PLANNING COMMITTEE SOON FOR THIRD UNIVERSITY
* * * * *

HONG KONG'S THIRD UNIVERSITY, WITH A CAPACITY OF 7 000 PLACES AND ROOM FOR FURTHER DEVELOPMENT UP TO 10 000 PLACES, IS SCHEDULED TO HAVE ITS FIRST INTAKE OF STUDENTS IN THE 1994-97 TRIENNIUM, A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN ANNOUNCED TODAY.

A PLANNING COMMITTEE WOULD SOON BE APPOINTED TO WORK OUT IN DETAIL THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE UNIVERSITY.

IT WAS INTENDED TO HAVE A LOCAL PERSONALITY AS CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE, A SENIOR GOVERNMENT OFFICIAL AS THE SECRETARY-GENERAL, AND MEMBERSHIP WOULD INCLUDE LOCAL LAY MEMBERS, OVERSEAS ACADEMICS AND REPRESENTATIVES OF THE EXISTING INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

TO HELP THE COMMITTEE HAVE UP-TO-DATE KNOWLEDGE OF LOCAL DEMAND FOR PROFESSIONAL AND TECHNOLOGICAL GRADUATES, THE LOCAL LAY MEMBERS WOULD BE DRAWN MAINLY FROM INDUSTRY AND COMMERCE. IT WAS ALSO HOPED TO HAVE REPRESENTATIVES OF UMELCO.

+THE OVERSEAS ACADEMICS WILL CONTRIBUTE EXPERIENCE IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF UNIVERSITIES IN OTHER COUNTRIES, AND WILL REPRESENT THE INTERNATIONAL DIMENSION IN HIGHER EDUCATION,+ HE SAID.

+THE PRESENCE OF OVERSEAS ACADEMICS WILL HELP TO ENSURE THE INTERNATIONAL STATUS OF THE NEW UNIVERSITY.+

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THE NEW UNIVERSITY WOULD BE A GROUPING OF PROFESSIONAL SCHOOLS EMPHASISING SCIENCE TECHNOLOGY, MANAGEMENT AND BUSINESS STUDIES.

SEVERAL POSSIBLE SITES WERE BEING CONSIDERED, AND A DECISION WOULD BE MADE BY THE PLANNING COMMITTEE. HOWEVER, THE UNIVERSITY SHOULD HAVE EASY ACCESS TO THE METROPOLITAN AREA TO FACILITATE CLOSE CO-ORDINATION WITH BUSINESS, INDUSTRY AND THE GENERAL COMMUNITY.

THE SITE SHOULD ALSO BE LARGE ENOUGH TO ALLOW FOR FURTHER EXPANSION IN THE LONG TERM.

PRESENT FORECASTS INDICATED THAT THE NEW UNIVERSITY WOULD CATER FOR SOME 5 000 STUDENTS BY 1996-97, EXPANDING TO SOME 7 000 STUDENTS BY THE END OF THE CENTURY.

SEVERAL BROAD POLICY GUIDELINES HAD BEEN LAID FOR THE NEW UNIVERSITY, INCLUDING :

- * IT SHOULD VALIDATE ITS DEGREE COURSES INTERNALLY;
- * IF IT WAS TO BE ESTABLISHED IN STAGES, THE STAGING SHOULD NOT EXTEND OVER TOO LONG A PERIOD; AND

/* STAFF RECRUITMENT

* STAFF RECRUITMENT WOULD GIVE PREFERENCE TO LOCAL CANDIDATES, BUT WOULD INCLUDE AN OVERSEAS ELEMENT.

HE SAID THE NEW UNIVERSITY HAD THE FULL SUPPORT OF THE UNIVERSITY AND POLYTECHNIC GRANTS COMMITTEE. THE EDUCATION COMMISSION ALSO SUPPORTED THE SCHEME, AND THE INCREASE IN THE NUMBER OF FIRST-YEAR FIRST-DEGREE PLACES IT WOULD MAKE AVAILABLE.

AS THE COSTS OF THE NEW UNIVERSITY DEPENDED ON MANY VARIABLE AND UNKNOWN FACTORS IT WAS DIFFICULT TO QUOTE A FIGURE AT THIS STAGE.

