ANTI-11 DRIVE STEPPED UP

* * * *

THE ANTI-ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION NET PULLED TIGHTER THIS WEEK AS THE POLICE, LABOUR AND IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENTS LAUNCHED ANOTHER SPECIAL OPERATION TO FERRET OUT ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS.

MORE THAN 77 000 PEOPLE WERE CHECKED FOR IDENTIFICATION AND 9 640 ESTABLISHMENTS VISITED, DURING THE THREE-DAY OPERATION.

FIFTY-THREE PERSONS SUSPECTED OF BEING HERE ILLEGALLY WERE TURNED UP AND REFERRED TO THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT FOR FURTHER INVESTIGATION. THOSE FOUND TO BE ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS WILL BE REPATRIATED.

THE JOINT OPERATION WAS PART OF THE ONGOING TERRITORY-WIDE EFFORT AGAINST ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION.

+THIS EFFORT HAS BY NO MEANS SLACKENED,+ A GOVERNMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SATURDAY). +ON THE CONTRARY, THE SECURITY FORCES AND THE POLICE CONTINUE TO MAINTAIN A HIGH STATE OF VIGILANCE BOTH AT THE BORDER AND THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY.

+THERE IS NO PLACE FOR ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS IN HONG KONG AND THEY WILL BE SENT BACK,+ HE STRESSED.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO DISCOUNTED THE POSSIBILITY OF AN AMNESTY WHEN THE FIRST BATCH OF THE REPLACEMENT IDENTITY CARDS WILL BE ISSUED NEXT YEAR.

+AS THE GOVERNOR SAID IN HIS POLICY ADDRESS IN THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL LAST MONTH, THERE IS NO QUESTION OF AN AMNESTY,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+ANYONE FOOLISHLY HOPING FOR THAT IS ONLY DELUDING HIMSELF AND OTHERS.+

DURING THE SPECIAL OPERATION, POLICE STEPPED UP THEIR IDENTIFICATION SPOT CHECKS IN PUBLIC PLACES AND ALSO CARRIED OUT SPECIAL OPERATIONS IN SUSPECT AREAS AND LOCATIONS THROUGHOUT THE TERRITORY.

THEY ARRESTED 14 SUSPECTED ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS WITH FORGED IDENTITY CARDS. ANOTHER 384 PERSONS WERE SUMMONSED FOR FAILING TO PRODUCE PROPER PROOF OF IDENTITY, AND A FURTHER 218 WERE WARNED IN RESPECT OF THIS OFFENCE, WHICH CARRIES A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$1 000.

ON THE LABOUR FRONT, INSPECTORS OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT VISITED 9 640 ESTABLISHMENTS TO WEED OUT ANY ILLEGAL IMMIGRANT WHO MAY BE WORKING, AND TO CHECK THAT EMPLOYERS FULFILL THEIR LEGAL OBLIGATION OF KEEPING PROPER RECORDS OF THEIR EMPLOYEES.

TWENTY-SIX PERSONS IN 26 ESTABLISHMENTS WERE FOUND WITHOUT PROPER PROOF OF IDENTITY. THEY TOO HAVE BEEN REFERRED TO THE IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT FOR INVESTIGATION.

ONE HUNDRED AND FOURTEEN ESTABLISHMENTS WERE FOUND NOT TO BE KEEPING PROPER RECORDS OF EMPLOYEES.

THE SPOKESMAN REMINDED EMPLOYERS THAT OFFERING EMPLOYMENT TO ILLEGAL IMMIGRANTS IS AN OFFENCE PUNISHABLE BY A FINE OF UP TO \$50 000 AND IMPRISONMENT FOR ONE YEAR.

POPULATION'S COOPERATION NEEDED TO KEEP HK CLEAN

A PROPER STANDARD OF CLEANLINESS CAN NEVER BE MAINTAINED UNLESS THE POPULATION AS A WHOLE SHARES A CONVICTION THAT A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT IS FUNDAMENTAL TO A DECENT LIFE. THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE, SAID THIS (SATURDAY) MORNING AT THE LAUNCHING OF THE THIRD CLEAN FOR CHARITY CAMPAIGN ORGANISED BY THE COMMUNITY CHEST.

