SPECIAL STAMPS TO MARK YEAR OF RABBIT

*** * * * ***

A NEW LUNAR NEW YEAR SPECIAL STAMP SERIES, COMMENCING WITH THE YEAR OF THE RABBIT, WILL BE ISSUED BY THE POST OFFICE ON JANUARY 21 (WEDNESDAY).

THIS FOLLOWS THE POPULAR FIRST SERIES ISSUED BETWEEN 1967 AND 1978.

THE STAMPS, DESIGNED BY MR KAN TAI-KAN, DEPICT VARIOUS POSTURES OF A RABBIT IN AN EMBROIDERY STYLE.

+ORNAMENTAL EMBROIDERY HAS BEEN A POPULAR PASTIME IN THE CHINESE COMMUNITY FOR MANY CENTURIES AND THE ADORNMENT IT PROVIDES GIVES A FEELING OF PROSPERITY AND HAPPINESS,+ A POST OFFICE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+FOR THIS REASON, MANY EMBROIDERY ITEMS ARE CREATED FOR FESTIVE AND RITUAL USE, ESPECIALLY DURING NEW YEAR CELEBRATIONS.+

THE STAMPS ARE IN DENOMINATIONS OF 50 CENTS, \$1.30, \$1.70 AND \$5. A SOUVENIR SHEET CONTAINING A SET OF THE FOUR STAMPS WILL ALSO BE ISSUED AT \$8.50 EACH.

THE STAMPS WILL BE ON DISPLAY FOR TWO DAYS FROM TOMORROW (SATURDAY) AT THE GROUND FLOOR ENTRANCE ARENA OF SHA TIN NEW TOWN PLAZA. FROM JANUARY 7 (WEDNESDAY) ONWARDS, THEY WILL BE SHOWN AT THE PHILATELIC CENTRE ON THE FIRST FLOOR OF THE GENERAL POST OFFICE AND IN THE TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE.

OFFICIAL FIRST DAY COVERS AT 50 CENTS EACH WILL BE AVAILABLE ON JANUARY 7.

ADVANCE ORDERS FOR FIRST DAY TREATMENT OF FIRST DAY COVERS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM JANUARY 7 TO 16 AT ALL POST OFFICES. THE MINIMUM QUANTITY PER ORDER IS FIVE.

+CUSTOMERS WISHING TO AVOID CONGESTION ON THE FIRST DAY OF ISSUE ARE ADVISED TO MAKE USE OF THIS SERVICE,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF CUSTOMERS, FIRST DAY COVERS PRE-AFFIXED WITH A SET OF THE STAMPS AND CANCELLED WITH THE PHILATELIC BUREAU DATESTAMP WILL BE AVAILABLE FOR SALE AT \$10 AT DESIGNATED COUNTERS AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, BEACONSFIELD HOUSE, QUEEN'S ROAD, TSIM SHA TSUI AND KOWLOON CENTRAL POST OFFICES ON JANUARY 21.

GLOSSARY OF COMMON TERMS IN COMMERCE, SERVICE
* * * * *

THE COMMITTEE ON TRANSLATION OF THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING COUNCIL HAS COMPILED AN ENGLISH-CHINESE GLOSSARY OF COMMON TERMS IN COMMERCE AND SERVICES.

ENTITLED +A GLOSSARY OF COMMON TERMS IN COMMERCE AND SERVICES+, THE GLOSSARY COMPRISES 3 500 TERMS SELECTED AND TRANSLATED FROM THOSE SUPPLIED BY THE COUNCIL'S TRAINING BOARDS.

THE GLOSSARY IS AIMED AT STANDARDISING TERMS USED IN COMMERCE AND SERVICES, ALTHOUGH LOCAL TERMS, MOSTLY IN CANTONESE TRANSLITERATIONS ARE ALSO INCLUDED, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE COUNCIL SAID.

HE SAID IT WAS HOPED THAT THE STANDARD TERMS WILL BE POPULARISED AND EVENTUALLY REPLACE LOCAL TERMS.

MEANWHILE, THE BANKING TRAINING BOARD HAS REPRINTED THE LATEST JOB SPECIFICATION FOR THE PRINCIPAL JOBS IN THE BANKING INDUSTRY. MORE THAN 50 JOB SPECIFICATIONS WITH JOB RESPONSIBILITIES, PERSONAL REQUIREMENTS, QUALIFICATIONS AND OTHERS ARE LISTED IN THE MANUAL.