+COSTS ARE VERY DIFFICULT TO ESTIMATE BEFORE THE ACADEMIC PROFILE, THE TYPE AND MIX OF COURSES, THE LOCATION AND THE RATE OF GROWTH TO FULL DEVELOPMENT HAVE BEEN DETERMINED.+

SIMILARLY, HE SAID, RECURRENT COSTS WERE ALMOST IMPOSSIBLE TO FORECAST ACCURATELY, ESPECIALLY AS RECURRENT COSTS IN A NEW INSTITUTION WERE EXPECTED TO BE MUCH HIGHER THAN THOSE IN ESTABLISHED, MATURE INSTITUTIONS.

THE NAMES OF THE CHAIRMAN AND MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING COMMITTEE WOULD BE ANNOUNCED IN A FEW MONTHS TIME.

BIG BOOST IN RECREATIONAL FACILITIES IN KWUN TONG

* * * * *

RESIDENTS IN KWUN TONG WILL HAVE MORE RECREATIONAL AND SPORTS FACILITIES TO ENJOY ON COMPLETION OF SEVERAL MULTI-MILLION-DOLLAR URBAN COUNCIL PROJECTS THERE.

+THE FIRST TO COME ON STREAM WILL BE THE HIU KWONG STREET PLAYGROUND AND INDOOR GAMES HALL SCHEDULED TO OPEN SOON,+ SAID A COUNCIL SPOKESMAN TODAY.

THE \$19.5 MILLION PROJECT INCLUDES AN INDOOR GAMES HALL, A REST GARDEN AND A CHILDREN'S PLAY AREA.

+THE TWO-STOREY INDOOR GAMES HALL HAS SUCH MODERN FACILITIES AS A 1 400 SQUARE-METRE BALL GAMES ARENA WITH A SPECTATOR STAND TO ACCOMMODATE 700 PEOPLE,+ HE SAID.

+THE ARENA IS SUITABLE FOR BASKETBALL, VOLLEYBALL, BADMINTON OR GYMNASTICS.

+IN ADDITION, THERE WILL BE THREE FULLY AIR-CONDITIONED SQUASH COURTS WITH PUBLIC GALLERIES, AND TWO TRAINING ROOMS SUITABLE FOR CONFERENCES, GAMES OR YOGA PRACTICE PURPOSES.

+TO ENABLE HANDICAPPED PEOPLE TO GET TO THE INDOOR GAMES HALL, A SPECIALLY-DESIGNED LIFT IS BEING PROVIDED.+

THE SPOKESMAN SAID ANOTHER MULTI-MILLION-DOLLAR PROJECT NOW UNDER CONSTRUCTION WAS THE KOWLOON BAY SPORTS COMPLEX COVERING A TOTAL AREA OF 5.7 HECTARES.

ON ITS COMPLETION BY EARLY 1987, HE SAID, KWUN TONG WOULD HAVE THE FIRST SPORTS COMPLEX OF INTERNATIONAL STANDARD IN KOWLOON.

+THE \$50 MILLION PROJECT WILL HAVE SUCH FIRST-CLASS FACILITIES AS A FULL-SIZE 100 X 64 METRE GRASSED INFIELD FOOTBALL PITCH, AN EIGHT-LANE 400 METRE ALL-WEATHER RUNNING TRACK AND FACILITIES FOR TRACK AND FIELD EVENTS, AS WELL AS A SPECTATOR STAND TO ACCOMMODATE 1 500 PEOPLE,+ HE SAID.

+SINCE IT WILL SERVE AS A REGIONAL SPORTS CENTRE FOR KOWLOON EAST, FUNCTIONS ORGANISED BY THE URBAN COUNCIL AND OTHER NATIONAL SPORTS BODIES WILL BE GIVEN PRIORITY.

+HOWEVER, WHEN NOT BEING USED FOR ORGANISED SPORTS MEETS, THE SPORTS COMPLEX WILL BE OPENED TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC FOR JOGGING.

+OTHER FACILITIES INCLUDE AN INDOOR GAMES HALL, ONE HARD-SURFACED MINI-SOCCER PITCH, TWO BASKETBALL-CUM-VOLLEYBALL COURTS, A LANDSCAPED GARDEN AND A CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND.+

ALSO IN THE PIPELINE FOR KWUN TONG WAS THE \$3.8 MILLION KWUN TONG FERRY PIER SQUARE SCHEDULED FOR COMPLETION EARLY NEXT YEAR.

+CONSTRUCTION WILL BEGIN NEXT MONTH AND THE PROJECT WILL COMPRISE A POND, A CASCADE, A CHINESE PAVILION, ARBOURS AND A LANDSCAPED SITTING-OUT AREA FOR PASSIVE RECREATIONAL PURPOSES,+ HE ADDED.

