LARGE-SCALE SURVEY ON CONSTRUCTION NOISE

* * * *

THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY IS COMPLETING ITS COMPILATION OF PRELIMINARY FINDINGS OF A LARGE-SCALE SURVEY ON HOW TO CONTROL THE CONSTRUCTION NOISE PROBLEM IN HONG KONG.

THE FINDINGS ARE INTENDED FOR USE IN DEVELOPING GUIDELINES BY THE AUTHORITIES IN AMENDING EXISTING NOISE CONTROL LEGISLATION AND DRAFTING NEW ONES.

THE AMENDMENTS AND NEW CONTROLS WOULD THEN BE INCORPORATED IN A NEW NOISE CONTROL BILL.

THE SURVEY, THE LARGEST OF ITS KIND IN HONG KONG, IS BEING UNDERTAKEN BY THE SURVEY SECTION OF THE NOISE AND VIBRATION GROUP, EPA.

DR ANDREW KWAN, SENIOR ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION OFFICER WHO HEADS THE SECTION, SAID THE SURVEY BEGAN IN SEPTEMBER 1981 WITH THE ESTABLISHMENT OF HIS UNIT AND WOULD CONTINUE IN THE YEARS TO COME AS PART OF THE GOVERNMENT'S ONGOING EFFORT TO IMPROVE THE LIVING ENVIRONMENT.

DR KWAN POINTED OUT THAT A SURVEY CONDUCTED LAST YEAR INDICATED THAT PEOPLE IN HONG KONG CONSIDERED ENVIRONMENTAL POLLUTION A SERIOUS PROBLEM.

AIR AND NOISE POLLUTION, IN PARTICULAR, DREW MUCH PUBLIC CONCERN, HE ADDED.

THE SOUND LEVEL OF THE AVERAGE BEDROOM IN SOME MORE NOISY LOCATIONS IN HONG KONG CAN BE AROUND 60 DB(A) -- AN AUDIO-MEASURING UNIT -- WHICH HE CONSIDERED TO BE ON THE HIGH SIDE.

AN INCREASE OF EVERY 10 DB(A) MEANS THAT THE NOISE HAS DOUBLED, HE EXPLAINED.

AS AN EXAMPLE, HE SAID THAT ON A BUSY STREET WITH 80 DB(A) PEOPLE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO HEAR EACH OTHER.

AMONG THE FIRST PROBLEMS COVERED BY THE SURVEY IS PILING AT CONSTRUCTION SITES WHICH DR KWAN DESCRIBED AS +UNQUESTIONABLY THE MOST INTRUSIVE AND PREVALENT NOISE SOURCE+ IN HONG KONG.

HE CONCEDED THAT THIS WAS A DIFFICULT PROBLEM BECAUSE OF THE TERRITORY'S SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

+HONG KONG IS A HIGHRISE CITY DUE TO LAND SHORTAGE. MANY BUILDINGS HAVE TO BE CONSTRUCTED ON RECLAIMED LAND OR SITES CARVED OUT OF HILLS SO THAT CONSIDERABLE PILING IS REQUIRED TO STRENGTHEN THE FOUNDATION FOR THE HEAVY LOADING,+ HE SAID.

THE INVESTIGATION COVERS NOISE CAUSED BY PILING AND ROCK-BREAKING EQUIPMENT AS WELL AS TECHNIQUES COMMONLY USED IN HONG KONG, +SILENCED+ PILING DEVELOPED IN OTHER COUNTRIES AND POSSIBLE CONTROLS.

ONE POSSIBILITY WOULD BE TO SET A MAXIMUM NOISE CRITERION AND PRESCRIBE THE USE OF DIFFERENT PILING METHODS DEPENDING ON THE DISTANCE BETWEEN THE SITE AND THE NEAREST BUILDING, PARTICULARLY A NOISE-SENSITIVE RESIDENTIAL BLOCK, DR KWAN SAID.

GIVING AN ACCOUNT OF THE INDIVIDUAL SURVEY PROJECTS CARRIED OUT SO FAR, DR KWAN SAID THEY BEGAN WITH TWO STUDIES TO DETERMINE THE SOUND RATING OF DIFFERENT PILING AND EARTH-BREAKING TECHNIQUES.

THIS WAS FOLLOWED BY CONSULTATION WITH GOVERNMENT DEPARTMENTS INVOLVED IN PUBLIC WORKS, INCLUDING THE BUILDING ORDINANCE OFFICE, THE ENGINEERING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT, THE BUILDING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT'S ARCHITECTURAL OFFICE AND THE HOUSING DEPARTMENT.

OPINION WAS SOUGHT FROM PROFESSIONALS, SUCH AS EQUIPMENT SUPPLIERS, PILING CONTRACTORS, ARCHITECTS AND STRUCTURAL ENGINEERS.

