LAST SHA TIN DB MEETING FOR DR HASE

THE SECOND MEETING OF THE SHA TIN DISTRICT BOARD TO BE HELD ON WEDNESDAY (JULY 21) WILL BE THE LAST ONE TO BE CHAIRED BY DR PATRICK HASE, THE DISTRICT OFFICER.

HE WILL TAKE UP A NEW POST YET TO BE DECIDED AFTER HIS LEAVE WHICH BEGINS LATER THIS MONTH WHEN HE WILL BE SUCCEEDED BY MR DONALD TSANG.

AT WEDNESDAY'S DISTRICT BOARD MEETING, MR HSU SHAU-WOO FROM THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT WILL BRIEF MEMBERS ON THE ALLOCATION OF JUNIOR SECONDARY SCHOOL PLACES.

AN ENTERTAINMENT STANDARDS CONTROL OFFICER FROM THE TELEVISION AND ENTERTAINMENT LICENSING AUTHORITY WILL EXPLAIN, AND INVITE COMMENTS ON, A PROPOSED FILM CLASSIFICATION SYSTEM CONCERNING A STATUTORY AGE RESTRICTION FOR VIEWING OF ADULT FILMS.

MEMBERS WILL ALSO GIVE THEIR VIEWS ON THE SETTING UP OF MUTUAL AID COMMITTEE OFFICES IN THE HOME OWNERSHIP SCHEME SUI WO COURT AND THE HOUSING SOCIETY JAT MIN CHUEN.

IN ADDITION, THE +MEETING THE PUBLIC+ SESSION BY DISTRICT BOARD MEMBERS, WHICH BEGAN IN MARCH THIS YEAR, WILL BE REVIEWED.

RESTAURANT OPERATORS WARNED OF FIRE HAZARDS

* * * * *

THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS DISCOURAGING RESTAURANT OPERATORS FROM LETTING THEIR EMPLOYEES SLEEP IN RESTAURANT PREMISES AFTER CLOSING TIME.

A SPOKESMAN OF THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THERE HAD BEEN CASES WHERE EMPLOYEES SLEEPING IN RESTAURANTS DID NOT KNOW THE LOCATIONS OF SAFETY EXITS DURING EMERGENCIES, THUS ENDANGERING THEIR LIVES.

+IT HAS BEEN NOTED BY THE FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT THAT EXITS IN MANY RESTAURANTS ARE LOCKED AND CHAINED, MAKING ESCAPE DIFFICULT IN CASE OF FIRE OR OTHER EMERGENCIES,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

HE WARNED THAT IT IS AGAINST FIRE SAFETY REGULATIONS TO LOCK OR CHAIN EMERGENCY EXITS, AND ADVISED THAT IF EMPLOYEES MUST SLEEP IN RESTAURANTS AFTER WORK, THEY SHOULD BE PROVIDED WITH SLEEPING SPACE NEAR AN EXIT AND BE INFORMED OF ITS LOCATION.

OFFICERS FROM THE FIRE PROTECTION BUREAU ARE AVAILABLE TO ADVISE RESTAURANT OPERATORS ON NECESSARY SAFETY MEASURES.

THE HONG KONG REGIONAL OFFICE OF THE BUREAU IS LOCATED AT THE SHEUNG WAN FIRE STATION, THE KOWLOON OFFICE ON THE 5TH FLOOR OF SAN PO KONG GOVERNMENT OFFICES BUILDING, AND THE NEW TERRITORIES REGIONAL OFFICE IN THE SHA TIN FIRE STATION.

FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT SCHEME FOR CHILDREN

YOUNGSTERS ARE INVITED TO JOIN A GOAL-SCORING FOOTBALL TRAINING SCHEME IN THE NEW TERRITORIES DURING THE SUMMER HOLIDAYS.

THE 'HOW TO SCORE A GOAL' COURSE OF THE HONG KONG 1982 CHILDREN FOOTBALL DEVELOPMENT SCHEME IS AIMED AT DEVELOPING CHILDREN'S POTENTIAL IN THE SPORT, SAID A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NTSD.

THE SCHEME, JOINTLY ORGANISED BY THE HONG KONG FOOTBALL ASSOCIATION, THE URBAN COUNCIL, HONG KONG BOY'S AND GIRL'S CLUBS ASSOCIATION, SILVER JUBILEE SPORTS CENTRE AND THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT, WILL BE HELD BETWEEN MONDAY (JULY 19) AND AUGUST 25.

THE EIGHT-SESSION COURSE IS DIVIDED INTO A PRIMARY SECTION FOR CHILDREN UNDER 12 AND A SECONDARY SECTION FOR THOSE FROM 12 TO 15.

OUTSTANDING PERFORMERS WILL RECEIVE FURTHER TRAINING FOR DISTRICT-WIDE FOOTBALL MATCHES.

APPLICATION FORMS ARE OBTAINABLE AT ALL DISTRICT URBAN SERVICES OFFICES, PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS, SPORTSGROUNDS AND INDOOR GAMES HALLS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

+CONTRARY TO CLAIMS BY SOME SALESMEN, SUCH PLATES ARE NOT YET COMPULSORY,+ A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

+IT IS INTENDED THAT ONLY NEW VEHICLES WILL BE AFFECTED INITIALLY, AND A TRANSITIONAL PERIOD FOR THE CHANGE WILL BE ALLOWED FOR OTHER VEHICLES,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN DISCLOSED THAT YELLOW WAS LIKELY TO BE THE REQUIRED COLOUR FOR THE NEW REAR PLATES AND WHITE FOR THE FRONT PLATES.

HE CAUTIONED THAT AS MOST REFLECTIVE PLATES ON SALE WERE WHITE, THEY MIGHT BE LEGALLY UNACCEPTABLE.
