"EVERYONE WHO VISITS HONG KONG FIRE SERVICES COMES AWAY WITH A TREMENDOUS ADMIRATION AND RESPECT FOR A BRIGADE WHICH TODAY IS NOT ONLY ONE OF THE LARGEST IN THE WORLD, BUT ALSO ONE OF THE MOST EFFICIENT."

THIS IS THE OPENING REMARKS MADE BY MR NORMAN ANDERSON, THE EDITOR OF A WORLDWIDE FIRE JOURNAL "FIRE INTERNATIONAL", IN A SPECIAL SUPPLEMENT TO MARK THE 125TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT.

THE 32-PAGE PUBLICATION FEATURES THE VARIOUS ASPECTS OF THE DEPARTMENT FROM ITS STRUCTURE, DEVELOPMENT, LEGISLATION, MOBILISATION AND COMMUNICATION, TRAINING, AMBULANCE SERVICE TO FIRE-FIGHTING AND RESCUE AT THE AIRPORT AND AT SEA, HIGH-RISE FIRE PROTECTION AND RISKS FACED BY FIRE-FIGHTERS.

THE ARTICLES ARE SUPPLEMENTED BY PHOTOGRAPHS.

THE SUPPLEMENT ALSO CONTAINS MESSAGES OF CONGRADULATION FROM SEVERAL OVERSEAS FIRE BRIGADES AND ORGANISATIONS.

"THE SPECIAL ISSUE IS INTENDED TO GIVE THOSE WHO HAVE NOT BEEN TO HONG KONG AN INSIGHT INTO WHAT IS HAPPENING THERE," HE WRITES.

"MORE THAN THAT, IT IS A TRIBUTE TO A BRIGADE WHICH CAN, AND HAS, GIVEN FREELY OF ITS EXPERTISE - IN, FOR EXAMPLE, HIGH-RISE FIRE-FIGHTING - TO THE REST OF THE WORLD," HE SAYS.

RECORD NUMBER OF STUDENTS TO COMPETE IN CAREERS QUIZ

A RECORD NUMBER OF 136,500 STUDENTS FROM 283 SECONDARY SCHOOLS WILL TAKE PART IN THE CAREERS QUIZ '94 ORGANISED BY THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT FROM NOVEMBER 1 TO 8.

THE QUIZ IS DESIGNED FOR FORM 3 TO FORM 5 STUDENTS.

PARTICIPANTS WILL HAVE TO ANSWER 50 MULTIPLE-CHOICE QUESTIONS RELATING TO INFORMATION ON CAREERS, TECHNICAL AND VOCATIONAL TRAINING, AND LOCAL EMPLOYMENT LEGISLATION.

SENIOR LABOUR OFFICER, MRS CLARE SIU, SAID TODAY (SATURDAY) THE EVENT AIMED TO AROUSE STUDENTS' AWARENESS OF THE IMPORTANCE OF CHOOSING SUITABLE CAREERS AND TO ENCOURAGE THEM TO LOOK FOR UP-TO-DATE INFORMATION ON CAREERS AND FURTHER TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES.

"THE FAVOURABLE RESPONSE TO THE QUIZ REFLECTS THE IMPORTANCE SCHOOLS AND STUDENTS ATTACHED TO CAREER EDUCATION," SHE ADDED.

A STRONG LEGAL SYSTEM NEEDS COMMUNITY SUPPORT

* * * * *

OUR LAW SHOULD DRAW ITS STRENGTH NOT ONLY FROM JUDGES AND LAWYERS, BUT ALSO FROM THE COMMUNITY IT SERVED, THE ATTORNEY GENERAL, MR JEREMY MATHEWS, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

MR MATHEWS BELIEVES A COMMUNITY WHICH UNDERSTANDS AND APPRECIATES THE VALUES OF THE LAW AND THE LEGAL SYSTEM WILL ABIDE BY THE LAW AND CAN DEFEND THAT LAW AND ITS INSTITUTIONS.

