SAFE LOADING OF GOODS VEHICLE MUST NOT BE NEGLECTED

THE GOVERNMENT HAS ALWAYS BEEN CONCERNED WITH THE DEVELOPMENT AND SAFETY OF THE TRUCKING INDUSTRY AND HAS PUT MUCH EMPHASIS ON PROMOTING THE IMPORTANCE OF SAFE LOADING OF GOODS VEHICLES, THE ACTING COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, DR PANG HAU-CHUNG, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE "SAFE LOADING OF GOODS VEHICLES" EXHIBITION AND CARNIVAL, DR PANG SAID THE OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT ARE TO FOSTER THE CONCEPT OF SAFE LOADING AND TO PROMOTE PUBLIC KNOWLEDGE OF THE LOADING LEGISLATION AND CORRECT LOADING METHODS.

"WHILE IT IS IMPORTANT TO IMPROVE EFFICIENCY, OPERATIONAL SAFETY MUST NOT BE NEGLECTED. AS THE GOODS VEHICLES ALWAYS HAVE TO CARRY LARGE VOLUMES OF GOODS, THE CORRECTNESS OF LOADING METHODS WILL DIRECTLY AFFECT THE SAFETY OF DRIVERS AND OTHER ROAD USERS," HE SAID.

THUS, APART FROM ASSISTING THE TRUCKING INDUSTRY'S DEVELOPMENT THROUGH IMPROVING THE INFRASTRUCTURE, THE GOVERNMENT PUTS MUCH EMPHASIS ON PROMOTING THE IMPORTANCE OF SAFE LOADING, DR PANG SAID.

OTHER GUESTS OFFICIATING AT THE CEREMONY INCLUDED MRS MIRIAM LAU KIN-YEE, CHAIRMAN OF THE LEGCO PANEL ON TRANSPORT; MR ANDREW WELLS, KWAI TSING DISTRICT OFFICER; MR H AITKEN, DISTRICT COMMANDER OF KWAI TSING POLICE DISTRICT, AND MR DAVID THOMAS, SENIOR SUPPORT OFFICER/TRAFFIC, NEW TERRITORIES/SOUTH.

THE EXHIBITION AND CARNIVAL WAS JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT, THE HONG KONG CONTAINER TRACTOR ASSOCIATION, THE KOWLOON TRUCK MERCHANTS' ASSOCIATION AND THE GOODS VEHICLE FLEET OWNERS' ASSOCIATION, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF A NUMBER OF OTHER ASSOCIATIONS RELATED TO THE TRUCKING INDUSTRY.

THE MAIN THEMES OF THE EXHIBITION ARE TO PROMOTE THE IMPORTANCE OF USING SAFE LOADING METHODS, TO EXPLAIN THE LEGAL REQUIREMENTS REGARDING LOADING OF GOODS VEHICLES, TO PROVIDE GUIDELINES ON HOW TO LOAD GOODS SAFELY AND TO DEMONSTRATE HOW THE POLICE ENFORCE LEGISLATION RELATED TO LOADING OF VEHICLES.

TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT STAFF AND POLICE OFFICERS WERE AT THE EXHIBITION TO ANSWER PUBLIC ENQUIRIES. PAMPHLETS AND CODE OF PRACTICE WERE ALSO DISTRIBUTED.

HONG KONG PORT MAINTAINS ITS LEAD

\* \* \* \* \*

HONG KONG HAS MAINTAINED ITS POSITION AS THE WORLD'S BUSIEST CONTAINER PORT WITH A 22.6 PER CENT JUMP IN THROUGHPUT IN THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF THIS YEAR.

FIGURES RELEASED BY THE MARINE DEPARTMENT SHOW THAT THE PORT HANDLED 5.11 MILLION TEUS IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE YEAR, COMPARED WITH 4.17 MILLION IN THE FIRST SIX MONTHS OF 1993.

THE BIG RISE IN THROUGHPUT IS BECAUSE OF THE RAPID GROWTH OF THE CHINESE ECONOMY, PARTICULARLY IN SOUTHERN CHINA. SOME 60 PER CENT OF HONG KONG'S THROUGHPUT IS DESTINED FOR, OR COMES FROM, CHINA.

