HONG KONG PUPIL WINS GOLD MEDAL  
\* \* \* \* \*

A SEVEN-YEAR-OLD PUPIL OF NORTH POINT KAIFONG ASSOCIATION MADAM CHAN WAI CHOW MEMORIAL SCHOOL HAS BEEN AWARDED A GOLD MEDAL FOR AN OUTSTANDING ENTRY IN THE 28TH WORLD SCHOOL CHILDREN'S ART EXHIBITION HELD TO COMMEMORATE THE 10TH ASIAN GAMES IN SEOUL.

CHAN CHUN-MING WON HIS GOLD MEDAL WITH A PAINTING DEPICTING A SWIMMING CONTEST, USING SUBTLY CONTRASTING HUES. HE HAD THE DISTINCTION OF JOINING A NUMBER OF OTHER GOLD MEDAL WINNERS FROM AROUND THE WORLD.

THE COMPETITION FOR SCHOOL CHILDREN AGED SIX TO 12 WAS JOINTLY SPONSORED BY THE SEOUL ASIAN GAMES ORGANISING COMMITTEE AND THE KOREAN CHILDREN'S CENTRE AT SEOUL.

IT ATTRACTED 15 562 ENTRIES FROM 65 COUNTRIES. SIXTY OF THE ENTRIES WERE FROM HONG KONG PRIMARY SCHOOL STUDENTS.

HONG KONG STUDENTS ALSO WON ONE SILVER MEDAL, TWO BRONZE MEDALS AND EIGHT OTHER PRIZES IN THE COMPETITION.

SEMINAR ON BUILDING MANAGEMENT ORGANISED

VARIOUS ASPECTS OF BUILDING MANAGEMENT WILL BE DISCUSSED AT A SEMINAR TO BE HELD AT THE HENRY G. LEONG YAU MA TEI COMMUNITY CENTRE TOMORROW (SATURDAY).

THE SEMINAR IS AMONG ACTIVITIES ORGANISED FOR THE CURRENT YAU MA TEI ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT CAMPAIGN AND IS AIMED AT EDUCATING MEMBERS OF OWNERS CORPORATIONS, MUTUAL AID COMMITTEES AND AREA COMMITTEES ON THE CONCEPT OF PROPER BUILDING MANAGEMENT AND THE FINANCIAL AND LEGAL IMPLICATIONS IN MANAGEMENT.

SPEAKERS AT THE SEMINAR INCLUDE A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE LAW SOCIETY OF HONG KONG, MR KWAN LIM-HO, HOUSING MANAGER OF THE DISTRICT'S BUILDING MANAGEMENT CO-ORDINATION TEAM, MR WONG KAI-SHU, AND A REPRESENTATIVE FROM THE MUNICIPAL SERVICES BRANCH, MR KEUNG CHI-WAI.

THEY WILL TOUCH ON ISSUES SUCH AS THE RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF BUILDING OWNERS AS WELL AS MAINTENANCE OF BUILDINGS.

REPRESENTATIVES FROM THE DISTRICT OFFICE, THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE URBAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT, THE POLICE AND A PRIVATE CHARTERED SURVEYOR FIRM WILL BE PRESENT TO ANSWER ENQUIRIES.

BEFORE THE SEMINAR, A VIDEO FILM FOCUSING ON THE NEED FOR HOME SAFETY WILL ALSO BE SHOWN AND PAMPHLETS ON FIRE PREVENTION, ENVIRONMENTAL HYGIENE AND BUILDING MANAGEMENT WILL BE DISTRIBUTED.

CIVIC EDUCATION INFORMATION FOLDER PRODUCED

A CIVIC EDUCATION INFORMATION FOLDER HAS BEEN PRODUCED BY THE WORKING GROUP ON CIVIC EDUCATION OF THE WAN CHAI DISTRICT BOARD FOR DISTRIBUTION TO SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE DISTRICT.

THE FOLDER, CONSISTING OF SEVEN PAMPHLETS, OUTLINES THE GOVERNMENT STRUCTURE, THE DEVELOPMENT OF DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION AND REPRESENTATIVE GOVERNMENT, AND THE WAN CHAI DISTRICT BOARD AND ITS COMMITTEES.