INFORMATION HAS ALSO BEEN GATHERED FROM OVERSEAS MANUFACTURERS OF LOW-NOISE PILING MACHINES.

IN ADDITION, STUDIES HAVE BEEN CONDUCTED AT MORE THAN 150 CONSTRUCTION SITES TO DETERMINE THEIR NOISE IMPACT ON RESIDENTS IN NEIGHBOURHOOD BUILDINGS.

THE SECTION IS NOW ASSESSING THE RESULTS OF ALL THESE PROJECTS AND WILL COMPILE IN-DEPTH TECHNICAL REPORTS.

+AS WE GO ALONG, WE WILL ATTEMPT TO SURVEY THE WHOLE SPECTRUM OF CONSTRUCTION NOISES,+ HE SAID.

CURRENTLY, PILING NOISE IS CONTROLLED BY THE SUMMARY OFFENCES ORDINANCE WHICH BANS PILING WORK FROM 7 PM TO 7 AM ON WEEKDAYS AND ROUND-THE-CLOCK ON PUBLIC HOLIDAYS. THE ORDINANCE ALSO REGULATES THE ISSUE OF PERMITS UNDER SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES.

PEAK ROAD TO FULLY OPEN BY LUNAR NEW YEAR

THE SECTION OF PEAK ROAD WHICH DISAPPEARED IN A LANDSLIDE IN JUNE FOLLOWING A MASSIVE DOWNPOUR SHOULD BE FULLY RESTORED TO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC BY LUNAR NEW YEAR.

THIS WAS SAID TODAY (TUESDAY) BY A SPOKESMAN FOR THE HIGHWAYS OFFICE, WHO EXPLAINED THAT THE MOST DIFFICULT PART OF THE PROJECT HAD ALREADY BEEN COMPLETED.

THIS INVOLVED HAND DIGGING 15 CAISSONS, SOME OF WHICH WERE OVER 37 METRES LONG. GOOD ROCK FOUNDATION TURNED OUT TO BE DEEPER THAN ANTICIPATED, DESPITE SITE INVESTIGATION, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

TRAFFIC FLOW HAS BEEN MAINTAINED IN THE AREA THROUGH USE OF A TEMPORARLY SINGLE-LANE STEEL BRIDGE WHICH WAS PUT INTO PLACE WITHIN A WEEK OF THE LANDSLIDE OCCURRING. IT HAS BEEN TWO-WAY, LIGHT CONTROLLED AND THERE HAVE HAD TO BE SOME DIVERSIONS IN THE AREA.

THIS ARRANGEMENTS CONTINUED UNTIL YESTERDAY WHEN THE NEWLY-CONSTRUCTED, SINGLE-LANE BRIDGE DECK OPENED IN THE EARLY HOURS. TRAFFIC WAS DIVERTED ON TO IT AND THE TEMPORARY BRIDGE DEMOLISHED.

THE PERMANENT STRUCTURE TO BE PUT IN ITS PLACE IS A RELATIVELY SIMPLE PART OF THE PROJECT, THE SPOKESMAN SAID.

+WE HAVE EVERY CONFIDENCE THAT A FULL OPENING SHOULD BE POSSIBLE IN TIME FOR THE CHINESE NEW YEAR HOLIDAY AT THE BEGINNING OF FEBRUARY WITH THE REMOVAL OF THE TRAFFIC LIGHTS,+ HE ADDED.

THE NEW BRIDGE DECK, TOGETHER WITH LINKING BEAMS, WAS CAST UNDERNEATH THE TEMPORARY BRIDGE AND HAS BEEN LAID AT APPROXIMATELY THE SAME LEVEL AS THE ORIGINAL ROAD.

THE TOTAL COST OF THE WORK WILL BE \$7.5 MILLION. THE PROJECT USED A TOTAL OF 450 METRES OF 1 800 MILLIMETRE DIAMETER CAISSON, WHICH HAD BEEN REINFORCED AND CONCRETED BY THE MIDDLE OF LAST MONTH.

SUPPORT FOR +CLEAN AND GREEN+ URGED

SCHOOL CHILDREN IN THE NEW TERRITORIES WERE URGED TO PLAY AN ACTIVE ROLE IN SUPPORTING THE CLEAN AND GREEN HONG KONG CAMPAIGN.

THOUSANDS OF STUDENTS OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS IN THE NEW TERRITORIES AND IN OUTLYING ISLANDS WERE TOLD THAT GOOD HABITS, SUCH AS KEEPING THE LIVING ENVIRONMENT CLEAN AND GREEN, ARE BEST CULTIVATED FROM THE EARLIEST AGE IN THE HOME AND SCHOOL.

THE MESSAGE WAS BROUGHT TO THEM BY VISITING HEALTH INSPECTORS OF THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT WHO HAVE BEEN CALLING AT SCHOOLS SINCE EARLY THIS YEAR.

