LANTAU PORT PENINSULA DEVELOPMENT STUDIES

* * * * *

THE GOVERNMENT ANNOUNCED TODAY (TUESDAY) THE APPOINTMENT OF APH CONSULTANTS TO CARRY OUT THE LANTAU PORT PENINSULA DEVELOPMENT STUDIES WHICH WILL COMMENCE ON AUGUST 12.

THE STUDY COVERS THE WHOLE OF THE TSING CHAU TSAI PENINSULA IN NORTHEAST LANTAU ISLAND, INCLUDING YAM O, PENNY'S BAY AND DISCOVERY BAY TOGETHER WITH THE ISLANDS OF MA WAN AND PENG CHAU.

THE PROJECT MANAGER OF THE PORT DEVELOPMENT OFFICE OF THE CIVIL ENGINEERING SERVICES DEPARTMENT, MR C.L. AU, SAID THE MAIN PURPOSE OF THE STUDY IS TO PRODUCE A RECOMMENDED OUTLINE DEVELOPMENT PLAN AND IMPLEMENTATION PROGRAMME FOR THE LANTAU PORT PENINSULA AT THE TSING CHAU TSAI PENINSULA.

HE NOTED THAT PARTICULAR REFERENCE WILL BE MADE TO THE PROVISION OF PORT FACILITIES SUCH AS CONTAINER TERMINALS, MULTI-PURPOSE TERMINALS, RIVER TRADE TERMINALS, PORT BACK-UP AREAS, PRIVATE WATERFRONT, INDUSTRIAL LAND AND OTHER LAND USES TO MEET THE DEMAND UP TO THE YEAR 2011.

THE STUDY, WHICH IS EXPECTED TO BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF NEXT YEAR, WILL ALSO INCLUDE THE PREPARATION OF COST ESTIMATES AND FORMULATION OF PACKAGES TO ALLOW FOR PRIVATE PARTICIPATION.

SEVEN NOMINATIONS RECEIVED TODAY FOR LEGCO ELECTIONS

SEVEN NOMINATIONS FOR THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL ELECTIONS IN SEPTEMBER WERE RECEIVED TODAY (TUESDAY), BRINGING THE TOTAL NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS SO FAR TO 78.

THREE NOMINATIONS WERE SUBMITTED FOR THE FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCY ELECTIONS TO BE HELD ON THURSDAY, SEPTEMBER 12. FOUR NOMINATIONS WERE RECEIVED FOR THE DIRECT ELECTIONS TO BE HELD ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 15.

SO FAR, THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS FOR FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCIES WERE REGISTERED IN FINANCIAL SERVICES, TEACHING AND TOURISM WITH EACH RECEIVING THREE NOMINATIONS.

THE HIGHEST NUMBER OF NOMINATIONS FOR THE DIRECT ELECTIONS WERE IN KOWLOON CENTRAL AND NEW TERRITORIES EAST WITH EACH RECEIVING SEVEN NOMINATIONS.

THE NOMINATION PERIOD WILL END ON AUGUST 12.

THERE ARE 21 SEATS IN THE 20 FUNCTIONAL CONSTITUENCIES, WITH TWO SEATS FOR THE LABOUR CONSTITUENCY. AS FOR THE DIRECT ELECTIONS, ALL NINE GEOGRAPHICAL CONSTITUENCIES ARE DOUBLE-SEATED.

OPERATION HOURS OF LOK MA CHAU BORDER CROSSING TO BE EXTENDED
 * * * * *

THE OPENING HOURS OF THE LOK MA CHAU BORDER CROSSING WILL BE EXTENDED FROM THE EXISTING 9 AM - 5 PM TO 7.30 AM - 8 PM DAILY FROM THURSDAY, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCED TODAY (TUESDAY).

THE CROSSING, HITHERTO RESTRICTED TO GOODS VEHICLES, WILL NOW BE OPENED TO OTHER CATEGORIES OF VEHICLES INCLUDING PASSENGER COACHES AND PRIVATE CARS.

A QUOTA SYSTEM FOR THE LICENSING OF VEHICLES USING THIS CROSSING IS BEING JOINTLY ADMINISTERED BY THE HONG KONG AND GUANGDONG AUTHORITIES.

COACH OPERATORS WHO WISH TO PROVIDE CROSS-BORDER BUS SERVICE BETWEEN HONG KONG AND CHINA THROUGH THIS CONTROL POINT SHOULD, IN ACCORDANCE WITH ESTABLISHED PROCEDURE, MAKE APPLICATIONS BOTH TO THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT IN HONG KONG AND THE CHINESE AUTHORITIES.

