GOOD NEWS FOR KIDNEY PATIENTS

* * * *

THE GOVERNMENT PLANS TO SET UP TWO RENAL DIALYSIS CENTRES, ONE AT ABERDEEN AND THE OTHER AT QUEEN ELIZABETH HOSPITAL, TO AUGMENT THE EXISTING HAEMODIALYSIS SERVICES FOR KIDNEY PATIENTS.

A SUM OF \$2.7 MILLION HAS BEEN DONATED BY THE LEE FAMILY IN MEMORY OF THE LATE DR LEE IU CHEUNG TOWARDS THE CONSTRUCTION COSTS OF THE TWO CENTRES WHILE THE GOVERNMENT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ANNUAL RECURRENT EXPENDITURE.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT TODAY DESCRIBED THE DONATION AS +A MOST TIMELY CONTRIBUTION+ AS IT IS ESTIMATED THAT THERE WILL BE AN ANNUAL INCREASE OF 200 PATIENTS REQUIRING RENAL DIALYSIS.

+THE ESTABLISHMENT IN THE NEXT FEW YEARS OF THE TWO RENAL DIALYSIS CENTRES WILL BE OF GREAT HELP TO ALL RENAL PATIENTS IN NEED OF SUCH TREATMENT,+ HE SAID.

THE FIRST CENTRE, EXPECTED TO COME INTO BEING IN 1982, WILL BE SET UP AT THE ABERDEEN JOCKEY CLUB CLINIC AT A COST OF ABOUT \$1 MILLION.

THE SECOND CENTRE IS PLANNED TO BE SET UP IN THE NEW EXTENSION AT QUEEN ELIZABETH HOSPITAL IN 1985.

+THE PURPOSE OF SETTING UP A SATELLITE DIALYSIS CENTRE IS TO PROVIDE ON AN OUT-PATIENT BASIS FOLLOW-UP TREATMENT TO THOSE PATIENTS WHOSE CONDITION HAS BEEN STABILISED AND THUS REQUIRING MINIMAL NURSING CARE AFTER A SERIES OF TREATMENT AT A REGIONAL HOSPITAL,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

AT PRESENT THERE ARE TWO RENAL DIALYSIS UNITS, ONE AT QUEEN MARY HOSPITAL AND THE OTHER AT PRINCESS MARGARET HOSPITAL WITH 12 AND 16 MACHINES RESPECTIVELY.

+THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SATELLITE CENTRE AT ABERDEEN WILL HELP EASE THE PRESSURE ON EXISTING FACILITIES AT QUEEN MARY HOSPITAL WHICH SHOULD BE USED FOR MORE SEVERE AND COMPLICATED CASES,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

PLANS ARE ALSO IN THE PIPELINE TO INCORPORATE RENAL DIALYSIS UNITS IN THE NEW SHA TIN AND TUEN MUN HOSPITALS, TUEN MUN POLYCLINIC STAGE 2, AND KWUN TONG POLYCLINIC.

STUDENT GUIDANCE HELPS PREVENT JUVENILE DELINQUENCY

ASSISTANT DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MRS EVELYN DOE, SAID TODAY THE STUDENT GUIDANCE SERVICE PLAYED A POSITIVE ROLE IN PREVENTING JUVENILE DELINQUENCY.

SHE WAS SPEAKING AT THE CLOSING CEREMONY OF A 13-WEEK PRE-SERVICE TRAINING COURSE JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE AND EDUCATION DEPARTMENTS FOR 50 STUDENT GUIDANCE OFFICERS AT THE LADY TRENCH TRAINING CENTRE.

MRS DOE SAID THE SERVICE WAS BOTH PREVENTIVE AND REMEDIAL WORK.

IN THEIR CONTACTS WITH STUDENTS THROUGH INTERVIEWS, HOME VISITS AND GROUP ACTIVITIES, SHE SAID, STUDENT GUIDANCE OFFICERS DETECT AT AN EARLY STAGE PROBLEMS THAT MAY AFFECT THEIR PHYSICAL AND MENTAL DEVELOPMENT.

