ANTI-DRUG MESSAGE SPREADS TO ALL SCHOOLS

THE ACTION COMMITTEE AGAINST NARCOTICS AND THE COMMUNITY YOUTH CLUB SECTION OF THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT ARE JOINTLY ORGANISING AN ANTI-DRUG CHINESE ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION AND A POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION FOR PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL STUDENTS.

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY (SATURDAY), A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NARCOTICS DIVISION SAID THE PROJECTS ARE EDUCATIONAL REQUIRING A LOT OF RESEARCH ON THE PART OF ENTRANTS AND IT IS HOPED THAT THE STUDENTS WOULD LEARN ABOUT THE DANGERS OF DRUG ABUSE AND NEVER TO EXPERIMENT WITH DRUGS.

HE ADDED THAT A GREAT DEAL OF EFFORT AND RESOURCES WILL BE DEVOTED BY ACAN THIS YEAR TO PREVENT YOUNG PEOPLE FROM BECOMING ADDICTED AND INVOLVED IN DRUG CRIME.

THE ESSAY AND POSTER DESIGN COMPETITIONS ARE THE FIRST TWO PROJECTS. OTHER YOUTH ACTIVITIES PLANNED INCLUDE A YOUTH AGAINST DRUGS SCHEME, YOUTH VOLUNTEER SCHEME, SCHOOL TALKS AND EXHIBITIONS AND SPECIAL TRAINING CAMPS FOR YOUTHS.

THE ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION IS DIVIDED INTO TWO SECTIONS -- A JUNIOR SECTION FOR FORM 1-3 STUDENTS, AND A SENIOR SECTION FOR FORM 4-7 STUDENTS. THE NUMBER OF ENTRIES FOR EACH SECTION IS LIMITED TO 10 PER SCHOOL.

EACH PARTICIPANT SHOULD SUBMIT AN ESSAY OF 800 TO 1 000 WORDS ON ONE OF THE FOLLOWING TOPICS:

- \* HOW TO AVOID BECOMING INVOLVED IN DRUG TRAFFICKING;
- \* THE EFFECT OF ADDICTION ON INDIVIDUALS, FAMILIES AND THE COMMUNITY; AND
- \* WHAT YOUNG PEOPLE SHOULD DO TO HELP CURB THE INCREASE IN DRUG ABUSE.

THE POSTER DESIGN COMPETITION IS ALSO DIVIDED INTO JUNIOR AND SENIOR SECTIONS. THE JUNIOR SECTION IS FOR PRIMARY STUDENTS AND THE OTHER IS FOR SECONDARY STUDENTS.

THERE IS NO LIMIT TO THE NUMBER OR STYLE OF ENTRIES, BUT THE DESIGN MUST BE OF INTERNATIONAL STANDARD ORGANISATION A2 SIZE, I.E. 420 MM X 594 MM.

THE POSTER, APART FROM ORIGINALITY, SHOULD CONVEY AN ANTI-NARCOTICS THEME.

ENTRIES SHOULD BE SUBMITTED THROUGH HEADS OF PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS TO THE COMMUNITY YOUTH CLUB SECTION, EDUCATION DEPARTMENT AT 8 YUN PING ROAD, CAROLINE MANSION, 4TH FLOOR, CAUSEWAY BAY, HONG KONG ON OR BEFORE APRIL 30.

ENTRIES TO BOTH COMPETITIONS WILL BE JUDGED BY DIFFERENT PANELS OF ADJUDICATORS AND SCHOOLS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THE RESULTS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE.

FOR BOTH COMPETITIONS, THE FIRST THREE WINNERS WILL BE AWARDED PRIZES VALUED AT \$500, \$300 AND \$200 RESPECTIVELY. THERE WILL ALSO BE 12 MERIT PRIZES FOR EACH SECTION.

IN ADDITION, ALL PARTICIPATING SCHOOLS AND STUDENTS WILL RECEIVE SOUVENIRS.

THE COMMUNITY YOUTH CLUB SECTION HAS ALREADY SENT OUT CIRCULARS CONTAINING REGULATIONS AND OTHER DETAILS OF THE COMPETITIONS AS WELL AS ENTRY FORMS TO SOME 2 000 SCHOOLS. GRAVE VISITORS URGED TO KEEP COUNTRYSIDE CLEAN

PEOPLE GOING TO CEMETERIES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES DURING THE CHING MING FESTIVAL AND EASTER HOLIDAY-MAKERS ARE TODAY URGED TO KEEP THE COUNTRYSIDE CLEAN.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT SAID ENFORCEMENT ACTION AGAINST LITTERBUGS WILL BE STEPPED UP DURING THE HOLIDAY PERIOD IN AN ATTEMPT TO KEEP THE ENVIRONMENT CLEAN.

LITTERING COULD COST A GRAVE VISITOR, A PICNICKER OR A HIKER \$5 000 ON FIRST CONVICTION FOR A LITTER OFFENCE, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

ON THE OTHER HAND, KEEPING THE PUBLIC CEMETERIES AND THE COUNTRYSIDE CLEAN BY MAKING USE OF THE REFUSE BINS OR REFUSE COLLECTION POINTS PROVIDED THERE WOULD COST NOTHING, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+ONE OF THE BEST EFFORTS TO AVOID LITTERING A PUBLIC PLACE IS TO BRING ALONG WITH YOU A PLASTIC BAG FOR DISPOSAL OF LITTER WHILE OUT ON A JOURNEY.

