MOTHER, CHILD WELFARE OF PRIMARY CONCERN -- SIR EDWARD  
\* \* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE, STRESSED TODAY (SATURDAY) THAT THE WELFARE OF THE MOTHER AND CHILD SHOULD BE THE PRIMARY CONCERN IN THE KWOK AH-NUI CASE.

SPEAKING TO REPORTERS AFTER OPENING THE KADOORIE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH CENTRE OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG, HE SAID: +FOR ALL THE DISCUSSION ABOUT WHAT HAS HAPPENED, DON'T FORGET THE MOTHER AND THE CHILD.+

+WHAT WE ARE MOSTLY CONCERNED WITH IS THEIR WELFARE AND I THINK A LITTLE BIT OF QUIET TIME FOR THEM WOULD NOT BE A BAD IDEA AT ALL.+

SIR EDWARD SAID HE WAS QUITE SATISFIED THAT THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT HAD DONE THEIR VERY BEST FOR THE MOTHER AND THE CHILD. +AND THAT IS INDEED WHAT I THINK THEY DID DO.

+WE'VE ALSO SAID THAT THE FIRST THING TO DO IS TO HAVE A LOOK TO SEE WHAT LESSONS THERE ARE TO BE LEARNED.

+BUT DO REMEMBER THIS HAS BEEN RAISED IN QUESTION IN THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL WHEN THERE WAS A VERY FULL ACCOUNT GIVEN OF WHAT IS HAPPENING, AND THEN ANSON CHAN HAS MET THE PRESS AND DONE WHAT SHE CAN TO LOOK AT IT.+

REPLYING TO ANOTHER QUESTION, SIR EDWARD SAID HE DID NOT PERSONALLY PUT THE 'BRAKE' ON THE OMBUDSMAN IDEA. +IT WASN'T A PERSONAL 'BRAKE'. IT'S JUST THAT THE PROCESS NEEDS TO BE CONTINUED A BIT FURTHER.+

+THE OMBUDSMAN IDEA IS PART OF A MUCH WIDER REVIEW OF ALL ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS,+ HE SAID.

+AND THE OTHER THING IS THAT NOW THAT THE NEW LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL HAS SETTLED DOWN MORE, I WANT TO LOOK AT IT IN THAT CONTEXT.

+AND THE THIRD THOUGHT WAS THAT WE MUSTN'T GET WHAT I CALL 'ADMINISTRATIVE INDIGESTION'. IF YOU MAKE TOO MANY CHANGES ALL AT ONCE BEFORE THE SYSTEM HAS SETTLED DOWN, YOU MAY FIND LATER ON THAT YOU WANT TO RE-ADJUST THEM.

+SO THE NEW LEGCO SYSTEM IS WORKING QUITE WELL, THE MEMBERS ARE GETTING INTO IT, AND IN NOT TOO DISTANT FUTURE, I THINK WE'LL BE ABLE TO LOOK AT THE WHOLE FIELD OF ADMINISTRATIVE REVIEWS.+

ASKED WHETHER INDIRECTLY-ELECTED LEGISLATIVE COUNCILLORS WOULD BE APPOINTED TO FILL VACANCIES IN THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, SIR EDWARD SAID: +IF I WAS YOU, I'LL PUT THAT FILE AWAY FOR A LITTLE WHILE BECAUSE THERE WON'T BE ANY EARLY ANNOUNCEMENT ON THESE MATTERS. BUT TRY AGAIN IN A COUPLE OF MONTHS' TIME.+

GOVERNOR OPENS AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH CENTRE  
\* \* \* \* \*

AN AGRICULTURAL VENTURE WITH A STRONG EDUCATIONAL LINK - THE KADOORIE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH CENTRE - WAS OPENED TODAY (SATURDAY) BY THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE.

SIR EDWARD SAID THAT APART FROM PROVIDING A TEACHING FIELD STATION FOR THE ENVIRONMENTAL SCIENCE DEPARTMENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG, THE CENTRE WOULD ALSO PROVIDE FACILITIES FOR RESEARCH INTO AGRICULTURAL AND HORTICULTURAL PROBLEMS OF RELEVANCE TO HONG KONG AND NEIGHBOURING REGIONS.

HE SAID THAT HE WAS PARTICULARLY PLEASED TO SEE THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE RESEARCH CENTRE BEING COMBINED WITH THE RESEARCH WORK OF THE UNIVERSITY.

