HRH PRINCESS ANNE VISITS ELECTRONICS FACTORY  
\* \* \* \*

HER ROYAL HIGHNESS, THE PRINCESS ANNE TODAY (MONDAY) VISITED ONE OF THE LARGEST CONSUMER ELECTRONICS MANUFACTURERS IN HONG KONG WHICH HAS WON 14 HONG KONG DESIGN AWARDS FOR ITS PRODUCTS OVER THE PAST SIX YEARS.

AT RADOFIN ELECTRONICS FACTORY IN KWUN TONG, PRINCESS ANNE WAS MET BY THE SECRETARY FOR TRADE AND INDUSTRY, MR E.P. HO, WHO PRESENTED RADOFIN'S MANAGING DIRECTOR, MR LAURENCE SCOTT JR.

THE PRINCESS FIRST WENT UP TO THE MAIN OFFICE ON THE TOP FLOOR OF THE FACTORY, WHERE SHE WAS SHOWN EXAMPLES OF FINISHED PRODUCTS INCLUDING PERSONAL COMPUTERS, 40 COLUMN PRINTERS AND OTHER COMPUTER PERIPHERALS AND VIDEO GAMES. DURING A TOUR OF THE PLANT THAT FOLLOWED SHE SAW THE RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT AND THREE PRODUCTION FLOORS WHERE WORKERS WERE ASSEMBLING AND TESTING ITEMS ON THE PRODUCTION LINES.

MR SCOTT EXPLAINED TO THE PRINCESS THAT THE COMPANY'S IN-HOUSE DESIGN STAFF MADE IT POSSIBLE FOR RADOFIN TO CONCEIVE, DEVELOP AND MANUFACTURE HIGH TECHNOLOGY PRODUCTS FOR THEIR CUSTOMERS. THE PRINCESS ALSO LEARNT THAT ABOUT 90 PER CENT OF RADOFIN'S OUTPUT IS PRODUCED FOR MAJOR COMPANIES IN THE UNITED STATES AND EUROPE, AND PRODUCED UNDER THE CUSTOMER'S BRAND NAME.

THE COMPANY BEGAN PRODUCTION IN 1975, INITIALLY PRODUCING LOW COST ELECTRONIC CALCULATORS. BY THE END OF 1976, IT HAD PROGRESSED TO MANUFACTURING VIDEO GAMES, AND WON VIRTUALLY EVERY HONG KONG DESIGN AWARD IN THE FOLLOWING YEAR.

WITH THE RETIREMENT OF DIESEL TRAINS ON JULY 15, PEOPLE LIVING IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WILL ENJOY THE BENEFITS OF A MODERN, FAST, COMFORTABLE AND RELIABLE TRAIN SERVICE, THE FINANCIAL SECRETARY, MR JOHN BREMRIDGE, SAID TODAY (MONDAY).

MR BREMRIDGE SAID AN ADDITIONAL BENEFIT OF THE NEW RAILWAY WAS THAT IT SUBSTANTIALLY INCREASED BOTH THE PASSENGER AND FREIGHT MOVEMENT CAPABILITY BETWEEN HONG KONG AND CHINA.

THE KCRC MODERNISATION AND ELECTRIFICATION PROJECT WAS A VITAL PART OF THE OVERALL GOVERNMENT TRANSPORT DEVELOPMENT STRATEGY, HE SAID.

HE SAID THE NEW TAI PO MARKET STATION WHICH PROVIDED AN INTEGRATED TRANSPORT INTERCHANGE BETWEEN A NUMBER OF TRANSPORT MODES DEMONSTRATED GOVERNMENT'S AWARENESS OF THE TRANSPORT NEEDS OF THE COMMUNITY.

THE PRINCESS WAS SEEN OFF AT THE AIRPORT BY THE GOVERNOR, SIR EDWARD YOUDE AND LADY YOUDE; THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE AND LADY HADDON-CAVE; THE CHIEF JUSTICE, SIR DENYS ROBERTS; THE COMMANDER BRITISH FORCES, MAJOR-GENERAL DEREK BOORMAN AND MRS BOORMAN; SENIOR UMELCO MEMBERS MR OSWALD CHEUNG AND MR ROGER LOBO, MRS CHEUNG AND MRS LOBO; THE CONSUL-GENERAL OF PAKISTAN, MR KAMAL AFSAR AND MRS AFSAR; AND THE MASTER OF SIGNALS, MAJOR-GENERAL J.M.W. #### GENERAL HOUSEHOLD SURVEY

\* \* \*

THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT IS CONDUCTING, ON A MONTH-TO-MONTH BASIS, A GENERAL HOUSEHOLD SURVEY.

