TAXIS FOR LANTAU

* * *

LANTAU ISLAND WILL HAVE ITS OWN TAXIS SOON, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY.

+THIS IS TO MEET STRONG LOCAL DEMAND FROM RESIDENTS AS WELL AS TOURISTS FOR A MORE PERSONALISED FORM OF TRANSPORT, AND ALSO AS AN ALTERNATIVE TO PRIVATE CARS AND PRIVATE HIRE CARS, THE NUMBERS OF WHICH ARE REGULATED ON THE ISLAND,+ HE ADDED.

THIS WAS ENDORSED BY THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL TODAY WHEN IT MADE CERTAIN AMENDMENTS TO THE ROAD TRAFFIC (PUBLIC SERVICE VEHICLES) REGULATIONS AND THE ROAD TRAFFIC (REGISTRATION AND LICENSING OF VEHICLES) REGULATIONS.

CURRENT LEGISLATION APPLICABLE TO HONG KONG AND KOWLOON TAXIS AND NEW TERRITORIES TAXIS GENERALLY WILL APPLY TO LANTAU TAXIS.

THE FARE CHARGES WILL BE THE SAME AS FOR NEW TERRITORIES TAXIS.

THE SPOKESMAN STATED THAT ALTHOUGH 20 LANTAU TAXIS WILL INITIALLY BE REGISTERED, THE NUMBER WILL BE REVIEWED SIX MONTHS AFTER COMMENCEMENT OF OPERATION.

THE RIGHT TO REGISTER THESE TAXIS WOULD BE BY OPEN TENDER TO BE ANNOUNCED SHORTLY BY NOTICE IN THE GAZETTE.

DUE TO ROAD CONDITIONS IN PARTS OF LANTAU, CLOSED ROAD PERMITS ISSUED TO LANTAU TAXIS WILL INITIALLY RESTRICT THEIR OPERATION TO SOUTH LANTAU (I.E. ALL ROADS IN LANTAU EXCEPT THE ACCESS ROAD LEADING FROM SHAM WAT ROAD TO PO LIN MONASTERY IN NGONG PING).

THE NEW TAXIS WILL BE BLUE IN COLOUR WITH A WHITE ROOF. AS WITH OTHER VEHICLES REGISTERED AND LICENSED TO OPERATE ON LANTAU ONLY, A LANTAU TAXI WILL BE CHARGED ONE QUARTER OF THE ANNUAL LICENCE FEE LEVIED ON HONG KONG AND KOWLOON TAXIS.

CONCURRENT WITH THE CREATION OF LANTAU TAXIS, AN AMENDMENT HAS BEEN MADE TO THE REGULATIONS RELATING TO REGISTERING AND LICENSING OF NEW TERRITORIES TAXIS TO DISPENSE WITH THE REQUIREMENT FOR APPLICANTS TO HAVE HELD A DRIVING LICENCE FOR A PRIVATE CAR FOR AT LEAST THREE YEARS.

THE SPOKESMAN

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT THE OPPORTUNITY HAS BEEN TAKEN TO REMOVE FROM THE DRIVING LICENCE REGULATIONS THE SEPARATE DRIVING ENTITLEMENTS OF HONG KONG AND KOWLOON TAXIS AND NEW TERRITORIES TAXIS.

FROM DECEMBER 17, 1982, THERE WILL BE ONLY ONE DRIVING ENTITLEMENT OF +TAXI+.

THE EFFECT OF THIS CHANGE WILL BE THAT HOLDERS OF EXISTING DRIVING LICENCES FOR HONG KONG AND KOWLOON TAXIS AND NEW TERRITORIES TAXIS WILL BE ALLOWED TO DRIVE ALL TYPES OF TAXIS INCLUDING LANTAU TAXIS UNTIL THE RENEWAL OF THEIR DRIVING LICENCES WHEN BOTH ENTITLEMENTS WILL BE REPLACED BY THE NEW ENTITLEMENT.

