POK FU LAM BUS ONLY LANE A SUCCESS

LIKE SHANGHAI STREET IN KOWLOON, THE BUS-ONLY LANE SCHEME IN POK FU LAM ROAD HAS PROVED TO BE A GREAT SUCCESS, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY.

PRIOR TO ITS IMPLEMENTATION LAST OCTOBER, BUS JOURNEY ALONG THE 1.2 KILOMETRE NORTHBOUND CARRIAGEWAY BETWEEN QUEEN MARY HOSPITAL AND POKFIELD ROAD TOOK 20 MINUTES DURING THE MORNING PEAK.

NOW, IT ONLY TAKES SEVEN MINUTES, ACCORDING TO A RECENT SURVEY CARRIED OUT BY THE DEPARTMENT.

FOLLOWING THE PARTIAL OPENING OF THE ABERDEEN TUNNEL, OTHER VEHICLES ARE ALSO TRAVELLING FASTER AND THE STUDY SHOWED THAT JOURNEY TIME HAS BEEN SPEEDED UP TO 14 MINUTES COMPARED WITH 19 MINUTES IN THE PAST.

FURTHER IMPROVEMENTS ARE EXPECTED WHEN THE ROAD BETWEEN POKFIELD ROAD AND CHIU SHEUNG SCHOOL IS WIDENED EARLY NEXT YEAR.

THE SHANGHAI STREET SCHEME IMPLEMENTED SIX YEARS AGO, STILL COPE WITH 200 BUSES HOURLY AT AN AVERAGE SPEED OF 15 KILOMETRES PER HOUR.

THIS HAS RESULTED IN A SUBSTANTIAL SAVING OF JOURNEY TIME FOR PASSENGERS AND FOR THIS REASON, IT WILL BE CONTINUED.

MEANWHILE, ANOTHER SURVEY IN YU CHAU STREET SHOWED THAT DESPITE A HIGHER VOLUME OF VEHICLES USING THE SECTION BETWEEN PORTLAND STREET AND YEN CHOW STREET, CIRCULATION HAS SIGNIFICANTLY IMPROVED FOLLOWING NEW TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS INTRODUCED LAST APRIL.

THESE INCLUDED CLEARWAY RESTRICTIONS, REARRANGEMENT OF BUS STOPS AND IMPROVEMENT TO TRAFFIC SIGNALS.

ROAD PROJECT FOR JUNK BAY DEVELOPMENT

THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT WILL SHORTLY INVITE TENDERS FOR A CONTRACT WHICH WILL BE THE FIRST STEP IN A PROGRAMME TO PROVIDE ACCESS FROM KOWLOON TO A NEW TOWN AT JUNK BAY, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE JUNK BAY DEVELOPMENT OFFICE OF THE NTDD SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

THE CONTRACT CALLS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 1.2 KILOMETRES OF SINGLE TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAY OF 10.3 METRES WIDE BEGINNING NEAR THE EASTERN END OF SAU MAU PING ROAD AND RUNNING ALONG VIRGIN HILLSIDES TO CONNECT WITH THE EXISTING ANDERSON ROAD NEAR MAU YAU TONG. CLIMBING LANES AND A FOOTPATH ON ONE SIDE WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID THIS IS THE FIRST OF TWO CONTRACTS TO EXTEND AND RECONSTRUCT PO LAM ROAD SO AS TO FACILITATE THE BUILDING OF THE NEW TOWN AND TO SERVE THE FIRST INHABITANTS EXPECTED TO BE MOVING IN DURING 1986.

CONSTRUCTION WORK, EXPECTED TO BEGIN SOON AND TAKE ABOUT 16 MONTHS TO COMPLETE, WOULD COMPRISE MAINLY OF ROAD FORMATION WORK AND CONCRETE PAVEMENT CONSTRUCTION, WITH ASSOCIATED DRAINAGE WORK, WATER MAIN DIVERSION AND LANDSCAPING.

RECLAMATION FOR TSING YI NORTH BRIDGE

THE LANDS DEPARTMENT PLANS TO CONSTRUCT PIERS IN RAMBLER CHANNEL AND RECLAIM A WORKS AREA TO FACILITATE THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE TSING YI NORTH BRIDGE, WHICH WILL BE LOCATED ABOUT 1 500 METRES NORTH OF THE EXISTING TSING YI BRIDGE.

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY, A DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THE NEW BRIDGE, WHICH WOULD CARRY DUAL TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAYS AND PEDESTRIAN FOOTWAYS AS WELL AS PUBLIC UTILITY SERVICES TO THE ISLAND, WOULD FORM A MAJOR LINK BETWEEN TSING YI AND KOWLOON.

