THE SECRETARY OF STATE FOR SOCIAL SERVICES, THE RT. HON. DAVID ENNALS, M.P., AND MR. RODERICK MACFARQUHAR, M.P. WILL ARRIVE IN HONG KONG TOMORROW (MONDAY) FOR A FIVE-DAY VISIT ON THEIR WAY HOME FOLLOWING A TOUR OF CHINA.

MR. ENNALS AND MR. MACFARQUHAR WILL BE MET AT THE LOWU BORDER BY THE GOVERNOR, SIR MURRAY MACLEHOSE.

DURING THEIR STAY HERE, THEY WILL BE BRIEFED ON HONG KONG'S SOCIAL SERVICES PROGRAMMES AND SEE FOR THEMSELVES THE WORK OF VARIOUS WELFARE AND MEDICAL INSTITUTIONS.

THEY WILL ALSO SEE THE DEVELOPMENT WORKS OF SHA TIN NEW TOWN AND VISIT THE HEADQUARTERS OF THE HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR BRIEFING ON THE HOUSING PROGRAMME.

MR. ENNALS AND MR. MACFARQUHAR WILL LEAVE HONG KONG ON FRIDAY (JUNE 2).

WORK ON CHEUNG CHAU DEVELOPMENT TO BEGIN SOON

* * * * *

THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT WILL BEGIN WORK SHORTLY ON A MAJOR SCHEME TO DEVELOP CHEUNG CHAU OVER THE NEXT TEN YEARS.

TENDERS FOR THE WORK, WHICH INCLUDES THE FORMATION OF ABOUT 12 HECTARES OF LAND ARE BEING INVITED BY THE P.W.D.

MR. T.S. NG, GOVERNMENT ENGINEER (NEW TERRITORIES), SAID THAT THE CONTRACT WOULD BE THE FIRST STAGE IN THE PLANNED DEVELOPMENT OF CHEUNG CHAU.

+THE FULL SCHEME INVOLVES THE PROVISION OF PUBLIC HOUSING FOR 5,000 PEOPLE, LAND FOR PRIVATE HOUSING FOR ANOTHER 10,000 PEOPLE AND SITES FOR LIGHT INDUSTRIES,+ HE SAID.

+GOVERNMENT AND COMMUNITY FACILITIES, INCLUDING SCHOOLS, MARKETS, SEWAGE TREATMENT WORKS, INCINERATORS, AN ABATTOIR, OPEN SPACES WILL ALSO BE PROVIDED.+

OF THE 12 HECTARES OF LAND TO BE FORMED, SIX WOULD BE RECLAIMED FROM THE SEA AT CHEUNG CHAU WAN, KWAI TSAI WAN AND TAI KWAI WAN, HE ADDED.

FILLING MATERIALS WILL BE TAKEN FROM A BORROW AREA ON A HILLSIDE NORTH OF TAI KWAI WAN AND FROM THE AREA EAST OF KWAI TSAI WAN WHERE A PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE WILL BE SITUATED.

TO CONTAIN THE FILLING MATERIALS, MR. NG SAID, 300 METRES OF SEAWALLS AND 1,400 METRES OF RUBBLE REVETMENT WOULD BE BUILT.

FOR TRANSPORTATION OF THE FILLING MATERIALS ABOUT ONE KILOMETRE OF HAUL ROAD WILL BE CONSTRUCTED.

THE CONTRACT ALSO COVERS THE CONSTRUCTION OF THREE KILOMETRES OF ROADS, PATHWAYS AND PROMENADES. SOME NINE KILOMETRES OF STORM WATER DRAINS AND SEWERS WILL ALSO BE LAID.

ON COMPLETION OF THE WORK, MR. NG POINTED OUT, SITES WOULD BE PROVIDED AT CHEUNG CHAU WAN, KWAI TSAI WAN AND TAI KWAI WAN FOR A PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE FOR 1870 PEOPLE AND FOR VILLAGE TYPE HOUSING AND INDUSTRIAL USES.

PART OF THE LAND TO BE FORMED OR RECLAIMED, HE ADDED, WOULD BE USED AS SITES FOR A CENTRAL SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT, AN INCINERATOR, AN ABATTOIR, AND A NEW MARINE FUELLING STATION.

A SYSTEM OF STORM AND SANITARY WATER DRAINS WILL BE PROVIDED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW TRUNK SEWERS TO SERVE CENTRAL AND NORTHERN CHEUNG CHAU. THIS SYSTEM WILL, IN FUTURE, BE FURTHER EXTENDED.