FOLLOWING IS THE TEXT OF SIR PHILIP'S SPEECH:

+THE SECOND CLEAN HONG KONG CAMPAIGN WAS LAUNCHED JUST A YEAR AGO WITH THE AIM OF MAKING HONG KONG A CLEANER PLACE TO LIVE IN THROUGH THE INVOLVEMENT OF THE WHOLE COMMUNITY. ANTI-LITTER MEASURES BY THE GOVERNMENT AND THE URBAN COUNCIL ALONE, NO MATTER WHAT RESOURCES ARE DEPLOYED, CAN NEVER BE ENOUGH AND A PROPER STANDARD OF CLEANLINESS CAN NEVER BE MAINTAINED UNLESS THE POPULATION AS A WHOLE SHARES A CONVICTION THAT A CLEAN ENVIRONMENT IS FUNDAMENTAL TO A DECENT LIFE. IT IS FOR THIS REASON THAT I AM VERY HAPPY TO BE HERE TODAY, TO TAKE PART IN THE COMMUNITY CHEST'S CONTRIBUTION TO KEEP HONG KONG CLEAN.

+LAST YEAR, 44 ORGANISATIONS SPONSORED TEAMS TO TAKE PART IN CLEAN-UP EXERCISES AND A TOTAL OF \$520 000 WAS RAISED FOR THE COMMUNITY CHEST. THE CHEST IS TO BE CONGRATULATED ON THE SUCCESSFUL COMBINATION OF FUND RAISING WITH A PRACTICAL OBJECTIVE: AND WE SHOULD ALL BE GRATEFUL TO THE SPONSORING BODIES AS WELL AS TO THE PARTICIPATING TEAMS.

+THIS IS THE THIRD CLEAN FOR CHARITY CAMPAIGN ORGANISED BY THE CHEST. THE TEAMS WILL BE CLEANING UP RECREATIONAL AREAS USED BY MANY PEOPLE IN THEIR LEISURE TIME. IT IS UNFORTUNATELY TRUE THAT, AMONG THOSE SAME PEOPLE WHO ENJOY THESE AREAS ARE THE ONES WHO LEAVE LITTER BEHIND THEM, SELFISHLY DISREGARDING THE RIGHTS OF OTHERS. BUT, HOPEFULLY, THE EXAMPLE SET BY CHEST TEAMS WILL AROUSE A SENSE OF PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY AND CIVIC PRIDE IN ALL USERS OF THE COUNTRYSIDE AND MAKE THEM MINDFUL OF THE IMPORTANCE OF KEEPING OUR ENVIRONMENT CLEAN AND TIDY.

+SO, ON BEHALF OF THE GOVERNMENT I CONGRATULATE ALL OF YOU WHO ARE CONTRIBUTING TO THIS CAMPAIGN, WHETHER YOU BE CLEANERS, SPONSORS OR ORGANISERS AND I AM SURE THIS YEAR'S CLEAN FOR CHARITY CAMPAIGN WILL BE A SUCCESS.+

HOSPITALITY INDUSTRY MANPOWER SURVEY PUBLISHED

* * * * *

WITH MORE NEW HOTELS COMING INTO OPERATION IN THE NEXT FEW YEARS, THE HOSPITALITY INDUSTRY MUST EMBARK ON A MANPOWER TRAINING PROGRAMME OR THE SHORTAGE OF TRAINED OPERATIVE STAFF MIGHT BECOME MORE ACUTE.

THIS WAS POINTED OUT IN A REPORT ON THE MANPOWER SURVEY HELD IN 1981 BY THE HOTEL, CATERING AND TOURISM TRAINING BOARD OF THE FORMER HONG KONG TRAINING COUNCIL.

TO COPE WITH MANPOWER REQUIREMENTS, THE REPORT RECOMMENDED TWO REMEDIAL MEASURES: TO STANDARDISE AND UNIFY THE PRESENT HOSPITALITY COURSES IN THE EXISTING INSTITUTIONS AND TO SET UP A HOTEL TRAINING CENTRE MAINLY FOR OPERATIVES.

COMMENTING ON THE FINDINGS, MR LARRY TCHOU, CHAIRMAN OF THE TRAINING BOARD NOW UNDER THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL, SAID, "WELL-TRAINED AND EDUCATED EMPLOYEES ARE IN GREAT DEMAND BY THE HOSPITALITY INDUSTRY, ESPECIALLY WITH TOURISM BEING ONE OF THE LEADING REVENUE GENERATORS OF HONG KONG."