THE PORT HAS BEEN ABLE TO COPE WITH THE GROWTH IN TRAFFIC VOLUME, THANKS, IN PART, TO THE EARLY COMPLETION OF CONTAINER TERMINAL 8 ON STONECUTTERS ISLAND. THE FOURTH BERTH OF THE CONTAINER TERMINAL 8, ORIGINALLY SCHEDULED FOR COMPLETION NEXT FEBRUARY, BEGAN TAKING VESSELS IN JULY.

THIS HAS ENABLED THE KWAI CHUNG TERMINALS TO INCREASE THROUGHPUT BY 29.4 PER CENT TO A TOTAL OF 3.34 MILLION TEUS IN THE FIRST SIX MONTHS. BY CONTRAST, MID-STREAM OPERATIONS ROSE BY ONLY ONE PER CENT DURING THE PERIOD TO TOTAL 1.35 MILLION TEUS.

THE BIGGEST PERCENTAGE INCREASE WAS IN CONTAINERS HANDLED BY RIVER TRADE. THESE INCREASED BY 65.5 PER CENT TO 424,585 TEUS IN THE FIRST HALF OF THE YEAR.

THIS CONFIRMS THE INCREASING TREND AMONG SHIPPERS TO USE THE PEARL RIVER AS A "HIGHWAY" BETWEEN CHINESE CENTRES AND HONG KONG.

TO COPE WITH INCREASED RIVER TRADE, THE GOVERNMENT PLANS TO CALL TENDERS FROM PRIVATE COMPANIES TO BUILD AND OPERATE THE TERRITORY'S FIRST DEDICATED RIVER TRADE TERMINAL.

IT WILL BE SITED AT TUEN MUN, AND THE FIRST PHASE IS EXPECTED TO BE IN OPERATION IN 1997.

THE BIG RISE IN THROUGHPUT FOR THE WHOLE PORT MEANS THAT HONG KONG WILL HANDLE MORE THAN 10 MILLION TEUS THIS YEAR. THE QUESTION IS, HOW CLOSE WILL THE TOTAL APPROACH 11 MILLION?

#### BEDSPACE APARTMENT OPERATORS URGED TO REGISTER

\* \* \* \* \*

THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION (CNTA) HAS URGED ALL OPERATORS OF EXISTING BEDSPACE APARTMENTS TO APPLY FOR A CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION BEFORE THE REGISTRATION PERIOD ENDS IN A MONTH'S TIME.

AN ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF CNTA, MR TIM STEPHENSON, SAID OPERATORS WERE REQUIRED TO REGISTER WITH THE OFFICE OF THE LICENSING AUTHORITY (OLA) BEFORE NOVEMBER 30 OR FACE A FINE OR IMPRISONMENT.

HE SAID ANY PERSON WHO OPERATED A BEDSPACE APARTMENT WITHOUT A VALID CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION OR A LICENCE WOULD BE LIABLE ON CONVICTION TO A FINE OF \$100,000 AND IMPRISONMENT FOR TWO YEARS.

THE PERSON WILL ALSO BE LIABLE TO A FINE OF \$20,000 FOR EACH DAY DURING WHICH THE OFFENCE CONTINUES.

HE SAID A CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION WOULD INITIALLY EXEMPT A BEDSPACE APARTMENT FROM OBTAINING A LICENCE.

"UPON THE RENEWAL OF THE CERTIFICATE OF EXEMPTION AFTER ONE YEAR, OPERATORS WILL BE ADVISED OF THE UPGRADING REQUIREMENTS TO BE CARRIED OUT FOR A LICENCE TO BE ISSUED," HE ADDED.

OPERATORS WILL THEN BE GIVEN ONE FURTHER YEAR IN WHICH TO CARRY OUT THE WORK.

COPIES OF THE LEAFLET - "HOW TO APPLY FOR A LICENCE UNDER THE BEDSPACE APARTMENTS ORDINANCE" - ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT THE OLA ON THE SEVENTH FLOOR, HENNESSY CENTRE, EAST WING, 500 HENNESSY ROAD, CAUSEWAY BAY AND AT DISTRICT OFFICES.

THE BEDSPACE APARTMENTS ORDINANCE, WHICH WAS PASSED BY THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL IN APRIL THIS YEAR, IS AIMED AT ENSURING THAT PREMISES COMPLY WITH BUILDING AND FIRE SAFETY, AND HEALTH AND HYGIENE REQUIREMENTS.