SPEAKING AT THE OPENING CEREMONY OF 'LAW WEEK', MR MATHEWS PAID TRIBUTE TO THE LAW SOCIETY FOR ORGANISING SUCH A 'MEANINGFUL AND VALUABLE' EVENT TO HEIGHTEN PUBLIC AWARENESS OF THE BENEFITS OF LAW TO SOCIETY.

"IT ENABLES ALL MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC, THROUGH THEIR PARTICIPATION IN THE ACTIVITIES ORGANISED BY LAW WEEK, TO DEVELOP A BETTER UNDERSTANDING OF THE LAW, THE LEGAL PROFESSION AND THE LEGAL SYSTEM.

"THIS WILL, IN TURN, STRENGTHEN THE LEGAL SYSTEM AND HELP TO ENTRENCH THE RULE OF LAW," HE SAID.

MR MATHEWS SAID HE WAS PROUD OF THE FACT THAT THE RULE OF LAW WAS WELL ESTABLISHED IN HONG KONG; THE JUDICIARY WAS INDEPENDENT AND FAIR.

THAT PEOPLE SEEKING JUSTICE HAVE ACCESS TO LEGAL ASSISTANCE AND TO THE COURTS AND THE LEGAL PROFESSION PROVIDES QUALITY AND EFFICIENT SERVICES IN ALL ASPECTS OF THE LAW.

FOR THE CONTINUANCE OF THE LEGAL SYSTEM AFTER 1997, THE JOINT DECLARATION AND THE BASIC LAW CONTAIN MANY SPECIFIC GUARANTEES, AND THESE GUARANTEES PROVIDE A SOUND BASIS FOR CONFIDENCE IN THE FUTURE LEGAL SYSTEM IN HONG KONG.

TO MAKE THE LEGAL SYSTEM AND LAWS MORE ACCESSIBLE AND LESS DAUNTING TO THE COMMUNITY, MR MATHEWS SAID THE GOVERNMENT WAS DOING ITS PART BY PRODUCING CHINESE TEXTS FOR ALL THE LAWS OF HONG KONG.

AND THE JUDICIARY IS CONSIDERING WAYS IN WHICH GREATER USE MAY BE MADE OF THE CHINESE LANGUAGE IN PROCEEDINGS IN ALL COURTS.

DANGEROUS OPENINGS ON SITES MUST BE COVERED

* * * * *

BUILDING CONTRACTORS MUST ENSURE THAT SUITABLE GUARD-RAILS OR COVERINGS ARE PROVIDED AT ALL DANGEROUS FLOOR EDGES OR OPENINGS ON CONSTRUCTION SITES TO PREVENT WORKERS FALLING FROM A HEIGHT.

E MAN CONSTRUCTION COMPANY LIMITED WAS RECENTLY GIVEN A HEAVY FINE OF \$40,000 BY A SHA TIN MAGISTRATE FOR FAILING TO PROVIDE SUITABLE GUARD-RAILS TO THE FLOOR EDGE.

THE COMPANY WAS ALSO FINED ANOTHER \$40,000 FOR FAILING TO PROVIDE SUITABLE GUARD-RAILS OR A FIXED COVERING TO A LIFT SHAFT OPENING.

"THE OFFENCES WERE DETECTED BY OUR FACTORY INSPECTORS DURING A ROUTINE INSPECTION AT A SHA TIN CONSTRUCTION SITE EARLIER THIS YEAR," LABOUR DEPARTMENT'S CHIEF FACTORY INSPECTOR, MR CHAN TAT-KING, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

HE SAID DURING THE INSPECTION, THE FLOOR EDGE ON THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE HOSPITAL BUILDING UNDER CONSTRUCTION AND THE LIFT SHAFT OPENING ON THE FOURTH FLOOR OF THE STAFF QUARTER BUILDING UNDER CONSTRUCTION WERE FOUND NEITHER PROTECTED BY GUARD-RAILS NOR A COVERING.

