CHIEF SECRETARY COMMENDS ST JOHN AMBULANCE BRIGADE

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THE ST JOHN AMBULANCE BRIGADE IS EXPANDING ITS ACTIVITIES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES TO MEET THE EVER GROWING DEMAND OF THE NEW TOWNS, THE CHIEF SECRETARY, SIR PHILIP HADDON-CAVE, SAID AT THE BRIGADE'S ANNUAL INSPECTION AND MARCH PAST TODAY (SUNDAY).

THREE MORE COMBINED ASSOCIATION TRAINING CENTRES AND BRIGADE DIVISIONAL HEADQUARTERS WILL BE ESTABLISHED IN TSUEN WAN, TAI PO AND YUEN LONG BEFORE THE END OF THE CURRENT FINANCIAL YEAR, HE SAID.

AS GROWING NUMBERS OF PEOPLE ENJOY MORE LEISURE AND RECREATIONAL PURSUITS, DEMANDS ON THE BRIGADE'S SERVICES WILL INCREASE, HE ADDED.

LAST YEAR, MEMBERS OF THE BRIGADE SPENT OVER 125 000 HOURS ON FIRST AID AND AMBULANCE DUTIES, WHICH SIR PHILIP DESCRIBED AS +A GRAPHIC MEASURE+ OF THE BRIGADE'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE COMMUNITY.

THE TEXT OF SIR PHILIP'S SPEECH FOLLOWS:

+IT IS A GREAT PLEASURE TO BE HERE THIS MORNING AS THE REVIEWING OFFICER AT THIS ANNUAL PARADE AND TO PRESENT TROPHIES AND LONG SERVICE MEDALS.

+SINCE IT STARTED ITS WORK IN HONG KONG 67 YEARS AGO, THE ST JOHN AMBULANCE BRIGADE HAS BEEN PROVIDING FIRST AID SERVICES AT ATHLETICS MEETINGS, BEACHES AND SWIMMING POOLS, FOOTBALL MATCHES, RACE MEETINGS, FAIRS, WALKATHONS AND AT NUMEROUS OTHER FUNCTIONS WHERE NUMBERS OF PEOPLE GATHER AS SPECTATORS OR AS ACTIVE PARTICIPANTS AND A RISK FACTOR EXISTS. THE BRIGADE ALSO PROVIDES A LIMITED FREE AMBULANCE SERVICE TO THE PUBLIC. APART FROM ATTACHMENTS TO FIRST AID TEAMS, THE CADET SECTION OF THE BRIGADE ALSO PLAYS AN ACTIVE PART IN A VARIETY OF PROFICIENCY AND LEADERSHIP TRAINING PROGRAMMES.

+A GRAPHIC MEASURE OF THE BRIGADE'S CONTRIBUTION TO THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF THE COMMUNITY IS THAT LAST YEAR MEMBERS SPENT OVER 125 000 HOURS ON FIRST AID AND AMBULANCE DUTIES. THIS IS, INDEED, A RECORD TO BE PROUD OF. HONG KONG IS FORTUNATE TO HAVE SO MANY MEN, WOMEN AND YOUNG PEOPLE WHO ARE PREPARED TO DEVOTE THEIR FREE TIME TO VOLUNTARY WORK. THE PRESENCE OF QUALIFIED FIRST AID PERSONNEL INSTILLS A FEELING OF CONFIDENCE AMONG MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC IN THE EVENT OF AN EMERGENCY AND IT IS A MANIFESTATION OF THAT SPIRIT OF COMMUNITY SERVICE WHICH REALLY IS SO CHARACTERISTIC OF HONG KONG.

+AS HONG KONG DEVELOPS AND AS INCREASING NUMBERS OF PEOPLE ENJOY MORE LEISURE AND RECREATIONAL PURSUITS, THE DEMANDS ON THE SERVICES OF THE BRIGADE WILL INEVITABLY INCREASE.