THEY HELP THESE STUDENTS OVERCOME DIFFICULTIES BY GIVING THEM PERSONAL, EDUCATIONAL AND VOCATIONAL GUIDANCE, SHE SAID.

+AT A TIME WHEN THE JUVENILE CRIME RATE IS ON THE INCREASE, THEIR SERVICE PLAYS A POSITIVE ROLE IN PREVENTING JUVENILE DELINQUENCY THROUGH HELPING STUDENTS WITH BEHAVIOURAL OR OTHER PROBLEMS,+ SHE ADDED.

MRS DOE POINTED OUT THAT THE WORK OF STUDENT GUIDANCE OFFICERS WAS BOTH HEAVY AND CHALLENGING.

JUDGING FROM THE RATIO OF ONE OFFICER FOR EVERY 2 000 PRIMARY STUDENTS IN RURAL AREAS AND ONE FOR EVERY 3 000 IN URBAN AREAS, THE 50 GRADUATING OFFICERS WOULD SERVE OVER 100 000 SCHOOL CHILDREN, SHE SAID.

SHE TOLD THE GRADUATES TO COMBINE THEORETICAL TRAINING WITH THEIR OWN TEACHING EXPERIENCE AND OBSERVATION TO MAXIMISE THE EFFECT OF THEIR SERVICE.

IN ADDITION, SHE SAID, THEY NEED TO KEEP CLOSE TOUCH AND COOPERATE WITH THE PROFESSIONAL WORKERS IN THE FIELDS OF SPECIAL EDUCATION AND SOCIAL WORK.

FOR INSTANCE IN CASEWORK, SHE ADDED, THERE ARE STUDENT GUIDANCE CONSULTING-RECEIVING OFFICERS IN EACH DISTRICT BOTH FROM HER DEPARTMENT AND THE VOLUNTARY SECTOR TO PROVIDE A BACK-UP SERVICE.

MRS DOE SAID SCHOOL SOCIAL WORK SERVICE WAS ONE OF THE IMPORTANT AREAS OF SOCIAL WELFARE SERVICES WHICH HAD SHOWN MARKED DEVELOPMENT IN PAST YEARS.

SHE SAID THE SERVICE WAS PROVIDED IN SECONDARY SCHOOLS BY SOCIAL WORKERS FROM THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT AND VOLUNTARY AGENCIES- AND IN PRIMARY SCHOOLS, BY STUDENT GUIDANCE OFFICERS OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

SNT INAUGURATES NORTH DISTRICT ARTS ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION

OPPORTUNITIES FOR CULTURAL ACTIVITY IN THE NEW TERRITORIES ARE INCREASING AS PURPOSE-BUILT VENUES FOR THE PERFORMANCE AND APPRECIATION OF MUSIC, DANCE AND DRAMA BEGIN TO APPEAR, SECRETARY FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES, MR DAVID AKERS-JONES, SAID TODAY.

MR AKERS-JONES WAS SPEAKING AT THE INAUGURATION OF OFFICE-BEARERS FOR NORTH DISTRICT ARTS ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION.

+IN TSUEN WAN, THE TOWN HALL IS ALREADY PLAYING A MAJOR ROLE IN THE CULTURAL LIFE OF THE COMMUNITY,+ HE SAID.

+EARLY NEXT YEAR, THE CHIU LUT SAU HALL WILL OPEN IN YUEN LONG- LATER IN THE YEAR THERE WILL BE THE TOWN HALL HERE IN SHEUNG SHUI, AIR-CONDITIONED BY PRIVATE DONATION.

+PLANS ARE WELL AHEAD TO START WORK ON AUDITORIA IN TUEN MUN, IN SHA TIN AND IN SAI KUNG IN 1981.+

WITH THE INAUGURATION OF NORTH DISTRICT ARTS ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION THERE IS NOW AN ORGANISATION OF LOCAL PEOPLE FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF THE ARTS IN EACH OF THE EIGHT NEW TERRITORIES DISTRICTS, MR AKERS-JONES SAID.

