DUKE OF EDINBURGH TO VISIT HK

HIS ROYAL HIGHNESS, THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH, INTERNATIONAL PRESIDENT OF WORLD WIDE FUND FOR NATURE AND PATRON AND TRUSTEE OF THE DUKE OF EDINBURGH'S AWARD SCHEME, WILL VISIT HONG KONG, JAPAN AND AUSTRALIA FROM NOVEMBER 15 TO 30 THIS YEAR, BUCKINGHAM PALACE HAS ANNOUNCED.

ACTING GOVERNOR VISITS LEADING PHOTO/OPTICAL EQUIPMENT MANUFACTURER

THE ACTING GOVERNOR, SIR DAVID FORD, TODAY (THURSDAY) VISITED ONE OF THE WORLD'S LEADING MANUFACTURERS OF PHOTOGRAPHIC AND OPTICAL EQUIPMENT.

SIR DAVID WAS MET ON ARRIVAL AT THE W. HAKING INDUSTRIES LIMITED FACTORY IN NORTH POINT BY THE COMPANY'S SENIOR MANAGEMENT STAFF, INCLUDING THE CO-FOUNDERS, DR HAKING WONG, GROUP CHAIRMAN; DR PAULINE CHAN, GOVERNING DIRECTOR AND CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER; AND MR HERBERT WONG, MANAGING DIRECTOR.

SIR DAVID WAS BRIEFED ON THE OPERATION OF THE FACTORY, WHICH WAS THE FIRST TO INTRODUCE PRECISION ENGINEERING TO HONG KONG WHEN IT STARTED MANUFACTURING OPTICAL GOODS, INCLUDING CAMERAS AND BINOCULARS, IN 1956.

THE COMPANY HAS SINCE EXPANDED INTO A NETWORK OF EIGHT-BRANCH FACTORIES IN HONG KONG AND FIVE OTHER PRODUCTION FACILITIES IN THAILAND, TAIWAN AND MACAU.

IT ALSO MAINTAINS CENTRES FOR DESIGN, RESEARCH AND DEVELOPMENT, AND DISTRIBUTION IN VARIOUS PARTS OF THE WORLD, INCLUDING THE UNITED STATES. IT EMPLOYS MORE THAN 5,200 PEOPLE WORLDWIDE.

THE MANAGEMENT EXPLAINED TO SIR DAVID DURING HIS TWO-HOUR VISIT THE FUNCTIONS OF SOME SOPHISTICATED MACHINERY USED.

THE HAKING GROUP OF FACTORIES HAS A DAILY PRODUCTION CAPACITY OF 30,000 CAMERAS AND 5,000 PAIRS OF BINOCULARS. IT HAS WON NUMEROUS AWARDS IN INDUSTRIAL PRODUCTS COMPETITIONS.

HONG KONG'S PHOTOGRAPHIC GOODS INDUSTRY MAINLY PRODUCES STILL CAMERAS, FLASHLIGHTS, CINEMATOGRAPHIC EQUIPMENT, SLIDE VIEWERS AND PROJECTORS.

THE NUMBER OF PHOTOGRAPHIC GOODS MANUFACTURERS IN HONG KONG HAS RISEN FROM 17 IN 1975 TO 58 IN 1988. DURING THE SAME PERIOD, THE NUMBER OF PEOPLE ENGAGED IN THE INDUSTRY HAS INCREASED FROM 2,863 TO 7,400.

SIR EDWARD YOUDE MEMORIAL FELLOWSHIPS AND SCHOLARSHIPS

* * * * *

THE SIR EDWARD YOUDE MEMORIAL FUND COUNCIL ANNOUNCED TODAY (THURSDAY) THAT ITS FELLOWSHIPS AND SCHOLARSHIPS FOR OVERSEAS STUDIES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 1991-92 ARE NOW OPEN FOR APPLICATION.