/+PRESENTLY, THE

+PRESENTLY, THE BRIGADE IS EXPANDING ITS ACTIVITIES IN THE NEW TERRITORIES TO MEET THE EVER GROWING DEMAND OF THE NEW TOWNS; AND THREE MORE COMBINED ASSOCIATION TRAINING CENTRES AND BRIGADE DIVISIONAL HEADQUARTERS ARE TO BE ESTABLISHED IN TSUEN WAN, TAI PO AND YUEN LONG BEFORE THE END OF THIS FINANCIAL YEAR. THE FIRST SUCH COMBINED CENTRE IN SHA TIN WAS OPENED LAST YEAR. ALTHOUGH THE GOVERNMENT HAS FINANCED THE BUILDING OF THESE CENTRES, MANY BENEFACTORS HAVE DONATED GENEROUSLY TOWARDS THE COST OF FITTING OUT THE NEW PREMISES AND THE PURCHASE OF EQUIPMENT. IN THESE AND OTHER CENTRES, THE BRIGADE WILL ENSURE THAT MEMBERS ARE KEPT UP-TO-DATE ON MODERN FIRST AID TECHNIQUES.

+I AM CONFIDENT THAT, UNDER THE ABLE LEADERSHIP OF THE COMMISSIONER, MR CHIU, AND WITH THE SUPPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN OF THE ST JOHN COUNCIL, MR MARDEN, THE BRIGADE WILL BE ABLE TO RESPOND TO ANY NEW CHALLENGE WITH ITS TRADITIONAL ENTHUSIASM AND INNOVATIVE INGENUITY.

+I CONGRATULATE ALL OF YOU ON PARADE THIS MORNING ON YOUR EXCELLENT BEARING AND APPEARANCE AND I WISH YOU EVERY SUCCESS IN THE FUTURE.+

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ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES TO GO METRIC

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THE ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES INDUSTRY WILL BE THE NEXT TO GO METRIC FOLLOWING THE PIECE GOODS AND TAILORING TRADES, THE METRICATION COMMITTEE ANNOUNCED TODAY (SUNDAY).

AS FROM TOMORROW, TV SCREENS WILL BE MEASURED IN 'CENTIMETRES' INSTEAD OF 'INCHES', AND REFRIGERATOR CAPACITIES WILL BE EXPRESSED IN 'LITRES' RATHER THAN 'CUBIC FEET'.

+REFRIGERATORS AND TV SETS ARE TWO OF THE MOST POPULAR ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES IN THE TRADE,+ SAID THE COMMITTEE'S SPOKESMAN, +AND IT WILL BE MOST SUITABLE TO START OFF THE TRADE'S METRICATION PROGRAMME WITH THESE TWO.+

HE SAID AN ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES WORKING PANEL HAD ALREADY BEEN FORMED UNDER THE METRICATION COMMITTEE TO COORDINATE MATTERS ARISING FROM THE CHANGEOVER PROCESS OF THESE TWO APPLIANCES.

THE CONVERSION OF OTHER ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES WOULD BE TACKLED AT A LATER STAGE, HE ADDED.

HE SAID: +THE ENTIRE CONVERSION PROCESS WOULD TAKE ABOUT A YEAR TO COMPLETE.

+BY THEN, ALL ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES WILL BE SOLD IN METRIC UNITS,+ HE SAID.

THE SPOKESMAN DISCLOSED PLANS TO PRODUCE A QUESTIONNAIRE IN FEBRUARY 1983 TO REVIEW PROGRESS IN THIS AREA, AND TO TEST PUBLIC RESPONSE TO THE MOVE.

HE SAID IMPORTERS OF ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES HAD ALREADY GIVEN SUPPORT TO THE METRICATION PROGRAMME BY AGREEING TO USE METRIC UNITS IN THEIR CATALOGUES, PRICE LISTS AND PROMOTION LITERATURE.

RETAILERS IN THE TRADE WILL DISPLAY POSTERS AND CONVERSION CHARTS FOR HOME ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES IN THEIR SHOPS.

