETH TOPLEY, TODAY CALLED UPON SCHOOL HEADS TO TAKE THE SUBJECT OF SOCIAL STUDIES SERIOUSLY.

HE WAS SPEAKING AT THE OPENING OF THE SHENG KUNG HUI TRINITY CHURCH SECONDARY SCHOOL AT OI MAN ESTATE IN HO MAN TIN, KOWLOON.

SOCIAL STUDIES, HE SAID, WAS NOT AN EASY SUBJECT TO DEVELOP IN A RESPONSIBLE BUT CLEAR MANNER BUT THE CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE WAS MAKING AN EFFORT TO CREATE A SYLLABUS FOR FORMS IV AND V WHICH WOULD BE CHALLENGING AND HAVE INTELLECTUAL BITE AND WHICH WOULD AT THE SAME TIME PROVIDE STUDENTS WITH A GENUINE PREPARATION FOR LIFE.

+IT IS BASICALLY A SUBJECT ABOUT RELATIONSHIPS, ABOUT COMMUNICATION, BUT IT MUST AT SOME STAGE GRAPPLE THE PROBLEMS OF HUMAN PERSONALITY. THIS IS PERHAPS THE HARDEST PART OF ALL,+ MR TOPLEY SAID.

WHAT IT MUST NOT BECOME, HE SAID, IS A LIST OF THE RAILWAY STATIONS ON THE WAY TO LO WU.

+OUR CHILDREN DESERVE A LOT BETTER THAN THAT. THEY DESERVE THE BEST POSSIBLE AID TO ENABLE THEM TO THINK ABOUT AND PERCEIVE INTELLIGENTLY THE OTHERWISE CONFUSING WORLD IN WHICH WE LIVE,+ HE SAID.

THE DIRECTOR SAID THAT THE OPENING OF THE NEW SCHOOL WAS YET ANOTHER MARK OF THE INVALUABLE CONTRIBUTION THE SHENG KUNG HUI HAD MADE TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF EDUCATION IN HONG KONG.

HE ALSO PRAISED THE PARISH COUNCIL OF THE HOLY TRINITY CHURCH AND THE SCHOOL BUILDING COMMITTEE FOR THEIR EARNEST DEDICATION AND UNFLAGGING ENTHUSIASM FOR THIS SCHOOL PROJECT.

A CONSTRUCTION WORKER WAS HIT ON THE HEAD BY A FALLING HAMMER AND A FACTORY OWNER YELLED AT HIS ACCOUNTANT BECAUSE OF RISING MEDICAL BILLS -- BUT EVERYBODY WAS LAUGHING AT THE END OF THE DAY.

WHY? WELL THE CONSTRUCTION WORKER WAS WEARING HIS SAFETY HELMET AND THE FACTORY BOSS INSTALLED SAFETY GUARDS ON ALL MACHINES TO SAVE HIS WORKERS FROM SUFFERING AND CUT HIS MEDICAL EXPENSES.

AND ANYWAY, ALL PLAYERS IN THESE SOMETIMES ALL TOO REAL DRAMA SITUATIONS WERE PUPPETS TAKING PART IN SHOWS AT HOUSING ESTATES TO GET THE INDUSTRIAL SAFETY MESSAGE ACROSS FOR THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT.

ORGANISED BY THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SERVICES, THE SHOWS ARE PART OF THE PUBLICITY PROGRAMMES ON VARIOUS THEMES PRESENTED BY THE DEPARTMENT'S MOBILE STREET THEATRE AND FILM VAN THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY A TOTAL OF SIX PROGRAMMES WOULD BE CONDUCTED THIS MONTH (JUNE) TO PUBLICISE INDUSTRIAL SAFETY.

+WE ARE GOING OUT OF OUR WAY TO REACH THE PEOPLE, ESPECIALLY WORKERS, AND TO DRAW THEIR ATTENTION, THROUGH ENTERTAINMENT, TO THE IMPORTANCE OF SAFETY AT WORK,+ HE ADDED.

THE FIRST PROGRAMME IS SCHEDULED FOR CHAI WAN TEMPORARY HOUSING AREA ON WEDNESDAY (JUNE 4) WITH THE VAN SHOWING TELEVISION FILMS AND SLIDES ON INDUSTRIAL SAFETY. IT WILL BE REPEATED AT KO CHIU ROAD ESTATE ON JUNE 11.