A DISTRICT BOARD SPOKESMAN SAID IT WAS HOPED THAT THE FOLDER WOULD BECOME USEFUL REFERENCE MATERIALS FOR STUDENTS, AND THAT IN LEARNING ABOUT DISTRICT ADMINISTRATION AND THE DISTRICT BOARD, THEY MIGHT BECOME MORE INTERESTED IN TAKING PART IN DISTRICT AFFAIRS.

THE DISTRICT BOARD HAS ALLOCATED ABOUT \$20 000 FOR THE PRINTING OF 10 000 INFORMATION FOLDERS.

THE INFORMATION FOLDERS WILL BE DISTRIBUTED FREE TO STUDENTS WHEN WAN CHAI DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS VISIT SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE DISTRICT TO GIVE TALKS ON CIVIC EDUCATION.

NEW UNIT TO TACKLE DRAINAGE PROBLEMS

TUEN MUN NULLAH WILL BE THE FIRST TARGET OF A DRAINAGE UNIT NEWLY FORMED WITHIN THE BUILDINGS ORDINANCE OFFICE.

THE UNIT WILL DEAL WITH MAJOR DRAINAGE PROBLEMS IN BUILDINGS WITH THE INTENTION OF REMOVING OR ALLEVIATING POLLUTION IN WATERCOURSES CAUSED BY THE DISCHARGE OF EFFLUENT AND WASTE FROM INDUSTRIAL PREMISES.

THIS WILL HAVE THE POTENTIAL OF MAKING A SIGNIFICANT CONTRIBUTION TO IMPROVING THE ENVIRONMENT.

IT WILL ALSO DEAL WITH SANITARY NUISANCES IN OTHER PREMISES.

THE UNIT WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE ENTIRE ENFORCEMENT PROCEDURE, INCLUDING INVESTIGATION, SERVICE OF ORDERS AND EVENTUALLY ENFORCING ORDERS.

IT WILL BE HEADED BY A SENIOR BUILDING SURVEYOR AND MANNED INITIALLY BY REDEPLOYING EXISTING STAFF IN THE BUILDINGS ORDINANCE OFFICE.

**SHEK O WATER SUPPLY TO BE IMPROVED  
\*\*\*\*\***

SHEK O NORTH IS TO GET AN IMPROVED FRESH WATER SUPPLY SYSTEM.

THE PROJECT WILL INCLUDE CONSTRUCTION OF A SERVICE RESERVOIR WITH A CAPACITY OF 3 200 CUBIC METRES AT SHEK O NEAR KWUN YAM SHAN AND A TANK OF 800 CUBIC METRES AT MOUNT COLLINSON.

ALSO TO BE CONSTRUCTED IS A SINGLE-STOREY PUMPING STATION AT TAI TAM GAP AND LAYING ABOUT 6.9 KILOMETRES OF WATERMAIN FROM TAI TAM GAP, ALONG BIG WAVE BAY ROAD TO SHEK O VILLAGE.

WORK IS EXPECTED TO START AT THE END OF FEBRUARY AND TAKE ABOUT 16 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

#### ELECTRICAL INSTALLATION CONTRACT AWARDED

A CONTRACT WORTH \$856 620 HAS BEEN AWARDED BY THE ARCHITECTURAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT FOR INSTALLATION OF ELECTRICAL WIRING AND EQUIPMENT AT YUEN LONG DIVISIONAL FIRE STATION.

THE STATION IS BEING BUILT ON A 5 037-SQUARE-METRE SITE AT FUNG CHEUNG ROAD. IT WILL INCLUDE A STANDARD AMBULANCE DEPOT AND A RESCUE TRAINING CENTRE.

THE BUILDING PROJECT IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED IN MAY 1988.

**WAN CHAI ROAD CLOSURE**

THE UNNAMED ROAD ADJACENT TO THE WAN CHAI FERRY PIER BUS TERMINUS WILL BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC DAILY BETWEEN 1 AM AND 6 AM FROM DECEMBER 28 (SUNDAY) TO DECEMBER 30, TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOOTBRIDGE.

DURING THE CLOSURE, WESTBOUND VEHICLES ON HUNG HING ROAD HEADING FOR FLEMING ROAD WILL HAVE TO USE SEAFRONT ROAD.