THE FELLOWSHIPS AND SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AIMED AT ENCOURAGING THE BEST STUDENTS TO PURSUE FURTHER EDUCATION IN REPUTABLE INSTITUTIONS OVERSEAS.

SUCCESSFUL CANDIDATES FOR THE AWARDS ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE A STRONG SENSE OF COMMITMENT TO HONG KONG AND BE READY TO CONTRIBUTE SIGNIFICANTLY TO THE COMMUNITY UPON RETURN FROM THEIR OVERSEAS STUDIES. THEY WILL BE REQUIRED TO SERVE IN HONG KONG FOR AT LEAST THREE YEARS UPON GRADUATION.

THE FELLOWSHIPS ARE FOR STUDIES LEADING TO POSTGRADUATE DEGREES EITHER BY RESEARCH OR BY COURSEWORK; THE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE FOR UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES LEADING TO FIRST DEGREES.

THE APPLICANTS WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR FULFILLING ALL APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS OF THE ACADEMIC INSTITUTIONS OF THEIR CHOICE, AND BE OFFERED A PLACE SUBSEQUENTLY.

THE VALUE FOR THE FELLOWSHIP IS AT PRESENT \$135,000 PER YEAR FOR UP TO TWO YEARS; THE VALUE FOR SCHOLARSHIPS \$120,000 PER YEAR UP TO THREE YEARS.

THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT TODAY (THURSDAY) ADVISED STUDENTS SEEKING ENTRY TO BRITISH UNIVERSITIES IN 1991 TO APPLY ONE YEAR IN ADVANCE THROUGH THE UNIVERSITIES CENTRAL COUNCIL ON ADMISSIONS (UCCA) IN BRITAIN.

FOR THOSE APPLYING FOR PLACES IN OXFORD OR CAMBRIDGE UNIVERSITY, THEY SHOULD RETURN THE COMPLETED APPLICATION FORMS AND A FEE OF SIX POUNDS STERLING TO UCCA BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 1 AND OCTOBER 15 THIS YEAR, A SPOKESMAN SAID.

APPLICATIONS FOR ALL OTHER BRITISH UNIVERSITIES WILL CLOSE ON DECEMBER 15.

APPLICATION FORMS ARE NOW AVAILABLE AT THE EDUCATION DEPARTMENT'S OVERSEAS STUDENTS AND SCHOLARSHIPS SECTION ON THE FIFTH FLOOR, LEE GARDENS, HYSAN AVENUE, CAUSEWAY BAY.

MEANWHILE, APPLICATIONS FOR ADMISSION TO THE FIRST-YEAR FIRST-DEGREE, DIPLOMA OF HIGHER EDUCATION AND HIGHER NATIONAL DIPLOMA COURSES AT ALL UK POLYTECHNICS AND CERTAIN COLLEGES AND INSTITUTES OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHOULD BE MADE THROUGH THE POLYTECHNICS CENTRAL ADMISSION SYSTEM (PCAS).

COMPLETED FORMS AND A SIX-POUND STERLING FEE MUST REACH PCAS BETWEEN SEPTEMBER 1 AND DECEMBER 15 THIS YEAR.

HK TO TAKE PART IN WORLD STAMP EXHIBITION

* * * * *

THE POST OFFICE WILL PARTICIPATE IN AN INTERNATIONAL STAMP EXHIBITION TO BE HELD IN AUCKLAND, NEW ZEALAND FROM AUGUST 24 TO SEPTEMBER 2, THE ACTING POSTMASTER GENERAL, MISS ELLE SHUM, ANNOUNCED TODAY (THURSDAY).

THE WORLD STAMP EXHIBITION NEW ZEALAND 1990 IS THE FIRST INTERNATIONAL STAMP EXHIBITION UNDER INTERNATIONAL PHILATELIC FEDERATION PATRONAGE TO BE HELD IN NEW ZEALAND.

IT IS HELD TO COMMEMORATE THE SIGNING OF THE TREATY OF WAITANGI IN 1840 -- WHICH IS OF HISTORICAL IMPORTANCE TO NEW ZEALAND AS IT FORESHADOWED THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ORGANISED GOVERNMENT, AND THE 150TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE FIRST POSTAGE STAMP.