NEW URBAN COUNCIL SPORTS CENTRE IN NORTH POINT

THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE FORMER PRINTING DEPARTMENT BUILDING IN JAVA ROAD, NORTH POINT, HAS BEEN CONVERTED INTO AN URBAN COUNCIL SPORTS CENTRE AND WILL BE OPENED TO THE PUBLIC TOMORROW (TUESDAY).

THE NEW CENTRE WILL TAKE THE PLACE OF THE CITY LIONS CLUB SPORTS CENTRE IN SPORTS ROAD, HAPPY VALLEY, WHICH WILL BE CLOSED DOWN AS FROM TOMORROW AND HANDED BACK TO THE HONG KONG FOOTBALL CLUB.

/+ALL ACTIVITIES

+ALL ACTIVITIES FORMERLY SCHEDULED AT THE HAPPY VALLEY CENTRE WILL BE HELD IN THE NEW VENUE AT JAVA ROAD,+ SAID COUNCIL SPOKESMAN TODAY.

THE JAVA ROAD TEMPORARY SPORTS CENTRE WILL OCCUPY A TOTAL FLOOR AREA OF 201 SQUARE METRES AND BE MAINLY DIVIDED INTO TWO SECTIONS -- ONE WITH 16 FITNESS STATIONS FOR BODY BUILDING, AND THE OTHER SECTION MAINLY FOR AEROBICS, YOGA AND DANCE CLASSES.

+ALL CLASSES WILL BE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF QUALIFIED INSTRUCTORS,+ SAID THE SPOKESMAN.

+THE CENTRE WILL ALSO SERVE IN FUTURE AS THE MAIN VENUE ON HONG KONG ISLAND FOR FITNESS CLASSES ORGANISED BY THE DISTRICT RECREATION AND SPORTS OFFICES OF THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT,+ HE ADDED.

THE CENTRE WILL BE OPEN FROM 7 A.M. TO 10 P.M. DAILY. ENQUIRIES CONCERNING PROGRAMMES CAN BE MADE AT 5-632853.

STATUTORY HOLIDAY REMINDER
* * * *

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT REMINDED EMPLOYERS THAT UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT ORDINANCE, CHING MING FESTIVAL, WHICH FALLS ON APRIL 5, IS ONE OF THE 11 STATUTORY HOLIDAYS.

UNDER THE ORDINANCE, ALL MANUAL EMPLOYEES AND THOSE NON-MANUAL EMPLOYEES EARNING NOT MORE THAN \$9 500 A MONTH ARE ENTITLED TO THE HOLIDAY AND MUST BE PAID FOR THE DAY-OFF IF THEY HAVE WORKED CONTINUOUSLY FOR THREE MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY.

HOLIDAY PAY SHOULD BE EQUIVALENT TO AN EMPLOYEE'S EARNINGS ON A NORMAL WORKING DAY AND SHOULD INCLUDE BASIC WAGES AS WELL AS ALLOWANCES THAT CAN BE EXPRESSED IN MONEY TERMS SUCH AS MEALS AND COST OF LIVING ALLOWANCES.

WHERE THE EARNINGS VARY FROM DAY-TO-DAY, HOLIDAY PAY SHOULD BE THE AVERAGE DAILY EARNINGS DURING EVERY COMPLETE WAGE PERIOD, WHICH COULD BE BETWEEN 28 DAYS TO 31 DAYS, PRECEDING THE HOLIDAY.

IF AN EMPLOYEE IS REQUIRED TO WORK ON A STATUTORY HOLIDAY, HE MUST BE GIVEN AN ALTERNATIVE DAY-OFF WITHIN 60 DAYS BEFORE OR AFTER THAT DAY.

ENQUIRIES ABOUT STATUTORY HOLIDAYS MAY BE MADE TO THE NEAREST BRANCH OFFICE OF THE LABOUR RELATIONS SERVICE.

ANNUAL REPORT ON THE CPI FOR 1985

AN ANNUAL REPORT ON THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR 1985 WAS RECENTLY PUBLISHED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT. THIS REPORT GIVES A COMPREHENSIVE ACCOUNT OF THE MOVEMENT OF CONSUMER PRICES AND DETAILED ANALYSES OF THE CONSUMER PRICE INDEXES DURING 1985.

INCLUDED IN THE REPORT ARE FOUR CHARTS AND FIVE TABLES SHOWING MOVEMENTS OF BOTH CPI(A) AND CPI(B) BY SECTION AND GROUP OF COMMODITY/SERVICE AS WELL AS THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE OVERALL CHANGE IN THE INDEXES.