THE SURVEY STARTED IN AUGUST 1981 AND IS CARRIED OUT ON A CONTINUOUS BASIS BY THE PERMANENT FIELD STAFF OF THE DEPARTMENT TO COLLECT UP-TO-DATE INFORMATION ON THE ECONOMIC AND SOCIAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE POPULATION.

A RANDOM SAMPLE OF SOME 6 000 HOUSEHOLDS ARE SELECTED THROUGHOUT ALL DISTRICTS IN HONG KONG FOR PARTICIPATION IN EACH MONTHLY SURVEY. ABOUT HALF OF THE HOUSEHOLDS WERE INTERVIEWED THREE MONTHS EARLIER AND ARE SELECTED AGAIN IN ORDER TO MEASURE MORE ACCURATELY THE CHANGES THAT HAVE OCCURRED SINCE THEN.

AN OFFICIAL LETTER, IN CHINESE AND ENGLISH, WILL BE SENT TO THE SAMPLED HOUSEHOLDS BEFORE THE SURVEY TO EXPLAIN THE PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY AND TO SEEK THEIR CO-OPERATION IN PARTICIPATING.

ASSISTANT CENSUS AND SURVEY OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT, EACH IDENTIFYING HIMSELF WITH A DEPARTMENTAL IDENTITY CARD ISSUED BY THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT, WILL VISIT THE SAMPLED HOUSEHOLDS TO COLLECT THE REQUIRED INFORMATION.

QUESTIONS ASKED IN THE SURVEY INCLUDE THOSE ON THE PERSONAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE POPULATION (SUCH AS AGE, SEX AND EDUCATIONAL ATTAINMENT) AS WELL AS ON THE LABOUR FORCE CHARACTERISTICS (SUCH AS ACTIVITY STATUS, HOURS OF WORK, INDUSTRY, OCCUPATION, ETC.)

IN ADDITION, SUPPLEMENTARY QUESTIONS ON VARIOUS SOCIO-ECONOMIC ASPECTS OF THE POPULATION ARE ALSO INQUIRED.

FOR THE MONTHS OF MAY AND JUNE 1983, QUESTIONS ON PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE WORK OF DISTRICT BOARD AND EFFECTIVENESS OF THE PUBLICITY ON SOCIAL WELFARE SERVICES FOR THE DISABLED, ETC. WILL BE INCLUDED.

ALL INFORMATION COLLECTED IN THE SURVEY WILL BE TREATED AS STRICTLY CONFIDENTIAL AND WILL NOT BE REVEALED TO ANY PERSON OR ORGANISATION OUTSIDE THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT.

HONG KONG TEAM LEAVES FOR ADB MEETING

MR DOUGLAS BLYE, SECRETARY FOR MONETARY AFFAIRS, LEFT FOR MANILA TODAY (MONDAY) TO ATTEND THE 16TH ANNUAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF GOVERNORS OF THE ASIAN DEVELOPMENT BANK.

THE MEETING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE PHILIPPINE INTERNATIONAL CONVENTION CENTRE, MANILA, BETWEEN MAY 4 AND 6. MR BLYE IS EXPECTED TO ADDRESS THE MEETING AT A GOVERNORS' SESSION.

ALSO IN THE HONG KONG DELEGATION ARE MR JOSEPH YAM, PRINCIPAL ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR MONETARY AFFAIRS AND MR KEVIN HO, ASSISTANT SECRETARY FOR MONETARY AFFAIRS.

THE DELEGATION IS EXPECTED TO RETURN ON FRIDAY (MAY 6).

HONG KONG-NORWAY TEXTILES TALKS ADJOURNED  
\* \* \* \*

THE NEGOTIATION FOR A BILATERAL TEXTILE AGREEMENT BETWEEN HONG KONG AND NORWAY, WHICH BEGAN IN HONG KONG ON APRIL 21, WERE ADJOURNED THIS MORNING (MONDAY) WITHOUT AN AGREEMENT, ACCORDING TO AN AGREED STATEMENT ISSUED BY THE TWO NEGOTIATING TEAMS.