THESE PUBLICITY MATERIALS ARE PRODUCED AND DISTRIBUTED BY THE ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES WORKING GROUP TO FACILITATE THE CHANGEOVER.

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SOUTHEAST ASIAN GEOTECHNICAL CONFERENCE

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THE SECRETARY FOR LANDS AND WORKS, MR DAVID MCDONALD, WILL OPEN THE SEVENTH SOUTHEAST ASIAN GEOTECHNICAL CONFERENCE AT THE REGENT HOTEL AT 10 AM TOMORROW (MONDAY).

THE GEOTECHNICAL CONTROL OFFICE OF THE ENGINEERING DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT WILL BE ONE OF 31 EXHIBITORS.

THE GCO DISPLAY WILL FEATURE PHOTOGRAPHS AND PUBLICATIONS ILLUSTRATING THE ACTIVITIES OF THE GEOTECHNICAL CONTROL OFFICE, WITH PARTICULAR EMPHASIS ON SLOPE STABILITY AND SLOPE-RELATED PROJECTS.

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FOUR MODERN MARKETS TO OPEN IN NT SOON

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FOUR NEWLY COMPLETED MODERN MARKETS BUILT AT KWAI CHUNG, TUEN MUN AND SAI KUNG WILL SOON BE OPENED TO THE PUBLIC.

THE MARKETS, TO BE MANAGED BY THE NEW TERRITORIES SERVICES DEPARTMENT, FORM PART OF THE DEPARTMENT'S PLAN TO PROVIDE PROPER MARKET FACILITIES TO RESIDENTS IN RAPIDLY DEVELOPING NEW TOWNS.

THE FIRST NEW MARKET TO OPEN WILL BE THE WING FONG STREET MARKET IN KWAI CHUNG. MORE THAN 120 STALL HOLDERS WILL START BUSINESS AT THE MARKET ON DECEMBER 1.

APART FROM TAKING IN THE UNLICENSED HAWKERS NOW PLYING AT AN OPEN SPACE UNDERNEATH A FLYOVER AT TAI LIN PEI ROAD NEAR KWAI HING ESTATE, THE MARKET WILL HAVE 23 OTHER STALLS DESIGNED FOR SELLING MEAT, POULTRY, FISH AND ICE WHICH WERE LEASED TO OPERATORS AT A PUBLIC AUCTION LAST FRIDAY (NOVEMBER 19). THE MARKET COSTS \$5.8 MILLION TO BUILD.

ON THE ROOF OF THE BUILDING THERE IS A PLEASANT GARDEN WITH FLOWER BEDS AND BENCHES AND A CHILDREN'S PLAYGROUND.

THE SECOND NEW MARKET BUILDING TO COME INTO OPERATION SOON WILL BE THE SAN HUI MARKET IN TUEN MUN.

FINISHING TOUCHES TO THE MARKET BUILDING IS NOW BEING MADE AND IT IS EXPECTED TO BE READY AND OPEN TO THE PUBLIC WITHIN THE NEXT TWO MONTHS.

MORE THAN 300 ON-STREET HAWKERS AND TRADERS PLYING AT TEMPORARY MARKETS AND HAWKER BAZAARS AT SUN HUI WILL BE HOUSED IN THIS NEW MARKET COMPLEX.

THE THIRD NEW MARKET DUE TO BE COMPLETED EARLY NEXT YEAR IS LOCATED NEAR CHI LOK FA YUEN IN TUEN MUN NEW TOWN. THIS MARKET WILL HAVE 110 STALLS.

THE FOURTH NEW MARKET WILL BE THE TUI MIN HOI MARKET IN SAI KUNG.

IT WILL BE A SINGLE STOREY BUILDING AND WILL HAVE 34 STALLS FOR VARIOUS TRADES.