HE SAID HE WAS ABSOLUTELY CONFIDENT THAT OPPORTUNITIES PRESENTED BY THESE NEW FACILITIES WOULD BE SEIZED AND THAT LOCAL ARTS ASSOCIATIONS WOULD TAKE THE LEAD IN DEVELOPING AND ENSURING A RICH AND VARIED CULTURAL LIFE FOR THE PEOPLE IN THEIR AREAS.

THE GOVERNMENT WILL BE ABLE TO ASSIST THESE EFFORTS IN TWO WAYS: FINANCIALLY THROUGH THE DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARDS, AND BY PROVISION OF PROFESSIONAL TECHNICAL ADVICE, HE SAID.

MR AKERS-JONES SAID NORTH DISTRICT ARTS ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION WAS AT ONCE A NEW ORGANISATION IN A NEW DISTRICT WITH THE POSSIBILITIES FOR A FRESH APPROACH WHICH THAT ENTAILED, AND AN INHERITOR OF THE ACHIEVEMENTS OF THE FORMER TAI PO SIX DISTRICTS ARTS ADVANCEMENT ASSOCIATION.

IN SUPPORT OF THE ASSOCIATION, NORTH DISTRICT ADVISORY BOARD HAS AGREED TO PROVIDE \$100 000 TO FINANCE ITS PROJECTS AND ANOTHER \$80 000 WILL BE RAISED FROM PRIVATE DONATIONS.

TODAY'S CEREMONY WAS ALSO ATTENDED BY NORTH DISTRICT OFFICER, MR PETER JOHNSON, AND PRINCIPAL EDUCATION OFFICER (NT REGION), MR LEE TSE-CHUN.

AS PART OF THE INAUGURATION CEREMONY, AN EXHIBITION, ALSO ORGANISED BY THE ASSOCIATION, WAS OPENED BY MRS AKERS-JONES AT FIRST FUNG KAI SECONDARY SCHOOL HALL, SHEUNG SHUI.

EXHIBITS INCLUDED PHOTOGRAPHS, CALLIGRAPHY AND CHINESE PAINTINGS BY MEMBERS OF THE ASSOCIATION AND OTHER EXHIBITORS.

THE EXHIBITION WILL BE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC UNTIL DECEMBER 17 FROM 9 AM TO 5 PM DAILY.

COMMUNITY SERVICES A GOOD WAY TO TRAIN YOUTHS

REGIONAL SOCIAL WELFARE OFFICER (HONG KONG ISLAND), MR KWOK KA-CHI, TODAY DESCRIBED PROMOTING COMMUNITY SERVICES AS THE MOST EFFECTIVE WAY OF MORAL TRAINING FOR YOUNG PEOPLE.

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF A YOUTH AND SOCIAL SERVICE EXHIBITION AT VICTORIA PARK, HE SAID COMMUNITY SERVICES HAD SIGNIFICANT VALUE, NOT ONLY TO THE RECIPIENTS BUT TO THE PROVIDERS AS WELL.

THROUGH COMMUNITY SERVICES, HE SAID, YOUNG PEOPLE LEARN TO CARE MORE ABOUT THEIR SOCIETY AND HELP FOSTER A CARING COMMUNITY.

THE REASON IS THAT IN THE PLANNING PROCESS, IT NEEDS SOUND ORGANISATION AND LEADERSHIP, A PROFOUND UNDERSTANDING OF THE NEEDS OF THE SERVICE TARGET, AND CLOSE COOPERATION, HE SAID.

+IN EACH PLANNING STAGE, THERE ARE OPPORTUNITIES FOR THE PARTICIPANTS TO DEVELOP THEIR POTENTIAL AND INTEREST, AND THE COMPLETION OF A PROJECT CAN GIVE JOB SATISFACTION,+ HE ADDED.