AT THE MOMENT, HONG KONG'S EXPORTS OF NINE TEXTILE AND GARMENT ITEMS TO NORWAY ARE SUBJECT TO A GLOBAL GATT ARTICLE XIX IMPORT ACTION. THE NORWEGIAN DELEGATION HAVE INDICATED THAT, IF A SATISFACTORY BILATERAL AGREEMENT CAN BE REACHED WITH HONG KONG AND OTHER SUPPLIERS, NORWAY WOULD DISMANTLE THE ARTICLE XIX IMPORT ACTION AND REJOIN THE MULTI-FIBRE ARRANGEMENT.

ALTHOUGH SOME PROGRESS WAS MADE DURING THE TALKS, THERE WAS STILL A WIDE GAP BETWEEN THE TWO SIDES ON A NUMBER OF IMPORTANT ISSUES. THE TWO DELEGATIONS HAVE THEREFORE AGREED TO ADJOURN THE TALKS TO ALLOW BOTH SIDES TO REFLECT ON THEIR RESPECTIVE POSITIONS.

THE TWO SIDES PROVISIONALLY AGREED THAT THE NEGOTIATIONS SHOULD BE RESUMED IN JUNE THIS YEAR.

PROMOTION OF PERFORMING ARTS IN HONG KONG

GOVERNMENT IS FULLY AWARE OF THE CONTINUING NEED TO SURVEY AND REVIEW THE CULTURAL SCENE IN HONG KONG AND A NUMBER OF AREAS ARE NOW UNDER CONSIDERATION, THE ASSISTANT COMMISSIONER FOR RECREATION AND CULTURE (PERFORMING ARTS), MR BENJAMIN TANG SAID TODAY (MONDAY).

MR TANG, WHO WAS ADDRESSING THE ROTARY CLUB OF NEW TERRITORIES ON THE ROLE OF THE RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT IN THE PROMOTION OF PERFORMING ARTS, SAID A PROFESSIONAL REPORT ON THE SITUATION OF DRAMA IN HONG KONG HAS BEEN COMPLETED. HE DESCRIBED THE REPORT AS +AN IMPORTANT SURVEY FOR IT WILL HELP US TO FORMULATE POLICIES FOR FUTURE SUPPORT FOR DRAMA.+

+ALSO, WE ARE MAKING A PRELIMINARY EXAMINATION OF THE VISUAL ARTS,+ HE ADDED.

+MINDFUL TOO, OF THE CURRENT ECONOMIC CLIMATE, WE SEE THE DEVELOPMENT OF BUSINESS SPONSORSHIP FOR THE ARTS AS CRUCIAL IF THE ARTS ARE TO GROW AND CONTINUE TO CONTRIBUTE TO THE COMMUNITY,+ MR TANG SAID.

REFERRING TO THE ROLE OF THE PERFORMING ARTS DIVISION WHICH IS PRIMARILY ONE OF COMMUNITY BUILDING, MR TANG SAID IT AIMS TO INVOLVE AS MANY PEOPLE AS POSSIBLE IN THE PERFORMING ARTS, BOTH IN TERMS OF PARTICIPATION IN AND OF ENJOYMENT AND APPRECIATION OF THE VARIOUS PERFORMING ARTS FORMS.

HE CONTINUED: +UNLIKE THE CULTURAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE PERFORMING ARTS DIVISION DOES NOT MANAGE FACILITIES, NOR DOES IT ORGANISE CULTURAL EVENTS. ITS PRINCIPAL MEANS OF IMPLEMENTING THE POLICY OBJECTIVES ESTABLISHED BY THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL IS THROUGH PROVIDING FINANCIAL SUPPORT TO PROFESSIONAL ORGANISATIONS INVOLVED IN THE TRAINING OR PRESENTATION OF DANCE, MUSIC AND DRAMA.+

+THROUGH SUBVENTING SUCH PRIVATE ORGANISATIONS RATHER THAN GETTING INVOLVED IN THE MANAGEMENT OF PERFORMING ARTS THE PERFORMING ARTS DIVISION'S ROLE IS SUPPORTIVE, RATHER THAN COMPETITIVE.+

+WE FEEL THAT THIS IS THE RIGHT APPROACH, AS THERE IS NO REASON WHY GOVERNMENT SHOULD DUPLICATE THE SERVICES ALREADY PROVIDED, OR CAPABLE OF BEING PROVIDED, BY THE PRIVATE SECTOR.+

+APART FROM MANAGING AND IMPLEMENTING THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICIES ON PERFORMING ARTS, THE PAD ALSO EXAMINES POSSIBLE AREAS AND FORMS OF FUTURE GOVERNMENT SUPPORT.+

ALTHOUGH PAD'S INVOLVEMENT IN THE PERFORMING ARTS IS ONLY INDIRECT, MR TANG POINTED OUT, ITS ACTIVITIES ARE GEARED TOWARDS THE IMPROVEMENT IN HONG KONG'S COMMUNITY SPIRIT.