+IN TODAY'S COMPLEX WORLD, INTER-DISCIPLINARY RESEARCH AND CO-OPERATION IS INCREASINGLY IMPORTANT.

+WE LOOK FORWARD WITH ANTICIPATION TO THE COMPLETION OF PHASES II AND III WHICH WILL PROVIDE ADDITIONAL LABORATORIES AND GREENHOUSES,+ HE SAID.

SIR EDWARD NOTED THAT THE ASSISTANCE WHICH THE KADOORIE FAMILY HAD GIVEN TO HONG KONG'S RURAL AND FARMING COMMUNITIES WAS WELL KNOWN AND WENT BACK MANY YEARS.

HE SAID: +THE KADOORIE AGRICULTURAL AID LOAN FUND HAS CONTRIBUTED GREATLY TO THE DEVELOPMENT OF AGRICULTURE IN HONG KONG.

+THE AGRICULTURAL AID ASSOCIATION HAS PROVIDED SUPPORT TO A WIDE RANGE OF LOCAL PUBLIC WORKS FOR IMPROVING VILLAGE ACCESS, IRRIGATION AND TRANSPORTATION FACILITIES.

+RELIEF AND GIFTS OF LIVESTOCK AND ANIMAL FEED HAVE BEEN GIVEN TO FARMERS IN DIFFICULTY TO HELP THEM TO IMPROVE THEIR STANDARDS OF FARMING.

+TO COMPLEMENT THIS EFFORT, THE KADOORIE FARM UNDERTAKES LIVESTOCK AND CROP IMPROVEMENT PROGRAMMES AND DISSEMINATES INFORMATION ON GOOD FARMING PRACTICES.

+THE FARM HAS ALSO GIVEN COUNTLESS PARTIES OF SCHOOL CHILDREN AN INSIGHT INTO MODERN HORTICULTURE AND AN ENJOYABLE DAY IN THE COUNTRYSIDE.+

SIR EDWARD SAID THAT THE ESTABLISHMENT OF THE AGRICULTURAL RESEARCH CENTRE HAD BEEN MADE POSSIBLE BY THE GENEROUS DONATION OF THE KADOORIE FAMILY AND THE HARD WORK OF THE PROJECT COMMITTEE.

+WE ARE MOST THANKFUL TO THEM ALL FOR THEIR GENEROSITY AND EFFORTS,+ HE ADDED.

1984 BUILDING, CONSTRUCTION, REAL ESTATE SURVEY RESULTS  
\* \* \* \* \*

THERE WERE 6 779 CONSTRUCTION ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING IN 1984 EMPLOYING DIRECTLY A TOTAL OF 98 166 PERSONS, ACCORDING TO SURVEY RESULTS RELEASED TODAY BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT.

TOTAL GROSS VALUE OF CONSTRUCTION WORK PERFORMED BY THESE ESTABLISHMENTS DURING 1984 AMOUNTED TO \$40 307 MILLION, REPRESENTING AN INCREASE OF FOUR PER CENT OVER 1983.

THE TOTAL EXPENDITURES BY THE CONSTRUCTION ESTABLISHMENTS WERE \$38 530 MILLION WHICH INCLUDED \$9 661 MILLION ON COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES AND PAYMENTS TO LABOUR-ONLY SUB-CONTRACTORS= \$11 587 MILLION ON CONSUMPTION OF MATERIALS, SUPPLIES, AND INDUSTRIAL SERVICES= \$15 068 MILLION ON SUB-CONTRACT WORK RENDERED BY FEE SUB-CONTRACTORS= AND \$2 214 MILLION ON MISCELLANEOUS OPERATING EXPENSES.

AT \$12 180 MILLION, THE TOTAL VALUE ADDED WAS ONE PER CENT LESS THAN IN 1983. VALUE ADDED IS A MEASURE OF THE SECTOR'S CONTRIBUTION TO HONG KONG'S GROSS DOMESTIC PRODUCT.

OVER ONE-THIRD OF THE CONSTRUCTION ESTABLISHMENTS WERE ENGAGED IN RENOVATION AND MAINTENANCE OF ERECTED BUILDINGS AND STRUCTURES. HOWEVER, THEY ACCOUNTED FOR ONLY EIGHT PER CENT OF THE VALUE OF TOTAL CONSTRUCTION WORK PERFORMED BY ALL CONTRACTORS.