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SHAM SHUI PO CHILDREN'S CHOIR GIVES FIRST PERFORMANCE

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THE SHAM SHUI PO CHILDREN'S CHOIR WHICH WAS FORMED RECENTLY GAVE ITS FIRST PERFORMANCE TODAY (SUNDAY) AT THE SHAM SHUI PO SCHOOL HALL TO CELEBRATE ITS INCEPTION.

IT WAS ALSO THE INAUGURATION OF THE CHOIR'S MANAGEMENT COMMITTEE FIRST-TERM OFFICE BEARERS, OFFICIATED BY THE SHAM SHUI PO DISTRICT OFFICER, MR STEPHEN IP, AND MUSIC ADMINISTRATOR OF THE MUSIC OFFICE, MR M.C. LUKE.

SPEAKING AT THE CEREMONY, MR IP SAID THE CHOIR WAS FORMED TO TRAIN LOCAL CHILDREN WITH MUSICAL TALENT, PROMOTE THEIR INTEREST IN MUSIC AND PROVIDE A HEALTHY MEANS OF GROUP RECREATION.

HE SAID HE WAS PLEASED THE DISTRICT BOARD HAD ALSO GIVEN ITS SUPPORT BY ALLOCATING \$30 000 THIS YEAR FOR THE CHOIR'S TRAINING AND ACTIVITIES WITH ANOTHER \$60 000 TO \$80 000 BEING SET ASIDE FOR NEXT YEAR.

+FURTHERMORE, SOME BOARD MEMBERS HAVE ALSO TAKEN UP THE MANAGEMENT OF THE CHOIR AND I AM SURE IT WILL HAVE BETTER ACHIEVEMENT UNDER THEIR GUIDANCE,+ HE SAID.

IN THE COMING MONTHS, A RECRUITMENT FOR TUTORS, CONDUCTORS AND CHOIR MEMBERS WILL TAKE PLACE AND THERE ARE PLANS TO EXPAND THE CHOIR TO INCLUDE A SENIOR AND JUNIOR SECTIONS.

AT PRESENT, THE CHOIR HAS 77 MEMBERS, AGED BETWEEN EIGHT AND 12, WHO ARE EITHER LIVING OR STUDYING IN SHAM SHUI PO.

+MICRO+ SOCCER TOURNAMENT
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A TERRITORY-WIDE FIVE-A-SIDE FOOTBALL COMPETITION CURRENTLY BEING ORGANISED IS EXPECTED TO DRAW MORE THAN 400 TEAMS INVOLVING OVER 2 000 PLAYERS.

THE COMPETITION IS ORGANISED BY THE RECREATION AND SPORT SERVICE (RSS) OF THE RECREATION AND CULTURE DEPARTMENT WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF THE HONG KONG FOOTBALL REFEREE ASSOCIATION AND THE SPONSORSHIP OF CARLSBERG.

THE RSS RECREATION AND SPORT OFFICER (TEAM GAMES), MR THOMSON CHAN, SAID TODAY (SUNDAY): +OUR AIM IS TO INTRODUCE AND PROMOTE FIVE-A-SIDE FOOTBALL IN HONG KONG.+

+FIVE-A-SIDE FOOTBALL,+ HE POINTED OUT, +IS EVOLVED FROM TRAINING EXERCISES PRACTISED BY MOST PROFESSIONAL LEAGUE CLUBS IN BRITAIN.+

+THE GAME DEMANDS A HIGH DEGREE OF MOBILITY SPEED AND BALL CONTROL SKILLS,+ MR CHAN SAID.

+THIS GAME SHOULD BECOME VERY POPULAR IN HONG KONG BECAUSE IT CAN BE PLAYED IN A SMALL PITCH, ABOUT ONE-THIRD THE SIZE OF A REGULAR FOOTBALL PITCH, AND CAN BE PLAYED BOTH INDOORS AND OUTDOORS.

+BESIDES, HONG KONG PLAYERS ARE GOOD AT BALL CONTROL,+ HE NOTED.