+IT AIMS TO HELP PEOPLE BECOME INVOLVED IN THE PERFORMING ARTS, BOTH THROUGH SUPPORTING TRAINING ACTIVITIES AND PERFORMING ACTIVITIES,+ HE SAID.

#### SUBVENTED OUTWARD BOUND COURSES

A SCHEME TO ASSIST DESERVING YOUNG PEOPLE WHO WISH TO TAKE PART IN OUTWARD BOUND COURSES WAS ANNOUNCED TODAY (MONDAY).

SPEAKING AT A PRESS CONFERENCE, THE COMMISSIONER FOR RECREATION AND CULTURE, MR BARRIE WIGGHAM SAID ANY PERSON WHO HAS AN ACTIVE INTEREST IN OUTDOOR PURSUITS COULD APPLY FOR ASSISTANCE.

ALSO AT THE CONFERENCE WERE THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF THE SCHOOL, MR JACK TUCKER AND CHIEF RECREATION AND SPORT OFFICER, MR DAVID MAK.

THE SCHEME GOT OFF THE GROUND RECENTLY FOLLOWING A GRANT OF \$670 000 BY GOVERNMENT.

ABOUT 1 000 YOUNG PEOPLE, INCLUDING THE HANDICAPPED AND UNDERPRIVILEGED, WILL BE ABLE TO TAKE PART IN A NUMBER OF LAND AND SEA-BASED COURSES.

MR WIGGHAM SAID THE AMOUNT GIVEN BY THE GOVERNMENT IS A RECURRENT GRANT WHICH WOULD BE USED TO REDUCE THE COST OF NORMAL COURSE FEES BY ABOUT 50 PER CENT.

HE SAID THE GOVERNMENT'S DECISION TO SUBVENT A NUMBER OF PLACES ON SOME OUTWARD BOUND COURSES WAS DUE TO SEVERAL FACTORS.

+OUTWARD BOUND COURSES CAN MAKE A SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION TOWARDS THE GOVERNMENT'S POLICY OBJECTIVE OF COMMUNITY BUILDING BECAUSE THEY PROVIDE STRUCTURED AND INTENSIVE TRAINING AT A HIGH LEVEL WHICH COMPLEMENT THE COURSES AND PROGRAMMES ORGANISED BY MY DEPARTMENT,+ MR WIGGHAM SAID.

THESE COURSES HELP TO DEVELOP THE CHARACTER, SELF-RELIANCE AND LEADERSHIP QUALITIES OF THE PARTICIPANTS, AS WELL AS HELPING TO FOSTER A STRONG SENSE OF COMMUNITY SPIRIT.

BECAUSE OF THE BENEFITS YOUNG PEOPLE CAN GAIN FROM OUTWARD BOUND COURSES AND THE CONTRIBUTION THAT THEY CAN MAKE AFTERWARDS TO THE COMMUNITY AT LARGE, IT HAS BEEN DECIDED TO GIVE SELECTED YOUNG PERSONS THE OPPORTUNITY OF ATTENDING OUTWARD BOUND COURSES AT REDUCED COST. IN THIS WAY IT IS HOPED THAT A WIDER SECTION OF HONG KONG'S YOUTH CAN BENEFIT FROM OUTWARD BOUND TRAINING.

THE GOVERNMENT SUBVENTED COURSES ARE: STANDARD COURSE, JUNIOR AND SENIOR ADVENTURE COURSES, MOUNTAIN LEADERSHIP COURSES AND SKILLS COURSES.

THE STANDARD COURSE IS FOR PERSONS BETWEEN 16 AND 26 YEARS OF AGE AND LASTS FOR THREE WEEKS. PRACTICAL AND THEORY LESSONS ARE GIVEN ABOARD THE SCHOOL'S BRIGANTINE JI-FUNG.

ADVENTURE COURSES CONSIST OF ORGANISED ACTIVITIES IN SAILING, CANOEING, MOUNTAINEERING AND ROCK-CLIMBING.

MOUNTAIN LEADERSHIP COURSES ARE SEVEN-DAY HIGH INTENSITY SKILLS COURSES DESIGNED FOR THOSE AGED 18 YEARS AND OVER.