WORK ON THE CONTRACT IS EXPECTED TO BEGIN IN SEPTEMBER AND WILL TAKE ABOUT 21 MONTHS TO COMPLETE.

FAST MAIL DELIVERY SERVICE

* * * *

A NEW POSTAL SERVICE KNOWN AS +RAPID BOX DELIVERY SERVICE+ WILL BE INTRODUCED BY THE POST OFFICE FROM JUNE 1.

THE NEW SERVICE WILL ENSURE THAT MAIL ADDRESSED TO POST OFFICE BOXES AT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE, THE KOWLOON CENTRAL POST OFFICE AND TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE AND POSTED AT THESE THREE OFFICES WILL BE DELIVERED WITHIN TWO HOURS EXCEPT ON SUNDAYS AND PUBLIC HOLIDAYS.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE POST OFFICE SAID SPECIAL POSTING BOXES FOR THIS NEW SERVICE HAVE BEEN SET UP IN THE P.O. BOX LOBBIES OF THESE THREE POST OFFICES.

HE SAID ARRANGEMENT HAS ALSO BEEN MADE TO EXTEND THE NEW SERVICE TO COVER SPECIALLY SEGREGATED FRANKED POSTAL ITEMS ADDRESSED TO P.O. BOXES IN THESE THREE POST OFFICES.

UNDER THE ARRANGEMENT THE BULK ACCEPTANCE COUNTERS AT THESE THREE POST OFFICES WILL RECEIVE SUCH POSTAL ITEMS WHICH ARE ADDRESSED AND POSTED AT THAT PARTICULAR POST OFFICE. THEY WILL BE DELIVERED WITHIN TWO HOURS.

+THERE ARE NO ADDITIONAL CHARGES FOR THE NEW SERVICE, BUT IT IS RESTRICTED TO ITEMS FULLY PREPAID AT THE LETTER RATE OF POSTAGE,+ THE SPOKESMAN ADDED.

NEW FERRY PIER FOR NORTH POINT

NORTH POINT FERRY COMMUTERS WILL BE ABLE TO USE BY AUGUST NEXT YEAR A NEW PIER WITH A COVERED WALKWAY TO LINK WITH THE BUSY BUS TERMINUS WHICH WILL ALSO BE COVERED.

WORK ON THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW TWIN-DECK FERRY PIER BY THE CIVIL ENGINEERING OFFICE OF THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT IS PROGRESSING SATISFACTORILY AND IS ABOUT ONE-THIRD COMPLETE.

THE NEW PIER BEING BUILT AT A COST OF AROUND \$10.5 MILLION, IS IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE EASTERN CORRIDOR PROJECT.

WORK ON THE PIER IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BY JUNE 1979 WITH THE OPENING SCHEDULED FOR AUGUST.

THE PIER HAS BEEN DESIGNED TO ALLOW FOR AN EXTRA DECK SHOULD IT BECOME NECESSARY AT A LATER DATE.

ONCE THE NEW PIER IS OPENED THE OLD ONE WILL BE DEMOLISHED.

SPEECH THERAPY EXPERT TO SPEND TWO MONTHS WITH
EDUCATION DEPARTMENT

MR. ROBERT FAWCUS, A SPEECH THERAPY EXPERT FROM BRITAIN, WILL ARRIVE IN HONG KONG ON FRIDAY (JUNE 2) TO SERVE AS A CONSULTANT TO THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

HE WILL BE HERE FOR ABOUT TWO MONTHS ADVISING THE DEPARTMENT ON EXPANSION OF ITS SERVICES IN THE FIELD OF SPEECH THERAPY.

MR. FAWCUS HAS BEEN SELECTED FOR THE ASSIGNMENT BY THE COMMONWEALTH FUND FOR TECHNICAL CO-OPERATION.

HE HAS HAD LONG EXPERIENCE AND A DISTINGUISHED CAREER IN SPEECH THERAPY. HE IS IN CHARGE OF THE MASTER OF SCIENCE COURSE IN HUMAN COMMUNICATION STUDIES AT LONDON UNIVERSITY AND IS A MEMBER OF THE UNIVERSITY'S EXAMINATION BOARD.

HE IS ALSO AN EXTERNAL EXAMINER FOR THE BACHELOR OF SCIENCE (SPEECH PATHOLOGY) COURSE AT NEWCASTLE UNIVERSITY.

MR. FAWCUS WAS FOR SEVEN YEARS SENIOR SPEECH THERAPIST AT GUY'S HOSPITAL MEDICAL SCHOOL AND HAS ALSO BEEN A LECTURER IN DISORDERS OF COMMUNICATION AT THE KINGDON-WARD SCHOOL OF SPEECH THERAPY.