KNOCK-OUT MATCHES ARE BEING HELD IN SEVEN DISTRICTS BETWEEN NOVEMBER THIS YEAR AND JANUARY NEXT YEAR, LEADING TO THE CHAMPIONSHIP WHICH WILL BE HELD AT THE MACPHERSON PLAYGROUND IN KOWLOON ON JANUARY 22 AND 23 NEXT YEAR.

EACH MATCH LASTS 12 MINUTES WITH A TWO-MINUTE BREAK AT HALF-TIME.

TROPHIES WILL BE AWARDED TO THE CHAMPION AND RUNNER-UP TEAMS OF EACH DISTRICT AND PLAYERS WILL EACH RECEIVE A COMMEMORATIVE MEDAL.

THE SERVICE HAS ALSO PREPARED A BOOKLET ON THE BACKGROUND AND RULES OF THE GAME. THESE WILL BE DISTRIBUTED TO PARTICIPATING TEAMS.

THE EVENT IS OPEN TO PEOPLE OVER 14 AND ENTRY FEE IS \$3 PER TEAM.

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NEW LEAFLETS ON COUNTRY PARKS PUBLISHED
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DO YOU KNOW WHAT A NATURE TRAIL IS AND HOW MANY THERE ARE IN HONG KONG OR IF KITE-FLYING IS ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR RECREATION ACTIVITIES IN THE CLEAR WATER BAY COUNTRY PARK?

ANSWERS TO THESE QUESTIONS, IN ADDITION TO A WEALTH OF OTHER INFORMATION RANGING FROM TRANSPORT GUIDELINES TO THE PARTICULAR TYPES OF FLORA AND FAUNA LIKELY TO BE FOUND IN HONG KONG, ARE CONTAINED IN FOUR NEW LEAFLETS ON COUNTRY PARKS AND SPECIAL AREAS JUST PUBLISHED BY THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT.

AREAS COVERED BY THE FOUR FULL-COLOUR, BILINGUAL LEAFLETS ARE THE CLEAR WATER BAY COUNTRY PARK, THE TUNG LUNG FORT SPECIAL AREA, HONG KONG'S NATURE TRAILS, THE TAI PO KAU SPECIAL AREA, THE MAI PO MARSHES AND THE YIM TSO HA EGRETRY.

THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SERVICES DESIGNED THE LEAFLETS, WHICH ARE SPONSORED BY THE CHARTERED BANK AS A COMMUNITY SERVICE. CARTOGRAPHIC MAPS IN THE LEAFLETS WERE PREPARED BY THE LANDS DEPARTMENT.

COLOURFUL PHOTOGRAPHS DEPICTING SOME OF THE SCENERY AND THE SPECIAL TYPES OF FLORA FROM THESE AREAS ARE ALSO FOUND IN THE LEAFLETS.

THE LEAFLETS ARE AVAILABLE FREE OF CHARGE FROM THE AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES DEPARTMENT HEADQUARTERS ON THE 12TH FLOOR OF CANTON ROAD GOVERNMENT OFFICES IN KOWLOON, THE MARKETING AND ADVERTISING OFFICE OF THE GOVERNMENT INFORMATION SERVICES ON THE SECOND FLOOR OF BASKERVILLE HOUSE IN ICE HOUSE STREET AS WELL AS A NUMBER OF OTHER RELATED OUTLETS.

AMONG THESE COLLECTION POINTS ARE THE CITY AND NEW TERRITORIES DISTRICT OFFICES, COUNTRY PARK VISITOR CENTRES AT ABERDEEN AND TAI MEI TUK, AND MANAGEMENT CENTRES INSIDE COUNTRY PARKS AT TAI PO KAU, SHING MUN, MAN YEE, QUARRY BAY, KAM SHAN AND CLEAR WATER BAY.

COUNTRY PARKS IN HONG KONG OCCUPY ABOUT 40 PER CENT OF THE TERRITORY'S TOTAL LAND AREA, WITH A RECORD NUMBER OF 8.1 MILLION VISITS MADE TO THE PARKS IN 1981.