AIMED AT STIMULATING INTEREST AND AWARENESS AMONG THE YOUNGER GENERATION OF ENVIRONMENTAL HYGIENE, THE EDUCATION CAMPAIGN CONTINUED THROUGHOUT THE YEAR.

WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF PRINCIPALS OF PRIMARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOLS, INCLUDING THOSE IN REMOTE AREAS, MORE THAN 300 TALKS HAVE BEEN GIVEN SINCE EARLY THIS YEAR.

HE ALSO LISTED SOME POSSIBLE MEASURES:

- * KEEPING IRON GATES AT THE MAIN ENTRANCES OF BUILDINGS PROPERLY LOCKED AND ADMISSION CHECKED BY CARETAKERS IF POSSIBLE;
- * INSTALLATION OF SAFETY MIRRORS AT CORNER AREAS TO ENSURE VISIBILITY OF THE OTHER SIDE OF THE CORRIDOR;
- * INSTALLATION OF CLOSE CIRCUIT TELEVISION IN THE LIFT LOBBY SO THAT RESIDENTS CAN CHECK FROM THEIR OWN TV SET AT HOME THE SITUATION IN THE LIFT LOBBY BEFORE COMING DOWN; AND
- * FOR BUILDINGS WITH DOOR PHONES, RESIDENTS CAN MAKE IT A PRACTICE TO CALL THEIR FAMILIES UPSTAIRS, SIGNALLING THEIR SAFE DEPARTURE FROM THE BUILDING.

THE SPOKESMAN ADDED THAT WHERE POSSIBLE CARETAKERS OR WATCHMEN SHOULD BE PROVIDED WITH A SECURED OFFICE WITH AN ALARM CONNECTED FROM THE OFFICE TO THE OUTSIDE ENTRANCE OF THE BUILDING.

HE ALSO SAID THAT MANY BURGLARIES WERE THE RESULTS OF CARELESSNESS ON THE PART OF THE PEOPLE THEMSELVES.

+THE SOLUTION IS, THEREFORE, OBVIOUS,+ HE ADDED.

HE STRESSED THAT TIMELY REPORTS OF CRIMES WOULD ENABLE THE POLICE TO TAKE PROMPT ACTION AGAINST OFFENDERS.

HE URGED THE PUBLIC TO HELP FIGHT CRIME AND REPORT TO THE POLICE ANY SUSPICIOUS ACTS OR PERSONS BY DIALLING 999 OR THE POLICE HOTLINE 5-277177.

+PEOPLE ARE AFRAID TO REPORT MINOR CRIMES IN PROGRESS, FEARING THAT IT MIGHT CAUSE THEM INCONVENIENCE, ESPECIALLY WHEN THEY ARE UNCERTAIN WHETHER OR NOT THE CASE IS A GENUINE ONE,+ HE SAID.

+THE PUBLIC MAY REST ASSURED THAT ANY MISJUDGEMENT ON THEIR PART IN THE USE OF THE 999 FACILITY WOULD NOT RENDER THEM LIABLE TO PROSECUTION, SO LONG AS THE REPORT IS MADE IN GOOD FAITH.+

THE 999 FACILITY IS BASICALLY FOR USE BY MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC SEEKING URGENT POLICE ASSISTANCE, HE SAID.

HOWEVER, HE SAID THAT IN LESS URGENT MATTERS, THEY SHOULD DIAL THE POLICE HOTLINE OR THE LOCAL POLICE STATION.

'CORRIDOR' FIRST SECTION OPENING MID-1984

* * * * *

THE FIRST SECTION OF ISLAND EASTERN CORRIDOR, ONE OF HONG KONG'S MOST AMBITIOUS ROAD PROJECTS, IS EXPECTED TO OPEN IN THE MIDDLE OF NEXT YEAR.

ANNOUNCING THIS TODAY (TUESDAY), A SPOKESMAN FOR THE HIGHWAYS OFFICE OF THE ENGINEERING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT SAID THE SECTION, STRETCHING FROM CAUSEWAY BAY TO TAIKOO SHING, COVERS STAGE I AND PART OF STAGE II OF THE PROJECT.

WORK ON THIS SECTION IS PROGRESSING SATISFACTORILY AND IS NOW OVER 85 PER CENT COMPLETE.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID PILING AND SUB-STRUCTURE WORKS HAS BEEN FINISHED AND CASTING OF THE BRIDGE DECKS IS NEARLY COMPLETE.

+WE ARE NOW CONCENTRATING ON THE SLIP ROADS CONNECTING TO THE EXISTING ROADS AT DIFFERENT JUNCTIONS - AT VICTORIA PARK ROAD, TONG SHUI ROAD, HEALTHY STREET EAST AND TAIKOO SHING,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID WITH THE OPENING OF THIS SECTION TRAFFIC CONGESTION IN KING'S ROAD BETWEEN TAIKOO SHING AND CAUSEWAY BAY SHOULD EASE, ESPECIALLY DURING PEAK HOURS.