WITH IMMEDIATE EFFECT, NO FURTHER APPLICATIONS FOR NEW TERRITORIES TAXI DRIVING LICENCE WILL BE ACCEPTED. AS FROM FEBRUARY 1, 1983, ALL CANDIDATES FOR TAXI DRIVING LICENCE IRRESPECTIVE OF WHETHER THEY HAVE APPLIED AND HAVE BEEN ACCEPTED FOR HONG KONG AND KOWLOON TAXI DRIVING LICENCE OR NEW TERRITORIES TAXI DRIVING LICENCE WILL HAVE TO TAKE A COMPOSITE WRITTEN TEST WHICH WILL CONSIST OF:

- (A) HIGHWAY CODES;
- (B) RELEVANT TAXI REGULATIONS; AND
- (C) LOCATIONS ON HONG KONG ISLAND, KOWLOON AND NEW TERRITORIES, INCLUDING LANTAU ISLAND.

FOR THE INTERIM PERIOD UP TO AND INCLUDING JANUARY 31, 1983, CANDIDATES WILL TAKE, APART FROM HIGHWAY CODES AND RELEVANT TAXI REGULATIONS, THE LOCATION PAPER ON THE AREAS RELATING TO THEIR ORIGINAL APPLICATION.

SHA TIN TO LEAD REVIVAL OF BICYCLING

* * * *

SHA TIN IS THE ONLY DISTRICT IN HONG KONG WITH A COMPREHENSIVE CYCLE TRACK PLAN FOR TRANSPORTATION.

AND THE DISTRICT OFFICER, MR DONALD TSANG, IS CONFIDENT THAT PEOPLE IN THE NEW TOWN WILL ACCEPT BICYCLES AS A POLLUTION-FREE AND HEALTHY MODE OF TRANSPORT WITHIN THE DISTRICT.

SPEAKING AT A DINNER MEETING OF THE LIONS CLUB OF NEW TERRITORIES TONIGHT (TUESDAY), MR TSANG RECALLED THAT IN 1975 MR DAVID AKERS-JONES HAD PROPOSED A COORDINATED CYCLE TRACK SYSTEM FOR COMMUTERS.

THEN IN NOVEMBER 1978, THE GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED ITS DECISION TO PLAN A CYCLE TRACK NETWORK FOR THE DEVELOPING AREAS OF THE NEW TERRITORIES, HE SAID.

IT WAS STRESSED THAT A CYCLE TRACK WOULD MAKE THE ROAD SAFER AND ADD A NEW DIMENSION TO RECREATION.

IN DECEMBER 1981, THE 5.2 KM INITIAL SYSTEM OF THE CYCLE TRACK LINKING TAI WAI AND FO TAN IN SHA TIN, WAS OPENED.

BASED ON THE LATEST PROPOSAL, THE CYCLE TRACK IN SHA TIN, WHEN COMPLETED, WILL BE 47.5 KM LONG AND 60 KM LONG IF MA ON SHAN IS INCLUDED.

THE PROPOSED SYSTEM WILL EXTEND ALONG BOTH SIDES OF THE SHING MUN RIVER AS PART OF THE RIVERSIDE PROMENADE PROJECT. THE PROPOSED TRACK ON THE NORTHERN BANK OF THE RIVER WILL RUN TO THE JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE. ON THE SOUTHERN BANK, PROVISIONALLY IT WILL RUN TO THE SIU LEK YUEN VALLEY.

MR TSANG SAID THAT THE CYCLE TRACKS IN SHA TIN WOULD LOOP AROUND THE TOWN, ALLOWING RESIDENTS TO CYCLE BETWEEN THEIR HOMES AND OFFICES, FACTORIES AND SCHOOLS.

+AND IT IS PLANNED THAT CYCLISTS WILL HAVE THEIR SEPARATE TRACKS ON THE COASTAL ROAD CONNECTING SHA TIN AND TAI PO,+ HE ADDED.

HE ALSO SPOKE OF SOME MINOR DIFFICULTIES IN DEVELOPING SUCH A COMPREHENSIVE CYCLE TRACK FOR TRANSPORT PURPOSES.

