HONG KONG-CANADA TEXTILES TALKS ADJOURNED  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE TEXTILES CONSULTATIONS BETWEEN HONG KONG AND CANADA, WHICH BEGAN ON FRIDAY (AUGUST 19) WERE ADJOURNED TODAY (SATURDAY) WITHOUT RESULT. THE CANADIAN SIDE MADE CERTAIN PROPOSALS REGARDING ORDERLY MARKETING AND FLEXIBILITY PROVISIONS UNDER THE CURRENT (1982 - 1986) HONG KONG-CANADA TEXTILES AGREEMENT. THE TWO SIDES HAD A FRANK EXCHANGE OF VIEWS BUT WERE UNABLE TO REACH A MEETING OF THE MINDS.

NO DATE HAS BEEN ESTABLISHED FOR A RESUMPTION OF THE TALKS.

IN THESE CONSULTATIONS, THE CANADIAN DELEGATION WAS LED BY MR CAMPBELL STUART, ASSISTANT UNDER-SECRETARY, SPECIAL TRADE RELATIONS OFFICE IN THE CANADIAN DEPARTMENT OF EXTERNAL AFFAIRS, AND THE HONG KONG DELEGATION BY MR MICHAEL CARTLAND, ACTING DIRECTOR OF TRADE.

38 TSUEN WAN MARKET STALLS UP FOR AUCTION

THIRTY EIGHT STALLS AT THE TSUEN WAN MARKET IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WILL BE PUT UP FOR PUBLIC AUCTION ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 23).

THE AUCTION WILL BE HELD AT THE CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF TSUEN WAN MARKET, AND WILL START AT 10 AM, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT SAID.

OF THE STALLS TO BE AUCTIONED, 23 ARE DESIGNATED FOR THE SALE OF VEGETABLES, FIVE FOR GROCERIES, FOUR FOR HABERDASHERY, FOUR FOR FLOWERS, ONE FOR FRUIT AND THE REMAINING ONE FOR ICE.

THE UPSET MONTHLY RENTAL FOR THE STALLS RANGES FROM \$550 TO \$2 500, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

SUCCESSFUL BIDDERS CAN START THEIR BUSINESS ON SEPTEMBER 1 ON A THREE-YEAR CONTRACT, AND RENTS MUST BE PAID ON A QUARTERLY BASIS, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

BIDDERS MUST BE OVER 21 YEARS OF AGE AND MUST BRING ALONG THEIR IDENTITY CARDS AND FIVE PHOTOGRAPHS TO THE AUCTION VENUE.

ENTRIES INVITED FOR YUEN LONG RUNNING CLINIC

A THREE-MONTH RUNNING CLINIC WILL BE HELD FOR LOCAL RESIDENTS, AT YUEN LONG STADIUM FROM SEPTEMBER 1 (THURSDAY).

THE YUEN LONG RUNNING CLINIC IS ORGANISED FREE OF CHARGE BY THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

IT WILL BE OPENED TO THE PARTICIPANTS BETWEEN 7 AM AND 8 AM DAILY UNTIL THE END OF NOVEMBER, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NTSD SAID.

PARTICIPANTS WILL ALSO BE ALLOWED TO USE THE EIGHT-LANE, ALL-WEATHER RUNNING TRACK FOR ANY KIND OF PHYSICAL FITNESS EXERCISE DURING THE ONE-HOUR SESSION.

HOWEVER, COURSE MEMBERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR PROPER RUBBER SHOES AND ARE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE TURFED AREA OF THE STADIUM, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE COURSE, EACH PARTICIPANT WILL BE AWARDED A COMMEMORATIVE T-SHIRT AS A SOUVENIR.

ENTRIES ARE NOW BEING ACCEPTED FOR THE RUNNING CLINIC AND APPLICATION FORMS CAN BE OBTAINED AT THE OFFICE OF THE YUEN LONG STADIUM AT TAI YUK ROAD OR THE YUEN LONG URBAN SERVICES OFFICE.

COMPLETED ENTRY FORMS, TOGETHER WITH A RETURN, SELF-ADDRESSED ENVELOPE AND TWO PHOTOGRAPHS, SHOULD BE SENT TO THE YUEN LONG URBAN SERVICES OFFICE ON THIRD FLOOR, DISTRICT OFFICE BUILDING, MAIN ROAD, YUEN LONG, BEFORE WEDNESDAY (AUGUST 24).