OVER 9,000 ENQUIRIES ON TENANCY HANDLED

MORE THAN 9,000 PUBLIC ENQUIRIES ON TENANCY MATTERS WERE HANDLED UNDER THE RENT OFFICER SCHEME DURING THE FIRST THREE QUARTERS OF THIS YEAR.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES ADMINISTRATION (CNTA) SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT MOST OF THE 9,471 ENQUIRIES WERE RELATED TO LEGAL PROCEEDINGS OF TENANCY DISPUTES, RECOVERY OR EVICTION OF PREMISES AND ARREARS OF RENT.

UNDER THE SCHEME, RENT OFFICERS FROM THE RATING AND VALUATION DEPARTMENT WERE ON DUTY AT SET TIME EACH WEEK DURING OFFICE HOURS AT 14 DISTRICT OFFICES TO GIVE ADVICE TO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC.

THESE OFFICERS ALSO DIRECTLY DEAL WITH CASES REFERRED BY STAFF OF ALL THE PUBLIC ENQUIRY SERVICE CENTRES (PESCS) OF VARIOUS DISTRICT OFFICES.

THE DISTRICT OFFICES PROVIDING SUCH SERVICES ARE CENTRAL AND WESTERN, EASTERN, SOUTHERN AND WAN CHAI ON HONG KONG ISLAND; KOWLOON CITY, KWUN TONG, YAU TSIM MONG, SHAM SHUI PO AND WONG TAI SIN IN KOWLOON; KWAI TSING, SHA TIN, TSUEN WAN, TUEN MUN AND YUEN LONG IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

## NEW MINIBUS SERVES MID-LEVELS, NORTH POINT

A NEW GREEN MINIBUS ROUTE PLYING BETWEEN ROBINSON ROAD ON MID-LEVELS AND MARBLE ROAD IN NORTH POINT WILL START OPERATION ON TUESDAY (NOVEMBER 1), THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED.

ROUTE NO. 56 WILL TRAVEL VIA ROBINSON ROAD, LYTTTELTON ROAD, BONHAM ROAD, CAINE ROAD, QUEENSWAY, QUEEN'S ROAD EAST, LEIGHTON ROAD, CAUSEWAY ROAD, KING'S ROAD, JAVA ROAD AND MARBLE ROAD.

IT WILL RUN FROM 6.45 AM TO 8 PM FROM MONDAY TO SATURDAY AT 12 TO 20-MINUTE INTERVALS. NO SERVICE WILL BE PROVIDED ON SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS. THE FARE FOR EACH TRIP IS \$6.

## RADIO PROGRAMMES TO PROMOTE WORKING ABILITIES OF DISABLED

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT WILL LAUNCH A SERIES OF RADIO PROGRAMMES NEXT MONTH TO AROUSE PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE WORKING ABILITIES AND POTENTIALS OF THE DISABLED.

ENTITLED "EMPLOY ABILITIES" AND CARRYING A SLOGAN "TOGETHER WE WORK, TOGETHER WE DEVELOP", THE RADIO PROGRAMMES ARE BEING JOINTLY PRODUCED BY THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT'S SELECTIVE PLACEMENT DIVISION (SPD) AND RADIO TELEVISION HONG KONG, AND SPONSORED BY THE ROYAL HONG KONG JOCKEY CLUB.

"FEATURING VARIOUS KINDS OF DISABILITIES, THE PROGRAMMES WILL BE PRESENTED IN SEVERAL FORMATS INCLUDING TOPICAL INTERVIEWS WITH DISABLED EMPLOYEES, DRAMAS AND ON-THE-SPOT REPORTING," SENIOR LABOUR OFFICER (SELECTIVE PLACEMENT) MRS JENNIE CHOR SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

"DURING THE ON-THE-SPOT REPORTING SESSION, THE COMPERE, TOGETHER WITH SOME FAMOUS ARTISTES, WILL VISIT THE WORKPLACES OF THE AWARDED OUTSTANDING DISABLED EMPLOYEES OR OTHER DISABLED EMPLOYEES AND CONDUCT INTERVIEWS.

"THROUGH CONVERSATIONS, DISABLED EMPLOYEES COULD SHARE THEIR FEELINGS AND WORKING EXPERIENCE WITH THEIR EMPLOYERS AND COLLEAGUES," SHE SAID.

"IN ADDITION, A RECORDED SEGMENT OF 'MYTH AND FACT' WILL BE DELIVERED BY A SPECIALLY DESIGNED CHARACTER AFTER EACH RADIO PROGRAMME," SHE ADDED.

