GOVERNOR RETURNS FROM GENEVA CONFERENCE

THE GOVERNOR, SIR MURRAY MACLEHOSE, RETURNED TO HONG KONG THIS (MONDAY) AFTERNOON AFTER ATTENDING A TWO-DAY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE ON THE VIETNAMESE REFUGEE PROBLEM IN GENEVA AS PART OF THE BRITISH DELEGATION.

SIR MURRAY, WHO WAS ACCOMPANIED BY THE SECRETARY FOR INFORMATION, MR. DAVID FORD, WAS MET ON ARRIVAL AT THE AIRPORT BY LADY MACLEHOSE; THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR JACK CATER- THE COMMANDER BRITISH FORCES, MAJ-GEN SIR ROY REDGRAVE- THE SENIOR UNOFFICIAL MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, SIR YUET-KEUNG KAN- THE SENIOR UNOFFICIAL MEMBER OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, MR. OSWALD CHEUNG- THE DOYEN OF THE CONSULAR CORPS, MR. OSCAR MICHELENA- AND THE CHARGE DE MISSION OF THE UNHCR, MR. ANGELO RASANAYAGAM.

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS TO INTRODUCE, ON A TRIAL BASIS, A MORE EFFECTIVE TYPE OF ROAD MARKINGS IN AN EFFORT TO IMPROVE ROAD SAFETY.

A CONTRACT, THE FIRST OF ITS KIND, FOR THE PROVISION AND LAYING OF REFLECTIVE THERMOPLASTIC ROAD MARKINGS ON A NUMBER OF ROADS THROUGHOUT HONG KONG WILL BE SIGNED TOMORROW (TUESDAY).

OPENING OF FU SHAN POST OFFICE

THE POST OFFICE ANNOUNCED TODAY (MONDAY) THAT A NEW POST OFFICE IN FU SHAN ESTATE WILL BE OFFICIALLY OPENED BY MR. S.K. TAM, SENIOR CONTROLLER OF POSTS (KOWLOON AND NEW TERRITORIES) ON FRIDAY.

A FULL-RANGE OF POSTAL FACILITIES EXCEPT THE ACCEPTANCE OF INSURED LETTERS WILL BE PROVIDED IN THE NEW POST OFFICE SITUATED AT 1-2 FU SHUN HOUSE, GROUND FLOOR.

IT WILL OPEN FROM 9 A.M. TO 1 P.M. AND FROM 2.30 P.M. TO 5 P.M. ON WEEKDAYS AND FROM 9 A.M. TO 1 P.M. ON SATURDAYS.

THE FU SHAN POST OFFICE WILL BRING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF POST OFFICES TO 75, INCLUDING TWO MOBILE POST OFFICES OPERATING IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT TODAY (MONDAY) ANNOUNCED THAT THE SECTION OF KWUN TONG ROAD BETWEEN HONG TAK AND ELEGANCE ROADS WILL BE CLOSED TO ALL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC BETWEEN 1.30 A.M. AND 5.30 A.M. DAILY FROM WEDNESDAY TO SATURDAY TO FACILITATE THE DISMANTLING OF A STRUCTURE IN THE AREA.

DURING THE CLOSURE, NORTHBOUND TRAFFIC WILL BE DIVERTED TO NGAU TAU KOK ROAD VIA ELEGANCE ROAD OR TO WAI YIP STREET VIA LAI YIP STREET WHILE SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC WILL BE DIVERTED TO NGAU TAU KOK ROAD.