+WORK ON PHASE II OF STAGE II OF THE PROJECT, RUNNING FROM TAIKOO SHING TO SHAU KEI WAN, IS ALSO PROGRESSING SMOOTHLY AND WILL BE COMPLETED TOWARDS THE END OF 1985,+ HE SAID.

REFERRING TO STAGE III OF THE CORRIDOR - FROM SHAU KEI WAN TO CHAI WAN - THE SPOKESMAN SAID WORK HAS ALREADY COMMENCED FROM THE CHAI WAN END.

THE HIGHWAYS OFFICE AWARDED A \$41.8 MILLION CONTRACT IN THE MIDDLE OF LAST MONTH FOR CONSTRUCTION OF AN 800-METRE DUAL TWO-LANE CARRIAGEWAY BETWEEN WING TAI INTERCHANGE AND CHAI WAN ROUNDABOUT, AS PART OF STAGE III.

THIS CONTRACT ALSO INCLUDES AN EXTENSION TO WING TAI ROAD AND IMPROVEMENTS TO CHAI WAN ROUNDABOUT.

THREE FOOTBRIDGES WILL BE CONSTRUCTED ACROSS THIS SECTION OF THE CORRIDOR, ONE NEAR HING WAH TSUEN AND TWO AT CHAI WAN ROUNDABOUT TO PROVIDE SAFECROSSINGS FOR PEDESTRIANS.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID CONSTRUCTION OF THE FINAL SECTION OF ISLAND EASTERN CORRIDOR FROM WING TAI ROAD TO SHAU KEI WAN WOULD START AT A LATER DATE AND COMPLETION IN 1987 WAS PLANNED.

RABIES GUARD MUST BE RENEWED

* * *

SINCE THE LAST MAJOR RABIES OUTBREAK AT THE END OF 1980 MANY THOUSANDS OF DOGS HAVE BEEN INOCULATED AGAINST THE FATAL DISEASE.

BUT A SPOKESMAN FOR THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY: +THE INOCULATION PERIOD IS GOOD FOR THREE YEARS - AND AFTER THEN THE DOG MUST BE RE-INOCULATED.+

HE ADDED THAT ALL DOGS WHICH WERE INOCULATED IN LATE 1980 AND EARLY 1981 ARE NOW DUE FOR RE-INOCULATION.

INFORMATION LEAFLETS ABOUT THE DISEASE, AND A LIST OF ABOUT 25 INOCULATION CENTRES, ARE AVAILABLE FROM DISTRICT OFFICES, MUTUAL AID COMMITTEES, THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT AND LEADING PET SHOPS.

THE INOCULATIONS, GIVEN BY THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT, ARE FREE AND AT THE TIME OF INOCULATION DOG OWNERS ARE PRESENTED WITH A DOG LICENCE WHICH IS VALID FOR THREE YEARS.

THE MAXIMUM PENALTY FOR NOT HAVING A VALID DOG LICENCE IS \$5 000 AND 12 MONTHS IMPRISONMENT.

SURVEY OF ECONOMY STARTING SOON

THE CENSUS AND STATISTICS DEPARTMENT WILL NEXT MONTH BE CONDUCTING A SURVEY OF EMPLOYMENT, VACANCIES AND PAYROLL IN MAJOR SECTORS OF THE ECONOMY.

THE SURVEY RESULTS ARE USEFUL IN PROVIDING SHORT-TERM ECONOMIC INDICATORS AS WELL AS INFORMATION ON STRUCTURAL CHANGES IN THE LABOUR MARKET IN HONG KONG, A SPOKESMAN FOR THE DEPARTMENT SAID TODAY.

THE SURVEY COVERS ABOUT 48 000 ESTABLISHMENTS DRAWN FROM VARIOUS SECTORS, INCLUDING THE DISTRIBUTIVE TRADES SECTOR (WHOLESALE, RETAIL, IMPORT AND EXPORT, RESTAURANTS AND HOTELS), THE SERVICES SECTOR (TRANSPORT, STORAGE AND COMMUNICATION; FINANCING, INSURANCE, REAL ESTATE AND BUSINESS SERVICES; COMMUNITY, SOCIAL AND PERSONAL SERVICES) AND THE INDUSTRIAL SECTOR (MINING AND QUARRYING; MANUFACTURING; ELECTRICITY AND GAS).

INFORMATION ON THE NUMBER OF PERSONS ENGAGED AND EXISTING VACANCIES ON DECEMBER 30 WILL BE SOUGHT FROM EACH ESTABLISHMENT.