TO MARK THE OCCASION, THE FOLLOWING PHILATELIC PRODUCTS AND SERVICES WILL BE INTRODUCED ON AUGUST 24.

DEFINITIVE STAMP SHEETLET

A DEFINITIVE STAMP SHEETLET INCORPORATING A \$10 DEFINITIVE STAMP WILL BE RELEASED. THE DESIGN OF THE SHEETLET FEATURES THE CONTAINER TERMINAL AT KWAI CHUNG AND THE LOGO OF THE EXHIBITION.

THE LOGO OF THE EXHIBITION FEATURED ON THE SHEETLET IS BASED ON THE OBLITERATING HANDSTAMPS SUPPLIED FROM ENGLAND IN 1855 FOR USE ON NEW ZEALAND'S FIRST STAMPS.

THESE SHEETLETS WILL BE AVAILABLE AT \$10 EACH.

SOUVENIR COVER

SOUVENIR COVERS ESPECIALLY DESIGNED FOR THE EXHIBITION WILL BE AVAILABLE AT 70 CENTS EACH. SOUVENIR COVERS, AFFIXED WITH A DEFINITIVE STAMP SHEETLET AND CANCELLED WITH A SPECIAL DATESTAMP, WILL BE AVAILABLE AT \$12.20 EACH.

HAND-BACK SERVICE AND PICTORIAL DATESTAMP

HAND-BACK SERVICE WILL BE PROVIDED AT THE PHILATELIC OFFICES ON AUGUST 24 FOR OFFICIAL AND PRIVATELY-MADE SOUVENIR COVERS TO COMMEMORATE HONG KONG'S PARTICIPATION IN THE EXHIBITION.

A PICTORIAL DATESTAMP WILL BE INTRODUCED FOR THE HAND-BACK SERVICE. IN ADDITION, A CACHET WILL ALSO BE INTRODUCED FOR GENERAL CANCELLATION PURPOSES.

THE ABOVE PRODUCTS AND SERVICES WILL BE AVAILABLE AT THE FOLLOWING SEVEN PHILATELIC OFFICES: THE AIRPORT POST OFFICE, BEACONSFIELD HOUSE POST OFFICE, GENERAL POST OFFICE, GRANVILLE ROAD POST OFFICE, PEAK POST OFFICE, SHA TIN CENTRAL POST OFFICE AND TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE.

ALL POST OFFICES, EXCEPT THE GENERAL POST OFFICE AND THE TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE, WILL BE CLOSED DURING THE HOLIDAY PERIOD FROM AUGUST 25 TO 27, THE ACTING POSTMASTER GENERAL, MISS ELLE SHUM, ANNOUNCED TODAY (THURSDAY).

THE GENERAL POST OFFICE AND THE TSIM SHA TSUI POST OFFICE WILL BE OPEN FROM 9 AM TO NOON ON AUGUST 25.

LETTERS WILL ONLY BE DELIVERED ON AUGUST 25.

PEOPLE OBSTRUCTING BUILDING ESCAPE ROUTE LIABLE TO PROSECUTION

* * * * *

PEOPLE ARE LIABLE TO PROSECUTION IF THEY PLACE ANYTHING TO OBSTRUCT THE MEANS OF ESCAPE OF A BUILDING, A FIRE SERVICES DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID TODAY (THURSDAY).

THE REMINDER CAME AFTER A RECENT COURT CASE IN WHICH A FACTORY OWNER WAS FINED \$10,000 BY A TSUEN WAN MAGISTRATE FOR OBSTRUCTING THE MEANS OF ESCAPE IN A KWAI CHUNG INDUSTRIAL BUILDING.