THE EXTENT OF THE AREA INVOLVED IS DESCRIBED IN A NOTICE IN THE LATEST GOVERNMENT GAZETTE AND ANY PERSON HAVING OBJECTIONS TO THE PROPOSAL OR ANY CLAIM OF PRIVATE RIGHT SHOULD SUBMIT THEM TO THE DIRECTOR OF LANDS WITHIN TWO MONTHS.

THE NOTICE IN CHINESE AND ENGLISH WITH ITS RELATED PLAN CAN BE SEEN ON NOTICE BOARDS NEAR THE SITE.

DEVELOPMENT PROJECT FOR SHEK WU HUI

TENDERS HAVE BEEN INVITED FOR A PROJECT WHICH FORMS PART OF A CONTINUING PROGRAMME FOR THE DEVELOPMENT OF SHEK WU HUI.

THE PROJECT INCLUDED THE FORMATION OF A SITE FOR THE NEW SHEUNG SHUI ABATTOIR AND A LARGE SITE IN SHEK WU HUI FOR INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT'S TAI PO AND FANLING DEVELOPMENT OFFICE SAID TODAY (SUNDAY).

HE ADDED THAT A SECTION OF JOCKEY CLUB ROAD BETWEEN MAN KAM TO ROAD AND THE SHEK WU HUI JOCKEY CLUB CLINIC WOULD BE IMPROVED TO BECOME A DUAL TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAY.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE REMAINING SECTION OF THE DISTRIBUTOR ROAD REPLACING SAN FUNG AVENUE AND A NEW ROAD FORMING AN ACCESS TO THE ABATTOIR WOULD BE COMPLETED.

THERE WOULD ALSO BE EXTENSIVE LANDSCAPE WORKS, INCLUDING A LARGE LANDSCAPED AREA TO THE SOUTHEAST OF SHEUNG SHUI TSUEN, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

WORK IS EXPECTED TO START IN TWO MONTHS AND WILL TAKE TWO YEARS TO COMPLETE.

NEW ROOF FOR GARDEN ROAD RESERVOIR

* * * *

TENDERS ARE BEING INVITED BY THE WATER SUPPLIES DEPARTMENT FOR THE RECONSTRUCTION OF A ROOF SLAB AT THE GARDEN ROAD SERVICE RESERVOIR.

THE RESERVOIR, LOCATED AT THE NORTHEAST CORNER OF THE ZOOLOGICAL AND BOTANICAL GARDENS, WAS CONSTRUCTED IN 1931.

SINCE 1979, CRACKS HAVE DEVELOPED ON THE UNDERSIDE OF THE ROOF SLABS AND BEAMS, MAKING THEM SUSCEPTIBLE TO THE INFILTRATION OF WATER.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID SPALLING OF CONCRETE AND EXPOSURE OF STEEL REINFORCEMENT WERE FOUND ON THE BEAMS AT SEVERAL LOCATIONS.

ANALYSIS OF THE STRUCTURE SHOWED THAT SHEAR REINFORCEMENT AT THE MAIN BEAM WAS INSUFFICIENT TO PROVIDE ADEQUATE MEANS OF SAFETY FOR THE ASSUMED LOADS, HE SAID.

RECONSTRUCTION OF THE RESERVOIR ROOF WAS REQUIRED AS A PERMANENT SOLUTION, HE ADDED.

WORK IS SCHEDULED TO START IN OCTOBER THIS YEAR AND WILL BE COMPLETED IN ABOUT A YEAR.

IN WANG TAU HOM, JUNCTION ROAD BETWEEN FU MEI STREET AND WANG TAU HOM EAST ROAD WILL BE TEMPORARILY CLOSED TO TRAFFIC FROM 1 AM TO 5 AM ON TUESDAY (AUGUST 17) AND THE FOLLOWING DAY FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A FOOTBRIDGE.

DURING THE CLOSURE, TRAFFIC ON JUNCTION ROAD HEADING FOR KOWLOON TONG OR KOWLOON CITY WILL HAVE TO USE WANG TAU HOM EAST ROAD AND FU MEI STREET INSTEAD.

AT THE SAME TIME, FU ON STREET WILL ALSO BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC.