+AT PROBLEM JUNCTIONS, GUARDRAILS ARE REQUIRED TO PROTECT THE SAFETY OF BOTH CYCLISTS AND PEDESTRIANS WHO COMPETE FOR THE USE OF TRACKS,+ HE SAID.

+BESIDES, A NEW SET OF TRAFFIC AIDS AND SIGNS IS REQUIRED. AND A CYCLE TRACK CODE MAY ALSO BE NEEDED.+

HE SAID THE PROJECT MANAGER WILL HAVE TO BUILD CYCLE PARKS ALONG THE RIVER PROMENADES, FO TAN INDUSTRIAL AREA, TOWN CENTRE AND ALL TRANSPORT INTERCHANGES.

THE DISTRICT OFFICER ASSURED RESIDENTS THAT THEY COULD CYCLE SAFELY TO THEIR DESTINATIONS IN THE SAME TIME REQUIRED FOR WAITING A BUS.

TRADERS REMINDED ABOUT IMPORT AND EXPORT DECLARATIONS
* * * *

MANY IMPORTERS AND EXPORTERS APPEAR TO BE WASTING THEIR MONEY UNNECESSARILY ON PENALTY CHARGES FOR NOT SUBMITTING IMPORT OR EXPORT DECLARATIONS WITHIN THE ALLOWED PERIOD OF 14 DAYS, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY.

HE STRESSED THAT IMPORTERS AND EXPORTERS IN HONG KONG (INCLUDING INDIVIDUALS AND ORGANISATIONS NOT ENGAGED IN TRADE) ARE REQUIRED BY LAW TO SUBMIT IMPORT OR EXPORT DECLARATIONS COVERING ALL THEIR TRANSACTIONS (INCLUDING THOSE NOT FOR TRADE PURPOSES), OTHER THAN GOODS EXEMPTED UNDER REGULATION 3 OF THE IMPORT AND EXPORT (REGISTRATION) REGULATIONS, WITHIN 14 DAYS OF IMPORTATION OR EXPORTATION.

ANY IMPORT OR EXPORT DECLARATION SUBJECT TO PAYMENT OF AD VALOREM CHARGES SUBMITTED OUTSIDE THE PRESCRIBED PERIOD OF 14 DAYS WILL BE LIABLE TO PENALTY CHARGES WHICH RISE AFTER 2 MONTHS PLUS 14 DAYS TO A MAXIMUM OF \$100 PER DECLARATION WHERE THE TOTAL VALUE OF THE GOODS DOES NOT EXCEED \$20 000, AND TO A MAXIMUM OF \$200 PER DECLARATION WHERE THE TOTAL VALUE OF THE GOODS EXCEEDS \$20 000.

PROSECUTIONS MAY BE INITIATED AGAINST THOSE WHO, WITHOUT REASONABLE EXCUSE, FAIL TO LODGE THE NECESSARY IMPORT OR EXPORT DECLARATIONS.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THAT MANY OF THE PENALTY AND PROSECUTION CASES COULD HAVE BEEN AVOIDED IF THE DECLARANTS HAD LODGED THE IMPORT OR EXPORT DECLARATIONS WITHIN THE TIME ALLOWED. DECLARANTS MAY CONTACT THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DEPARTMENT AT TELEPHONE NUMBERS 5-455118, 5-444674, 5-436560 AND 5-439372 IF THEY HAVE ANY ENQUIRIES ABOUT LODGEMENT OF IMPORT AND EXPORT DECLARATIONS, HE SAID.

\$820 900 'LAI SEE' FOR NEEDY

NEW YEAR +LAI SEE+ PACKETS OF \$100 EACH WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO MORE THAN 8 000 NEEDY PEOPLE THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY FROM A LOCAL CHARITABLE FUND.

A TOTAL OF \$820 900 HAS BEEN ALLOCATED FOR THE DISTRIBUTION BY THE MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE OF THE TANG SHIU-KIN/HO TIM CHARITABLE FUND TO 2 347 WIDOWS OR WIDOWERS WITH DEPENDENT CHILDREN AND ON PUBLIC ASSISTANCE, 5 380 RESIDENTS OF HOMES AND HOSTELS FOR THE ELDERLY AND 482 ELDERLY PATIENTS OF THE TUNG WAH GROUP OF HOSPITALS.