UNDER THE CONSTRUCTION SITES (SAFETY) REGULATIONS, EVERY OPENING, CORNER, BREAK, EDGE OR OTHER DANGEROUS PLACES FROM WHICH A PERSON MAY FALL MUST BE PROVIDED WITH SUITABLE GUARD-RAILS OR FIXED COVERINGS.

ANY CONTRACTOR FAILING TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS WILL BE LIABLE TO A MAXIMUM FINE OF \$50,000 AND TO IMPRISONMENT FOR 12 MONTHS, HE ADDED.

MR CHAN REMINDED CONTRACTORS AND WORKERS THAT FALL OF PERSONS FROM A HEIGHT WAS A COMMON CAUSE OF ACCIDENTS IN CONSTRUCTION SITES WHICH OFTEN RESULTED IN SERIOUS INJURIES OR EVEN DEATHS.

HE URGED CONTRACTORS AND EMPLOYERS TO TAKE EVERY PRECAUTION TO ENSURE WORKERS' SAFETY AND HEALTH.

HE ALSO CALLED ON WORKERS TO REPORT ANY IRREGULARITIES, WHICH MIGHT PRESENT A HAZARD TO THEMSELVES WHILST AT WORK, EITHER TO THEIR SAFETY OFFICER ON SITE OR TO THE FACTORY INSPECTORATE DIVISION OF THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT ON TEL 815 0678.

AUTOMATED DRUG HOTLINE WELL-RECEIVED

* * * * *

THE AUTOMATION OF THE DRUG ABUSE TELEPHONE ENQUIRY SERVICE HOTLINE (DATES) HAS MADE IT MORE ACCESSIBLE TO MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO SEEK ADVICE AND INFORMATION ON DRUG-RELATED ISSUES, INCLUDING TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION FACILITIES FROM THE HOTLINE SET UP BY THE NARCOTICS DIVISION.

THE HOTLINE (366 8822) HAS BEEN AUTOMATED SINCE FEBRUARY 5 THIS YEAR WITH THE INTRODUCTION OF A VOICE MESSAGING SYSTEM (VMS).

SINCE THE AUTOMATION, THE NUMBER OF CALLERS AVERAGED SOME 1,100 A DAY.

"IT IS HOPED THAT JUST WITH A PRESS OF THE BUTTON, MORE PEOPLE COULD BE INFORMED ABOUT THE HARMFUL EFFECTS OF DRUG ABUSE WHENEVER THEY WANT," A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NARCOTICS DIVISION SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

AT PRESENT, THE DATES HOTLINE HAS A TOTAL OF EIGHT TELEPHONE LINES TO ALLOW MORE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC TO LISTEN TO PRE-RECORDED MESSAGES IN CANTONESE ON 12 TYPES OF COMMON SUBSTANCES OF ABUSE AND TO GAIN ACCESS TO INFORMATION ON DRUG TREATMENT AND REHABILITATION FACILITIES.

THE VOICE MENU OF THE HOTLINE WILL TELL THE CALLERS TO PICK THE PRE-RECORDED MESSAGE THEY WANT BY PRESSING A SUITABLE NUMBER BUTTON. THE CODES FOR THE 12 TYPES OF COMMON SUBSTANCE OF ABUSE ARE AS FOLLOWS:

DEAN OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG'S FACULTY OF SCIENCE, DR I J HODGKISS, HAS RECENTLY BEEN APPOINTED BY THE GOVERNOR AS THE NEW CHAIRMAN OF THE COUNTRY PARKS BOARD, REPLACING MR CARLOS CHEUNG HON-KAU.

AN AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT (AFD) SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THAT DR HODGKISS WOULD SERVE A TWO-YEAR TERM OF CHAIRMANSHIP UNTIL AUGUST 15, 1995.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID FOUR NEW MEMBERS HAD ALSO BEEN APPOINTED TO THE BOARD FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS. THEY ARE MR LEUNG MAN-WAI, MAN SAI-CHEONG, MRS MEI NG AND MR TANG PUI-TAT.