HE HAS BEEN AWARDED A FELLOWSHIP BY THE COLLEGE OF SPEECH THERAPISTS AND IS ALSO A MEMBER OF THE BRITISH PSYCHOLOGICAL SOCIETY AND THE BRITISH SOCIETY FOR AUDIOLOGY.

DON'T ADD YOUR ENGINE TO YOUR FUEL BILL
* * * *

IF YOU ARE WONDERING WHY MORE DIESEL VEHICLES SEEM TO BE BREAKING DOWN LATELY, IT IS POSSIBLY BECAUSE THEY HAVE BEEN RUNNING ON A MIXTURE OF KEROSENE AND DIESEL OIL.

DRIVERS AND VEHICLE OPERATORS SEEM TO HAVE CAUGHT ON TO THE FACT THAT MIXING CHEAPER KEROSENE WITH DIESEL FUEL CAN SAVE ON FUEL BILLS.

UP TILL NOW THIS HAS NOT BEEN ILLEGAL. BUT WHAT IT MUST HAVE DONE IS TO DAMAGE A LOT OF ENGINES LEAVING THE VEHICLE OWNERS TO FACE BIG REPAIR BILLS.

BESIDES THE TOLL IN DAMAGED LORRY AND MINIBUS ENGINES, THE GOVERNMENT, WHICH HAD IMPOSED A DUTY ON PETROL AND DIESEL FUEL USED IN ROAD VEHICLES, HAS BEEN LOSING REVENUE BECAUSE OF VEHICLES USING KEROSENE ON WHICH NO DUTY IS PAYABLE.

AND THE MAN IN THE STREET HAS HAD TO SUFFER FROM INCREASED POLLUTION CAUSED BY THE MIXTURE AS WELL AS SOMETHING OF AN INCREASED FIRE RISK.

THE DUTIABLE COMMODITIES (AMENDMENT) BILL 1978, WHICH PASSED ITS SECOND READING AT THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ON MAY 24, PROPOSES TO MAKE THE MIXING OF KEROSENE AND DIESEL OIL AN OFFENCE WITH A FINE OF HK\$100,000 OR UP TO TWO YEARS IN PRISON.

THE BILL IS EXPECTED TO TAKE ONE OR TWO MONTHS BEFORE IT IS PASSED. AFTER IT BECOMES LAW, THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE SERVICE WILL THEN CARRY OUT SPOT CHECKS ON VEHICLES TO MAKE SURE DRIVERS ARE NOT BREAKING THE LAW AS WELL AS DAMAGING THEIR VEHICLES' ENGINES.

CODE TO ADVISE PEOPLE TO CARE FOR COASTLINE

* * * * *

A CODE OF BEHAVIOUR HAS BEEN DRAWN UP TO ADVISE PEOPLE HOW TO CARE FOR HONG KONG'S SEASHORES.

DETAILS OF IT ARE GIVEN IN A NEW FREE BOOKLET, +A COASTAL CODE FOR HONG KONG+ WHICH IS BEING DISTRIBUTED TO SCHOOLS AND IS ALSO AVAILABLE FROM VARIOUS GOVERNMENT OUTLETS.

+THE CODE IS SUGGESTED SO THAT WE CAN ALL ENJOY OUR NATURAL INHERITANCE AND LEAVE IT UNSPOILED FOR OUR CHILDREN,+ THE BOOKLET SAYS.

IT HAS BEEN DESIGNED BY THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SERVICES AND IS PUBLISHED IN A COMBINED ENGLISH AND CHINESE VERSION ON BEHALF OF THE ENVIRONMENT BRANCH OF THE GOVERNMENT SECRETARIAT.

THE TEXT, WHICH IS EMBELLISHED WITH ORIGINAL DRAWINGS IN BLACK AND WHITE, WAS PREPARED BY DR. B.S. MORTON, OF THE UNIVERSITY OF HONG KONG.

COPIES OF THE BOOKLET CAN BE OBTAINED FROM CITY DISTRICT OFFICES ON HONG KONG ISLAND AND IN KOWLOON, DISTRICT OFFICES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES, COUNTRY PARKS AUTHORITY CENTRES AND THE GOVERNMENT PUBLICATIONS CENTRE, GENERAL POST OFFICE BUILDING, CENTRAL.

IT IS ALSO BEING DISTRIBUTED TO PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS THROUGH THE RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT.