ON THURSDAY (DECEMBER 16), THE FOUNDERS OF THE FUND, SIR SHIU-KIN TANG AND MR HO TIM, ACCOMPANIED BY THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR SELWYN ALLEYNE, WHO IS ALSO TRUSTEE OF THE FUND, WILL HELP DISTRIBUTE THE RED +LAI SEE+ PACKETS TO SOME 300 WIDOWED FAMILIES FROM HONG KONG ISLAND, AT THE TUNG WAH HOSPITAL AT 12 PO YAN STREET, HONG KONG, STARTING AT 3 PM.

OTHER MEMBERS OF THE FUND'S MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE WILL ALSO BE PRESENT, AS WILL TELEVISION ACTRESS MISS LEE SEE-KI AND MISS MONA FONG.

WIDOWED FAMILIES IN OTHER PARTS OF THE TERRITORY WILL RECEIVE THE +LAI SEE+ THROUGH THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT'S DISTRICT OFFICES.

RED PACKETS FOR RESIDENTS OF OLD PEOPLE'S HOMES AND HOSTELS AND THE TUNG WAH HOSPITALS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED BY THE INSTITUTIONS THEMSELVES.

THE FUND, ADMINISTERED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT, WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1977.

IT PROVIDES IMMEDIATE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO INDIVIDUALS OR FAMILIES IN COPING WITH HARDSHIPS ARISING FROM UNEXPECTED CIRCUMSTANCES, SUCH AS THE DEATH OF A BREADWINNER, AN ACCIDENT OR SUDDEN OR PROLONGED SERIOUS ILLNESS.

CASH GRANTS ARE ALSO PROVIDED FOR EDUCATION, PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT OR FOR MEDICAL TREATMENT, SPECIAL DIETS OR OTHER NEEDS.

GRANTS ARE ALSO GIVEN TO MEET SPECIAL NEEDS ARISING FROM PHYSICAL OR MENTAL DISABILITY OR CHRONIC ILLNESS AND THE BASIC NEEDS OF THOSE WHO DO NOT QUALIFY FOR PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

IN PARTICULAR, THE FUND HELPS VICTIMS OF NATURAL DISASTERS.

APPLICATIONS FOR ASSISTANCE FROM THE FUND CAN BE MADE TO THE TUNG WAH GROUP OF HOSPITALS, PO LEUNG KUK, THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT OR THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT.

SOCIAL WORKERS OF VOLUNTARY AGENCIES MAY ALSO REFER HARDSHIP CASES TO THE SECRETARY OF THE FUND OR THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE.

EXTENSION OF CARGO WORKING AREA AT TYPHOON SHELTER

THE HIGHWAYS OFFICE OF THE ENGINEERING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT IS TO EXTEND THE PRESENT PUBLIC CARGO WORKING AREA WITHIN THE RAMBLER CHANNEL TYPHOON SHELTER BY PAVING AND FENCING THE SITE.

THE LABOUR ADVISORY BOARD HELD ITS THIRD MEETING OF THE YEAR IN THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT TODAY (TUESDAY).

THE MEETING, WHICH WAS ATTENDED BY ALL EMPLOYEE REPRESENTATIVES AND FIVE EMPLOYER REPRESENTATIVES, DISCUSSED TWO MAIN TOPICS -

THE WAGE CEILING FOR NON-MANUAL EMPLOYEES IN THE EMPLOYMENT ORDINANCE, AND

THE MAXIMUM LEVEL OF COMPENSATION IN THE EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE AND THE PNEUMOCONIOSIS (COMPENSATION) ORDINANCE.

THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE BOARD WILL BE SUBMITTED TO THE GOVERNMENT FOR CONSIDERATION IN LINE WITH USUAL PRACTICE.

THE MEETING ALSO AGREED THAT AT THE END OF A BOARD MEETING A PRESS RELEASE SHOULD BE ISSUED ON THE TOPICS DISCUSSED AT THE MEETING.