THE OTHER FOUR PROGRAMMES ARE VARIETY SHOWS, INCLUDING OUR INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENT-PRONE PUPPET FRIENDS, TO BE STAGED BY THE STREET THEATRE AT LOWER PAK TIN ESTATE, SHUN LEE TSUEN TEMPORARY HOUSING AREA, TAI HANG TUNG ESTATE AND MA TAU WAI ESTATE.

THE SPOKESMAN POINTED OUT THAT THE VAN AND THE STREET THEATRE HAD BEEN VISITING VARIOUS HOUSING ESTATES AND PUBLIC PLAYGROUNDS IN DENSELY POPULATED AREAS THROUGHOUT THE YEAR IN A BID TO GET THE INDUSTRIAL SAFETY MESSAGE ACROSS TO AS MANY PEOPLE AS POSSIBLE.

#### PIRATED TAPES AND RECORDS GO UP IN SMOKE \* \* \* \*

A LARGE QUANTITY OF PIRATED TAPES AND RECORDS SEIZED BY THE COPYRIGHT PROTECTION SUB-DIVISION OF THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE SERVICE WAS DESTROYED AT THE KENNEDY TOWN INCINERATOR.

THE GOODS, WORTH MORE THAN \$600 000 WERE CONFISCATED WHEN EIGHT CASES, PROSECUTED UNDER THE COPYRIGHT ORDINANCE AND THE MERCHANDISE MARKS ORDINANCE, WERE CONCLUDED RECENTLY.

FINES AMOUNTING TO \$46 450 AND A TOTAL 18 MONTHS IMPRISONMENT SENTENCE WERE IMPOSED ON 10 PERSONS FOR 34 OFFENCES INVOLVED IN THE CASES.

ITEMS DESTROYED INCLUDED 112 500 FORGED BLANK CASSETTE TAPES BEARING WELL-KNOWN JAPANESE BRANDS- 30 800 RECORDED MUSIC CASSETTE TAPES AND A QUANTITY OF INLAID CARDS AND LABELS.

LAST YEAR THE COPYRIGHT PROTECTION UNIT HANDLED 42 CASES CONNECTED WITH COPYRIGHT INFRINGEMENT, RESULTING IN THE SEIZURE OF 14 TAPE RECORDERS FOR PRODUCING CASSETTES, 505 RECORDS, 4 645 PIRATED TAPES AND 10 439 COPIES OF PIRATED BOOKS.

A TOTAL OF 31 PEOPLE WERE CONVICTED OF VARIOUS COPYRIGHT OFFENCES, AND FINES AMOUNTING TO \$97 815 WERE IMPOSED BY THE COURTS.

NTA WORKS SECTION HAS OWN LOGO

SIGNBOARDS AT PROJECTS OF THE NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION WORKS SECTION ARE NOW MORE EASILY RECOGNISABLE - THEY HAVE THEIR OWN DISTINCTIVE LOGO.

THE LOGO WAS DESIGNED BY THE WORKS SECTION ATTACHED TO YUEN LONG DISTRICT OFFICE AFTER A COMPETITION WHICH ATTRACTED 20 ENTRIES FROM ALL EIGHT DISTRICT OFFICES.

JUDGING WAS CARRIED OUT BY SENIOR NTA OFFICIALS, ONE OF WHOM SAID THAT THE LOGO COMBINED SIMPLICITY OF OUTLINE WITH SYMBOLISM.

ACCORDING TO THE DESIGNER, IT CLOSELY RESEMBLES THE CHINESE CHARACTER FOR +WORKS+. THE TOP LINE LOOKS LIKE A BRIDGE, WHEREAS THE VERTICAL LINE REPRESENTS THE FLOW OF WATER IN A STREAM. THE HORIZONTAL LINE STANDS FOR A PATH OR A ROAD.

THIS YEAR, THE BUDGET FOR THE LOCAL PUBLIC WORKS VOTE OF THE NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION IS ABOUT \$8 MILLION. AT PRESENT THE WORKS SECTION IS HANDLING 100 PROJECTS AND HOPES TO COMPLETE 600 TO 700 DURING THIS FINANCIAL YEAR.