+HONG KONG, WITH ITS MAINLAND OF SHARP HEADLANDS AND NOTCHED BAYS AND CIRCLET OF SOME 230 ISLANDS, POSSESSES A LONG AND ATTRACTIVE SEASHORE,+ DR. MORTON OBSERVED.

+THE ANIMAL AND PLANT COMMUNITIES THAT COLONISE IT ARE DIVERSE.

+IN OUR IGNORANCE OF THESE COMMUNITIES, HOWEVER, WE MAY INADVERTENTLY DESTROY THE VERY FEATURES THAT ATTRACT US IN THE FIRST PLACE TO THE SEASHORE AND OUR COASTAL SEAS.+

SECTIONS IN THE FOLD-OUT BOOKLET INCLUDE CONSERVATION, PICNICKING, NATURE STUDIES, WATER SPORTS, FISHING, AQUATIC LIFE AND SHELLS.

POINTING OUT THAT CARELESSNESS CAN SPOIL BEACHES AND THE SEASHORE, THE BOOKLET EMPHASISES THE NEED TO KEEP THEM LITTER-FREE AND SAYS PEOPLE SHOULD NEVER BUILD BARBECUES ON SEASHORE GRASSES.

IT TELLS STUDENTS: +DO NOT MOVE ROCKS OR STONES UNNECESSARILY. IF YOU DO HAVE TO MOVE THEM REPLACE THEM IN THEIR NATURAL POSITION. SOME OF THE MOST DELICATE AND SUSCEPTIBLE FORMS OF MARINE LIFE OCCUR ON THE UNDERSIDES OF STABLE ROCKS. THESE WILL ALL DIE IF THE STONE IS NOT PUT BACK IN ITS NORMAL POSITION.+

SPEED BOAT DRIVERS ARE ADVISED TO KEEP AWAY FROM THE SHORES AS THE WASH FROM THEIR BOATS MAY DAMAGE DELICATE COASTAL PLANTS AND SWAMP BIRDS' NESTS.

THE BOOKLET ALSO SAYS PEOPLE SHOULD NOT ALLOW DETERGENTS, PAINTS, SOLVENTS OR FUEL TO ESCAPE FROM THEIR BOATS WHETHER THEY ARE MOVING OR STATIONARY.

+WE CAN ALL USE THE SEASHORE FOR EDUCATION AND RELAXATION. WE ALL HAVE A DUTY TO CARE FOR IT,+ 'A COASTAL CODE FOR HONG KONG' SAYS.

+SPECIAL CARE SHOULD BE TAKEN WHEN VISITING WILD LIFE SANCTUARIES, RESERVES OR NO-HUNTING AREAS. THESE ARE ALWAYS WELL SIGNPOSTED.

+THE DELICATE PATTERN OF LIFE ON THE SEASHORE CAN ONLY SURVIVE IF IT IS CARED FOR.+

THE BOOKLET SAYS HONG KONG HAS A NUMBER OF INTERESTING SEASHORE COMMUNITIES WHICH DESERVE SPECIAL CONSIDERATION. THE MOST IMPORTANT OF THESE ARE THE MANGROVES OF DEEP BAY, TOLO HARBOUR AND THE SAI KUNG AND SHALLOW-SEA CORAL FORMATIONS TO THE EAST.

+DO NOT COLLECT SPECIMENS OF CORAL. OUR CORAL COMMUNITY IN HONG KONG IS HELD IN A DELICATE BALANCE BECAUSE HERE IT IS APPROACHING THE NORTHERN LIMIT OF ITS RANGE,+ IT WARNS.

+ONCE THE CORAL DIES SO WILL ALL THE CORAL FISH THAT ARE ASSOCIATED WITH IT.+

YUEN CHAU TSAI SQUATTER AREA CLEARED FOR MAJOR DEVELOPMENT
* * * * *

THE YUEN CHAU TSAI SQUATTER AREA - OFFICIALLY DESCRIBED AS THE MOST SQUALID IN THE NEW TERRITORIES - NO LONGER EXISTS.

GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS THIS WEEK COMPLETED A FIVE-MONTH CLEARANCE OPERATION TO MOVE NEARLY 4,000 PEOPLE FROM THE AREA INTO PUBLIC AND TEMPORARY HOUSING.

ALL THAT REMAINS OF THE AREA TODAY ARE THE SMOKING RUINS OF THE FLIMSY WOODEN AND TIN STRUCTURES THAT WERE FIRST PUT UP ABOUT 20 YEARS AGO.

THE TAI PO DISTRICT OFFICER, MR. CLIVE OXLEY, SAID TODAY THAT THE CLEARANCE OPERATION - CARRIED OUT BY DISTRICT OFFICE AND THE HOUSING DEPARTMENT STAFF - HAD REMOVED AN EYESORE FROM THE DISTRICT.