ON THE OTHER HAND, THE GENERAL TRADE CONTRACTORS OPERATING AT BUILDING AND CONSTRUCTION SITES, WHICH NUMBERED ONLY 827, CONTRIBUTED \$26 540 MILLION OR 66 PER CENT OF TOTAL CONSTRUCTION WORK PERFORMED.

THE REST OF THE CONSTRUCTION SECTOR CONSISTED OF MOSTLY SPECIAL TRADE CONTRACTORS, SUCH AS CONTRACTORS SPECIALISING IN ELECTRICAL AND MECHANICAL FITTINGS.

THE SURVEY DID NOT COVER LABOUR-ONLY SUB-CONTRACTORS WHO MAINLY SUPPLIED LABOUR TO WORK ON A JOB-TO-JOB BASIS. HOWEVER, THE OUTPUT OF THESE SUB-CONTRACTORS WAS IMPLICITLY INCLUDED IN THAT OF THE CONTRACTORS COMMISSIONING THEIR SERVICES.

APART FROM CONSTRUCTION ESTABLISHMENTS, THE SURVEY ALSO INCLUDED FIRMS ENGAGED IN THE FOLLOWING ACTIVITIES: REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT, LEASING, BROKERAGE AND MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT= AND ARCHITECTURAL, SURVEYING AND PROJECT ENGINEERING.

THERE WERE 3 285 ESTABLISHMENTS IN REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT, LEASING, BROKERAGE AND MAINTENANCE SERVICES OPERATING DURING 1984, ENGAGING A TOTAL OF 24 762 PERSONS.

THEIR GROSS OUTPUT IN 1984 WAS \$15 229 MILLION WHICH INCLUDED \$8 522 MILLION OF SERVICE AND RENTAL INCOME, \$6 090 MILLION OF GROSS MARGIN OF REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS AND \$617 MILLION OF OTHER INCOME. THEIR TOTAL EXPENDITURES WERE \$6 370 MILLION.

AT \$13 171 MILLION, THE TOTAL VALUE ADDED WAS FOUR PER CENT LESS THAN IN 1983.

THESE FIGURES DO NOT INCLUDE ESTABLISHMENTS THAT DEVELOPED REAL ESTATE PROJECTS FOR THEIR OWN OCCUPATION OR THOSE THAT OWNED LAND WITHOUT DEVELOPING IT DURING THE REFERENCE YEAR. ALSO EXCLUDED WERE REAL ESTATE ACTIVITIES UNDERTAKEN BY SELF-EMPLOYED PERSONS OR HOUSEHOLDS.

REGARDING ARCHITECTURAL, SURVEYING AND PROJECT ENGINEERING SERVICES, THE SURVEY INDICATED THAT THERE WERE 486 SUCH ESTABLISHMENTS OPERATING IN 1984 ENGAGING A TOTAL OF 7 985 PERSONS.

THEIR TOTAL BUSINESS RECEIPTS WERE \$1 766 MILLION, REPRESENTING A DECREASE OF SEVEN PER CENT COMPARED WITH 1983. THEIR TOTAL EXPENDITURES WERE \$1 390 MILLION OF WHICH \$824 MILLION WAS ON COMPENSATION OF EMPLOYEES. THE TOTAL VALUE ADDED WAS \$1 193 MILLION, A DECREASE OF SIX PER CENT COMPARED WITH 1983.

BESIDES STATISTICS ON ESTABLISHMENTS, THE SURVEY ALSO COLLECTED DATA ABOUT CONSTRUCTION SITES AND REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS. A TOTAL OF 1 782 SITE CONTRACTS WERE CARRIED OUT IN 1984 WITH THE GROSS VALUE OF CONSTRUCTION WORK PERFORMED AMOUNTING TO \$21 160 MILLION, WHICH WAS FOUR PER CENT LOWER THAN IN 1983. THIS INCLUDED \$8 933 MILLION ON PUBLIC WORKS PROJECTS AND \$12 227 MILLION ON PRIVATE CONSTRUCTION SITES.

