INDUSTRIAL SAFETY IS A 'TRIPARTITE AFFAIR'
* * * * *

THE PROMOTION OF INDUSTRIAL SAFETY IS A TRIPARTITE AFFAIR INVOLVING THE GOVERNMENT, EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES AND EACH OF THEM HAD AN IMPORTANT ROLE TO PLAY.

THIS WAS STATED BY THE DEPUTY COMMISSIONER FOR LABOUR, MR DARWIN CHEN, AT THE INAUGURAL MEETING OF THE ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY SAFETY SUB-COMMTEE RECENTLY.

+FOR THIS REASON, THE INDUSTRY-BASED SAFETY SUB-COMMITTEES ARE FORMED WITH A TRIPARTITE COMPOSITION SO THAT ALL CONCERNED PARTIES MAY CO-OPERATE AND CONTRIBUTE TO THE CAUSE OF WORK SAFETY,+ HE SAID.

THE ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY SAFETY SUB-COMMITTEE IS THE SIXTH FORMED UNDER THE AUSPICES OF THE COMMITTEE ON INDUSTRIAL SAFETY AND ACCIDENT PREVENTION (CISAP), FOLLOWING THOSE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY, THE TEXTILES INDUSTRY, THE SHIPBUILDING AND SHIPREPAIRING INDUSTRY, THE PLASTICS INDUSTRY AND THE METALWARE INDUSTRY.

MR CHEN, WHO IS CHAIRMAN OF CISAP, SAID MEMBERS OF THE SAFETY SUB-COMMITTEES INCLUDED REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT, AS WELL AS FROM EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES ORGANISATIONS.

HE SAID THE SUB-COMMITTEES HAD PERFORMED VERY WELL IN IMPROVING SAFETY AT WORK IN THE RESPECTIVE INDUSTRIES.

+THEIR ACTIVITIES INCLUDED, FOR EXAMPLE, THE PREPARATION OF CODES OF PRACTICE FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE INDUSTRIES AND THE ORGANISING OF SAFETY SEMINARS AND COMPETITIONS.+

MR CHEN SAID THE ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY WAS ONE OF THE LARGEST IN HONG KONG AND EMPLOYED ABOUT 900 000 PEOPLE.

HOWEVER, BECAUSE OF ITS HIGH TECHNOLOGY CONTENT AND THE USE OF A WIDE RANGE OF CHEMICALS, WORKERS IN THE INDUSTRY WERE SUBJECT TO HEALTH HAZARDS ARISING FROM IMPROPER HANDLING OF THE SUBSTANCES.

IN 1984, HE SAID, 1 134 ACCIDENTS IN THE INDUSTRY HAD BEEN REPORTED AND IN THE FIRST THREE QUARTERS OF 1985, THE NUMBER OF ACCIDENTS WAS ABOUT 700.

MR CHEN SAID THE NEW SUB-COMMITTEE'S MAIN TASKS WERE TO PRODUCE A CODE OF SAFE PRACTICES FOR THE INDUSTRY AND TO PROMOTE SAFETY AT WORK THROUGH THE PARTICIPATION OF EMPLOYERS AND WORKERS.

+AS WITH OTHER SUB-COMMITTEES, IT IS OUR HOPE THAT THROUGH THE EFFORTS OF THE MEMBERS AND THEIR PRACTICAL EXPERIENCE AND ADVICE, THE ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY SAFETY SUB-COMMITTEE WOULD HELP REDUCE THE NUMBER OF ACCIDENTS IN THE INDUSTRY,+ HE ADDED.

MORE RECREATION FACILITIES AT TAI PO
* * * * *

TAI PO RESIDENTS WILL HAVE MORE RECREATION FACILITIES AS A NEW SCHEME FOR LAND FORMATION GETS UNDER WAY IN THE CONTINUING DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME FOR TAI PO NEW TOWN.