APPLICATIONS IN WRITING SHOULD REACH THE PUBLIC VEHICLES SECTION OF THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT AT ROOM 28, MEZZANINE FLOOR, MURRAY ROAD MULTI-STOREY CARPARK BUILDING, 2 MURRAY ROAD, CENTRAL, HONG KONG ON OR BEFORE AUGUST 16.

"WITH THE OPENING OF THE LOK MA CHAU CONTROL POINT FOR COACHES, THE EXISTING NUMBER OF LICENCES FOR PASSENGER COACHES USING MAN KAM TO AND SHA TAU KOK WILL BE FROZEN AND NEW APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

EMPLOYERS REMINDED TO TAKE OUT INSURANCE FOR EMPLOYEES

THE LABOUR DEPARTMENT TODAY (TUESDAY) REMINDED ALL EMPLOYERS OF THE REQUIREMENT FOR THEM TO TAKE OUT INSURANCE POLICIES FOR THEIR EMPLOYEES UNDER THE EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE.

THE REMINDER FOLLOWED A RECENT CASE AT WESTERN MAGISTRACY IN WHICH HUNG'S ALUMINIUM TRADING COMPANY IN FIRST STREET, WESTERN, WAS FINED \$5,000 FOR FAILING TO PRODUCE A VALID INSURANCE POLICY UNDER THE ORDINANCE.

THE OFFENCE WAS DETECTED BY LABOUR INSPECTORS DURING A ROUTINE VISIT TO THE COMPANY, WHICH EMPLOYED ONLY TWO WORKERS.

"ALL EMPLOYERS ARE REQUIRED TO TAKE OUT INSURANCE POLICIES TO COVER THEIR FULL LIABILITIES UNDER THE EMPLOYEES' COMPENSATION ORDINANCE AND UNDER COMMON LAW," SENIOR LABOUR OFFICER (PROSECUTIONS), MR TSANG KIN-WO, SAID.

"AN INSURED EMPLOYER IS REQUIRED TO DISPLAY, IN A CONSPICUOUS PLACE OF THE WORKPLACE, A NOTICE SHOWING THE NAME OF THE EMPLOYER AND THE NAME OF THE INSURER," MR TSANG STRESSED.

"OTHER DETAILS SHOULD INCLUDE THE POLICY NUMBER, THE DATES OF THE ISSUE OF THE POLICY AND OF THE COMMENCEMENT AND EXPIRY OF THE INSURANCE PERIOD, THE NUMBER OF EMPLOYEES AND THE EXTENT OF THE LIABILITY INSURED," HE ADDED.

MR TSANG NOTED THAT THE MAXIMUM FINE FOR THE OFFENCE WAS \$20,000.

A CSD SPOKESMAN TODAY (TUESDAY) SAID ALL FORM FIVE GRADUATES ARE WELCOMED TO USE THE HOTLINES 527 5951 AND 399 2560 TO ASK FOR MORE ABOUT THE JOB, PAY SCALE AND CAREER PROSPECTS AS WELL AS THE APPLICATION PROCEDURES FOR THE POST.

IN ADDITION, TWO SPECIAL COUNTERS TO HANDLE ENQUIRIES AND APPLICATIONS WERE SET UP AT CSD'S TWO RECRUITMENT CENTRES AT MONG KOK GOVERNMENT OFFICES, 30 LUEN WAN STREET, MONG KOK, AND AT WANCHAI TOWER I, 23RD FLOOR, 12 HARBOUR ROAD, WAN CHAI.

"OUR PAST EXPERIENCES SHOWED THAT QUITE A LARGE NUMBER OF SCHOOL-LEAVERS WOULD APPLY FOR THE CSD POST IMMEDIATELY AFTER THE RELEASE OF THE HONG KONG CERTIFICATE OF EDUCATION (HKCEE) RESULTS," THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

HE ADDED THAT IT IS HOPED THAT THIS YEAR'S ARRANGEMENTS WOULD HELP SPEED UP THE HANDLING OF APPLICATIONS.

THE SPOKESMAN REMINDED APPLICANTS THAT THEY SHOULD BRING ALONG WITH THEIR HKCEE RESULT SLIPS, IDENTITY CARDS AND BIRTH CERTIFICATES.