MR KWOK SAID THAT SOCIAL WORKERS NOWADAYS NO LONGER RELIED ON THEIR OWN EFFORTS BUT PLACED GREAT IMPORTANCE IN INVOLVING YOUNG PEOPLE IN YOUTH SERVICES.

+WITHOUT THEIR PARTICIPATION, IT IS APT TO COME ACROSS PROBLEMS THAT MAY WELL HAVE BEEN CAUSED BY OVERLOOKING THE NEEDS AND INTEREST OF YOUNG PEOPLE,+ HE SAID.

THE EXHIBITION AT VICTORIA PARK WAS SPONSORED BY THE TAI PING SHAN LIONS CLUB, AND JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE SOCIAL WELFARE AND EDUCATION DEPARTMENTS, VOLUNTARY AGENCIES, SCHOOLS AND YOUTH GROUPS IN THE EASTERN DISTRICT.

APART FROM EXHIBITS ON YOUTH SERVICES, THERE WERE PERFORMANCES OF WHEELCHAIR DANCING, SIGN-LANGUAGE SINGING, FOLK SONGS, AND FIRST AID DEMONSTRATION.

HOLIDAY REMINDER TO EMPLOYERS
* * * * *

A LABOUR DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN TODAY REMINDED EMPLOYERS THAT UNDER THE EMPLOYMENT ORDINANCE EITHER THE CHINESE WINTER SOLSTICE FESTIVAL (WHICH FALLS ON DECEMBER 22) OR CHRISTMAS DAY (DECEMBER 25) SHOULD BE APPOINTED AS A STATUTORY HOLIDAY AND THAT WORKERS MUST BE GIVEN A DAY OFF ON EITHER DAY.

UNDER THE ORDINANCE ALL MANUAL EMPLOYEES INCLUDING DOMESTIC SERVANTS IRRESPECTIVE OF THEIR EARNINGS, AND ALL NON-MANUAL EMPLOYEES EARNING NOT MORE THAN \$3 500 A MONTH, ARE ENTITLED TO THE HOLIDAY.

THEY MUST ALSO BE PAID FOR THE DAY OFF IF THEY HAVE WORKED CONTINUOUSLY FOR THREE MONTHS IMMEDIATELY PRECEDING THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY.

/HOLIDAY PAY

HOLIDAY PAY SHOULD BE EQUIVALENT TO THE EMPLOYEE'S EARNINGS, OTHER THAN OVERTIME PAY, ON A NORMAL WORKING DAY. WHERE THE EARNINGS VARY FROM DAY TO DAY, HOLIDAY PAY SHOULD BE THE AVERAGE OF THE DAILY EARNINGS DURING A PERIOD OF 28 DAYS PRECEDING THE HOLIDAY. PAYMENT SHOULD BE MADE ON THE NORMAL PAY DAY.

IF AN EMPLOYEE IS REQUIRED TO WORK ON THE HOLIDAY, THE SPOKESMAN CONTINUED, HE MUST BE GIVEN AN ALTERNATIVE DAY OFF WITHIN 60 DAYS BEFORE OR AFTER THAT DAY.

IF THE ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY IS TO BE GRANTED BEFORE THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY, THE EMPLOYER MUST NOTIFY THE EMPLOYEE 48 HOURS IN ADVANCE OF THE ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY.

IN THE CASE WHERE AN ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY IS TO BE GIVEN AFTER THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY, THE EMPLOYEE MUST BE NOTIFIED OF THE ARRANGEMENT AT LEAST 48 HOURS BEFORE THE STATUTORY HOLIDAY.

IF BOTH EMPLOYER AND EMPLOYEE AGREE, ANY DAY WITHIN 30 DAYS OF A STATUTORY HOLIDAY OR ALTERNATIVE HOLIDAY CAN BE TAKEN BY THE EMPLOYEE AS A SUBSTITUTED HOLIDAY, HE SAID.