+PLASTIC BAGS ARE BETTER THAN PAPER BAGS BECAUSE THEY ARE LESS LIKELY TO TEAR OR LEAK.+

TO REMIND THE PUBLIC OF THE NEED OF KEEPING THE COUNTRYSIDE CLEAN, A NUMBER OF WARNING BOARDS ARE BEING PUT UP IN THE RURAL AREAS AND ON OUTLYING ISLANDS.

+KEEP THE PICNIC SPOT CLEAN AND HAVE A NICE DAY+ IS THE MESSAGE WHICH THE DEPARTMENT IS TRYING TO GET ACROSS AND WHICH COINCIDES WITH THE CURRENT CLEAN HONG KONG CAMPAIGN, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

INLAND REVENUE ISSUES REMINDER

THE INLAND REVENUE DEPARTMENT TODAY (SATURDAY) REMINDED MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AND EMPLOYERS OF THEIR OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE INLAND REVENUE ORDINANCE.

A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID THAT UNDER THE ORDINANCE, EVERY PERSON CHARGEABLE TO TAX FOR ANY YEAR OF ASSESSMENT MUST NOTIFY THE COMMISSIONER OF INLAND REVENUE IN WRITING NOT LATER THAN FOUR MONTHS AFTER THE END OF THE BASIS PERIOD FOR THE YEAR IN WHICH HE IS SO CHARGEABLE UNLESS HE HAS ALREADY BEEN REQUIRED TO FURNISH A RETURN FOR THAT YEAR.

THE SPOKESMAN ALSO POINTED OUT THAT ANY PERSON WHO CEASES TO CARRY OUT A TRADE, PROFESSION OR BUSINESS- TO HOLD AN OFFICE OR EMPLOYMENT IN RESPECT OF WHICH SALARIES TAX IS CHARGEABLE- OR TO HAVE A SOURCE OF INCOME IN RESPECT OF WHICH HE IS PERSONALLY ASSESSED, MUST ADVISE THE COMMISSIONER IN WRITING WITHIN ONE MONTH OF SUCH CESSATION.

ANY PERSON CHARGEABLE TO SALARIES, PROFITS OR PERSONAL TAX AND IS ABOUT TO LEAVE HONG KONG FOR MORE THAN ONE MONTH MUST NOTIFY THE COMMISSIONER IN WRITING AT LEAST ONE MONTH BEFORE HIS DEPARTURE, HE SAID.

+THIS DOES NOT APPLY TO PERSONS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO LEAVE HONG KONG FREQUENTLY IN THE COURSE OF BUSINESS OR EMPLOYMENT,+ THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

HE ALSO REMINDED TAXPAYERS WHO HAVE CHANGED THEIR ADDRESS TO NOTIFY THE COMMISSIONER IN WRITING OF THE PARTICULARS OF THE CHANGE.

EMPLOYERS ARE ALSO REMINDED THAT THEY ARE REQUIRED TO INFORM THE COMMISSIONER IN WRITING OF THE PARTICULARS OF ANY NEW EMPLOYEE LIKELY TO BE CHARGEABLE TO SALARIES TAX WITHIN THREE MONTHS OF HIS EMPLOYMENT.

AN EMPLOYER WHO IS ABOUT TO CEASE TO EMPLOY IN HONG KONG ANY PERSON LIKELY TO BE CHARGEABLE TO SALARIES TAX MUST ADVISE THE COMMISSIONER IN WRITING AT LEAST ONE MONTH BEFORE THE TERMINATION OF SUCH EMPLOYMENT.

IT IS ALSO THE RESPONSIBILITY OF AN EMPLOYER TO NOTIFY THE COMMISSIONER WHENEVER AN EMPLOYEE WHO IS CHARGEABLE TO SALARIES TAX IS ABOUT TO LEAVE HONG KONG FOR MORE THAN A MONTH AT LEAST ONE MONTH BEFORE HIS DEPARTURE.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID WHEN AN EMPLOYER HAS INFORMED THE COMMISSIONER THAT HE IS ABOUT TO CEASE TO EMPLOY A PERSON CHARGEABLE TO SALARIES TAX, HE MUST NOT MAKE ANY PAYMENT TO THAT EMPLOYEE WITHIN A MONTH FROM THE DATE OF GIVING SUCH NOTICE, EXCEPT WITH THE CONSENT IN WRITING OF THE COMMISSIONER.

+THE EMPLOYER MAY HOWEVER, DURING THAT MONTH PAY TO THE COMMISSIONER OUT OF MONEYS DUE TO THE EMPLOYEE SUCH SUM AS THE EMPLOYEE MAY DIRECT HIM TO PAY.+

FORMS FOR GIVING SUCH NOTICES MAY BE OBTAINED AT THE INLAND REVENUE DEPARTMENT'S OFFICE ON THE EIGHTH FLOOR, WINDSOR HOUSE, 311 GLOUCESTER ROAD, CAUSEWAY BAY, HONG KONG.

- \* PEEL RISE, FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH ABERDEEN RESERVOIR ROAD TO A POINT BEYOND THE WESTERN LIMIT OF ABERDEEN CEMETERY;
- \* MOUNT AUSTIN ROAD, EXCEPT FOR VEHICLES REQUIRING ACCESS TO PREMISES ON THIS ROAD; AND