THE VALUE ACCRUED TO PRIVATE REAL ESTATE DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS DURING 1984 WAS \$15 060 MILLION, REPRESENTING A DECREASE OF SEVEN PER CENT COMPARED WITH 1983. THE TOTAL PROJECT OUTLAYS WERE \$11 478 MILLION WHICH INCLUDED PAYMENTS TO CONTRACTORS, FEES FOR ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN AND TECHNICAL CONSULTANCY, INTEREST PAYMENTS AND OTHER PROJECT EXPENSES.

THE SUMMARY STATISTICS FROM THE 1984 SURVEY OF BUILDING, CONSTRUCTION AND REAL ESTATE SECTORS WAS INCLUDED IN THE MAY 1986 ISSUE OF THE HONG KONG MONTHLY DIGEST OF STATISTICS. MORE DETAILED RESULTS WILL BE GIVEN IN THE SURVEY REPORT TO BE PUBLISHED IN A FEW WEEKS' TIME.

20 MORE INDOOR GAMES HALLS IN THE PIPELINE

THE URBAN COUNCIL IS PLANNING TO BUILD 20 MORE INDOOR GAMES HALLS OVER THE NEXT FIVE YEARS TO MEET AN INCREASING DEMAND FOR INDOOR SPORTS ACTIVITIES.

THIS WAS DISCLOSED TODAY BY THE COUNCIL VICE-CHAIRMAN, MRS ELSIE TU, WHEN SHE OFFICIATED AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE HIU KWONG STREET INDOOR GAMES HALL AND CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND IN KWUN TONG.

MRS TU SAID SIX NEW INDOOR GAMES HALLS WOULD BE OPENED TO THE PUBLIC LATER THIS YEAR OR EARLY NEXT YEAR, AT THE WAN CHAI RECLAMATION AND LOCKHART ROAD URBAN COUNCIL COMPLEX ON HONG KONG ISLAND, AND AT CHUK YUEN, NGAU CHI WAN URBAN COUNCIL COMPLEX, PO ON ROAD URBAN COUNCIL COMPLEX AND BOUNDARY STREET IN KOWLOON.

+ INDOOR SPORTS ACTIVITIES HAVE BECOME ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR FORMS OF RECREATION AMONG LOCAL RESIDENTS AS CAN BE EVIDENCED FROM THE VERY HIGH USAGE RATE OF VARIOUS URBAN COUNCIL INDOOR GAMES HALLS OVER THE YEARS, + SHE SAID.

+ INTERESTINGLY THIS AVERAGE USAGE RATE IS MORE THAN 90 PER CENT, WHICH IS PROOF IN ITSELF OF THE COUNCIL'S DECISION SOME YEARS AGO TO INTRODUCE THESE INNOVATIVE RECREATIONAL FACILITIES WHICH ARE UNIQUE TO HONG KONG WITH ITS SERIOUS SHORTAGE OF LAND FOR SPORTING ACTIVITIES.

+ THROUGH THIS OFFICIAL OPENING CEREMONY TODAY THE URBAN COUNCIL HAS AGAIN DEMONSTRATED ITS COMMITMENT TO MAKING LIFE HAPPIER AND HEALTHIER FOR THE PEOPLE OF HONG KONG. +

THE \$20 MILLION HIU KWONG STREET PROJECT IS THE FIRST FREE-STANDING INDOOR GAMES HALL IN KWUN TONG AND THE THIRD OF ITS KIND IN THE DISTRICT.

IT HAS SUCH MODERN FACILITIES AS A 1 300 SQUARE METRE GAMES ARENA WITH A SPECTATOR STAND ACCOMMODATING 400 PEOPLE.

THE ARENA IS DESIGNED FOR MULTI-PURPOSE SPORTS ACTIVITIES AND CAN ACCOMMODATE TWO BASKETBALL COURTS, OR TWO VOLLEYBALL COURTS, OR EIGHT BADMINTON COURTS. IT CAN ALSO BE USED FOR TABLE TENNIS, GYMNASTICS AND JUDO, FOR TRAINING AS WELL AS DISTRICT-WIDE COMPETITIONS.

IN ADDITION, THERE ARE THREE FULLY AIR-CONDITIONED SQUASH COURTS WITH PUBLIC VIEWING GALLERIES AND TWO TRAINING ROOMS SUITABLE FOR CONFERENCE, GAMES OR YOGA PRACTICE PURPOSES.