SPORTS GROUND FOR TSING YI ISLANDERS

A SPORTS GROUND WILL SOON BE BUILT ON TSING YI ISLAND TO PROVIDE MORE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES FOR RESIDENTS THERE.

THE SPORTS GROUND, TO BE BUILT ON AN AREA OF ABOUT 3 200 SQUARE METRES, WILL BE SITUATED ON CHING HONG ROAD NEAR CHEUNG CHING ESTATE.

THERE WILL BE TWO MINI-SOCCER PITCHES WITH FLOODLIGHTS, AND A SERVICE BUILDING WITH CHANGING ROOM FACILITIES AND TOILETS FOR PLAYERS AND THE DISABLED.

THE ARCHITECTURAL OFFICE OF THE BUILDING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE PROJECT.

WORK ON THE PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO START IN OCTOBER AND BE COMPLETED IN JULY NEXT YEAR.

PUBLIC LIGHT BUS RESTRICTED ZONE

\* \* \* \*

THE FOLLOWING ROAD SECTIONS WILL BE DESIGNATED AS 24-HOUR PUBLIC LIGHT BUS RESTRICTED ZONES FROM 10 AM ON MONDAY (AUGUST 22).

- (I) THE SECTION OF SHING CHUEN ROAD NORTH OF SHING HING STREET ;
- (II) SHING HING STREET ; AND
- (III) THE SECTION OF SHING WAN ROAD BETWEEN SHING HING STREET AND SHING CHUEN ROAD.

WITHIN THE RESTRICTED ZONE, ALL PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM PICKING UP OR SETTING DOWN PASSENGERS.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE EXISTING PUBLIC LIGHT BUS PROHIBITION AT THE SECTION OF SHING CHUEN ROAD NORTH OF ITS JUNCTION WITH SHING HING STREET WILL BE RESCINDED.

CASTLE PEAK ROAD SPEED LIMIT

FROM 10 AM ON MONDAY (AUGUST 22), THE FOLLOWING ROAD SECTIONS SHALL BE RESTRICTED ROADS SUBJECT TO A SPEED LIMIT OF 40 MILES PER HOUR :

- (A) CASTLE PEAK ROAD, THE SECTION BETWEEN A POINT 190M EAST OF YUEN LONG EAST ROUNDABOUT AND A POINT ABOUT 150M NORTH OF AU TAU ROUNDABOUT;
- (B) KAM TIN ROAD, THE SECTION BETWEEN ITS JUNCTION WITH AU TAU ROUNDABOUT AND A POINT ABOUT 130M EAST OF THE SAME JUNCTION.

TEMPORARY TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS - TAI PO MARKET

FROM 10 AM ON MONDAY (AUGUST 22), THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS WILL BE IMPLEMENTED IN PO HEUNG STREET AND PLOVER COVE ROAD TO FACILITATE ROAD RECONSTRUCTION WORK FOR ABOUT TWO WEEKS:-

- (I) THE SECTION OF PO HEUNG STREET BETWEEN PO YICK STREET AND PLOVER COVE ROAD WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC;
- (II) THE SECTION OF PLOVER COVE ROAD BETWEEN PO HEUNG STREET AND TUNG MAU SQUARE WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC;

- (IV) ALL TRAFFIC WILL HAVE TO TURN RIGHT FROM THE NORTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF PO HEUNG STREET INTO KWONG FUK ROAD, STRAIGHT MOVEMENT ACROSS KWONG FUK ROAD IS PROHIBITED.

FRESH WATER SUPPLY TO A NUMBER OF PREMISES IN KOWLOON CITY WILL BE TURNED OFF FROM 10 PM ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 23) FOR EIGHT HOURS FOR REPAIR WORK.

THE AFFECTED PREMISES INCLUDE NO. 11 - 25 JUNCTION ROAD, THE SECTION OF JUNCTION ROAD BETWEEN HENG LAM STREET AND TUNG TAU TSUEN ROAD, INVERNESS ROAD, DUMBARTON ROAD, LAI CHI YUEN, HO KAR YUEN AND BLOCKS 1 - 12, LOK FU ESTATE.