+THE GOVERNMENT HAD PLANNED FOR MANY YEARS TO REMOVE THE STRUCTURES BUT THE OPPORTUNITY ONLY CAME LAST YEAR WITH THE DEVELOPMENT PLANS FOR TAI PO AND THE AVAILABILITY OF SUITABLE ALTERNATIVE ACCOMMODATION IN THE DISTRICT.

+IT WAS NOT AN EASY CLEARANCE BECAUSE MOST OF THE YUEN CHAU TSAI RESIDENTS ARE FISHERFOLK WHO HAD LIVED IN THE AREA FOR MANY YEARS AND WERE WORRIED ABOUT THE MOVE, EVEN THOUGH THEY LIVED IN CONDITIONS THAT WERE EXTREMELY UNHYGENIC AND HAZARDOUS AS FAR AS FIRE WAS CONCERNED.

+BUT NOW THAT THE FAMILIES HAVE ALL MOVED INTO THEIR NEW ACCOMMODATION THEY REALISE THAT THEIR ORIGINAL WORRIES WERE GROUNDLESS. IN FACT, MANY FAMILIES HAVE SINCE MENTIONED TO ME HOW HAPPY THEY ARE WITH THEIR NEW ACCOMMODATION.+

MR. OXLEY SAID ABOUT 20 PER CENT OF THE 500 FAMILIES FROM YUEN CHAU TSAI HAD GONE TO LIVE AT THE WO CHE PUBLIC HOUSING ESTATE AT SHA TIN.

+MORE FAMILIES WERE ACTUALLY QUALIFIED FOR PUBLIC HOUSING, BUT THEY PREFERRED TO GO TO THE NEARBY YUE KOK TEMPORARY HOUSING AREA BECAUSE OF THEIR TIES WITH TAI PO,+ HE SAID.

APART FROM PROVIDING THE FAMILIES WITH NEW HOMES, MR. OXLEY SAID THE GOVERNMENT HAD ALSO PAID MORE THAN \$500,000 IN REMOVAL ALLOWANCES AND ANOTHER \$360,000 IN COMPENSATION FOR COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL CONCERNS.

THE SQUATTER AREA IS NOW THE SCENE OF INTENSE DEVELOPMENT ACTIVITY, AS PWD CONTRACTORS ARE ENGAGED ON SITE FORMATION WORKS WHICH WILL RESULT IN THE AREA HAVING A NEW BRIDGE, AN INTERCHANGE FOR THE \$220 MILLION SHA TIN-TAI PO COASTAL ROAD AND A PUBLIC RECREATION AREA.

+THE CLEARANCE HAS NOT ONLY REMOVED THE MOST SQUALID SQUATTER AREA IN THE NEW TERRITORIES, BUT HAS PROVIDED LAND WHICH IS NECESSARY FOR THE OVERALL DEVELOPMENT PLAN TO BUILD A MODERN TOWNSHIP FOR 220,000 PEOPLE IN TAI PO,+ MR. OXLEY ADDED.

WORKSHOP ON FAMILY LIFE EDUCATION
* * * * *

WAYS OF UTILISING RESOURCE MATERIALS TO HELP IMPLEMENT FAMILY LIFE EDUCATION PROGRAMMES WILL BE DEMONSTRATED AND THEIR MERITS AND SETBACKS DISCUSSED AT A WORKSHOP FOR TEACHERS, SOCIAL WORKERS AND NURSERY STAFF IN WANCHAI DISTRICT.

THE WORKSHOP, ORGANISED BY THE RECENTLY-FORMED WANCHAI DISTRICT COMMITTEE ON FAMILY LIFE EDUCATION, AIMS AT GIVING THOSE ALREADY ENGAGED IN EDUCATION AND COMMUNITY WORK AN INSIGHT INTO THE PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES AND CONTENTS.

MR. LAM HARK-CHEE, WANCHAI COMMUNITY AND YOUTH OFFICER, WHO IS ALSO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE COMMITTEE, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY) THE WORKSHOP, TO BE HELD ON JUNE 17 AT THE LADY TRENCH TRAINING CENTRE, WOULD COMPRISE TWO SESSIONS.

+THE WHOLE MORNING WILL BE DEVOTED TO LECTURES ON THE HISTORY, CONCEPT, CONTENTS, TARGET GROUPS AS WELL AS TRENDS OF DEVELOPMENT OF THIS COMMUNITY EDUCATION PROGRAMME,+ HE POINTED OUT.