LAND BEING RESUMED FOR JUNK BAY TUNNEL PROJECT

\* \* \* \* \*

THE GOVERNMENT IS TO RESUME TWO LOTS OF AGRICULTURAL LAND TOTALLING 3 240 SQUARE METRES, LOCATED TO THE EAST OF THE RESERVOIR AT LAM TIN, AS PART OF THE PROJECT TO LINK JUNK BAY AND KWUN TONG BY A ROAD TUNNEL.

THE TUNNEL WILL CONNECT JUNK BAY NEW TOWN WITH KWUN TONG AND LEI YUE MUN ROADS AND CONSTRUCTION IS EXPECTED TO START IN AUGUST.

INITIALLY, A SINGLE TUBE CARRYING TWO-WAY TRAFFIC WILL BE BUILT TO SERVE A POPULATION OF BETWEEN 150 000 AND 175 000 AT JUNK BAY.

FOR THE FULL DEVELOPMENT OF JUNK BAY PHASE ONE UP TO A POPULATION OF 223 000, A SECOND TUBE OF THE TUNNEL WILL HAVE TO BE BUILT AND THE ROAD UPGRADED TO DUAL-CARRIAGEWAY, TWO-LANE.

THE INITIAL SINGLE-TUBE TUNNEL WILL ALSO INCLUDE LARGE MAINS TAKING WATER FROM A NEW TREATMENT WORKS UNDER CONSTRUCTION AT PAK KONG IN SAI KUNG TO EAST KOWLOON, HONG KONG ISLAND AND THE NEW TOWN.

TREES TO MAKE +BRANCH+ LINE FOR LRT

MORE THAN 10 000 YOUNG TREES WILL BE PLANTED ALONG A SEVEN-KILOMETRE STRIP OF THE LIGHT RAIL TRANSIT SYSTEM IN THE TUEN MUN-YUEN LONG CORRIDOR AS PART OF A SOFT LANDSCAPING PROJECT.

THE TERRITORY DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT IS INVITING TENDERS FOR THE PROJECT EXPECTED TO START IN AUGUST AND TAKE ABOUT 28 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

THE PLANTING OF THE TREES, ALONG WITH SHRUBS AND FLOWER BEDS, WILL TAKE PLACE IN THE 1987 AND 1988 PLANTING SEASONS.

+AS PART OF THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE LRT SOME 1 000 TREES WILL HAVE TO BE FELLED OR TRANSPLANTED. BUT WE WILL BE REPLACING THEM WITH MORE THAN 10 TIMES THAT NUMBER,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TDD'S NEW TERRITORIES/NORTH WEST DEVELOPMENT OFFICE SAID.

+OF COURSE THESE WILL BE YOUNG TREES AND WILL TAKE TIME TO MATURE. BESIDES THE TREES WE WILL BE PLANTING THOUSANDS OF SHRUBS AND FLOWER BEDS.

+SOFT LANDSCAPING WILL BE PROVIDED FOR THE NEWLY-FORMED AREAS ADJACENT TO THE LRT LINE AND ALONG THE CENTRAL RESERVE ON CASTLE PEAK ROAD,+ HE ADDED.

THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT WILL HOLD ITS SECOND INTERNATIONAL SEMINAR FOR LANGUAGE TEACHERS IN DECEMBER. THE THEME THIS YEAR IS 'RE-EXPLORING CONTINUING EDUCATION FOR LANGUAGE TEACHERS (CELT)'.

THE SEMINAR, ORGANISED BY THE DEPARTMENT'S INSTITUTE OF LANGUAGE IN EDUCATION, WILL BE HELD AT THE SHANGRI-LA HOTEL, TSIM SHA TSUI EAST, FROM DECEMBER 15 TO 17.

THE OBJECTIVES ARE TO PROVIDE OPPORTUNITIES FOR TEACHER TRAINERS, LANGUAGE TEACHERS AND RESEARCHERS TO EXAMINE AND REDEFINE THE PURPOSE OF CELT AND TO ENHANCE THEIR UNDERSTANDING, KNOWLEDGE AND CAPABILITIES BY EXCHANGING IDEAS AND EXPERIENCES ON CELT.

EYE-DOTTING CEREMONY FOR DRAGON BOATS

A TOTAL OF 21 NEW DRAGON BOATS WILL BE LAUNCHED ON THE SHING MUN RIVER AT SHA TIN TOMORROW (SUNDAY) IN PREPARATION FOR THE DRAGON BOAT RACE THERE ON JUNE 11 (WEDNESDAY).