SKILLS COURSES INVOLVE A HIGH LEVEL OF TRAINING IN A SPECIFIC OUTDOOR ACTIVITY SUCH AS ROCK-CLIMBING, MOUNTAINCRAFT, ORIENTEERING, CANOEING AND SAILING.

SINCE THE OPENING OF THE OUTWARD BOUND SCHOOL IN 1970, MORE THAN 13 400 PEOPLE HAVE TAKEN PART IN VARIOUS COURSES.

OF THE TOTAL, 3 500 CHILDREN TOOK PART IN LAND ADVENTURE COURSES, AND 1 200 PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED IN SPECIAL COURSES.

MR ADOLF HSU, WHO ASSUMED THE DUTY OF DISTRICT COMMISSIONER (TSUEN WAN) JUST OVER A MONTH AGO, WILL CHAIR HIS FIRST DISTRICT BOARD MEETING TOMORROW (TUESDAY).

DURING THE MEETING, A PAPER ON RECLAMATION OF THE KWAI CHUNG CREEK AND REALIGNMENT OF CONTAINER PORT ROAD WILL BE DISCUSSED.

ALSO FOR DISCUSSION WILL BE A PAPER PREPARED BY AN UNOFFICIAL DB MEMBER ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A HOSTEL FOR MENTALLY RETARDED MALE ADULTS IN KWAI CHUNG.

MORE HOSTELS FOR ELDERLY PLANNED  
\* \* \* \* \*

SOME 2 300 ADDITIONAL HOSTEL PLACES FOR THE ELDERLY WILL BE AVAILABLE IN PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATES DURING THE NEXT FIVE YEARS, THE DIRECTOR OF SOCIAL WELFARE, MR JOHN CHAMBERS, SAID TODAY (MONDAY).

THE SOCIAL WELFARE DEPARTMENT IS PLANNING TO PROVIDE ONE SUCH HOSTEL IN EVERY PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE WITH OVER 3 000 UNITS.

MR CHAMBERS WAS SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF THE EASTERN DISTRICT WOMEN'S WELFARE CLUB'S WONG FUNG TING HOSTEL FOR THE ELDERLY AT CHOI YUEN ESTATE, SHEUNG SHUI.

REFERRING TO THE GOVERNMENT'S PLAN TO BUY ABOUT 150 FLATS IN VARIOUS PRIVATE DEVELOPMENTS FOR HOUSING 700 OLD PEOPLE IN URGENT NEED OF ACCOMMODATION, HE STRESSED THAT THIS SCHEME WOULD BE SUITABLE MAINLY FOR THOSE WHO ARE STILL FIT AND ABLE TO TAKE CARE OF THEIR OWN DAILY LIVING NEEDS.

“THERE WILL STILL BE A NEED FOR MORE HOSTELS IN PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATES WHICH ARE INTENDED TO HOUSE THOSE WHO NEED LIMITED ASSISTANCE IN PERSONAL CARE, THE GENERAL SUPERVISION OF HEALTH CARE AND THE ORGANISATION OF SOCIAL AND RECREATIONAL PROGRAMMES,” HE SAID.

THE NEW HOSTEL, WHICH WILL HOUSE 116 ELDERLY PEOPLE, HAS BEEN DECORATED AND FURNISHED TO A HIGH STANDARD. MEALS ARE PROVIDED AND ASSISTANCE GIVEN WITH HOUSEHOLD CHORES AND LAUNDRY.

ITS ESTABLISHMENT HAS BEEN MADE POSSIBLE BY AN \$800 000 DONATION FROM MADAM WONG FUNG-TING AND OTHER DONATIONS FROM FRIENDS AND MEMBERS OF THE WOMEN'S CLUB.

“AS THE NUMBER OF ELDERLY PEOPLE IN THE COMMUNITY INCREASES, THERE WILL BE A CORRESPONDING DEMAND FOR BOTH COMMUNITY SUPPORT SERVICES AND RESIDENTIAL CARE,” MR CHAMBERS SAID.

HE PAID TRIBUTE TO THE CLUB FOR MAKING A MOST VALUABLE CONTRIBUTION IN THESE AREAS.

APART FROM THE HOSTEL FOR THE ELDERLY, OTHER COMMUNITY FACILITIES IN CHOI YUEN ESTATE INCLUDE A NURSERY, A CHILDREN AND YOUTH CENTRE AND A SOCIAL CENTRE FOR THE ELDERLY.