LIFEGUARD TRAINING COURSES EXTEND TO KWAI CHUNG AND SHA TIN

THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT IS TO EXTEND ITS LIFEGUARD TRAINING COURSES TO KWAI CHUNG AND SHA TIN DISTRICTS FOLLOWING A SUCCESSFUL ONE AT FANLING.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NTSD SAID SOME 200 BUDDING LIFEGUARDS HAD RECEIVED TRAINING UNDER THE SCHEME HELD AT THE FANLING PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL.

STARTING AUGUST 31 (TUESDAY), FOUR 13-SESSION LIFEGUARD TRAINING COURSES WILL BE LAUNCHED AT THE KWAI SHING PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL AND THE SHA TIN JOCKEY CLUB PUBLIC SWIMMING POOL. EACH COURSE WILL BE HELD THREE TIMES A WEEK FROM 7.45 PM TO 9.45 PM.

THESE FREE TRAINING COURSES, WHICH LAST UNTIL THE END OF SEPTEMBER, WILL HELP RECRUIT MORE LIFEGUARDS TO SERVE AT THE VARIOUS PUBLIC BEACHES AND SWIMMING POOLS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES.

APPLICANTS FOR THE LIFEGUARD TRAINING COURSES SHOULD BE AGED 18 OR ABOVE AND SHOULD HAVE STRONG PHYSIQUE AND GOOD EYE-SIGHT. THEY MUST ALSO BE CAPABLE OF SWIMMING A DISTANCE OF 200 METRES.

TOWARDS THE END OF THE CLASS, TRAINEES WILL SIT FOR A TEST FOR A BRONZE MEDALLION ORGANISED BY THE ROYAL HONG KONG LIFE-SAVING SOCIETY. AFTER ACQUIRING THE STIPULATED QUALIFICATION, THEY WILL BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY FOR THE POST OF LIFEGUARD IN THE NTSD AND EARN \$2 350 A MONTH.

THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT TODAY (SUNDAY) ANNOUNCED THE LAUNCHING OF A SERIES OF IMPORT AND EXPORT PRICE SURVEYS. THESE SURVEYS ARE CONDUCTED TO COLLECT PRICE DATA ON SELECTED GOODS FROM PRINCIPAL IMPORTERS AND EXPORTERS.

THE IMPORT AND EXPORT PRICE INDEXES TO BE COMPILED FROM THE DATA COLLECTED ARE USED TO SUPPLEMENT THE EXISTING UNIT VALUE INDEXES PUBLISHED BY THE DEPARTMENT AND PROVIDE ACCURATE MEASURES OF PRICE MOVEMENTS OF GOODS TRADED.

A NUMBER OF IMPORTERS AND EXPORTERS HAVE BEEN RANDOMLY SELECTED FOR THIS SURVEY. CENSUS AND SURVEY OFFICERS OF THE DEPARTMENT WILL VISIT THEM SHORTLY AND REQUEST INFORMATION ON THE PRICE AND RELATED DATA IN CONNECTION WITH RECENT SHIPMENTS.

THE SAMPLED FIRMS ARE URGED TO GIVE FULL SUPPORT AND CO-OPERATION TO THE SURVEY.

THE MEDICAL AND HEALTH DEPARTMENT IS ORGANISING A SERIES OF CAMPAIGN ACTIVITIES TO PROMOTE GREATER AWARENESS AMONG THE PUBLIC OF THE IMPORTANCE OF A HEALTHY HEART.

THE CAMPAIGN, SPONSORED BY THE HONG KONG HEART FOUNDATION AND THE HONG KONG CARDIOLOGICAL SOCIETY, AIMS TO DRIVE HOME THE MESSAGE +PROTECT YOUR HEART, HAVE AN EARLY START+.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THERE IS A TENDENCY WORLD-WIDE THAT MORE AND MORE PEOPLE DIE OF HEART DISEASES AS A RESULT OF INTENSE URBANISATION AND HECTIC LIFE.

IN HONG KONG, MORE THAN 7 000 PERSONS DIED OF VARIOUS HEART DISEASES LAST YEAR, ACCOUNTING FOR ABOUT 30 PER CENT OF ALL DEATHS.

THE HIGH DEATH TOLL OF HEART DISEASES, WHICH INCLUDE HYPERTENSIVE AND CEREBROVASCULAR DISEASES, EXCEEDED THAT OF CANCER, HE ADDED.

THE +HEALTHY HEART+ CAMPAIGN WILL START WITH A MENU PLANNING AND COOKING CONTEST, WHICH IS JOINTLY RUN BY THE DEPARTMENT'S CENTRAL HEALTH EDUCATION UNIT AND A LOCAL TELEVISION STATION.