PLANS ARE READY FOR BUILDING A SPACIOUS SEA-FRONT PROMENADE BY THE SIDE OF A PROPOSED WATERFRONT PARK.

THE PROMENADE, 700 METRES LONG AND 10 METRES WIDE, WILL BE ON TOP OF THE SEAWALL ON LAND TO BE RECLAIMED NEAR THE TAI PO INDUSTRIAL ESTATE.

IT WILL BE PROVIDED WITH SEATING BAYS, SHADED STRUCTURES AND LANDSCAPE PLANTINGS.

A TOTAL OF 19 HECTARES OF LAND WILL BE FORMED SOUTHWEST OF THE INDUSTRIAL ESTATE FOR THE WATERFRONT PARK ADJOINING THE PROMENADE.

ANOTHER 2.7 HECTARES OF LAND WILL BE FORMED ADJACENT TO YUEN CHAU TSAI WHICH WILL BE DEVELOPED INTO A DISTRICT OPEN SPACE.

WORK WILL START IN MAY THIS YEAR AND THE WHOLE PROJECT WILL BE COMPLETED IN THREE YEARS.

OTHER FACILITIES INCLUDE A COVERED FOOTBRIDGE ACROSS TAI PO ROAD SOUTH OF THE KWONG FUK ESTATE WHICH IS DUE FOR COMPLETION IN THE AUTUMN OF NEXT YEAR.

CONSTRUCTION OF ROADS CONNECTING TING KOK ROAD IN THE NORTH WITH THE SHA TIN-TAI PO COASTAL ROAD AT THE ISLAND HOUSE INTERCHANGE IN THE SOUTH WILL BE COMPLETED IN THE AUTUMN OF 1988.

MAUNSELL CONSULTANTS ASIA ARE THE PROJECT ENGINEERS WHO WILL SUPERVISE CONSTRUCTION.

TENDERS FOR THE PROJECT ARE BEING INVITED BY THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT.

AIR FORCE VOLUNTEERS SOUGHT

THE ROYAL HONG KONG AUXILIARY AIR FORCE IS SEEKING VOLUNTEERS WITH A KEEN INTEREST IN AVIATION TO BE TRAINED AS OPERATIONS CONTROLLERS AND CREWMEN.

THE RECRUITS WILL BE REQUIRED TO UNDERGO TRAINING ON THURSDAY EVENINGS AND AT WEEKENDS.

/AFTER THE

AFTER THE TRAINING, RECRUITS FOR OPERATIONS CONTROLLER WILL MAN THE OPERATIONS DESK AT THE FORCE'S HEADQUARTERS AT WEEKENDS, LIAISING WITH AIRBORNE AIRCRAFT AND GROUND AGENCIES.

CREWMAN RECRUITS WILL SERVE ON THE FLEET OF FIXED AND ROTARY WING AIRCRAFT.

A RHKAAF SPOKESMAN SAID THAT VOLUNTEERS WOULD BE CAREFULLY SELECTED. ONE OF THE PRIME CONSIDERATIONS WAS WHETHER THEY COULD PUT IN THE NECESSARY TRAINING TIME TO ATTAIN THE HIGH STANDARD OF PROFICIENCY REQUIRED FOR THE DUTIES.

BASICALLY, HE SAID, ALL APPLICANTS SHOULD BE AGED BETWEEN 18 AND 30, MEDICALLY FIT, AND HAVE FIVE SUBJECTS INCLUDING ENGLISH LANGUAGE (SYLLABUS B) AT GRADE E OR ABOVE IN THE HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION EXAMINATION.