FIRE SERVICES STAFF INSPECTED THE BUILDING IN FEBRUARY THIS YEAR AND FOUND A NUMBER OF ARTICLES WHICH BELONGED TO A FACTORY ON THE 22ND FLOOR LIFT LOBBY OBSTRUCTING THE MEANS OF ESCAPE.

IN SUBSEQUENT FIRE HAZARD INVESTIGATION, THE FACTORY OWNER REFUSED TO CO-OPERATE AND OBSTRUCTED THE FIRE SERVICES STAFF IN THEIR DISCHARGE OF DUTIES.

THE FACTORY OWNER WAS THUS BROUGHT TO TSUEN WAN MAGISTRACY ON MONDAY (AUGUST 13) ON TWO CHARGES. HE PLEADED GUILTY TO THE CHARGE OF CREATING A FIRE HAZARD AND WAS FINED \$10,000.

HOWEVER, THE DEFENDANT PLEADED NOT GUILTY TO ANOTHER CHARGE OF OBSTRUCTING MEMBERS OF THE FIRE SERVICES ACTING IN THE EXECUTION OF THEIR DUTY.

AFTER THE COURT HEARING, THE DEFENDANT WAS BOUNDED OVER FOR A PERIOD OF 12 MONTHS WITH A SURETY OF \$2,000.

THE SPOKESMAN SAID UNDER SECTION 27(1) OF THE FIRE SERVICES ORDINANCE (CAP. 95), ANY PERSON WHO RESISTS OR OBSTRUCTS ANY MEMBER OF THE DEPARTMENT ACTING IN THE EXECUTION OF HIS DUTY SHALL BE GUILTY OF AN OFFENCE AND SHALL BE LIABLE TO A FINE OF \$2,000 AND TO IMPRISONMENT FOR SIX MONTHS.

FIVE OVERSTAYERS ARRESTED

IMMIGRATION INVESTIGATORS, ACTING ON INFORMATION ARRESTED FIVE OVERSTAYERS FROM CHINA TODAY (THURSDAY).

THE OVERSTAYERS, WHO HELD TWO-WAY PERMITS, WERE APPREHENDED AT A GARMENT FACTORY IN KWUN TONG. THEY ARE SUSPECTED TO HAVE TAKEN UP UNAPPROVED EMPLOYMENT IN THE FACTORY.

THE GROUP CONSISTED OF FOUR WOMEN, AGED 20 TO 26, AND A 18-YEAR-OLD MAN. THEY HAVE OVERSTAYED FOR ABOUT ONE TO FIVE MONTHS IN HONG KONG.

THE FACTORY MANAGER AND ANOTHER HONG KONG RESIDENT ARE ASSISTING WITH INVESTIGATIONS.

AN IMMIGRATION DEPARTMENT SPOKESMAN SAID THOSE WHO HAVE BREACHED THEIR CONDITION OF STAY IN HONG KONG ARE LIABLE TO PROSECUTION AND UPON CONVICTION TO A FINE OF \$5,000 AND IMPRISONMENT FOR TWO YEARS. THOSE WHO AID AND ABET THESE PEOPLE TO COMMIT THE OFFENCES ARE ALSO LIABLE TO PROSECUTION.

PLB URBAN CLEARWAYS IN WAN CHAI

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT FROM 10 AM ON SATURDAY (AUGUST 18), THE FOLLOWING SECTIONS OF ROADS WILL BE DESIGNATED URBAN CLEARWAYS FOR PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES FROM 7 AM TO MIDNIGHT DAILY:

- * THE SECTION OF THE NORTHERN KERBSIDE LANE OF LOCKHART ROAD FROM A POINT ABOUT 15 METRES WEST OF ITS JUNCTION WITH CANAL ROAD WEST TO A POINT ABOUT 33 METRES EASTWARD; AND
- * THE SECTION OF CANAL ROAD WEST FROM ITS JUNCTION WITH LOCKHART ROAD TO A POINT ABOUT FIVE METRES NORTH OF THE SAME JUNCTION.