REDISTRIBUTION OF IDENTITY REGISTRATION BUSINESS * * * * *

FROM MONDAY (DECEMBER 15) THE REGISTRATION OF PERSONS OFFICE ON THE 3RD FLOOR OF THE CAUSEWAY BAY MAGISTRACY BUILDING WILL NO LONGER HANDLE APPLICATIONS FOR REGISTRATION OF JUVENILE IDENTITY CARDS, RE-REGISTRATION OF JUVENILES FOR ADULT IDENTITY CARDS AND REGISTRATION OF NEW ARRIVALS.

THOSE WHO WANT TO USE SUCH FACILITIES MAY GO TO THE QUEENSWAY BRANCH OF THE OFFICE AT BLOCK 'G' OF VICTORIA BARRACKS.

+APPLICANTS WHO WANT TO APPLY FOR REPLACEMENT OF LOST OR DEFACED IDENTITY CARDS OR AMENDMENT OF THEIR REGISTERED PARTICULARS STILL HAVE TO APPROACH THE OFFICE IN THE MAGISTRACY BUILDING FOR THESE SERVICES,+ A SPOKESMAN SAID.

+THIS ARRANGEMENT WILL NOT ONLY REDUCE THE WORKLOAD AT THAT OFFICE BUT ALSO PROVIDE MORE FACILITIES TO APPLICANTS FOR IDENTITY CARDS, PARTICULARLY FOR JUVENILE IDENTITY CARDS DURING THE CLOSURE OF SCHOOLS FOR THE CHRISTMAS HOLIDAYS,+ HE ADDED.

HAPPY VALLEY ROADS OPENED TO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC

WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD BETWEEN QUEEN'S ROAD EAST AND VILLAGE ROAD, AND LEIGHTON ROAD BETWEEN CANAL ROAD EAST AND WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD WILL BE OPENED TO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC FROM 10 AM ON MONDAY (DECEMBER 15).

THE FOLLOWING TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN THE HAPPY VALLEY AREA WILL BE INTRODUCED:

- * THE BUS LANE ON THE WESTBOUND CARRIAGEWAY OF THE NEW TWO-WAY SECTION OF LEIGHTON ROAD WILL BE RESCINDED.
- * SING WOO ROAD BETWEEN WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD AND KING KWONG STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM TWO-WAY TO ONE-WAY SOUTHBOUND.
- * TSOI TAK STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED FROM TWO-WAY TO ONE-WAY EASTBOUND. RIGHT TURNS FROM NORTHBOUND SING WOO ROAD INTO TSOI TAK STREET WILL NO LONGER BE ALLOWED.

- * WESTBOUND TRAFFIC ON LEIGHTON ROAD WILL BE ABLE TO GO TO MORRISON HILL ROAD AND TIN LOK LANE. RIGHT TURNS FROM LEIGHTON ROAD WESTBOUND INTO CANAL ROAD WEST FOR THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL WILL NOT BE PERMITTED UNTIL LATER THIS MONTH DUE TO ROAD WORKS.
- * SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC FROM THE CROSS HARBOUR TUNNEL FOR BLUE POOL ROAD CAN GO VIA THE DOWN-RAMP OF CANAL ROAD FLYOVER EXTENSION, WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD SOUTHBOUND, VILLAGE ROAD, YICK YAM STREET AND SING WOO ROAD.
- * YICK YAM STREET WILL BE PROHIBITED TO LEARNER DRIVERS.
- * EXISTING PARKING SPACES ON YICK YAM STREET AND KING KWONG STREET WILL BE CANCELLED. HOWEVER SIX SPACES WILL BE PROVIDED ON THE WESTERN SIDE OF SING WOO ROAD BETWEEN HOUSE NO. 2 AND NO. 10A.
- * CMB ROUTE NOS. 10, 72, 17, 15B AND 170 WILL PROCEED VIA LEIGHTON ROAD, MORRISON HILL ROAD AND QUEEN'S ROAD EAST, INSTEAD OF GOING ROUND WONG NAI CHUNG ROAD.