MRS CHOR SAID THE OUTSTANDING DISABLED EMPLOYEES AWARD (ODEA) WOULD BE ANNOUNCED ON THURSDAY (NOVEMBER 3) WHILE THE RADIO PROGRAMMES WOULD BE BROADCAST ON 10 CONSECUTIVE FRIDAYS STARTING FROM NOVEMBER 25.

"WE HOPE THAT THROUGH THE PROGRAMMES, THE GENERAL PUBLIC CAN HAVE A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE WORKING ABILITIES OF THE DISABLED," SHE SAID.

"WE ALSO HOPE THAT MORE JOB OPPORTUNITIES WOULD BE PROVIDED FOR THEM SO THAT THEY CAN CONTRIBUTE THEIR TALENTS TO THEIR WORK AND ACHIEVE THE TARGET OF 'TOGETHER WE WORK, TOGETHER WE DEVELOP'," SHE ADDED.

MRS CHOR ALSO EXTENDED THE DEPARTMENT'S APPRECIATION TO THE JOCKEY CLUB FOR A DONATION OF \$140,000 TO MEET THE PRODUCTION COSTS.

THE ODEA IS AN ANNUAL EVENT ORGANISED BY THE SPD TO RECOGNISE THE OUTSTANDING PERFORMANCE OF DISABLED EMPLOYEES AS WELL AS TO PAY TRIBUTE TO THOSE EMPLOYERS WHO HAVE PROVIDED EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES AND SPECIAL ASSISTANCE TO THEIR DISABLED EMPLOYEES.

#### HONG KONG'S CREDIT UNION MOVEMENT ENCOURAGING

\* \* \* \* \*

THE DEVELOPMENT OF LOCAL CREDIT UNION MOVEMENT HAS BEEN ENCOURAGING, THE ACTING DIRECTOR OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES, MR RICHARD YIP SHUI-MING, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

SPEAKING AT THE INTERNATIONAL CREDIT UNION DAY, MR YIP SAID THE NUMBER OF CREDIT UNIONS IN HONG KONG HAD GROWN FROM ONE IN 1964, WHEN THE MOVEMENT WAS STARTED, TO 69 THIS YEAR.

AT PRESENT, THE NUMBER OF CREDIT UNION MEMBERS IS ABOUT 50,000, WITH A TOTAL SHARE CAPITAL OF MORE THAN \$520 MILLION.

HE POINTED OUT THAT THE LOCAL CREDIT UNION MOVEMENT OWED MUCH TO FATHER JOHN COLLINS AND MR ANDREW SO, WHOSE JOINT EFFORTS HAD MADE A GOOD START TO IT.

MR YIP STRESSED THAT THE CREDIT UNION CONCEPT WAS TO SEEK THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A MECHANISM TO FOSTER THRIFT, TO CHANNEL MEMBERS' SAVINGS TO PRODUCTIVE AND USEFUL UNDERTAKINGS AND TO PROVIDE A SOURCE OF PERSONAL CREDIT FOR MEMBERS IN TIMES OF NEED.

"INTERNATIONAL CREDIT UNION DAY IS AN OCCASION FOR RENEWING INDIVIDUAL AND INSTITUTIONAL COMMITMENTS TO THE IDEAL OF MUTUAL SELF-HELP AND SELF-RELIANCE."

THE THEME FOR THIS YEAR'S INTERNATIONAL CREDIT UNION DAY IS "CHOICES AND CHALLENGES", HE SAID, ADDING THAT IT COVERED VARIOUS DIMENSIONS INCLUDING VOLUNTEERISM, FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE AND GLOBAL CO-OPERATION.

"THE CHOICE TO BE MADE IS FINANCIAL INDEPENDENCE AND THE CHALLENGE IS TO MAKE THAT GOAL ATTAINABLE BY ENSURING ALL PEOPLE HAVE ACCESS TO SAFE AND SOUND CREDIT UNIONS," HE ADDED.

AT TODAY'S GATHERING, MR YIP PRESENTED CERTIFICATES OF RECOGNITION TO VARIOUS MEMBERS IN APPRECIATION OF THEIR OUTSTANDING OR LONG SERVICE TO THE MOVEMENT.

YOUNG PEOPLE GROWING UP IN A CHANGING COMMUNITY

YOUNG PEOPLE IN HONG KONG, TOGETHER WITH THEIR FAMILIES, ARE GROWING UP IN A COMMUNITY WHERE ITS POLITICAL, ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL ENVIRONMENT IS CHANGING RAPIDLY, THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR IAN STRACHAN, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

MR STRACHAN WAS ATTENDING THE 35TH ANNIVERSARY FOUNDER'S DAY PARADE OF THE BOYS' BRIGADE OF HONG KONG AT HING FONG ROAD PLAYGROUND, KWAI CHUNG.