WITHIN THE RESTRICTED AREAS, ALL PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES, EXCEPT THOSE WITH PERMITS ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM STOPPING FOR PASSENGERS AND GOODS.

TRAFFIC ARRANGEMENTS IN SOUTHERN DISTRICT

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT FROM 10 AM ON SATURDAY (AUGUST 18), THE CARPARK ON THE EASTERN KERBSIDE OF ISLAND ROAD, ADJACENT TO THE SOUTHERN END OF DEEP WATER BAY GOLF COURSE, WILL BE DESIGNATED A BAN ZONE TO PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES AND GOODS VEHICLES.

ALL PUBLIC LIGHT BUSES AND GOODS VEHICLES, EXCEPT THOSE WITH PERMITS ISSUED BY THE COMMISSIONER FOR TRANSPORT, WILL BE PROHIBITED FROM ENTERING THE CARPARK 24 HOURS DAILY.

AT THE SAME TIME, THE SECTION OF CHI FU ROAD BETWEEN A POINT ABOUT 10 METRES EAST OF ITS JUNCTION WITH THE ENTRANCE TO CHI FU FA YUEN BUS TERMINUS AND A POINT ABOUT 110 METRES WEST OF THE SAME JUNCTION WILL BE DESIGNATED AN URBAN CLEARWAY FROM 7 AM TO 10 AM AND FROM 4 PM TO 7 PM DAILY.

NO VEHICLES EXCEPT FRANCHISED BUSES WILL BE ALLOWED TO STOP FOR PASSENGERS OR GOODS THERE.

TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE IN TAI KOK TSUI

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT THE SECTION OF WONG TAI STREET FROM NO. 44 TO ITS JUNCTION WITH IVY STREET, IN TAI KOK TSUI, WILL CONTINUE TO BE CLOSED TO TRAFFIC UNTIL MONDAY (AUGUST 20) TO FACILITATE URGENT ROAD WORKS.

DURING THE CLOSURE, VEHICLES ON IVY STREET CANNOT TURN RIGHT ONTO WONG TAI STREET, WHILE THE SECTIONS OF TAI TSUN STREET AND IVY STREET BETWEEN WONG TAI STREET AND KOK CHEUNG STREET WILL BE RE-ROUTED INTO TWO-WAY TRAFFIC.

MOTORISTS ON TAI KOK TSUI ROAD NORTHBOUND HEADING FOR WONG TAI STREET TO THE NORTH OF IVY STREET ARE ADVISED TO TRAVEL VIA CHUNG WUI STREET WESTBOUND, KOK CHEUNG STREET SOUTHBOUND AND TAI TSUN STREET WESTBOUND.

THE TRANSPORT DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES THAT SEVERAL SECTIONS OF TOLO HIGHWAY IN TAI PO WILL BE PARTIALLY CLOSED TO FACILITATE ROAD MAINTENANCE WORKS.

A SECTION OF ABOUT 1.3 KILOMETRES OF THE SLOW LANE OF TOLO HIGHWAY NORTHBOUND NEAR ISLAND HOUSE INTERCHANGE WILL BE CLOSED ON SATURDAY (AUGUST 18).

A SECTION OF ABOUT 1.9 KILOMETRES OF THE OUTERMOST LANE OF TOLO HIGHWAY NORTHBOUND NEAR ISLAND HOUSE INTERCHANGE WILL BE CLOSED ON MONDAY AND TUESDAY (AUGUST 20 AND 21).

A SECTION OF ABOUT 1.6 KILOMETRES OF THE OUTERMOST LANE OF TOLO HIGHWAY SOUTHBOUND NEAR ITS JUNCTION WITH TAI PO TAI WO ROAD WILL BE CLOSED ON AUGUST 22 AND 23.

A SECTION OF ABOUT 1.3 KILOMETRES OF THE SLOW LANE OF TOLO HIGHWAY NORTHBOUND NEAR ITS JUNCTION WITH TAI PO TAI WO ROAD WILL BE CLOSED ON AUGUST 23 AND 24.