CURRENT PROJECTS INCLUDE THE TUNG CHUNG FOOTBRIDGE ON LANTAU, A CHINESE STYLE PAVILION AT SHAM TSENG AND WORK AT THE TAI MEI TUK WATER SPORTS CENTRE NEAR TAI PO.

THE MUSIC OFFICE AND THE CHEUNG CHAU CULTURAL AND RECREATIONAL ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION IS JOINTLY ORGANISING A +MUSIC FOR THE MILLIONS+ CONCERT ON CHEUNG CHAU THIS SATURDAY (JUNE 7).

THE CONCERT, THE FIRST OF ITS KIND TO BE GIVEN ON THE ISLAND BY THE OFFICE'S INSTRUCTOR ORCHESTRA, WILL BE HELD AT THE CARITAS ST PAUL PREVOCAIONAL SCHOOL BEGINNING AT 7.30 PM.

FREE ADMISSION TICKETS ARE AVAILABLE AT THE CHEUNG CHAU RURAL COMMITTEE ON A FIRST-COME-FIRST-SERVED BASIS.

REPLACEMENTS FOR OLD RAILWAY BRIDGES

\* \* \* \* \*

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF TWO RAILWAY BRIDGES AT WATERLOO ROAD AND PRINCE EDWARD ROAD.

THE PRESTRESSED CONCRETE BRIDGES, WHICH FORM PART OF THE MODERNISATION AND ELECTRIFICATION OF THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY WILL REPLACE THE TWO EXISTING ONES AT THE SAME LOCATIONS.

THEY WILL BE BUILT AND BROUGHT INTO USE IN STAGES IN ORDER NOT TO INTERRUPT THE RAILWAY TRAFFIC.

+THE NEW BRIDGES HAVE BEEN SO DESIGNED THAT THE ODD ARRANGEMENT OF THE EXISTING BRIDGE PIERS IS ELIMINATED, THUS ENABLING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE MUCH NEEDED ROAD IMPROVEMENT SCHEMES AROUND THESE AREAS,+ A PWD SPOKESMAN SAID.

A COVERED FOOTBRIDGE WILL BE INCORPORATED INTO EACH RAILWAY BRIDGE DESIGN TO PROVIDE AN ELEVATED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING OVER THE MAIN ROAD. THIS WILL FURTHER HELP TO IMPROVE THE TRAFFIC FLOW.

WORK ON THE PROJECT WILL START IN AUGUST AND BE COMPLETED IN EARLY 1982.

THE PROJECT HAS BEEN DESIGNED AND CONSTRUCTION WILL BE SUPERVISED BY THE RAILWAY DIVISION OF THE PWD CIVIL ENGINEERING OFFICE, ON BEHALF OF THE KOWLOON-CANTON RAILWAY.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS ON STUBBS ROAD

THE SECTION OF STUBBS ROAD BETWEEN THE ROUNDABOUT AND A POINT 300 METRES DOWNHILL WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC EACH NIGHT FROM 12.30 AM TO 5.30 AM FROM TUESDAY TO FRIDAY (JUNE 3 TO 6) AND AGAIN FROM JUNE 10 TO 13 AND ON JUNE 16, FOR THE FLYOVER CONSTRUCTION.

ACCESS TO TUNG SHAN TERRACE AND CRAIGMONT WILL BE POSSIBLE FROM THE LOWER SECTION OF STUBBS ROAD.

NORTH-BOUND OR SOUTH-BOUND TRAFFIC SHOULD USE TAI HANG ROAD OR BLUE POOL ROAD AS ALTERNATIVE ROUTES.

DURING THE PERIODS OF CLOSURE, THE LAST NO. 6 BUS FROM STANLEY TO CENTRAL DISTRICT WILL BE DIVERTED FROM WONG NAI CHUNG GAP ROAD TO QUEEN'S ROAD EAST VIA TAI HANG ROAD, BLUE POOL ROAD, SHING WOO ROAD, KING KWONG STREET AND WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD.

TRAFFIC SIGNS WILL BE PUT UP TO GUIDE MOTORISTS.