"THIS PRESENTS OUR YOUNG PEOPLE WITH MANY CHALLENGES. FOR EXAMPLE, THERE HAS BEEN A SIGNIFICANT RISE IN THE NUMBER OF TEENAGERS TAKING DRUGS IN THE PAST TWO YEARS.

"THE NUMBER OF YOUNG PEOPLE SUSPECTED WITH TRIADS CONNECTIONS IS ALSO INCREASING," MR STRACHAN SAID.

WHILE THERE WERE A NUMBER OF FACTORS WHICH CONTRIBUTED TO YOUTH PROBLEMS, MR STRACHAN SAID CURIOSITY, PEER GROUP INFLUENCE, ACADEMIC FAILURE, CRAVE FOR MATERIAL SATISFACTION AND FRUSTRATION WITHIN FAMILIES WERE BELIEVED TO BE COMMON FACTORS.

"TO TACKLE THESE PROBLEMS AND TO ASSIST OUR YOUNG PEOPLE DEVELOP INTO RESPONSIBLE AND CONTRIBUTING MEMBERS OF SOCIETY, THE COMMUNITY NEEDS TO GIVE THEM ADEQUATE EMOTIONAL SUPPORT, GUIDANCE AND REINFORCEMENT, BOTH IN FORMAL AND INFORMAL STRUCTURES, THAT IS IN SCHOOLS, FAMILIES AND YOUTH ORGANISATIONS," HE SAID.

MR STRACHAN PAID TRIBUTE TO THE BOYS' BRIGADE OF HONG KONG FOR CONTRIBUTING GREATLY TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF YOUNG PEOPLE, PARTICULARLY IN THE ASPECTS OF PROMOTION OF HABITS OF OBEDIENCE, REVERENCE, DISCIPLINE AND SELF-RESPECT.

71 NEW BUILDING PLANS APPROVED

THE BUILDINGS DEPARTMENT APPROVED 71 NEW BUILDING PLANS IN AUGUST THIS YEAR.

OF THE PLANS, 25 ARE FOR HONG KONG ISLAND, 28 FOR KOWLOON AND 18 FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES.

THE APPROVED PLANS INCLUDE 32 FOR APARTMENT AND APARTMENT/COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENTS, 17 FOR COMMERCIAL DEVELOPMENTS AND FIVE FOR FACTORY AND INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENTS.

IN THE SAME MONTH, CONSENT WAS GIVEN FOR WORK TO START ON 36 BUILDING PROJECTS, WHICH INVOLVE 6,987.7 SQUARE METRES OF USABLE DOMESTIC FLOOR AREA AND 131,658.9 SQUARE METRES OF USABLE NON-DOMESTIC FLOOR AREA.

THE DECLARED COST OF NEW BUILDINGS COMPLETED IN THE MONTH TOTALLED ABOUT \$2,021 MILLION.

OF THE BUILDINGS CERTIFIED FOR OCCUPATION IN THE MONTH, USABLE FLOOR AREAS FOR DOMESTIC AND NON-DOMESTIC USES ARE 114,417.6 SQUARE METRES AND 180,533.6 SQUARE METRES RESPECTIVELY.

IN THE SAME MONTH, THE DEPARTMENT ISSUED 30 OCCUPATION PERMITS - FOUR FOR HONG KONG ISLAND, FIVE FOR KOWLOON AND 21 FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES.

IN ADDITION, 43 DEMOLITION CONSENTS INVOLVING 106 BUILDINGS WERE ISSUED.

THE BUILDINGS DEPARTMENT'S CONTROL AND ENFORCEMENT DIVISION RECEIVED 833 COMPLAINTS OF UNAUTHORISED BUILDING WORKS, CARRIED OUT 1,453 INSPECTIONS AND ISSUED 413 REMOVAL ORDERS ON UNAUTHORISED WORKS.

THE DEPARTMENT'S DANGEROUS BUILDINGS SECTION ALSO INSPECTED 803 BUILDINGS AND OBTAINED 20 EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDERS FROM THE COURT.

SINGING COMPETITION TO CONVEY FIGHT CRIME MESSAGES