THE TRAINING BOARD ALSO RECOMMENDED SPECIFIC TRAINING PROGRAMMES FOR MANAGERIAL AND SUPERVISORY STAFF FOR THE INDUSTRY.

DURING THE SURVEY PERIOD, THERE WERE 784 VACANCIES IN THE 6 827 ESTABLISHMENTS SURVEYED, REPRESENTING 2.15 PER CENT OF THEIR TOTAL WORK FORCE.

THE ESTABLISHMENTS COMPRISED HOTELS, BOARDING HOUSES, AIR TRANSPORT CARRIERS, TRAVEL AGENCIES AND WESTERN-STYLE CATERING INSTITUTIONS WHICH INCLUDE RESTAURANTS, FAST FOOD SHOPS AND BARS.

THE REPORT, IN ENGLISH AND CHINESE, IS ON SALE AT \$43 A COPY AT THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE.

WINTER COURSES AND SEMINAR ON PHYSICAL EDUCATION

A SERIES OF WINTER COURSES AND A SEMINAR FOR TEACHERS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION WILL BE HELD BETWEEN DECEMBER AND FEBRUARY NEXT YEAR.

THE COURSES, WHICH WILL BE CONDUCTED BY THE PHYSICAL EDUCATION SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT, WILL INCLUDE THE TEACHING OF ARCHERY, TEAM TACTICS IN BASKETBALL, CHINESE DANCE, ORIENTEERING, MODERN DANCE AND VOLLEYBALL.

THE FIRST FOUR COURSES ARE MAINLY FOR SECONDARY SCHOOL PHYSICAL EDUCATION TEACHERS AND TEACHERS IN CHARGE OF SCHOOL TEAMS WHILE THE VOLLEYBALL COURSE IS FOR PRIMARY SCHOOL TEACHERS OF PHYSICAL EDUCATION. THE TEACHING OF MODERN DANCE IS OPEN TO TEACHERS FROM BOTH PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS.

IN ADDITION, AN IN-SERVICE COURSE WILL BE ORGANISED FOR TEACHERS TEACHING PHYSICAL EDUCATION IN SPECIAL SCHOOLS WHO HAVE NOT RECEIVED FORMAL TRAINING IN THE SUBJECT.

A SEMINAR ON THE TEACHING OF HANDBALL WILL BE HELD ON DECEMBER 23 FOR PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS WHO WISH TO PROMOTE HANDBALL IN SCHOOLS. THERE WILL BE TALKS, A FILM SHOW AND MATCH OBSERVATION AND DISCUSSION.

ONLY IN-SERVICE TEACHERS REGISTERED WITH THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT MAY APPLY. A CERTIFICATE OF ATTENDANCE WILL BE ISSUED TO TEACHERS WHO HAVE COMPLETED THE COURSE SATISFACTORILY.

ROAD PROJECT FOR TUEN MUN

THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT PROPOSES TO WIDEN A SECTION OF CASTLE PEAK ROAD BETWEEN THE TUEN MUN DISTRICT OFFICE BUILDING AND PUI TO ROAD AND TO CONSTRUCT AN ELEVATED INTERCHANGE AT THE JUNCTION OF TUEN MUN ROAD AND PUI TO ROAD.

THE SCHEME FORMS PART OF THE CONTINUING PROGRAMME FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF TUEN MUN NEW TOWN.

THE PROJECT WILL ALSO INVOLVE THE CONSTRUCTION OF ROOF COVERS TO THE THREE EXISTING FOOTBRIDGES OVER TUEN MUN ROAD NORTH OF PUI TO ROAD AND AN OPEN CAR PARK UNDER THE PROPOSED FLYOVER IN PUI TO ROAD.

NOTICES CONCERNING THE PROPOSED WORKS ARE PUBLISHED IN THE LATEST GOVERNMENT GAZETTE.

PROJECT PLANS MAY BE SEEN AT THE CENTRAL AND WESTERN DISTRICT OFFICE ENQUIRY SUB-OFFICE, CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES, WEST WING, MAIN ENTRANCE LOBBY, THE TUEN MUN DISTRICT LANDS OFFICE AND THE TUEN MUN DISTRICT OFFICE AT THE TUEN MUN DISTRICT OFFICE BUILDING, CASTLE PEAK ROAD, TUEN MUN, NEW TERRITORIES.