HOWEVER, A HIGHER PROFICIENCY IN SPOKEN AND WRITTEN ENGLISH IS REQUIRED OF MEN AND WOMEN WHO APPLY TO BE OPERATIONS CONTROLLERS AND THEY SHOULD HAVE ENGLISH LANGUAGE (SYLLABUS B) AT GRADE C, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

CANDIDATES FOR CREWMEN MUST BE YOUNG MEN WITH NORMAL EYESIGHT WITHOUT THE AID OF SPECTACLES. A GENERAL KNOWLEDGE OF FIRST AID, SOME MECHANICAL OR TECHNICAL APTITUDE, AND A STRONG SWIMMING CAPABILITY WOULD BE AN ADVANTAGE.

APPLICANTS SHOULD SUBMIT PERSONAL DETAILS AND PHOTOGRAPHS TO THE COMMANDING OFFICER, ROYAL HONG KONG AUXILIARY AIR FORCE, HONG KONG INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT, AIRPORT TUNNEL EAST EXIT, KOWLOON.

IMPROVING TRAFFIC FLOW ON GASCOIGNE ROAD
* * * *

THE GASCOIGNE ROAD FLYOVER WILL BE EXTENDED TO IMPROVE TRAFFIC FLOW BETWEEN JORDAN ROAD AND THE HUNG HOM INTERCHANGE.

THE FLYOVER EXTENSION WILL SPAN THE BUSY JUNCTION AT WYLIE ROAD THUS AVOIDING THE TRAFFIC LIGHTS.

THE PROJECT, WHICH IS EXPECTED TO START IN MAY, INCLUDES THE DEMOLITION OF 210 METRES OF THE EASTERN END OF THE EXISTING GASCOIGNE ROAD FLYOVER AND THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW 450-METRE FLYOVER BETWEEN JORDAN ROAD AND CHATHAM ROAD SOUTH.

THIS WILL BE CONNNECTED WITH THE REMAINING PORTION OF THE EXISTING FLYOVER.

IN ADDITION GASCOIGNE ROAD AND CHATHAM ROAD BETWEEN JORDAN ROAD AND HUNG HOM INTERCHANGE WILL BE WIDENED AND IMPROVED.

ALSO INCLUDED IN THE SCHEME IS THE EXTENSION OF THE PEDESTRIAN SUBWAY IN CHATHAM ROAD SOUTH, CONSTRUCTION OF A BOX CULVERT TO REPLACE THE OPEN NULLAH IN GASCOIGNE ROAD, CONSTRUCTION OF RETAINING WALLS IN GASCOIGNE AND CHATHAM ROADS AND DEMOLITION OF THE KCR BRIDGE NEAR THE CHATHAM ROAD FLYOVER.

ANY PERSONS WISHING TO OBJECT TO THE PROPOSED WORKS SHOULD WRITE TO THE SECRETARY FOR LANDS AND WORKS BEFORE APRIL 29.

SHAM TSENG DEVELOPMENT TO BE DISCUSSED

TSUEN WAN DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS WILL DISCUSS ADDITIONAL STUDIES ON DEVELOPMENTS IN SHAM TSENG AT THEIR MEETING ON TUESDAY (MARCH 4).

THE PAPER, TO BE PRESENTED BY THE PROJECT MANAGER OF THE TSUEN WAN NEW TOWN DEVELOPMENT OFFICE, WILL ENTAIL FURTHER EXTENDING THE SHAM TSENG DEVELOPMENT PROJECT TO PROVIDE ACCOMMODATION FOR 40 000 MORE PEOPLE BRINGING THE TOTAL POPULATION OF THE PROPOSED AREA TO ABOUT 100 000 PEOPLE.

MEMBERS OF THE BOARD WILL ALSO EXPRESS THEIR VIEWS ON A LAYOUT PLAN OF WO YI HOP VILLAGE FOR THE FUTURE DEVELOPMENT OF THE VILLAGE.

OTHER LOCAL ISSUES TO BE DISCUSSED INCLUDE A REPORT ON LAW AND ORDER IN TSUEN WAN IN 1985, AND THE DELINEATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE BOUNDARIES OF VARIOUS GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS IN RELATION TO DISTRICT BOARD ELECTORAL BOUNDARIES.