RATEPAYERS REMINDED TO PAY FIRST QUARTER RATES

RATEPAYERS ARE REMINDED THAT RATES FOR THE FIRST QUARTER OF 1987 MUST BE PAID BY 4 PM ON JANUARY 28.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TREASURY SAID TODAY (FRIDAY) THAT LATE PAYMENTS MAY BE SUBJECT TO A FIVE PER CENT SURCHARGE AND A FURTHER SURCHARGE OF 10 PER CENT ON ACCOUNTS STILL OUTSTANDING SIX MONTHS AFTER THE DUE DATE.

HE SAID RATEPAYERS SHOULD HAVE BY NOW RECEIVED DEMAND NOTES.

THOSE WHO HAVE NOT YET RECEIVED DEMAND NOTES SHOULD APPLY FOR A COPY AT THE RATES SECTION OF THE TREASURY, CENTRAL GOVERNMENT OFFICES (WEST WING), NINTH FLOOR, 11 ICE HOUSE STREET, HONG KONG- THE YAU MA TEI SUB-TREASURY, FOURTH FLOOR, 405 NATHAN ROAD, KOWLOON- OR THE KOWLOON CITY SUB-TREASURY, MAN SANG COMMERCIAL BUILDING, FIRST FLOOR, 348-352 PRINCE EDWARD ROAD (CORNER OF PRINCE EDWARD ROAD AND JUNCTION ROAD), KOWLOON.

+NON-RECEIPT OF THE DEMAND NOTE DOES NOT ALTER THE REQUIREMENT THAT RATES MUST BE PAID BEFORE THE DUE DATE,+ HE POINTED OUT.

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT RATES ARE PAYABLE ON VACANT PREMISES BUT ARE REFUNDABLE UNDER CONDITIONS SPECIFIED IN THE RATING ORDINANCE.

HOWEVER, THERE WILL BE NO REFUND IN THE CASE OF A VACANT TENEMENT LAST USED OR INTENDED TO BE USED WHOLLY OR PRIMARILY FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES OR FOR THE PARKING OF VEHICLES, UNLESS IT IS VACANT BY REASON OF AN ORDER OF THE GOVERNMENT.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO POINTED OUT THAT RATEPAYERS WHO HAD SUBMITTED A VALID DIRECT DEBIT AUTHORISATION SHOULD NOTE THAT PAYMENT SHOULD BE MADE BY POST OR IN PERSON AS STIPULATED IN THE DEMAND NOTE UNLESS THE WORDING +PAYMENT WILL BE MADE BY AUTOPAY+ WAS SHOWN IN THE NOTE.

IN THIS CASE THEIR PAYMENT WILL BE MADE BY DIRECT DEBIT TO THEIR BANK ACCOUNTS ON JANUARY 28, 1987.

IN THIS CONNECTION, RATEPAYERS SHOULD ENSURE THAT THEIR ACCOUNTS CONTAIN THE NECESSARY FUNDS ON THAT DATE.

TO AVOID QUEUEING, RATEPAYERS ARE URGED TO PAY BY CHEQUE OR MONEY ORDER SENT BY POST OR BY EARLY PERSONAL ATTENDANCE AT ANY OF THE OFFICES LISTED ON THE BACK OF THE DEMAND NOTE.

YAU MA TEI TO PROMOTE ROAD SAFETY

A WEEK-LONG CAMPAIGN TO PROMOTE ROAD SAFETY WILL BE LAUNCHED IN YAU MA TEI ON SUNDAY (JANUARY 4).

ORGANISED BY THE YAU MA TEI ROAD SAFETY CAMPAIGN ORGANISING COMMITTEE AND ASSISTED BY THE POLICE, THE CAMPAIGN WILL FOCUS ON EDUCATING THE PUBLIC ON ROAD TRAFFIC RULES AND ON THE IMPORTANCE OF ROAD SAFETY MEASURES.

FIFTY PUBLICITY SIGNBOARDS HAVE BEEN PUT UP AT 13 TRAFFIC ACCIDENT BLACK SPOTS IN THE DISTRICT AND PAMPHLETS CONTAINING ROAD SAFETY INFORMATION HAVE BEEN DISTRIBUTED TO MOTORISTS, PEDESTRIANS AND CYCLISTS.
